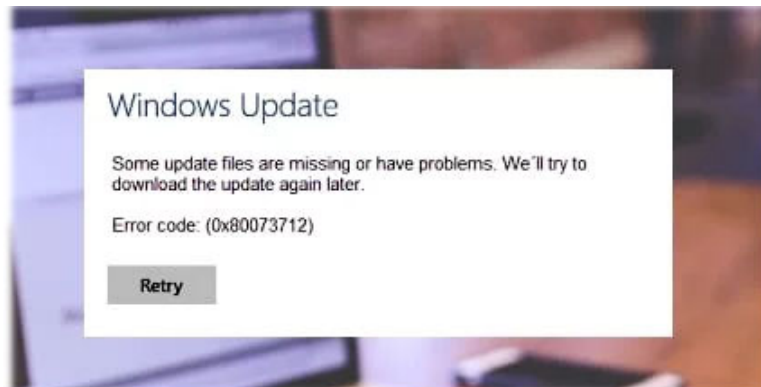

Windows Update Error 0x80073712 or 80073712 means that a file needed by Windows Update or Windows Setup is corrupted or missing, which causes the update or installation to fail.

## How to fix Windows Update error 0x80073712

Windows integrated tools and services are the most effective resources for troubleshooting and resolving this issue.

1. Scan your system for malware.
2. Download and run the Windows Update Troubleshooter. Microsoft provides free tools. When finished, restart your computer and check for updates.
3. Run the integrated Windows troubleshooter.
4. Run a **System File Checker** scan.
5. Perform a DISM scan: The Deployment Image Servicing and Management (DISM.exe) is a command-line tool that can find and repair corrupted system files or images. After running the tool, reboot the computer and try updating it again.
6. Delete pending files.
7. Restart the Windows Update service.
8. Restore, refresh or reset the PC: This action should only be taken as a last resort, if none of the above troubleshooting methods resolve the error code 0x80073712.

**Note** : Please make sure you are confident and comfortable to perform this action before using **Reset This PC** .
