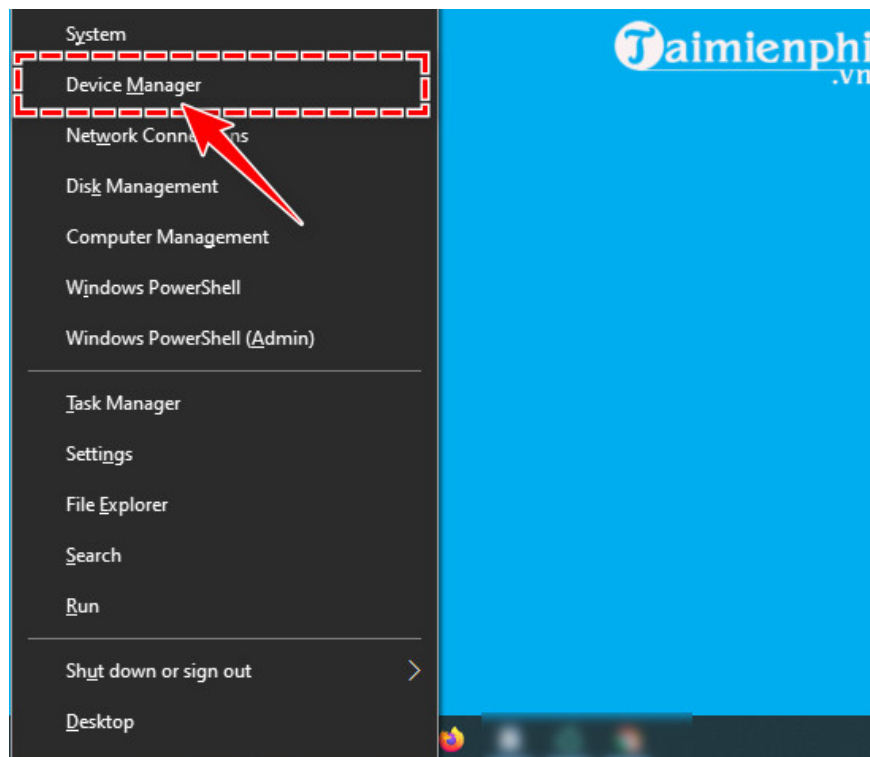
## *Instructions on how to fix common mouse errors on laptops*

### *Case 1. Error of Touchpad not working, unable to click*

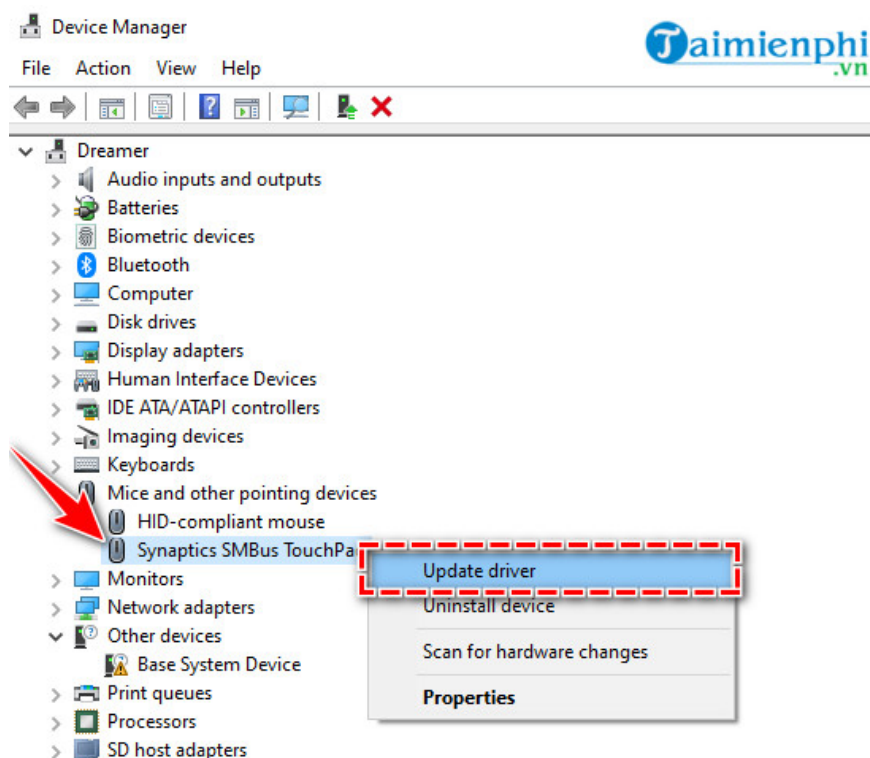
#### *Method 1: Update Driver*

Error of Touchpad not working, cursor not moving or mouse not clicking is often common with older devices or when users upgrade operating system. If you are in this situation, please do the following to fix mouse errors on your laptop.

