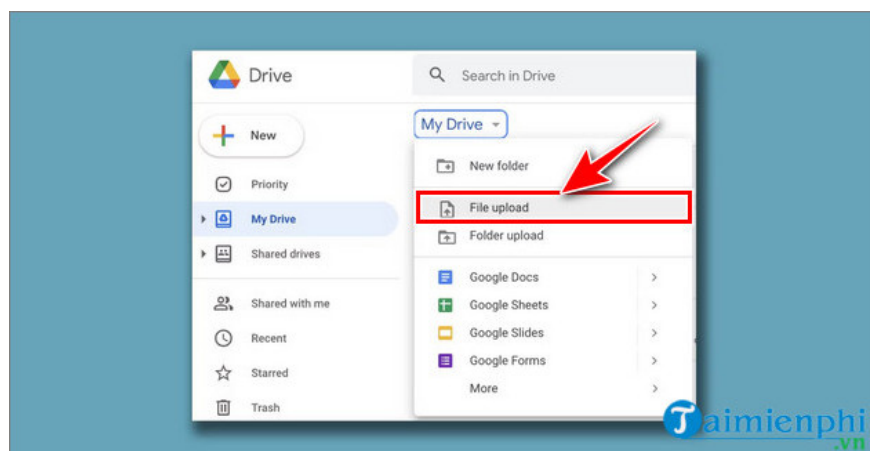
1. How to edit PDFs on Google Drive

Google Drive is a free cloud storage platform that allows you to open and edit PDF files online. You can convert PDFs to Google Docs for flexible content editing without needing specialized software.

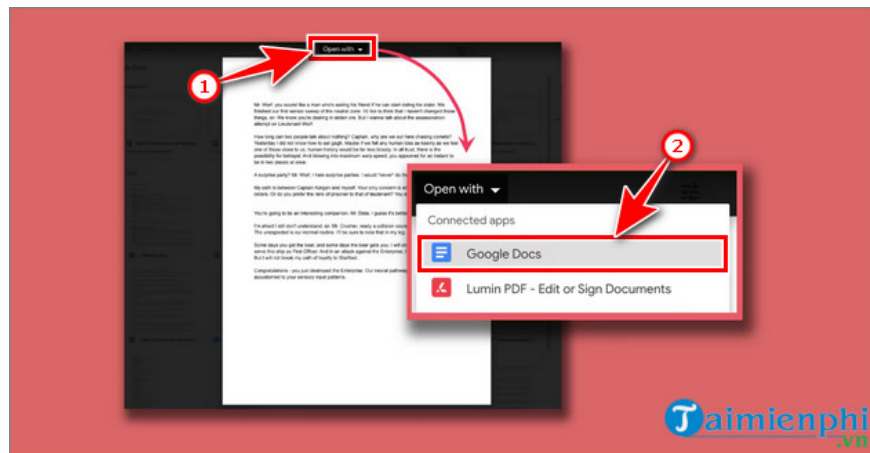

Step 1 : Upload the PDF file you want to edit to Google Drive using the File Upload button on your Google Drive page.

