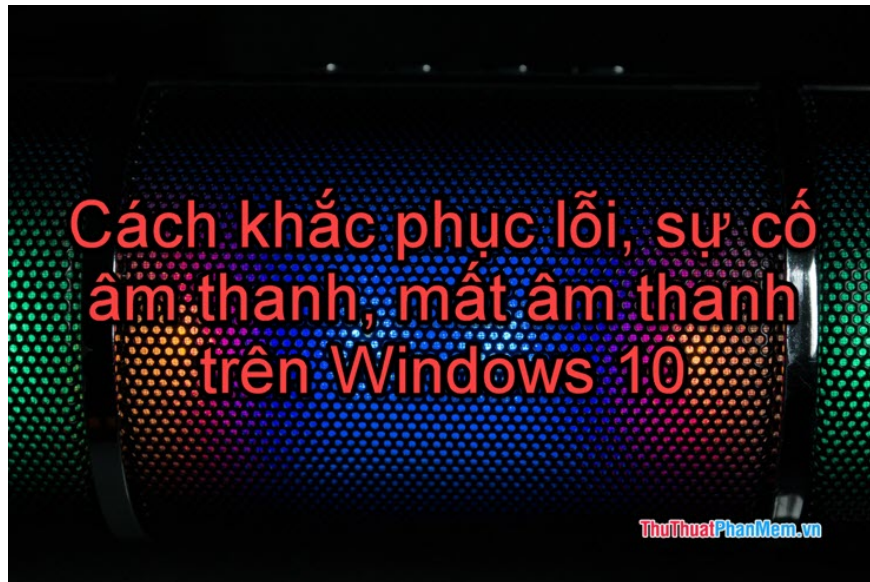


# How to fix audio loss sound issue on Windows 10

## How to fix errors, audio problems, sound loss in Windows 10

### 1. Check the audio connector

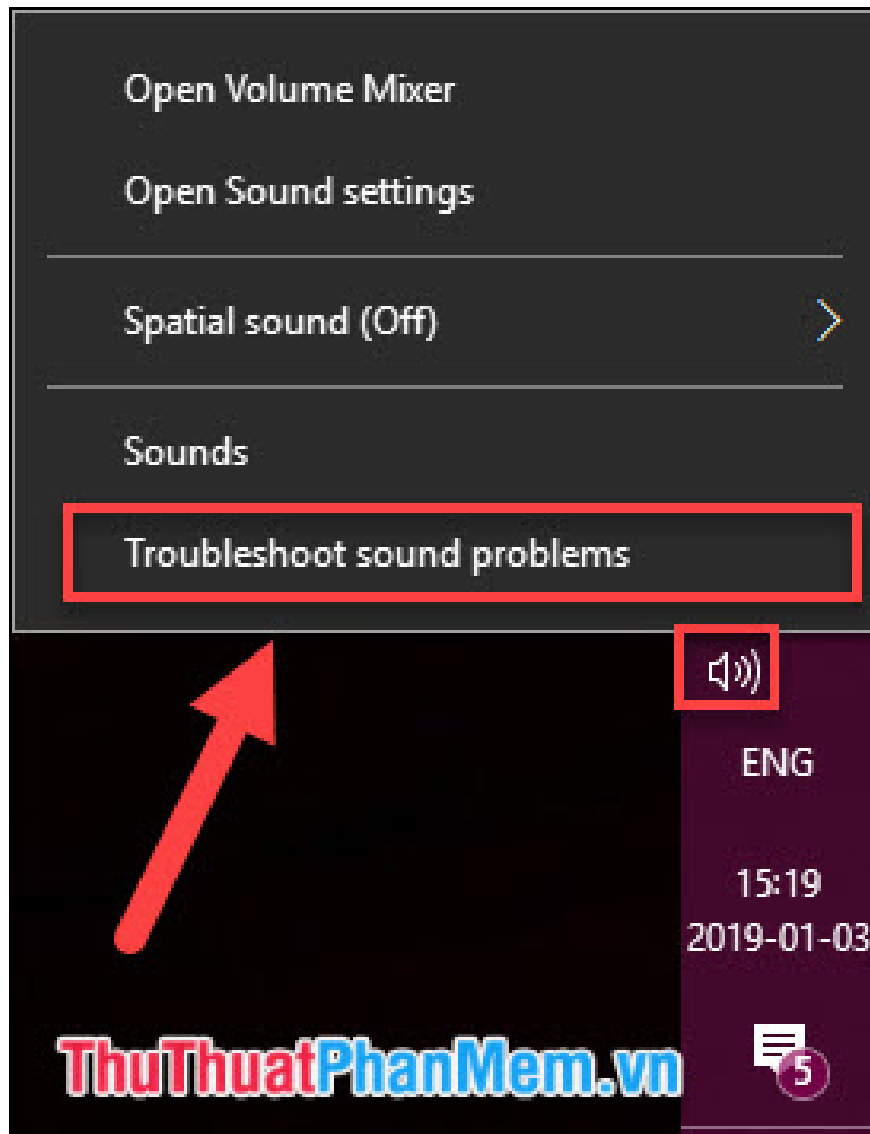
The first thing you need to do is to check the jack, the connection port to make sure that there is no physical impact preventing the connection between the output device and the computer.

