

How to fix error 0x800704C8 when Copying files on the computer

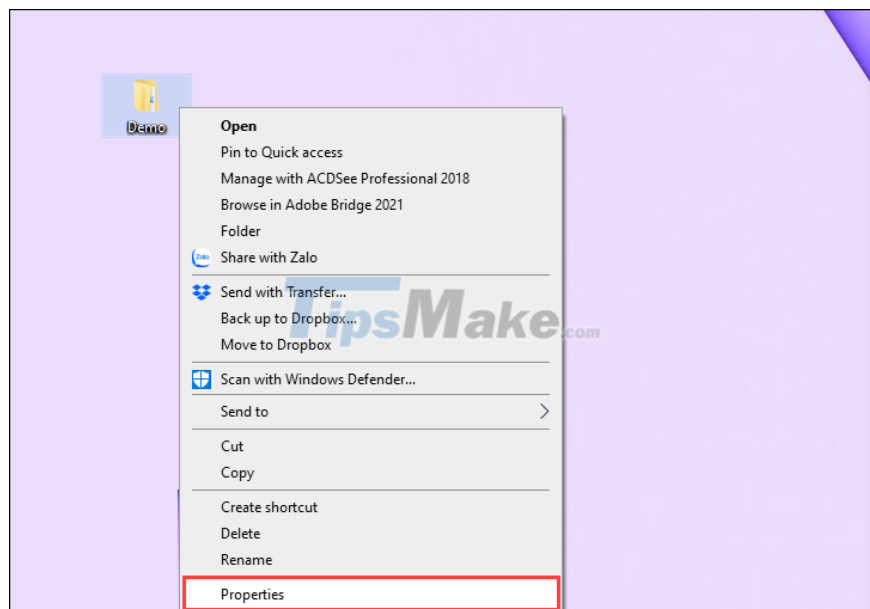
Error 0x800704C8 often appears when you copy something on your computer, this is a fairly common error on Windows.

One of the basic errors on Windows is that it cannot copy, error code 0x800704C8 appears on the dialog box when copying content. This is a common error on computers and they have many causes of errors, to solve this error you will have to intervene in the system. In case you get the error 0x800704C8 continuously, you should reinstall Windows to make it stable and if you only get the error occasionally, then handle it as follows:

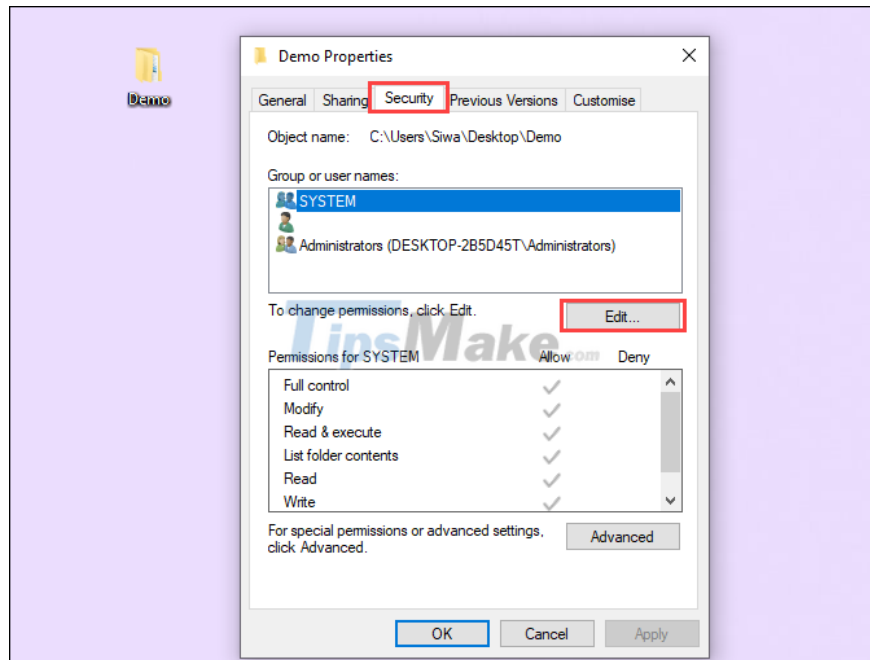
1. Fix error 0x800704C8 by granting account permission

On each account using Windows, they all have different access rights and you must grant enough permissions for the account to be able to copy/paste arbitrary content on the system.