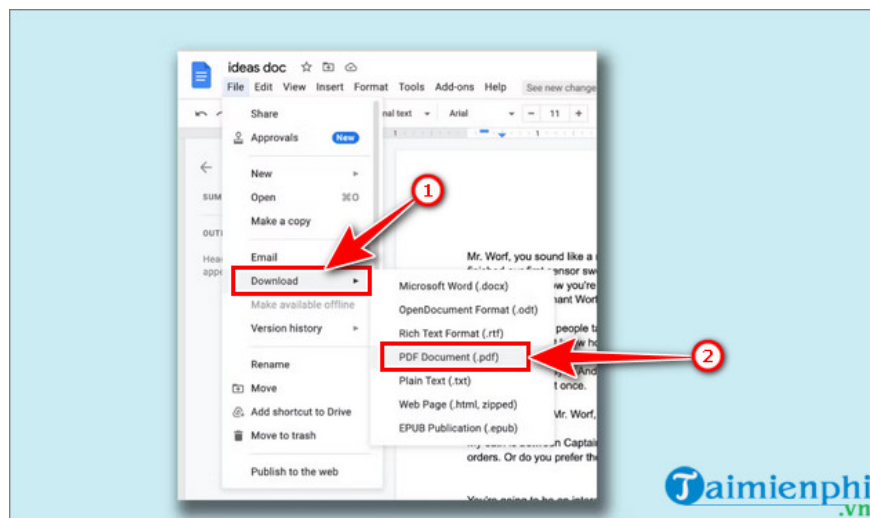


Step 2 : Click on the newly uploaded PDF file and select the "**Open with**" option at the top of the page. Choose Google Docs to open the PDF file as an editable file.

Step 4 : After completing the editing, you can download the file to your computer in PDF format.

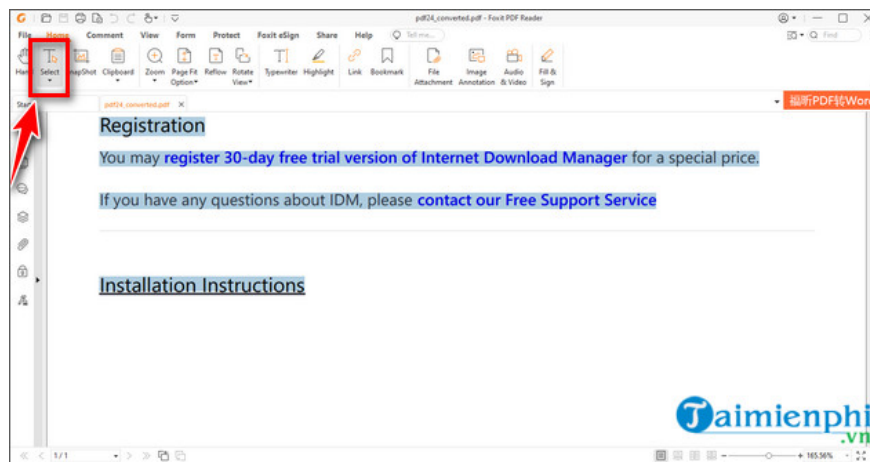


2. How to edit PDFs in Foxit Reader

Download **Foxit Reader** here.

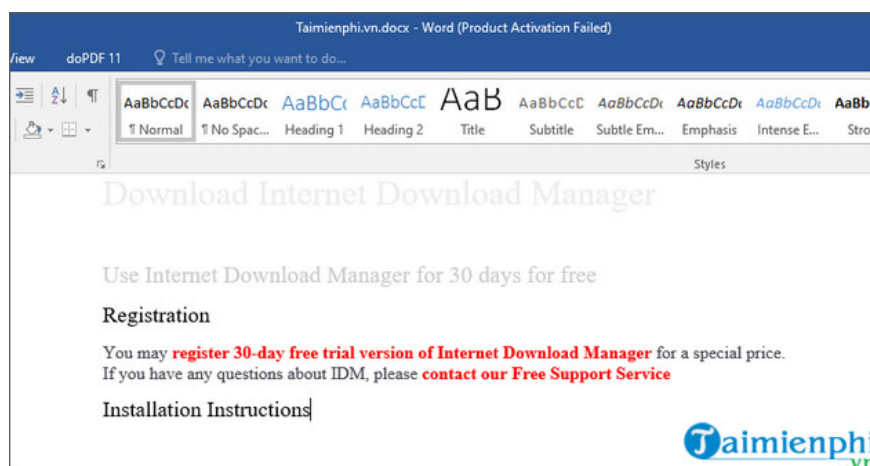
Step 1: Open the PDF file you need to edit using PDF reader software such as Foxit Reader.