1. Check if the cable is disconnected or plugged in incorrectly
2. Check the volume of the speaker, the headset is turned on or not
3. Try connecting to another port
4. Remember that the speaker may not work when the headset is plugged in

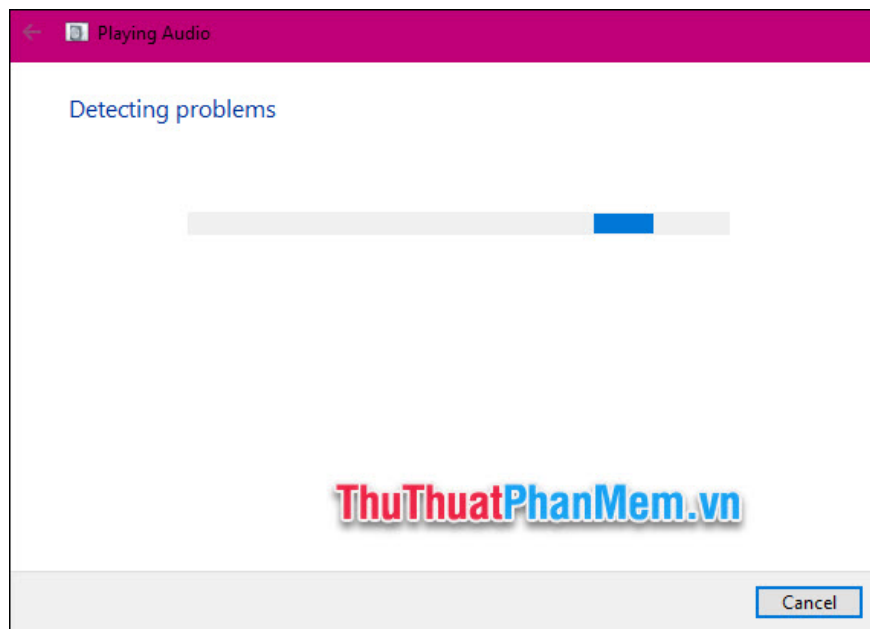
### 2. Run the Audio troubleshooter

This is a feature built into Windows 10 that will help you detect and automatically fix sound errors.

Right-click on the sound icon in the Taskbar and then select Troubleshoot sound Problems.



The feature will automatically find errors and offer solutions.

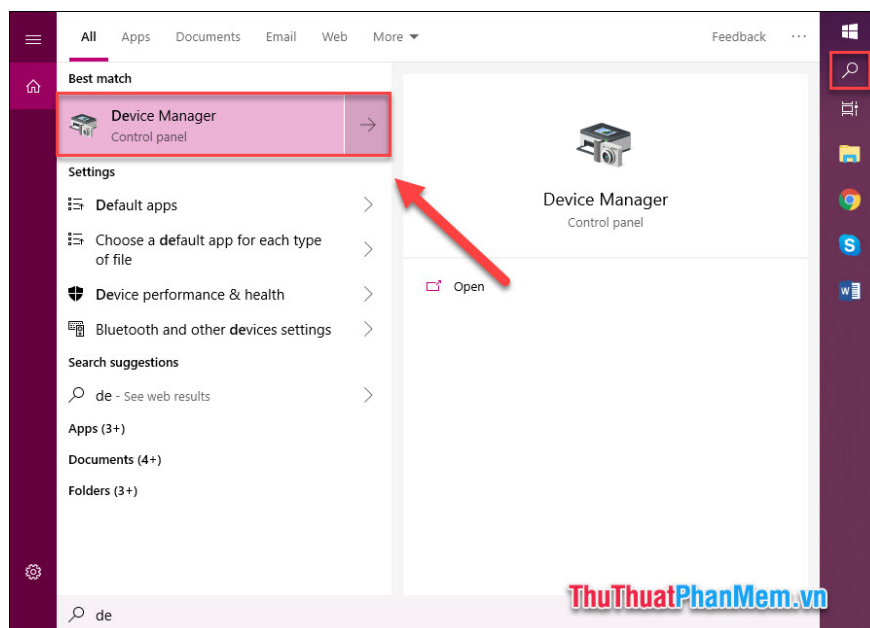


If this method does not work, then try the next method.

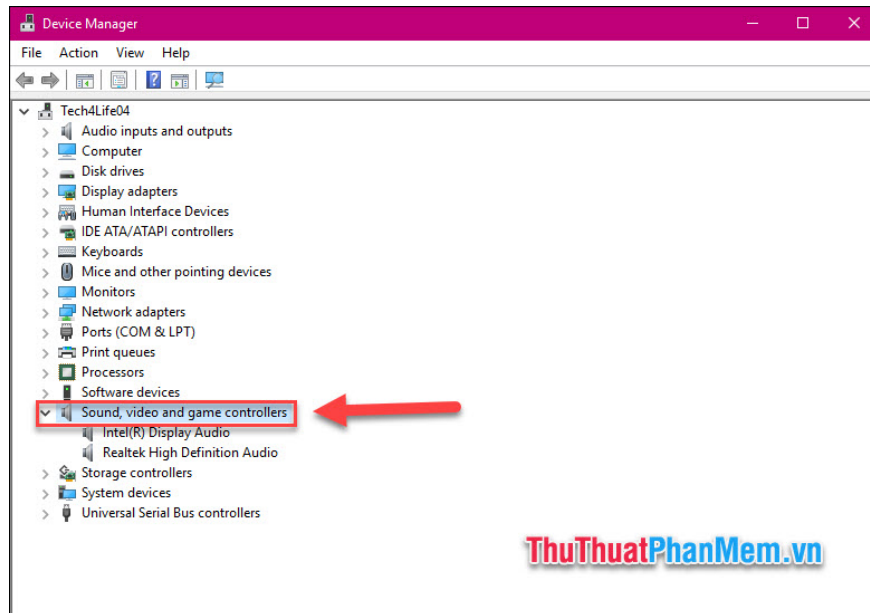
### 3. Check Update Driver

Outdated audio drivers can also cause audio problems on your computer, follow these steps to update audio drivers.

