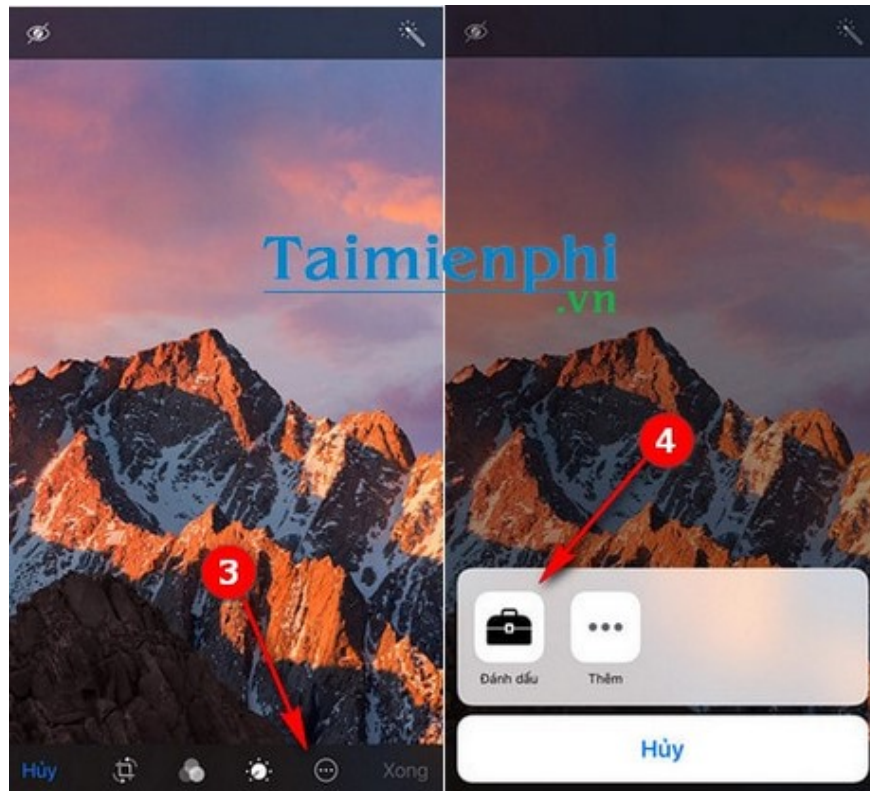
How to edit photos on iOS 10

Step 1 : Access the Photos app.

Step 2: Choose any image and select the **Settings** icon below the image.

