

How to effectively block ads on Twitter

How to turn off ads on Twitter

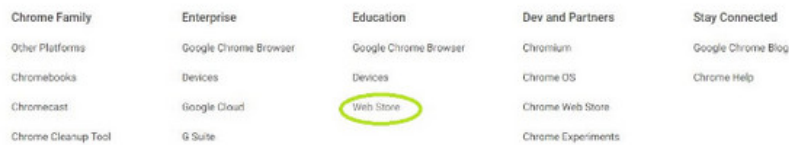
Download the latest version of Twitter here:

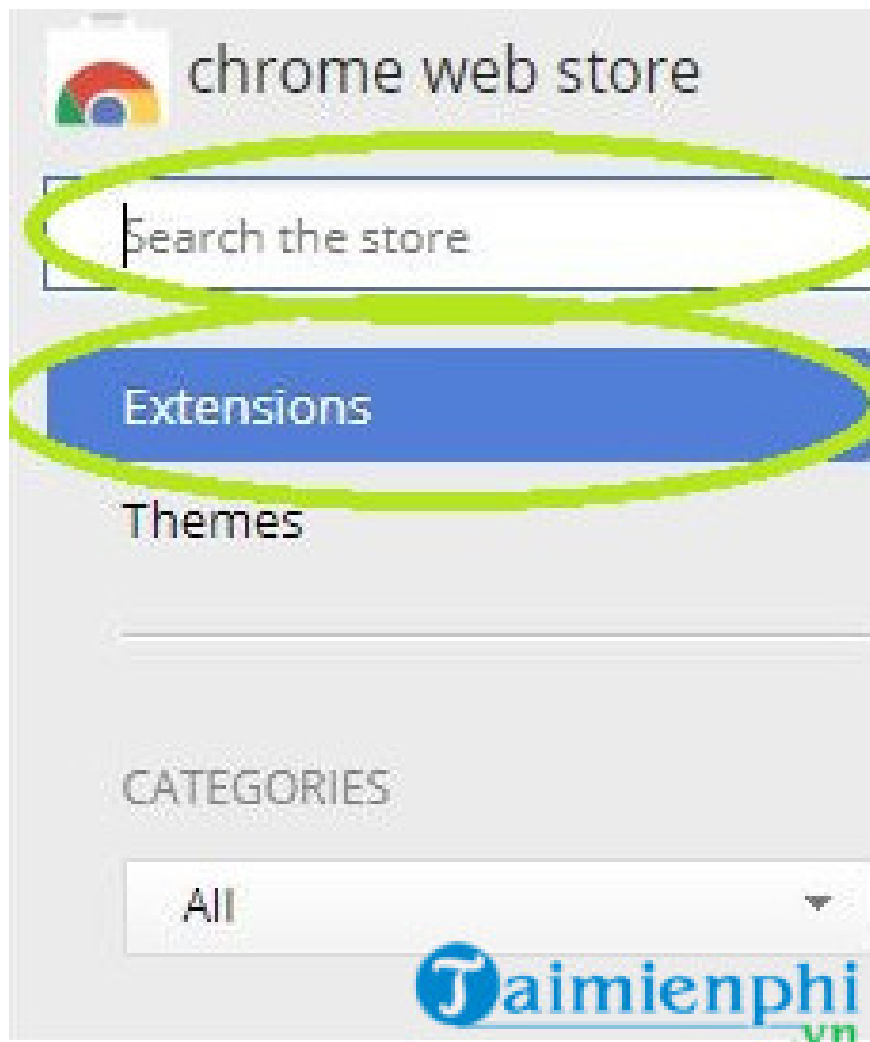
Refer to the content below to learn how to block ads on Twitter.

Step 1: Access the Chrome Web Store by typing www.google.com.vn/chrom/ into your browser's address bar and then pressing Enter.

In the window displayed on the screen, scroll down to find and click on **Web** store.



Step 2: In the Chrome Web Store window, type " **Promoted Tweet Block** " into the Search box in the upper left corner, click on Extensions, and then press **Enter** .



Step 3: In the search results list, find the "**Promoted Tweet Block**" item and click the "**Add to Chrome**" button in the upper right corner to install the extension on your browser.

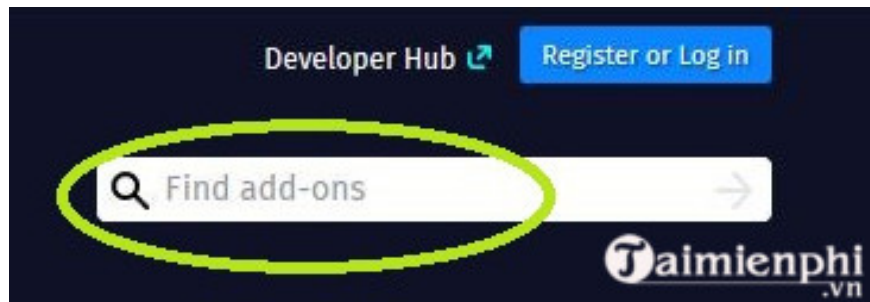
Step 4: A new window will now appear on the screen; click on "**Add extension** ".

With just these four simple steps, you can block ads on Twitter every time you log in using the Chrome browser.

The steps to block ads on Twitter in Firefox are similar to those in Chrome. Follow the steps below:

Step 1: Enter **addons.mozilla.org** into the Firefox browser's address bar and press Enter.

Step 2: Next, enter the keyword "**ublock**" into the search box located in the upper right corner.

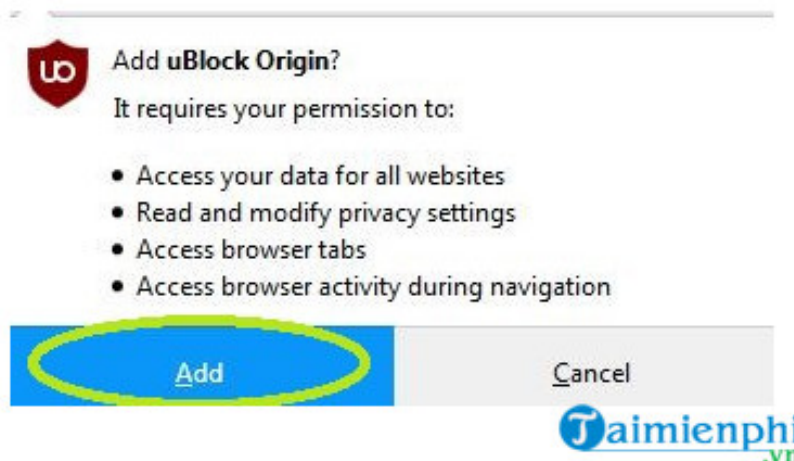


Step 3: In the search results list, find and click on **uBlock Origin** , then click on + **Add to Firefox** .

Step 4: A new window will appear on the screen; click "**Add**" here .



The process of installing Twitter ad blockers for Firefox is now complete. You can access Twitter again to check.