Step 1: Right-click the file/folder that has a copy error and select Properties.

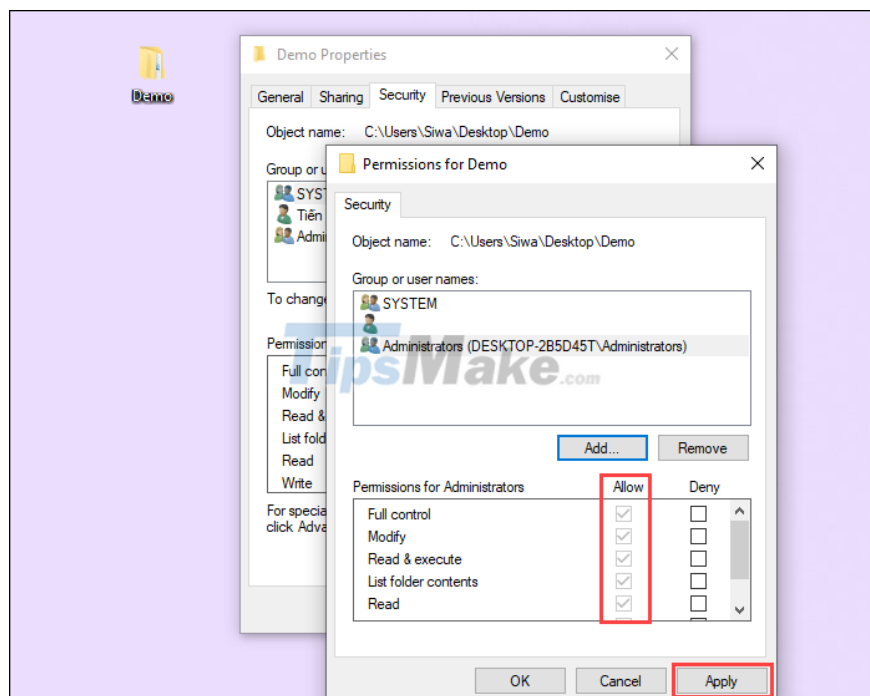


Step 2: Then, select the Security tab and click Edit to edit the permissions on each account that is accessed.



Step 3: In the Permissions window, check the box Full Control => Allow. When you're done, click Apply to apply the changes.

In this case, all accounts on the machine have been granted all permissions for the folder, so the Allow item cannot be checked. Accounts that have not been authorized, please mark to have the highest permissions.

