

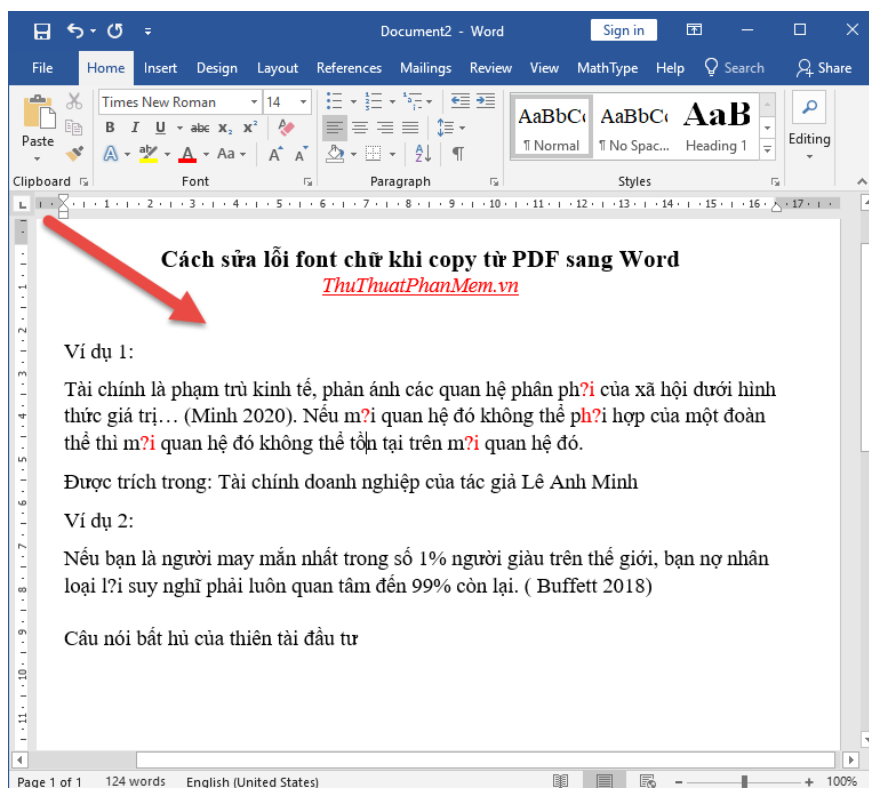
How to fix font errors when copying from PDF to Word

1. When copying content from PDF to Word, there are errors of some identical characters

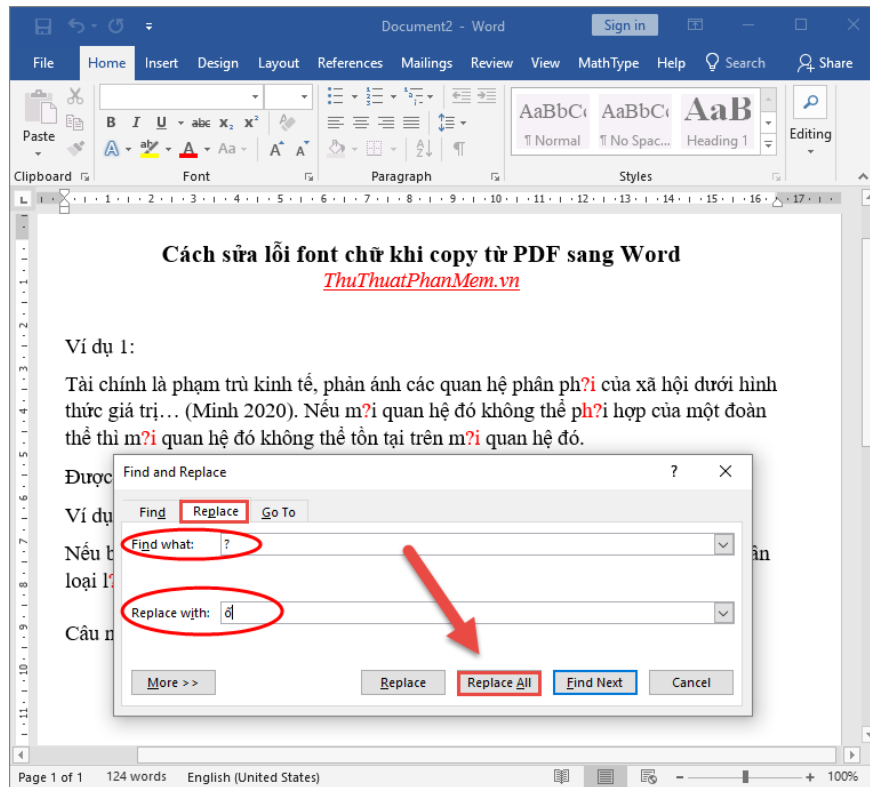
You observe that your text has a number of wrong characters replacing many words, the same word of the text may be a sign? or maybe a character that is not on the keyboard. With this error, you only need to use the replace feature for the same wrong characters:



