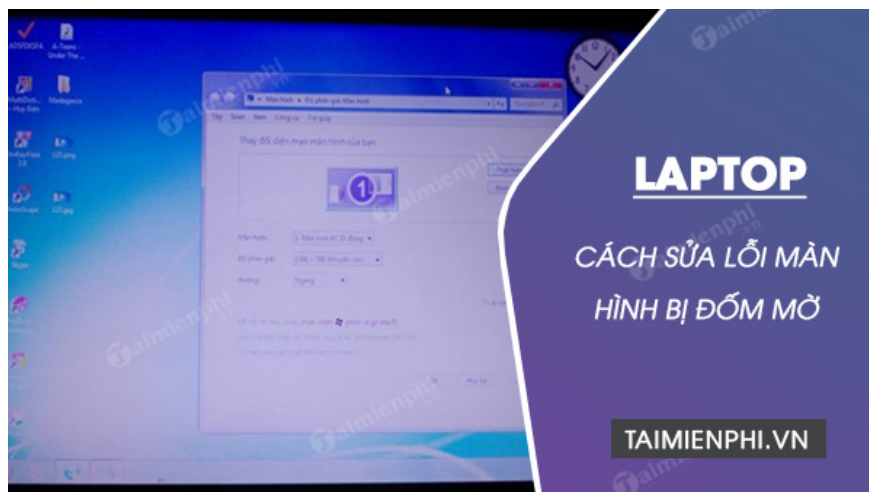


# How to fix blurry or white spots on a laptop screen.

## *How to fix blurry spots on a laptop screen.*

The cause of blurry spots on the screen could be due to low screen resolution, or it could be due to a faulty or malfunctioning display driver.

### ***Method 1: Check the monitor connection***

Sometimes, a faulty, damaged, or loose USB cable connecting the monitor can also cause screen flickering issues. Try checking to ensure the monitor cable is properly connected and functioning correctly.

If the error persists, please refer to the troubleshooting steps below.

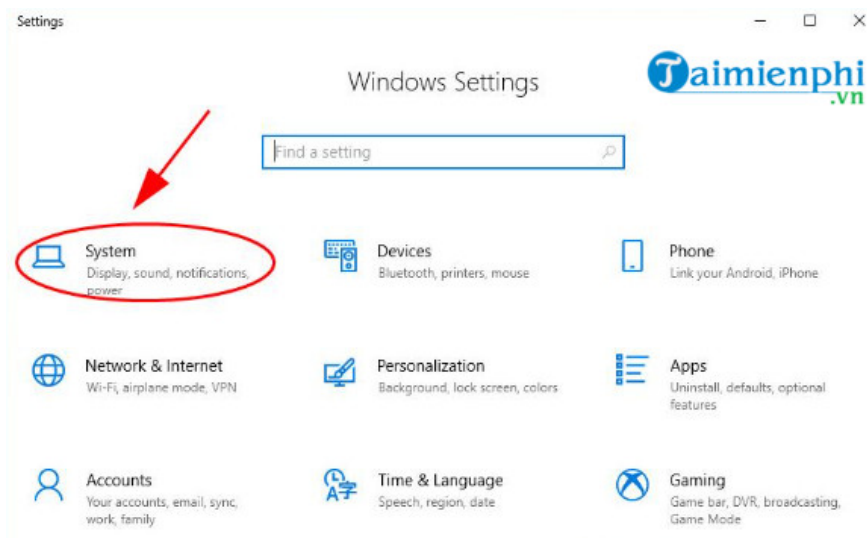
### ***Method 2: Enable the option "Let Windows try to fix apps so they're not blurry"***

Typically, when a blurry screen issue occurs, a pop-up window will appear with the message: "Let Windows try to fix apps so they're not blurry." If this message appears, simply allow Windows to resolve the issue.

