

How to enable and disable the Screenshot tool in Firefox browser.

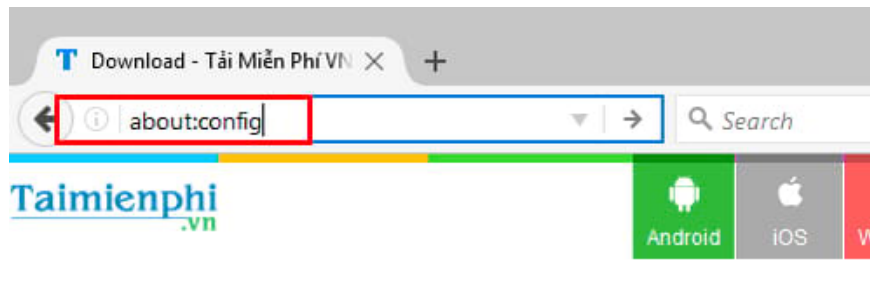

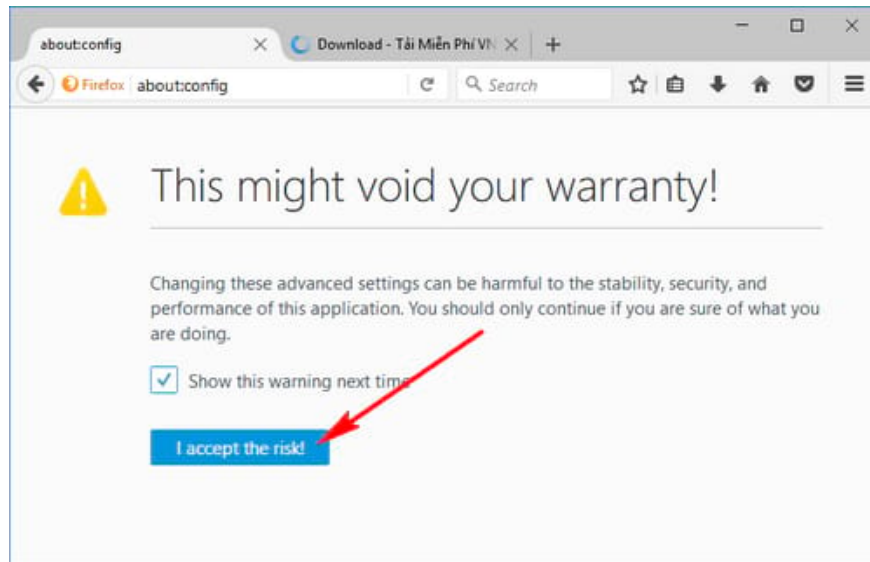
How to enable and disable the Screenshot tool in Firefox browser.

Step 1: To enable or disable the Screenshot tool , you need to download or update to the latest version of Firefox.

Step 2 : Open Firefox, type or copy **about:config** into the address bar and press Enter.

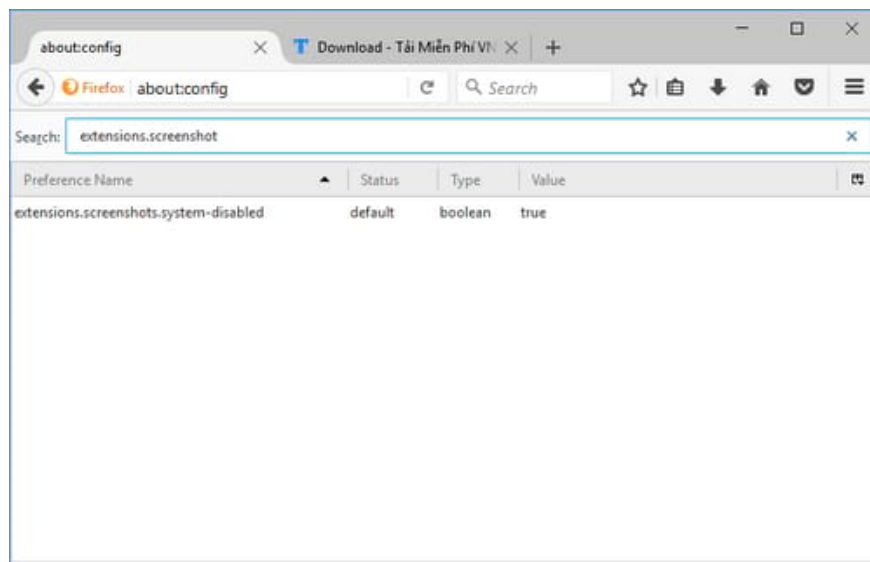


Step 3: When the warning message appears, press "**I accept the risk!**" to continue.