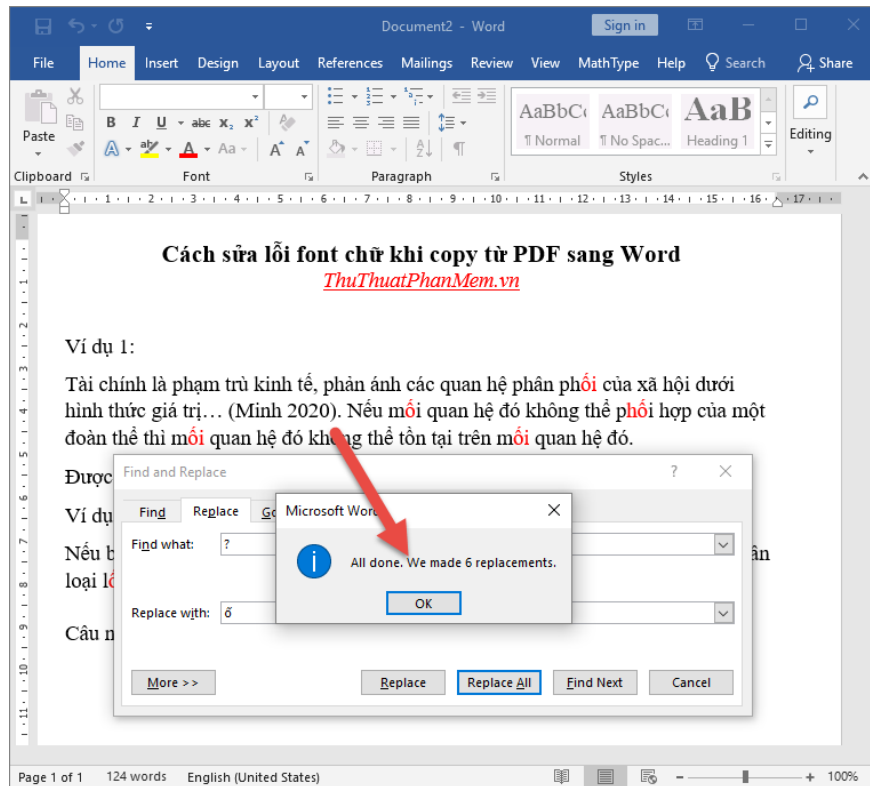
Press **Ctrl + H** to replace the same mistakes:

- In the **Find what** section : Enter the misspelled word.
- In the **Replace with** section : Enter the correct spelling word to replace the wrong spelling.