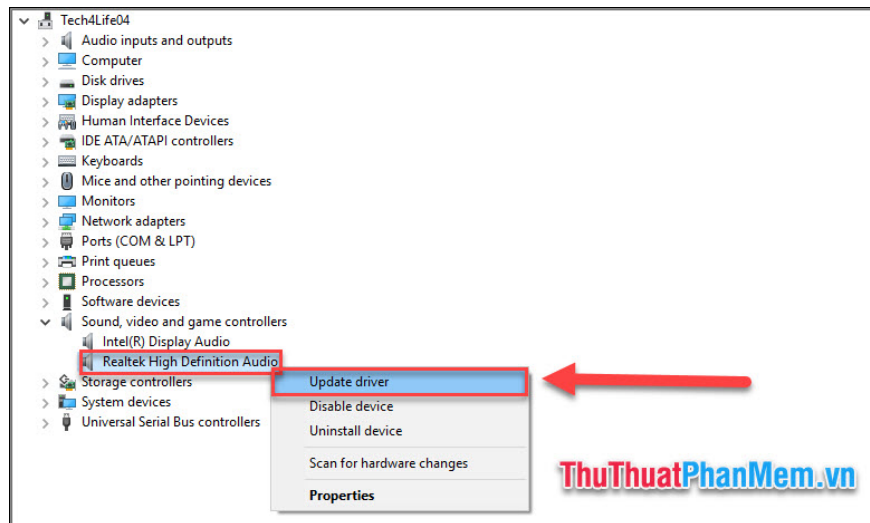
**Step 1 :** Click the **Search** icon in the Taskbar, type **Device Manager**, and then click **Open Device Manager** .



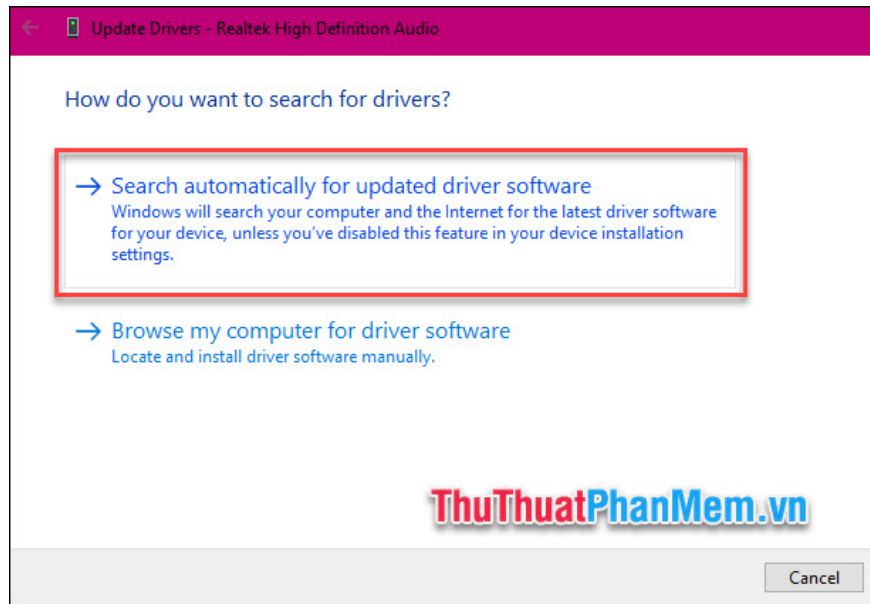
**Step 2 :** Double click on the **Sound, video and game controller** lines .



**Step 3 :** Right-click the driver, select **Update Driver** .



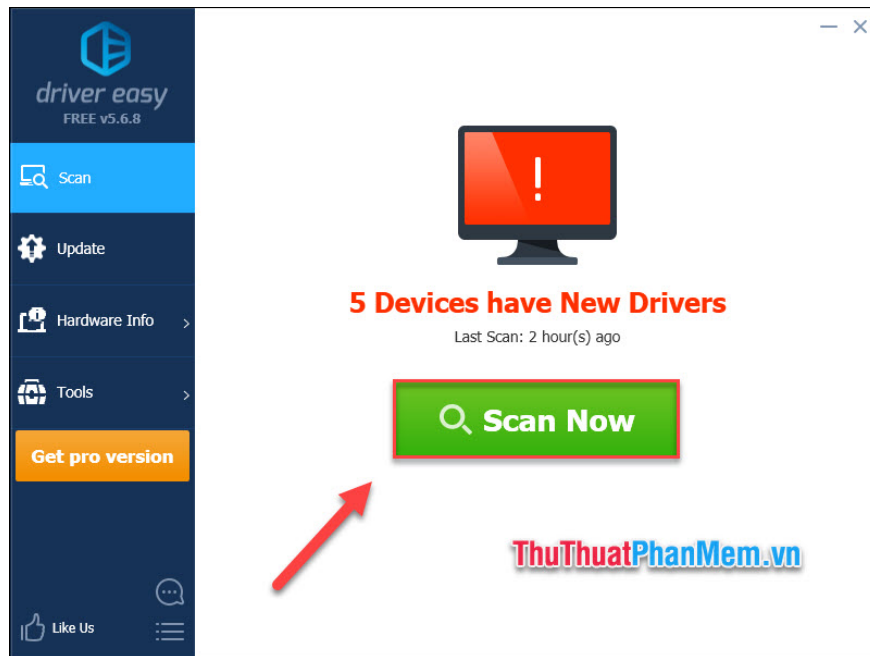
Select **Search automatically for updated driver software** .