- Then click on the "**Select**" option as shown in the image, then highlight the entire content of the PDF file (**Ctrl + A**) and copy that content using (**Ctrl + C**).



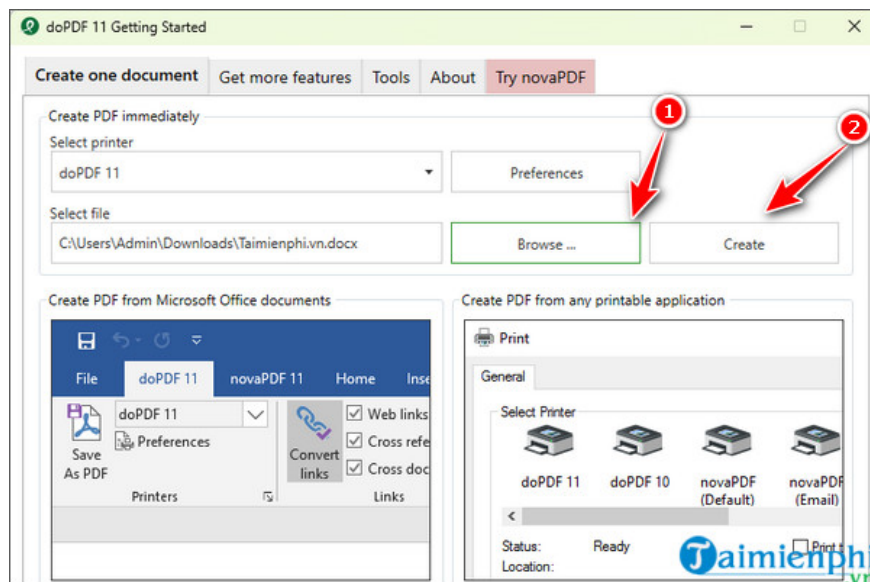
Step 2: Open **Microsoft Word** , then paste all the content you copied above into it.

- Here you can perform actions such as changing the content, editing the font, font style, or doing anything else you want.

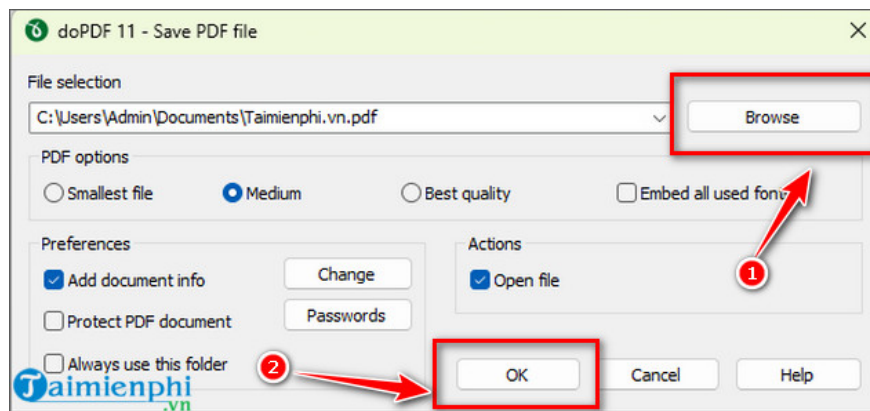


Step 3: Convert the Word document to PDF using the compact and free DoPDF tool. You can download the latest version here: **Download DoPDF** .

- **Open the DoPDF** software , select **Browser** to upload the Word file from step 2. Then select **Create** to convert the file.



Step 4: Click on **Browser** to select the folder to save the PDF file, then click **OK** to start the conversion process.



With today's PDF editing tools, you can easily change the content or extract data from a PDF file without having to recreate it from scratch.

Additionally, if more in-depth editing is needed, consider using free PDF editing software such as Foxit Reader or Adobe Acrobat. These tools support editing text in PDFs, adding notes, electronic signatures, and many other useful features.