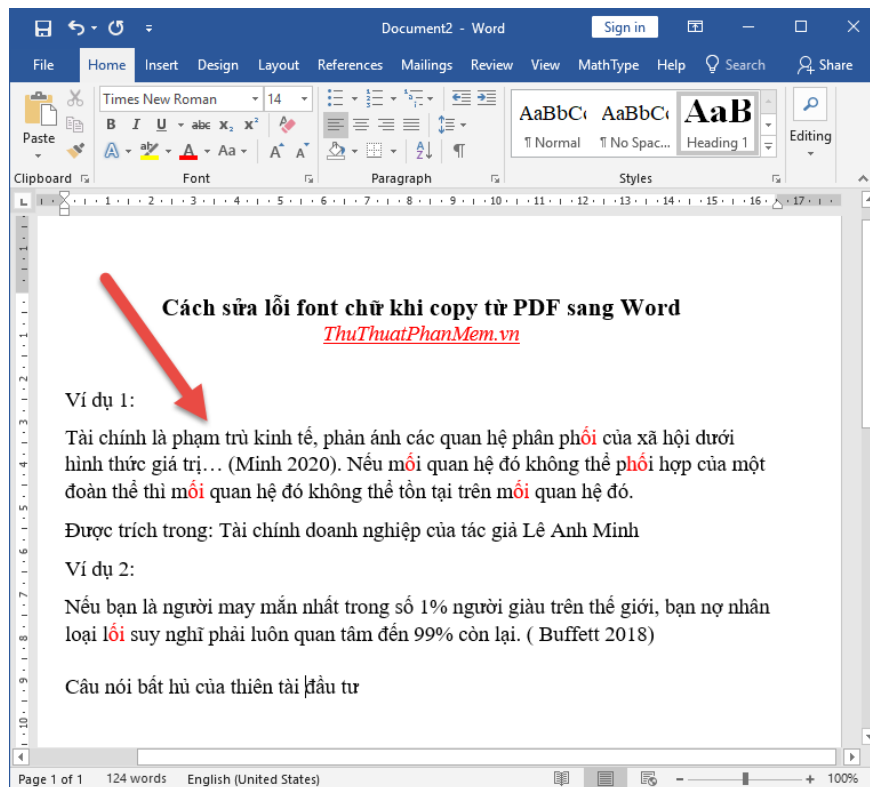
Finally, click **Replace All** to replace the error correction:



The results of the dialog box inform the total number of corrections, and then click **OK**:

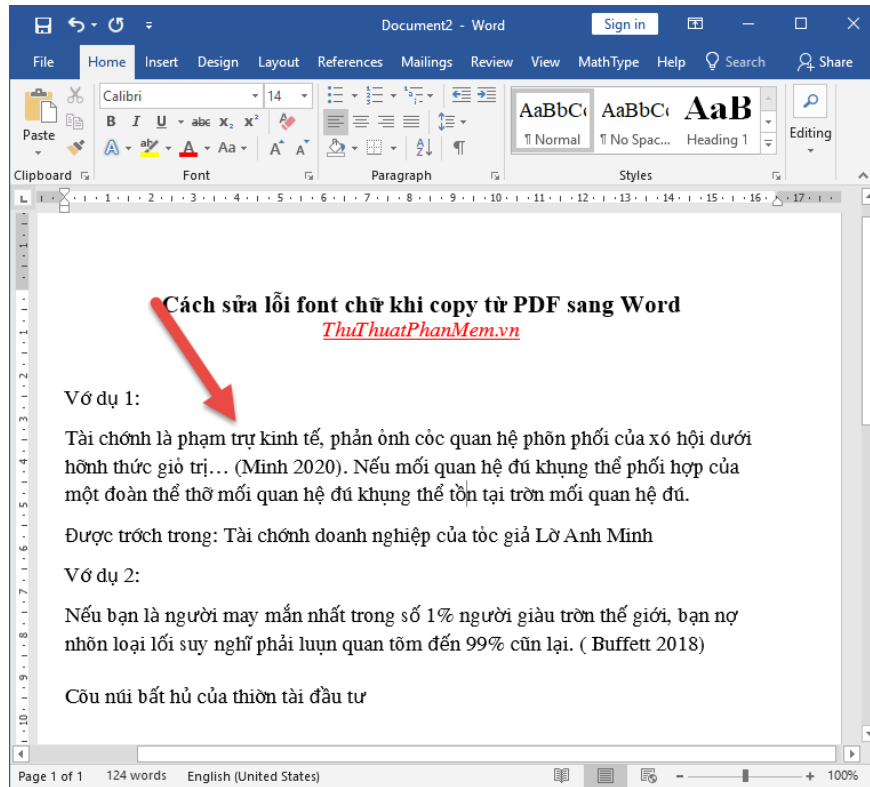


So you have finished editing your text. However, when replacing the correct written content, it is replaced so you should pay attention. You can click **Replace Next** to check that the character needs replacing.