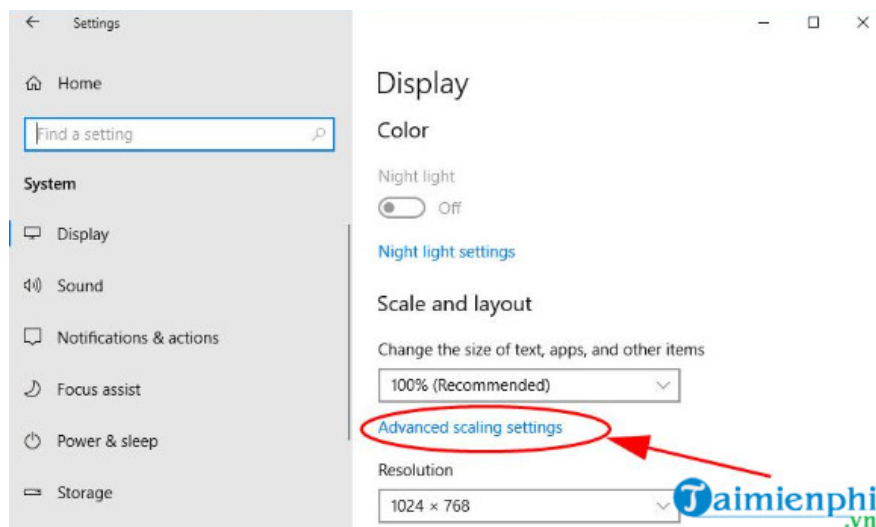
Otherwise, follow the steps below to enable the option and fix issues related to blurry spots on your laptop screen:

**Step 1:** Press **Windows + I** to open the Settings window.

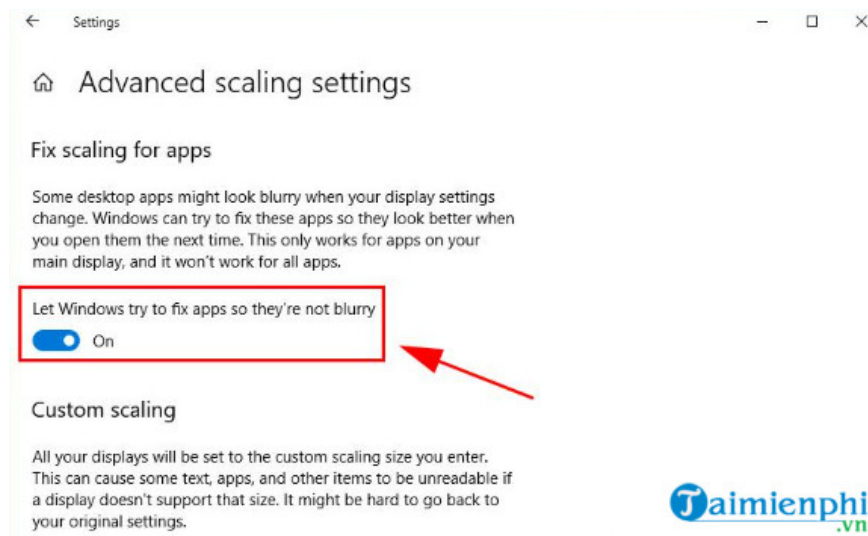
**Step 2:** In the Settings window, find and click on **System**.



**Step 3:** In the **Display** section, find and click on **Advanced scaling settings**.



**Step 4:** Turn on the option " **Let Windows try to fix apps so they're not blurry.**"



**Step 5:** Finally, restart your computer and see if the blurry screen issue persists.

### ***Method 3: Reinstall the graphics card driver.***

As mentioned above, a faulty graphics card driver can also cause blurry screen issues. Try reinstalling your graphics card driver, updating your VGA , and check if the screen problem persists.

To manually reinstall the graphics card driver, first uninstall the driver from the Device Manager window, then visit the manufacturer's website to find and download the latest driver version and install it.

Finally, check to see if the error persists.

### ***Method 4: Change DPI scaling settings***

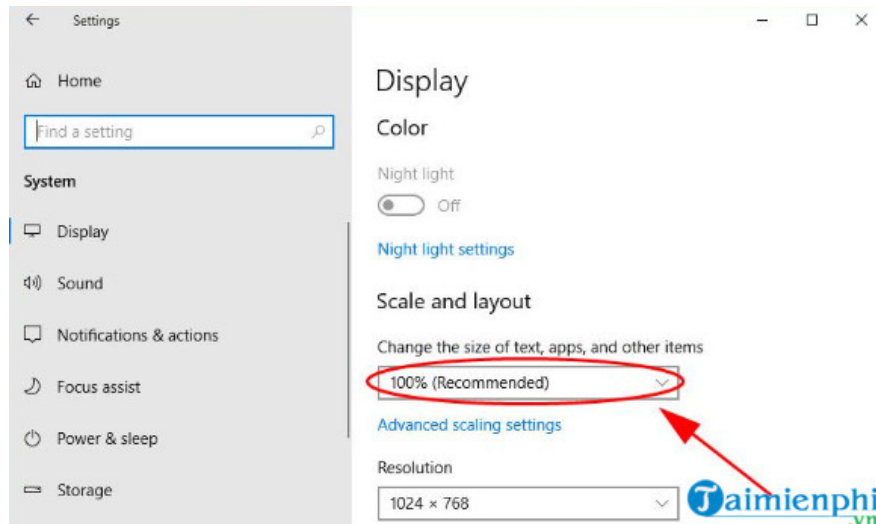
Another way to fix blurry spots on a laptop screen is to change the DPI scaling settings.