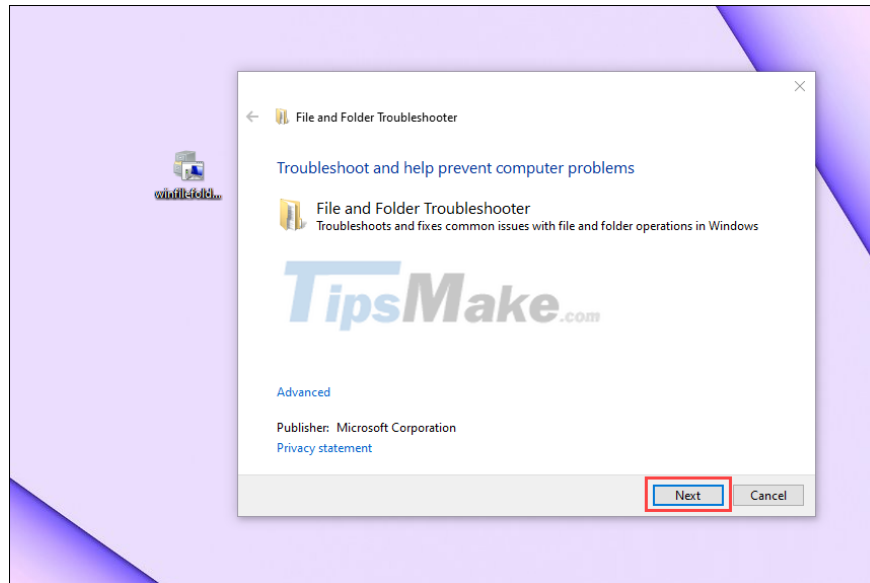


2. Fix error 0x800704C8 with Microsoft Troubleshooter

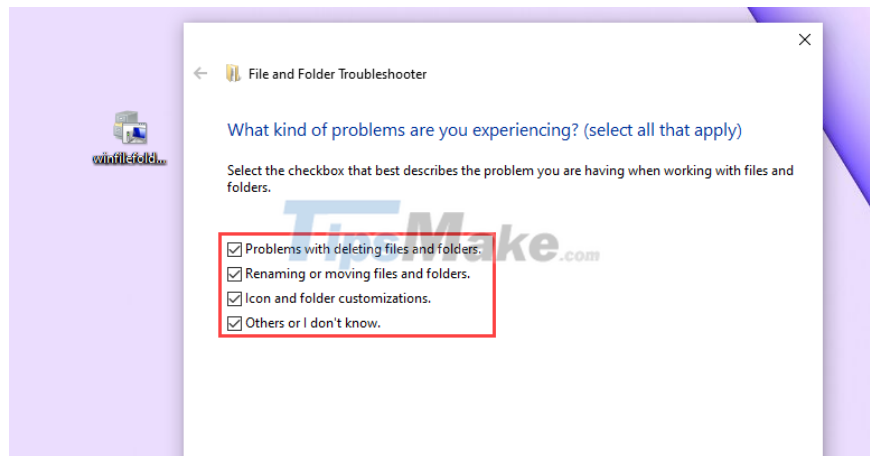
To help users fix errors easily, Microsoft also provides a set of effective error correction tools on Windows computers. Microsoft's fixer fixes errors related to folders, files, documents, etc.

Step 1: Go to Microsoft's homepage and select Download to download the error correction software to your computer.

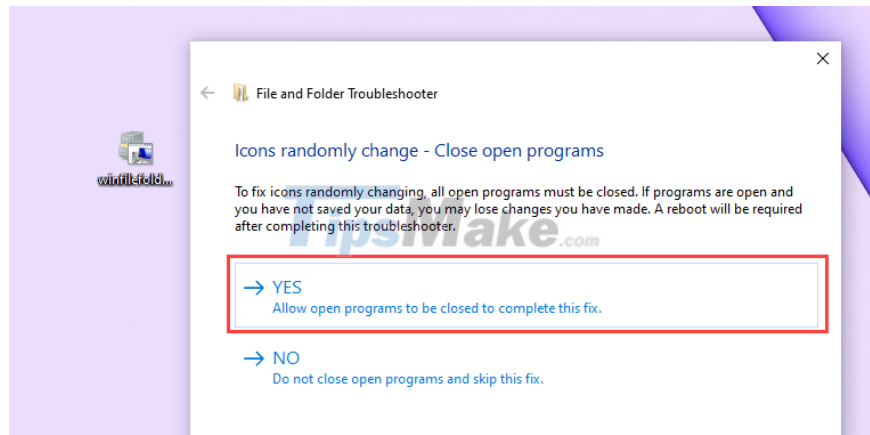
Step 2: Then, start the software and select Next to install it on your computer.



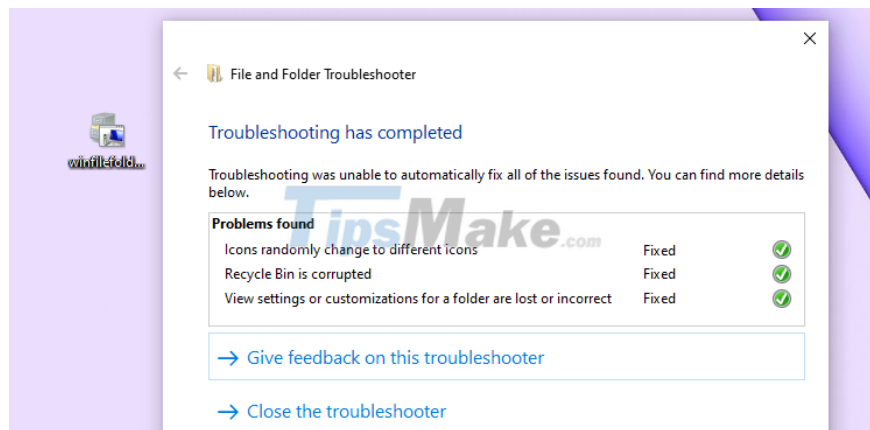
Step 3: In the error marking window, please tick all the items and then click Next to continue.