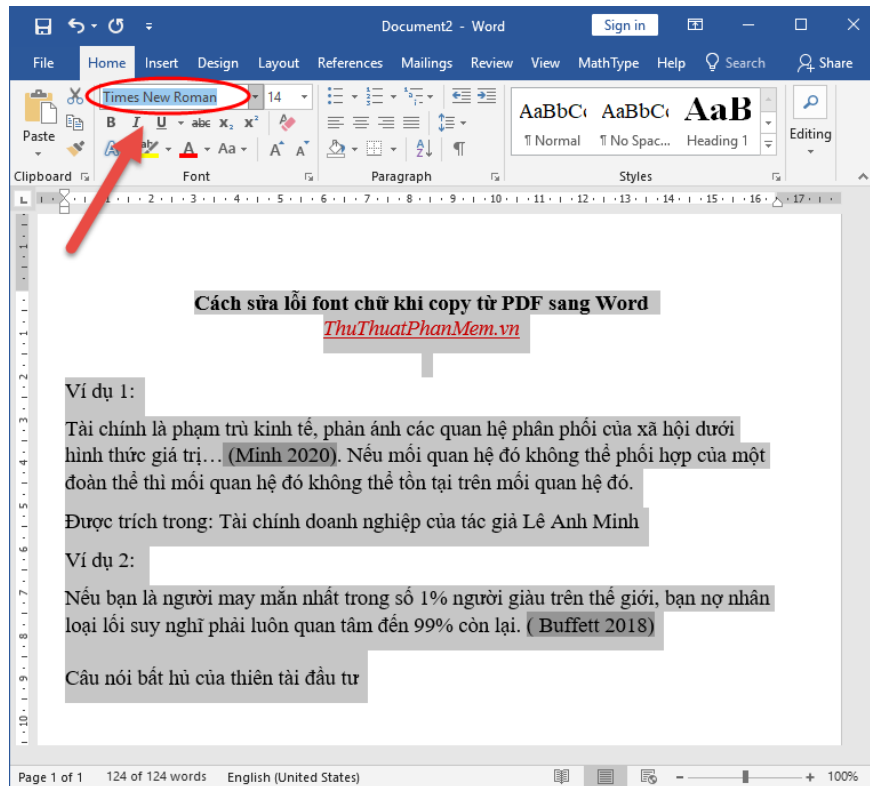


2. Font error when copying from PDF to Word.

When the copy appears error of some non-standard words, please check the font is appropriate. For example, under the source font .VnTime, however, the Time New Roman font is being set:

