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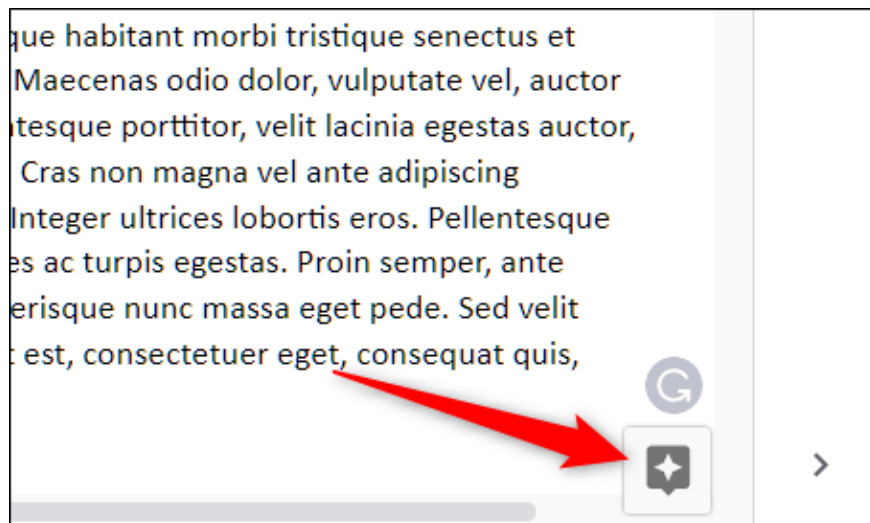
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How to find and add citations in Google Docs

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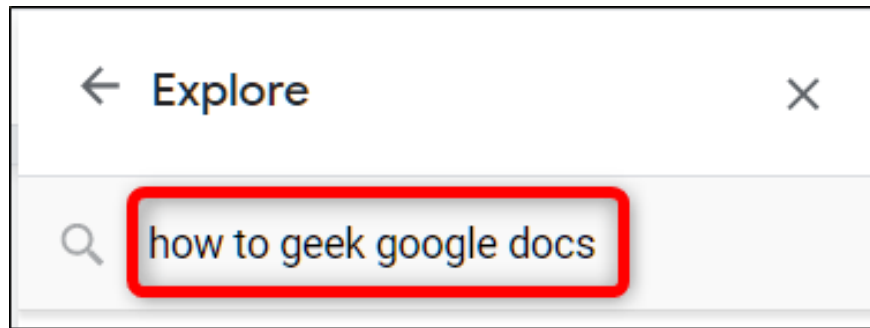