#### **- On Windows 10:**

**Step 1:** Press **Windows + I** to open the Settings window.

**Step 2:** In the Settings window, find and click **System** .

**Step 3:** In the **Display** section, make sure the **Scale and layout** option is set to **100%**.

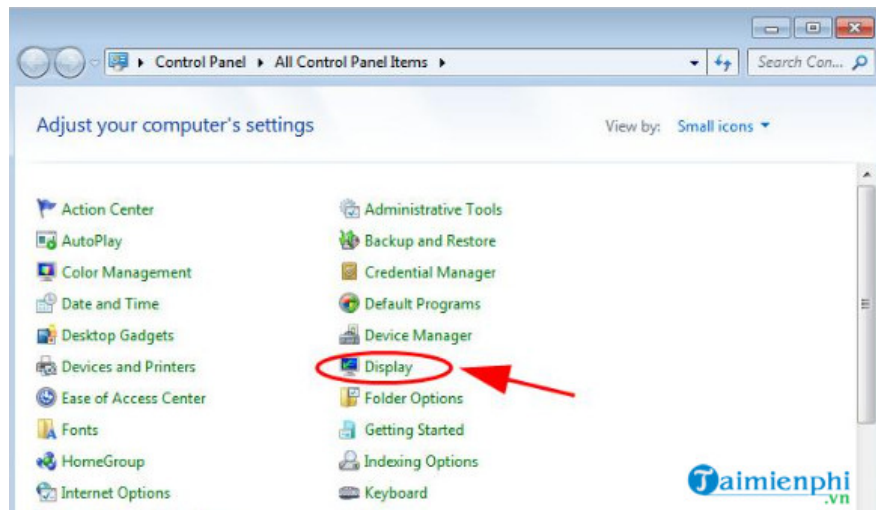


**Step 4:** Check if the blurry spots on your laptop screen still persist.

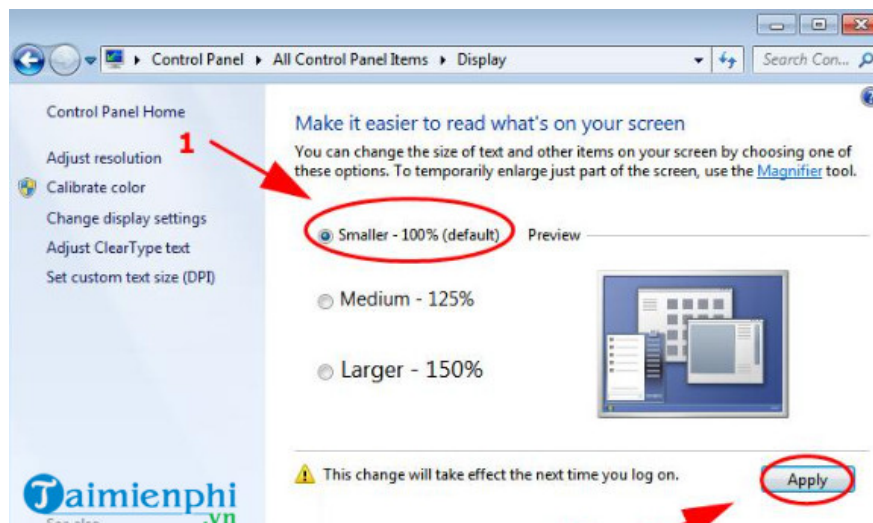
**- On Windows 8 and 7:**

**Step 1:** Open the Control Panel window. In the **View by** section, set it to either **Small icon** or **Large icon** .

**Step 2:** Next, find and click on **Display**.



**Step 3:** Set the text size and other display elements to **100%** , then click **Apply** .



**Step 4:** Restart your computer to apply the changes and see if the blurry screen issue persists.

**Option 5: Take it to a laptop repair center.**

The final option is to take your laptop to a reputable laptop repair center to fix the blurry spots on your laptop screen.