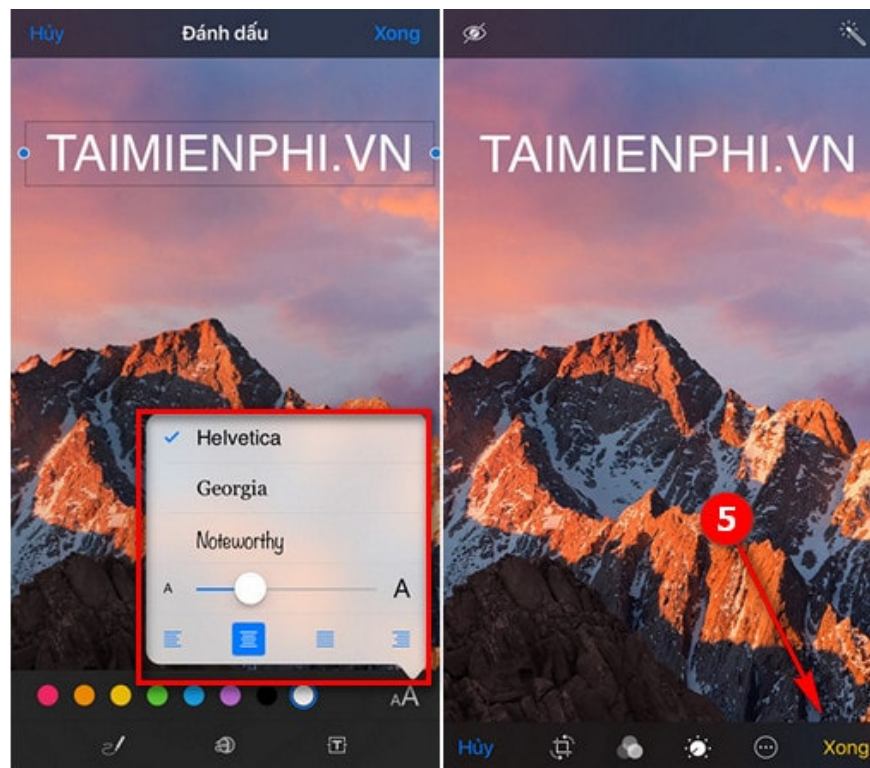


Step 3: Tap the three-dot icon to access additional settings. A pop-up will appear; tap the "Markup" option to start marking and annotating directly on the image.



Step 4: There will be three options allowing you to draw, create text, and scan text.

In the text options, the application allows users to delete, edit, or duplicate text with just one button press. When editing text, users can customize the text color, font, and size.



Users simply click and drag to move the object. To deselect an object, simply select 'Cancel'.

Step 5: After creating the image caption, press **Done** twice to complete the process.

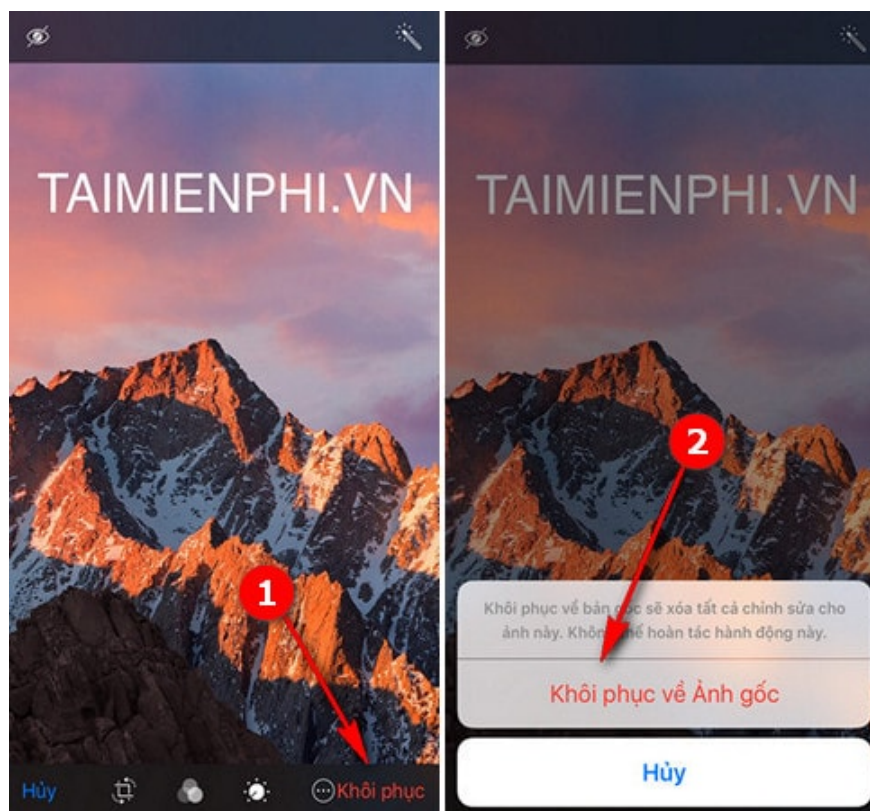
How to restore the original image

After marking an image, you may want to restore it to its original state without having to delete the markings. Follow these steps to undo the action.

