

How to edit quick call response on iPhone

On iOS 17 version, users can change the content of quick call response to their liking. This makes it easier for you to respond to others, with different audiences.

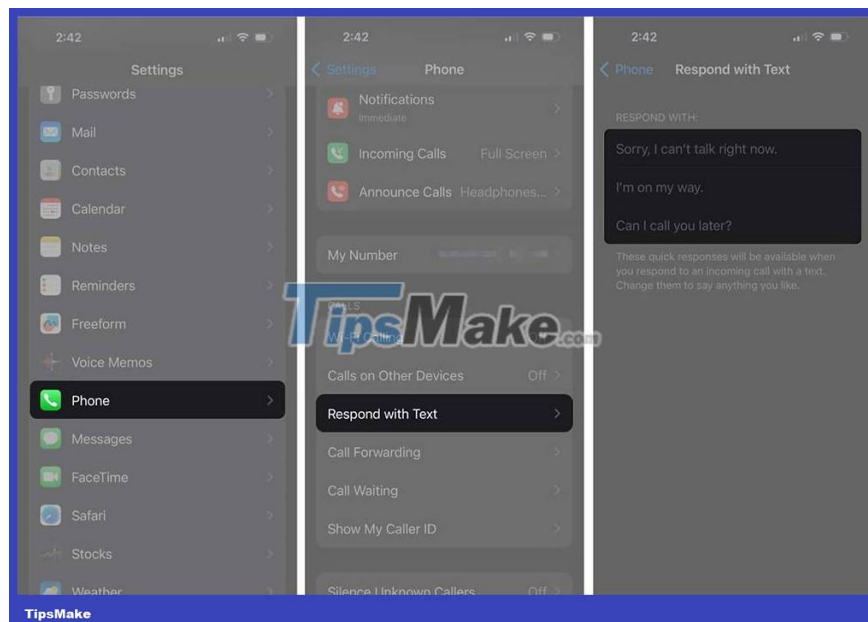
When there is an incoming call, if we cannot receive the call, we can text the other party through the iPhone call quick response messages available for you to choose from. And on iOS 17, users can completely change the responsive content as they like. This makes it easier for you to respond to others, with different audiences. However, you need to keep in mind that the quick response adjustment will be based on the existing response content. The following article will guide you to quickly respond to calls on iPhone.

Instructions for quick response to iPhone calls

Step 1:

You access **the Settings application** and then click on the Phone item. Next, switch to the new interface, we click **Respond with Text** in the Calls section to adjust the quick response to the call.

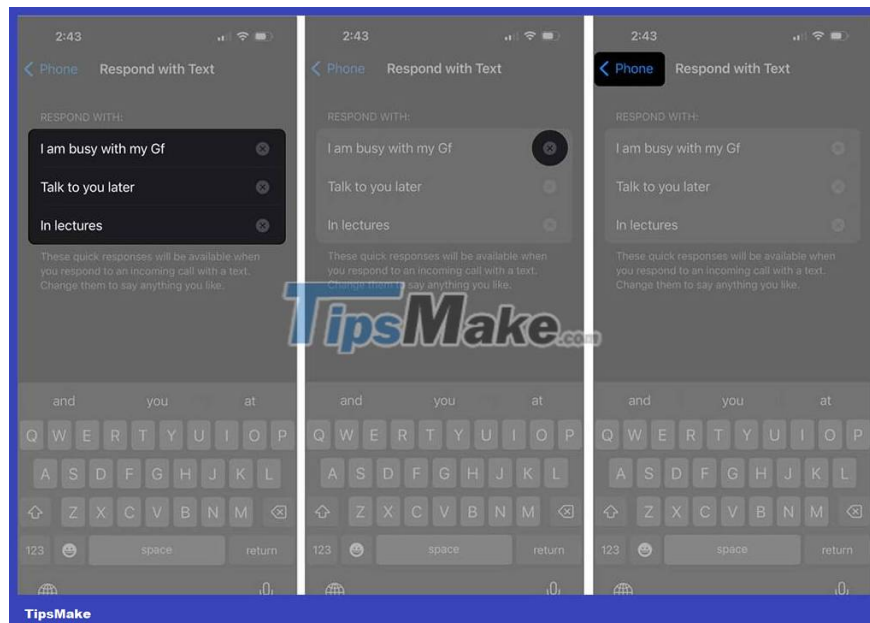
You will then see the default call responses on your iPhone.



Step 2:

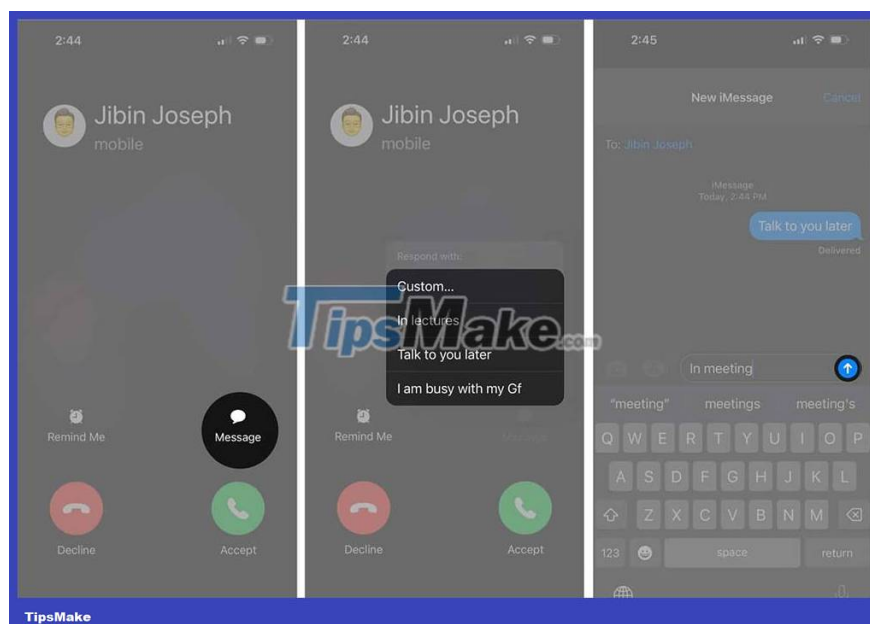
Now **click on the content of the call response you want to adjust**. Then you write the content that needs to be adjusted. If you want to remove the added feedback, click the x icon to delete it.

Finally, **click the Phone button** to save the new call response content.



Step 3:

When there is an incoming call that you cannot receive, we click on Message and then select the response that you edited earlier. Finally, the user sends a call response message.