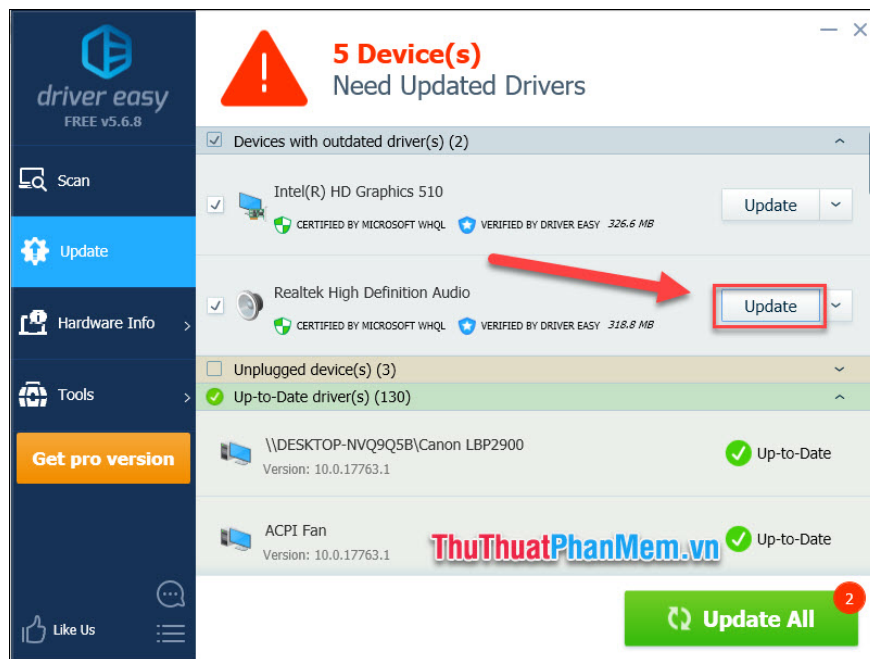
At this point the system will automatically find the latest version driver to update you. If the system cannot find it, use the **Easy Driver** software to find and install the latest driver.

Download and install Easy Driver here.

At the main interface of Easy Driver, select **Scan** to scan for outdated drivers.



Click **Update** for Sound Driver:



Wait for the Driver to be updated and then check if the sound is working normally or not.