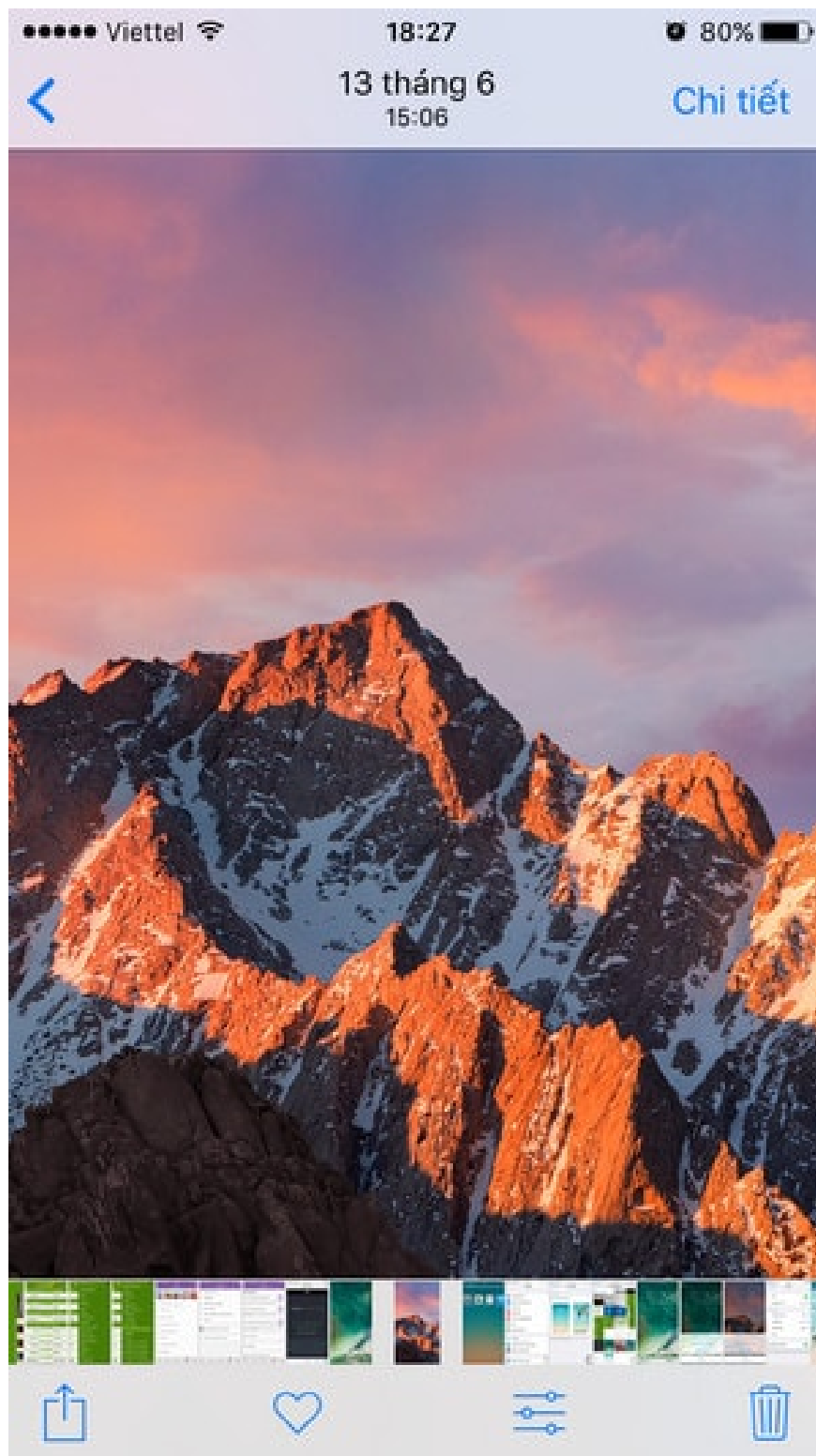
Step 1 : Select the image you just marked and continue following the instructions from step 1 to step 2 of the image marking technique.

Step 2 : At this step, you will see a red Restore icon appear next to the three dots.

Simply click here to restore the image to its original state.



Step 3: The application will ask if you want to restore the original image. Press **Restore to Original Image** to undo all previous edits.