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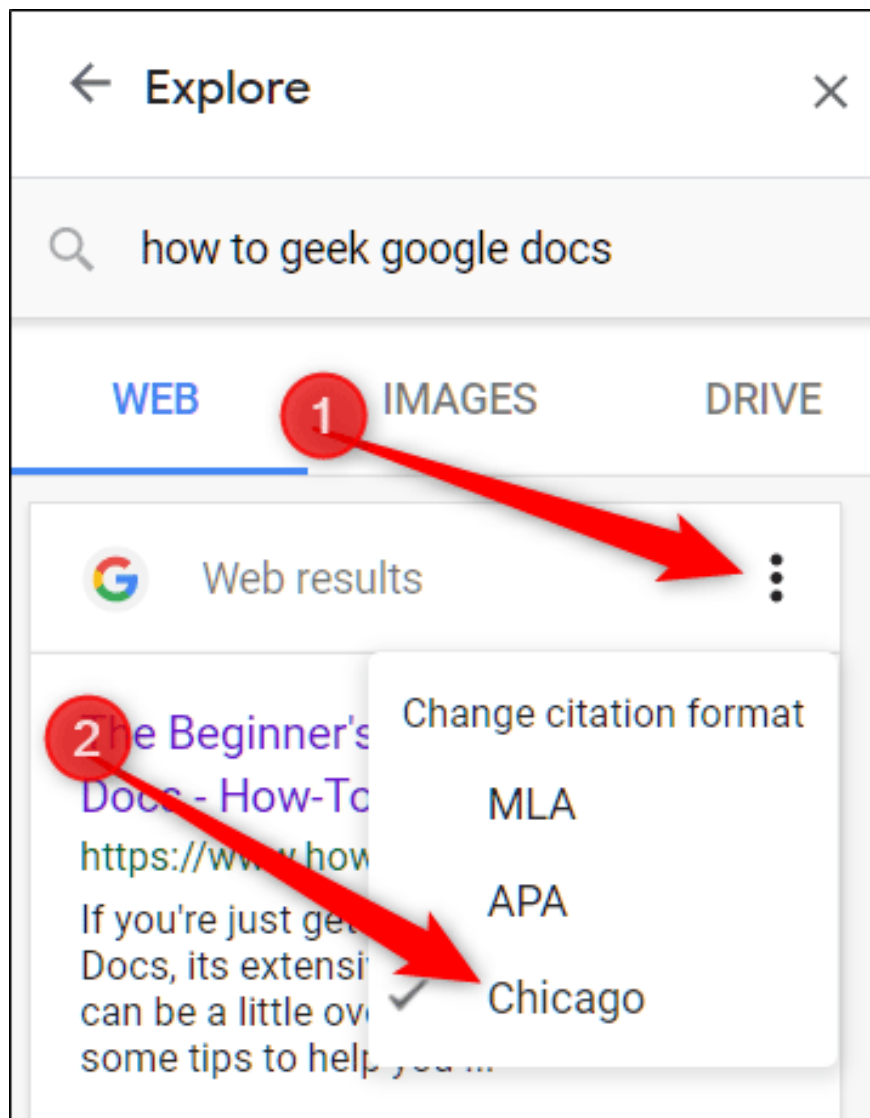

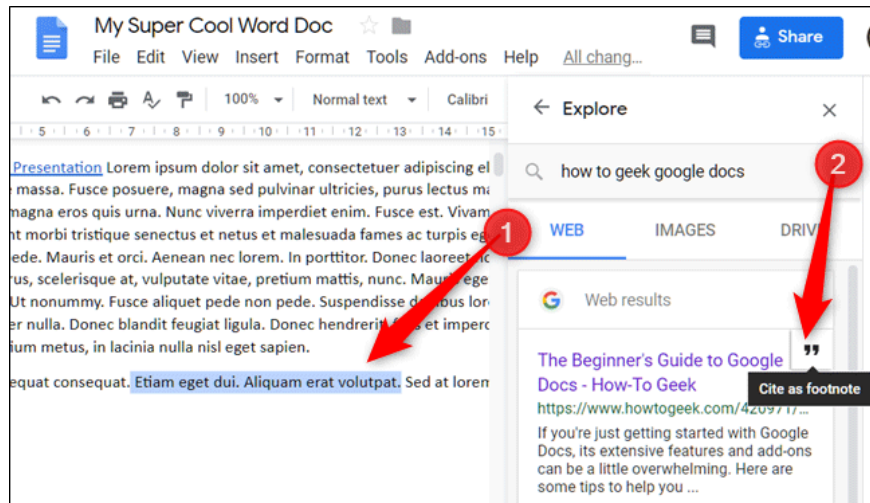
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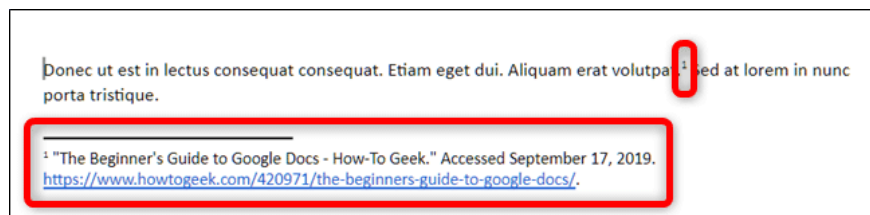
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After clicking on the icon, Docs will number the citation and citation links in the footnote.