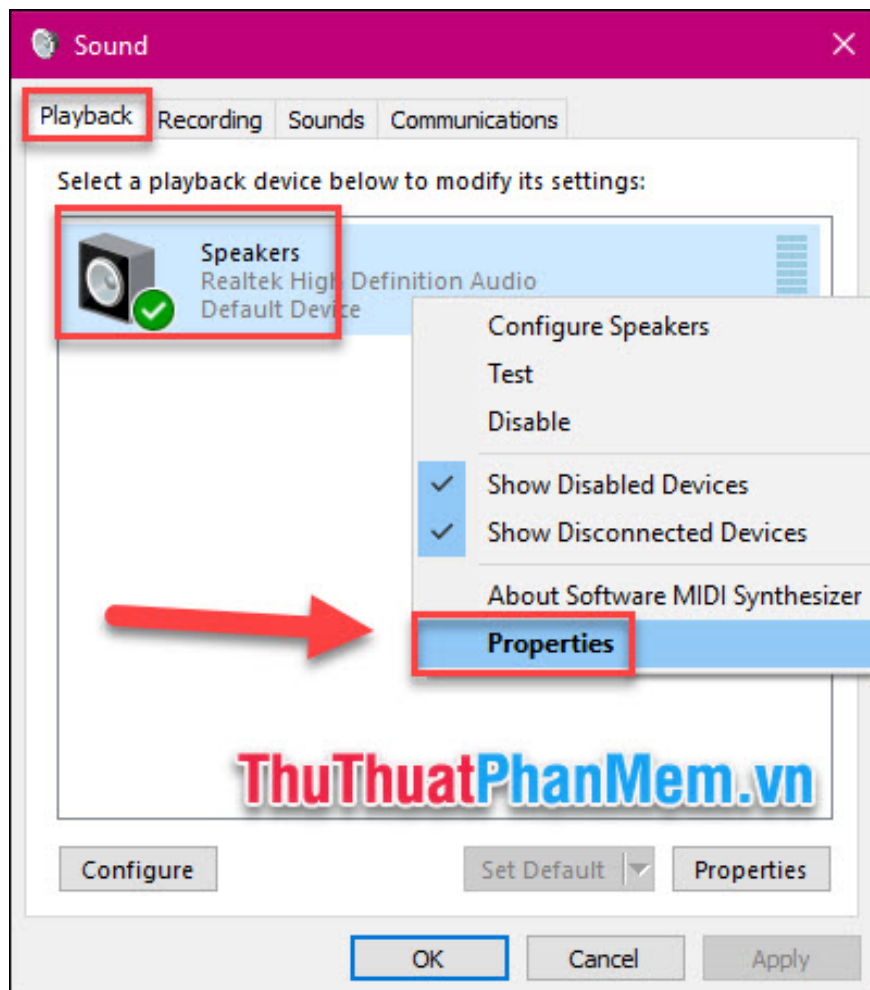
#### 4. Adjust the default audio format

Accidentally changing the audio format also causes the speakers or headphones to not work.

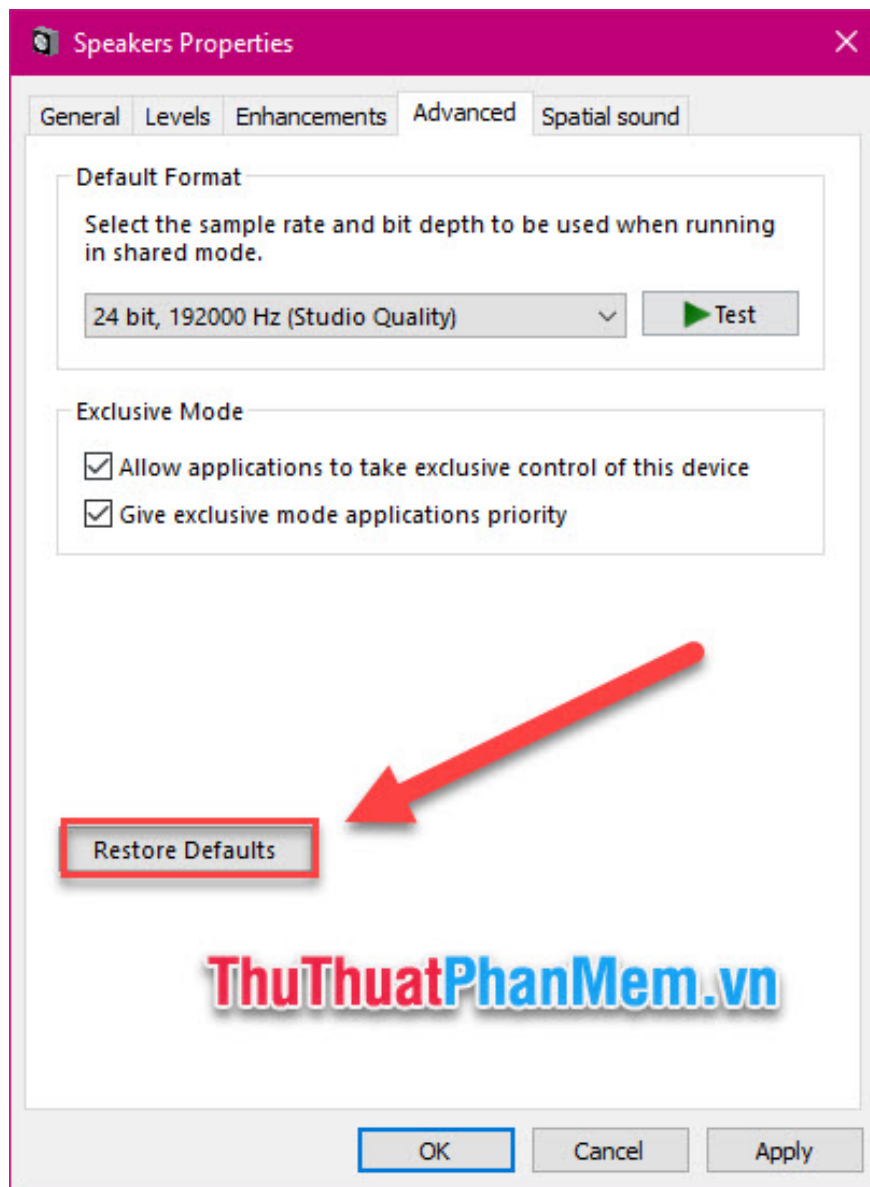
**Step 1** : Right-click **the sound icon** in the Taskbar, select **Sounds** .



**Step 2 :** In the **Playback** tab , right-click on the audio device in use >> **Properties** .

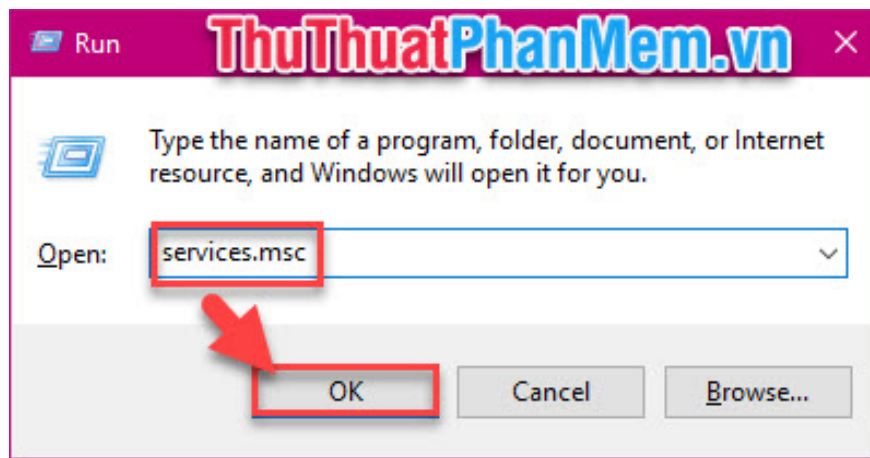


**Step 3** : Select **Restore Default** to bring the settings to the default, if still not effective you can change the frequency to **24 bit, 44100Hz**, **24 bit, 192,000Hz** or **16 bit, 44100 Hz** . Then click **OK** to apply.