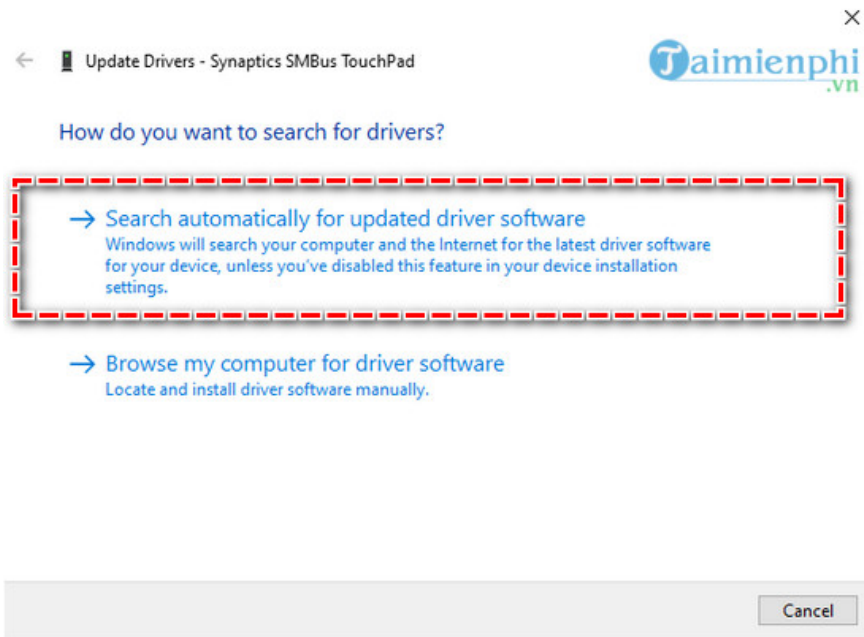
*Step 1:* Press the keyboard shortcut **Window + X** on the keyboard, select **Device Manager to enter the Driver management** screen on the device.



Step 2: Find and click on **Mice and other pointing devices** . In the drop-down list, right-click on the driver with a name like [**Brand name, Technology**] Touchpad and select **Update Driver** .



Step 3: The **Update Driver** window appears, select **Search automatically for updated driver software** to let the system automatically search for the appropriate driver, then download and install.

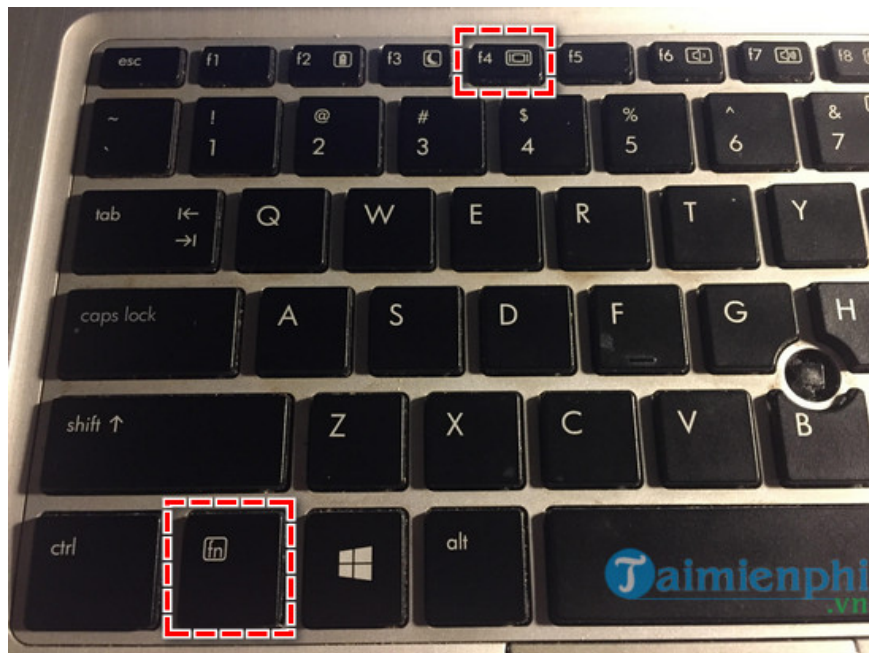


In addition to the system's driver update tool, users can use tools and software from third parties such as Driver booster, Driver Easy, to support. These software will automatically detect and notify you when new driver updates are available for your device, and help you install them quickly and conveniently.

### ***Method 2: Reactivate the Touchpad***

Even though the device's driver has been fully updated, the Touchpad still does not work. The cause is sometimes very simple, it is because the user is turning off or has not turned on the Touchpad's working function.

The way to fix mouse errors on Laptops in this case is to re-enable the Touchpad properly and accurately. Because depending on the model, the manufacturer will set up different shortcuts. Normally the key combination will be **Fn + Another key** with a touchpad or mouse icon. With HP models, press **Fn + F4** to quickly turn on and off Touchpad for laptops.



### ***Case 2: Touchpad error when using a mouse***

Besides the condition of the Touchpad not working, sometimes users also have a headache when the Touchpad is still working when you connect the mouse, causing software conflicts, causing the cursor to jump around. . What you need to do now is disable the Touchpad. With this topic, Taimienphi also shares specific instructions **for turning off the touch mouse** and locking the touchpad on the laptop in the article here.

### ***Case 3: Mouse error lights up but cannot move.***

Users today tend to use an external mouse connected via USB port to work more conveniently and quickly. Computer mice today have lights below to let users know whether the device has been successfully connected or not. However, sometimes the mouse lights up to indicate that it is connected to the laptop but still does not move.

#### ***Method 1: Change the connection port***

If the laptop mouse error on your laptop is due to the connection port - a hardware cause, then plug the mouse in another USB port and try to fix the broken connection port later. In many cases, users think the mouse is broken and immediately buy a new mouse, but still cannot fix the mouse error on the laptop, causing unnecessary waste.



#### ***Method 2: Update Driver, restart device.***

Similar to Case 1, the error of the mouse lighting up but not moving may also be due to the driver. Please update yourself through the instructions that Taimienphi has shared. This will not work immediately, usually you will need to restart the device for the system to apply the new settings.

### ***Case 4: Touchpad Scroll is reversed***

The cause of the Touchpad scroll error is due to the settings in the device settings. You just need to change the settings to default to fix the mouse error on this laptop and use it as normal.

The only difficulty for users is that you need to clearly identify the model and manufacturer of your device in order to operate it properly.