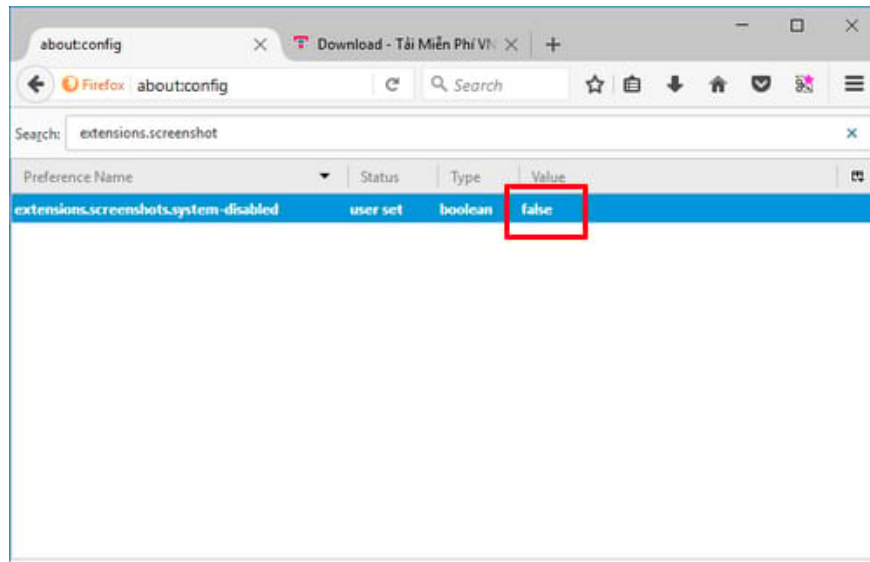


Step 4: In the **Search** box , enter the code **extensions.screenshot** .

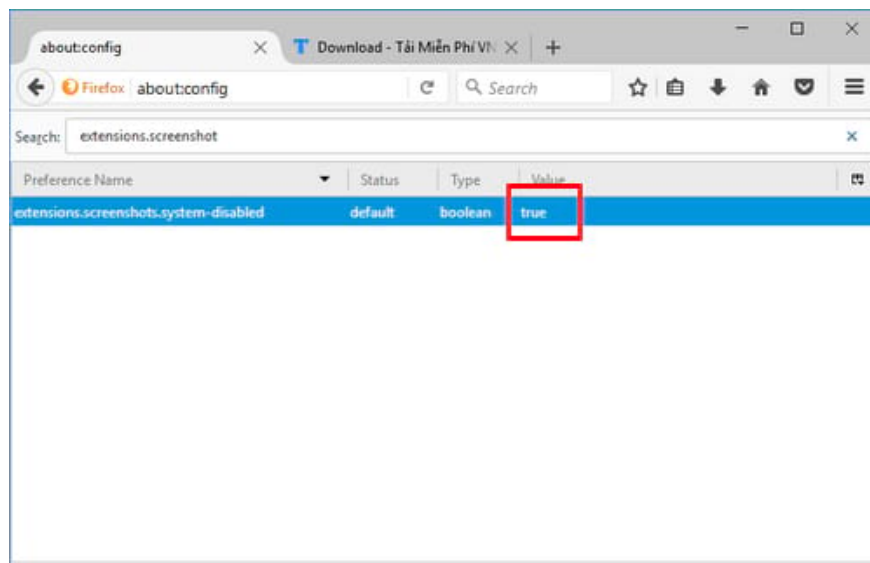
The results will be displayed immediately, as shown below.