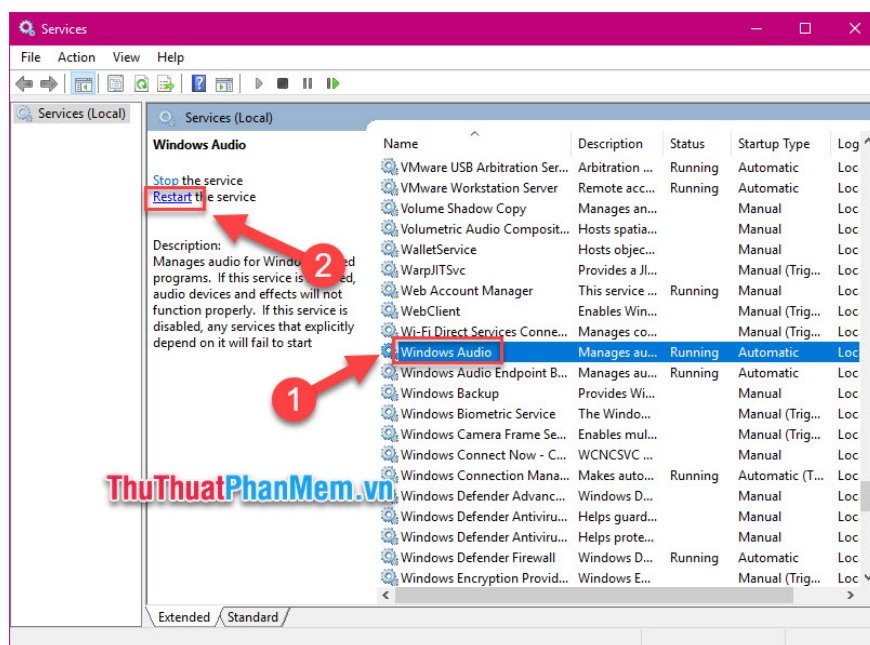


## 5. Restart Audio Service

**Step 1** : Press **Windows + R** to open the Run dialog box. Type **services.msc >> Enter** .



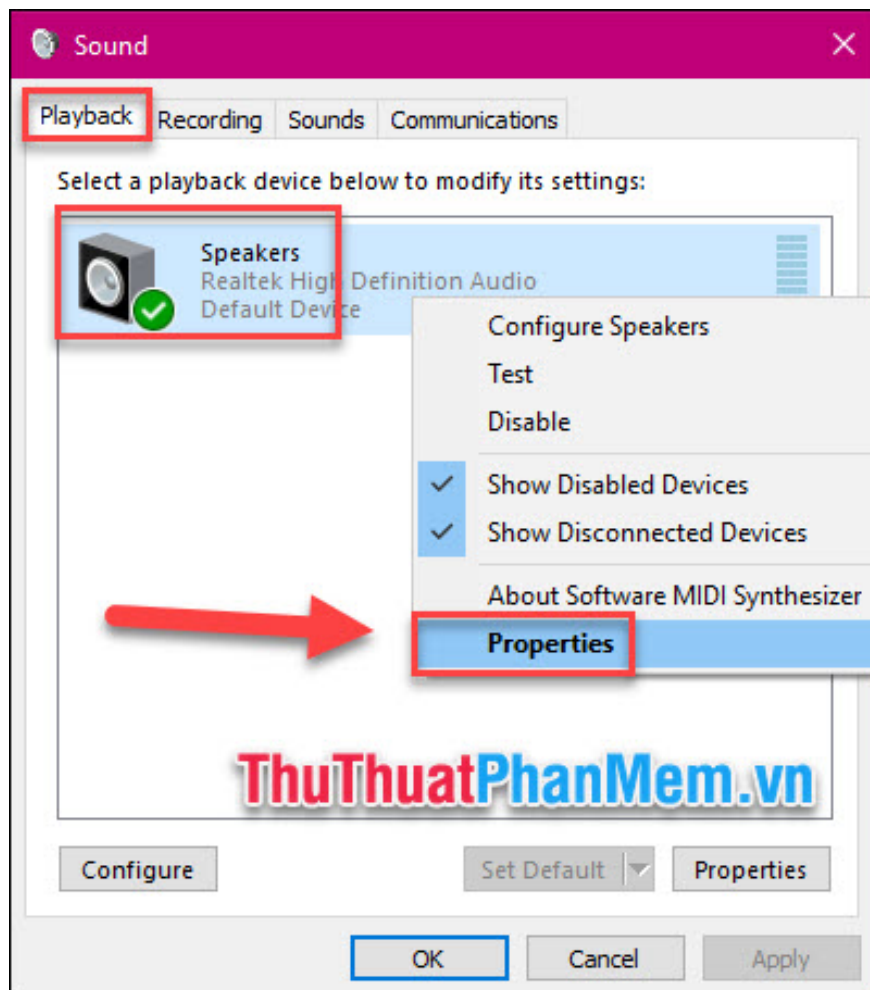
**Step 2 :** Click on **Windows Audio** , select **Restart the Service** to restart.