Step 4: When the software fixes errors, select Yes for all items.



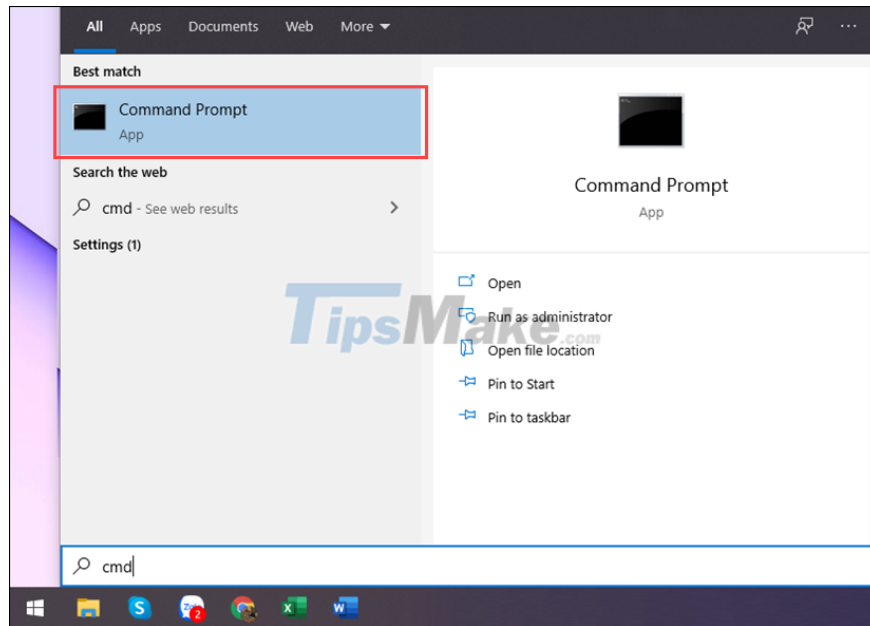
Step 5: The error correction process will take about 01 minute and when it is completed you will receive a message as shown in the picture. Now try copying the folder again to check for errors.



3. Fix error 0x800704C8 with Command Prompt

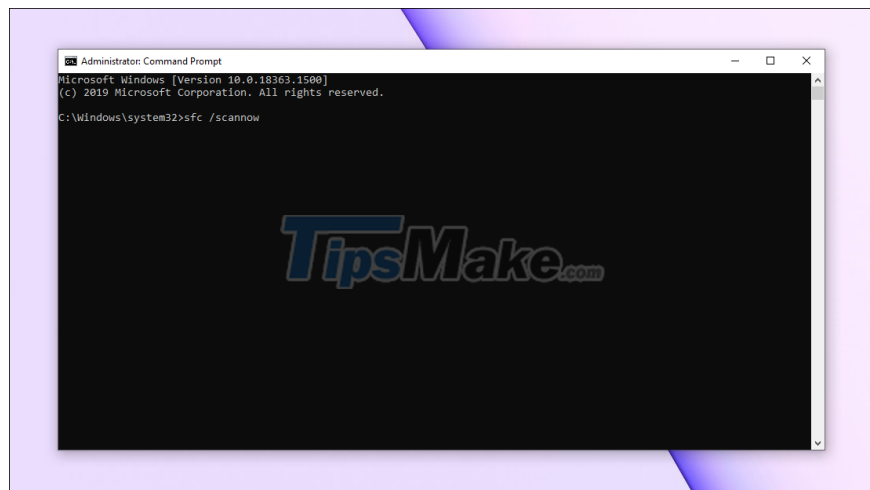
One of the ways to fix error 0x800704C8 on the computer is to use the file repair command on the Command Prompt. Rescanning the entire file will save your computer from silly errors.

Step 1: Open the Start Menu window and enter Command Prompt to open it.




Step 2: Then enter the following command and press Enter to run.

Sfc /scannow



Step 3: The SFC command will run for about 5-10 minutes and wait for them to finish running.



Step 4: When the process of running the command is complete (100%), try copying the content on the computer again, now the error has been fixed.