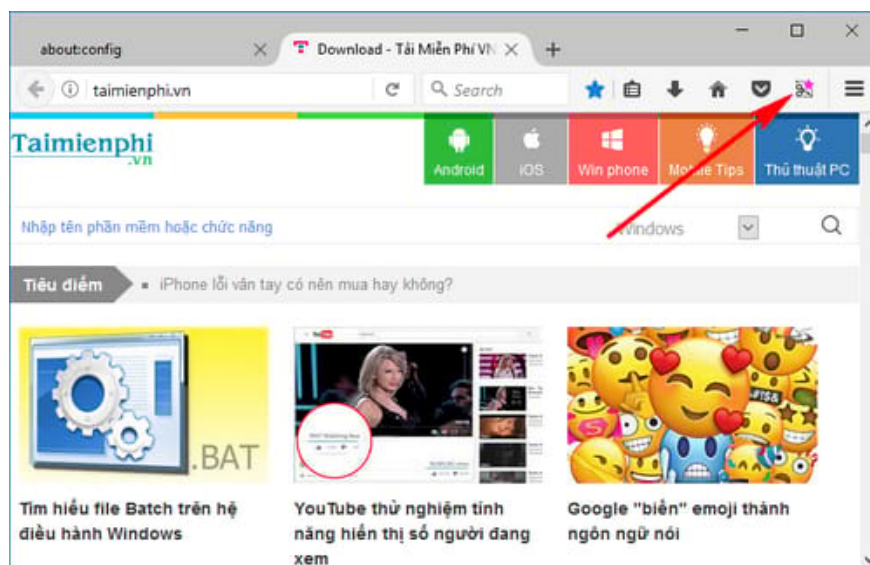
Step 5: To enable the **Screenshot** tool , double-click on **True** to change the value to **False**.



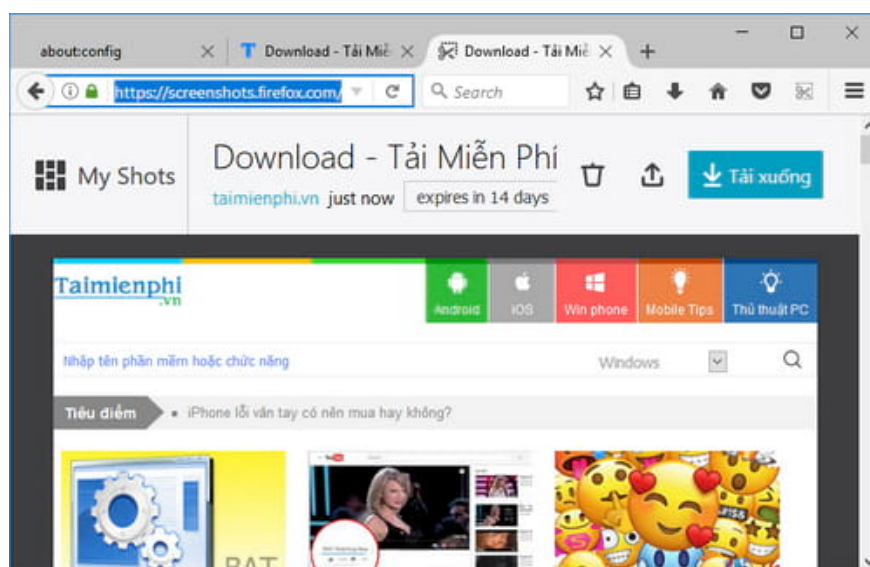
Conversely, to disable the Screenshot tool, change the value of this option to **True** .



You will see the change right on the Firefox status bar with a tool icon as shown below.



Firefox allows you to save screenshots to your device, but if you want to share them online, upload them to **screenshots.firefox.com** . This is a simple way to share images and store them for two weeks. If needed, you can delete the images early or change the storage time. To view saved images, click **My Shots**.



The Screenshot option in Firefox is very useful for capturing web pages, but you can enable or disable this tool as you wish. With the instructions above, you can customize the tool to suit your needs. If you don't like using the built-in tool, you can try other add-ons like **NativeShot** , a popular screenshot tool.