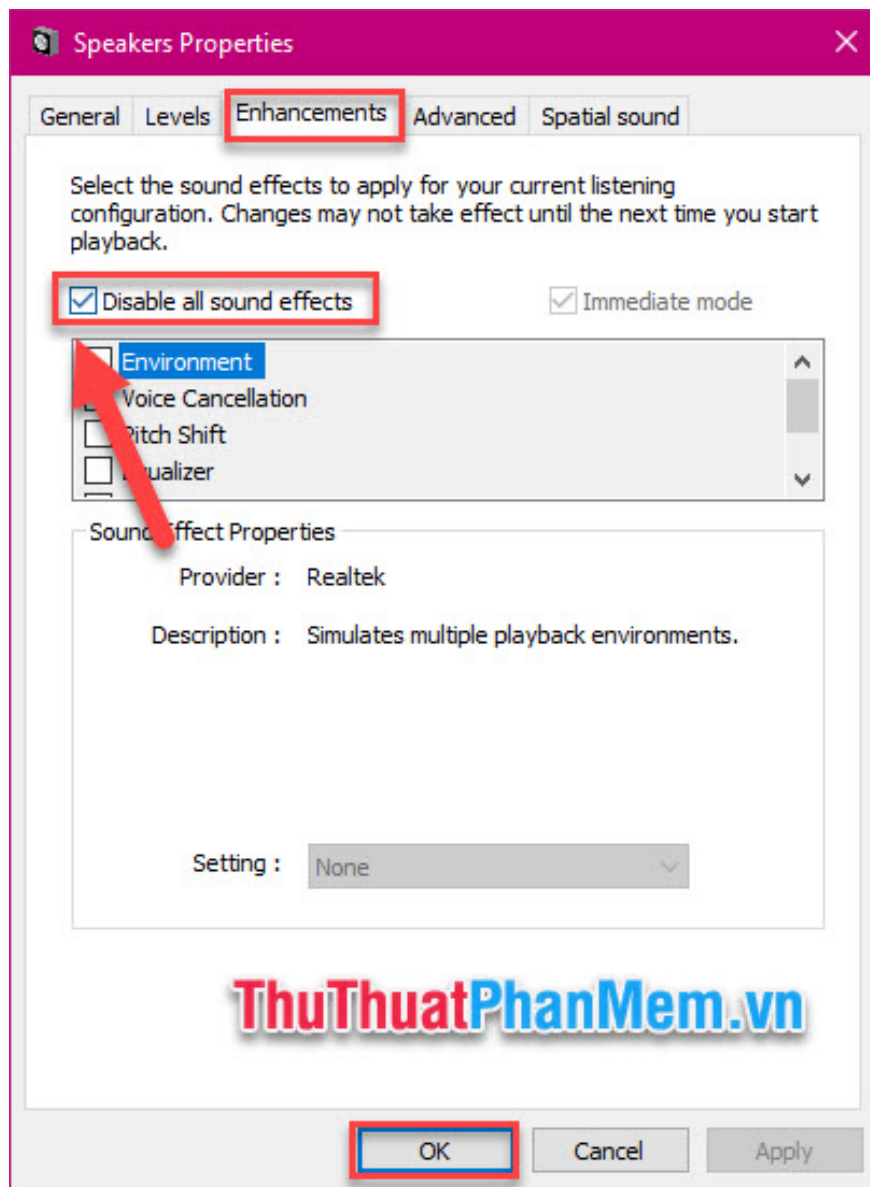
## 6. Disable the audio upgrade

Audio Enhancements are a feature built into Windows 10 with the aim of improving sound quality with speaker devices. But this feature is sometimes the cause of sound loss.

**Step 1 :** In the **Sounds** window , select the **Playback** tab , right click the audio device in use >> **Properties**.



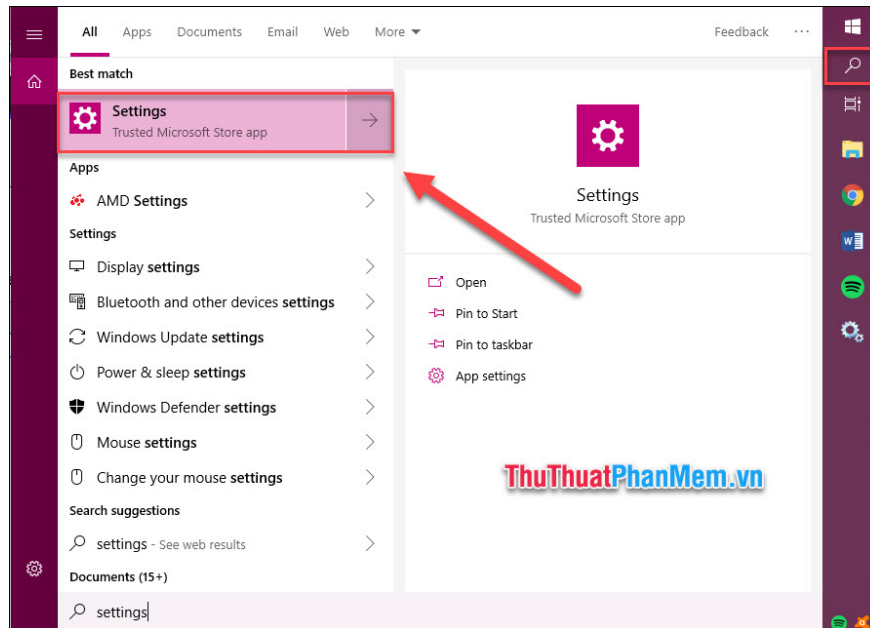
**Step 2 :** In the **Enhancements** tab , select the **Disable all sound effects** box . Click **OK** to apply.



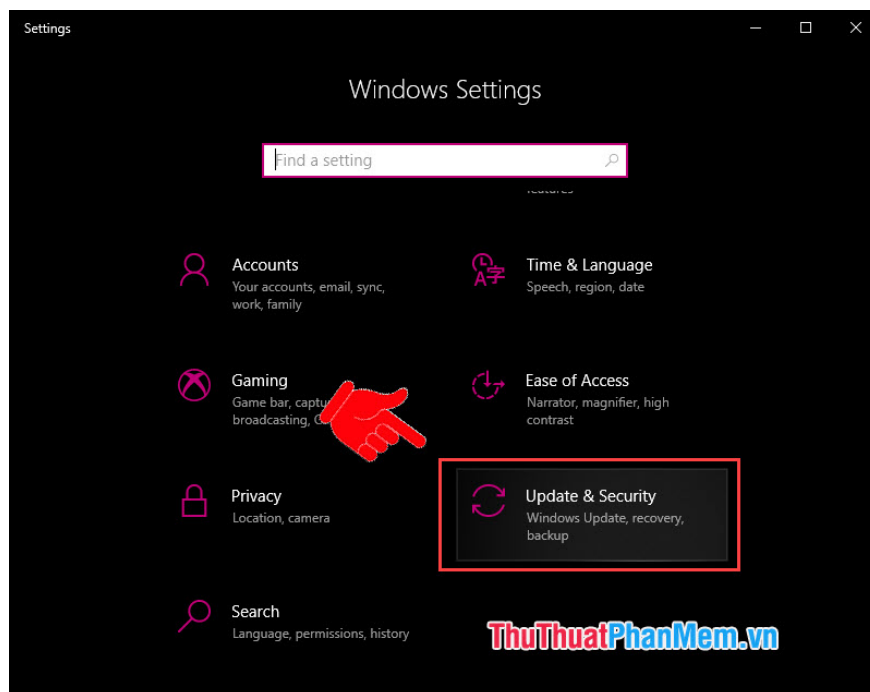
## 7. Upgrade the version of Windows 10

In case the sound of the current version has a problem, you must upgrade to the new version to fix the error.

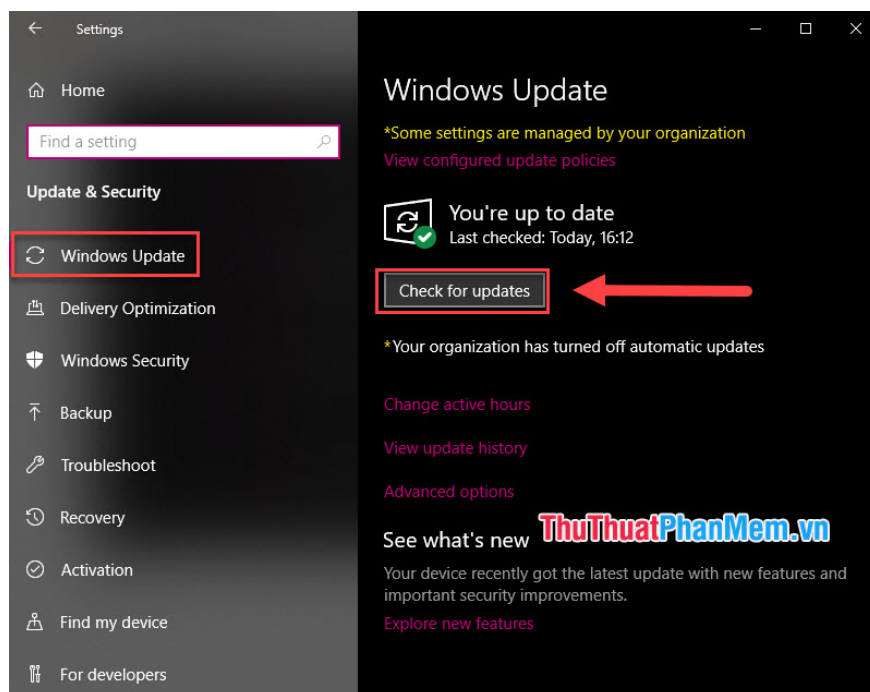
**Step 1 :** Click on **the search icon** in the Taskbar, enter **Settings** and click on the feature to open.



**Step 2 : Select Update & Security.**



**Step 3 : Select Windows Update in the left menu column >> Check for Updates .**



The system will check and install new updates if available.