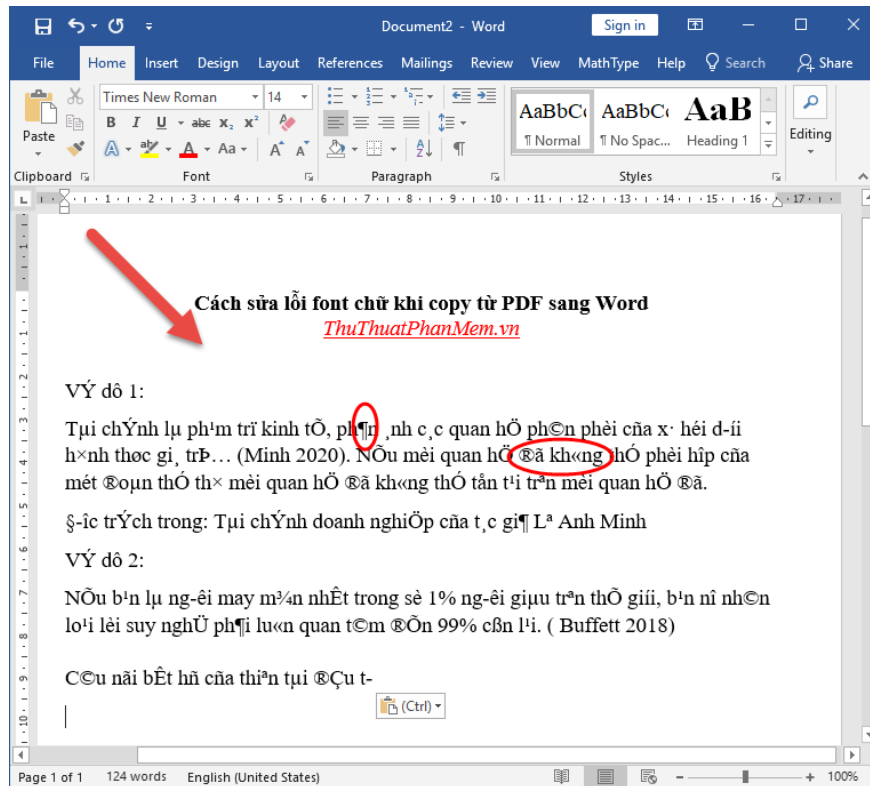


With this error, you only need to select the entire text and then select the font to fix the error:

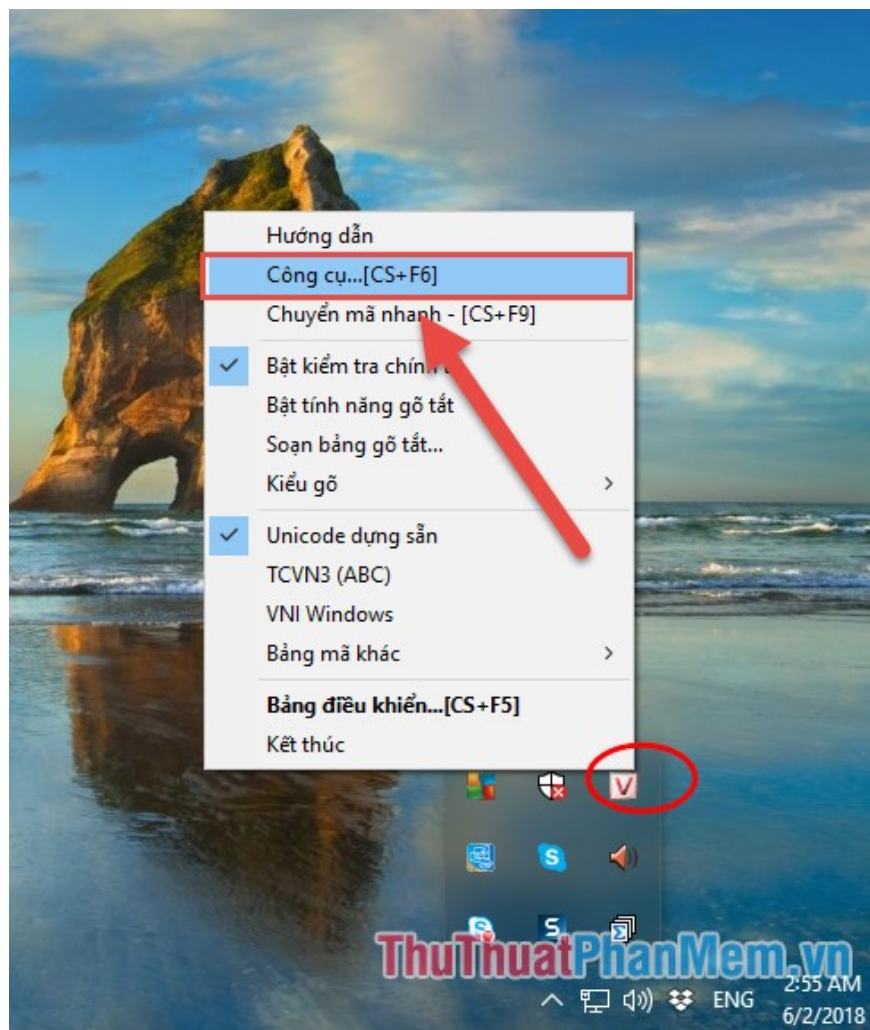


3. In case of font error when copying from PDF to Word due to wrong encoding.

When you see your text has a font error and the special characters appear in the picture, think immediately about converting the encoding to the text:



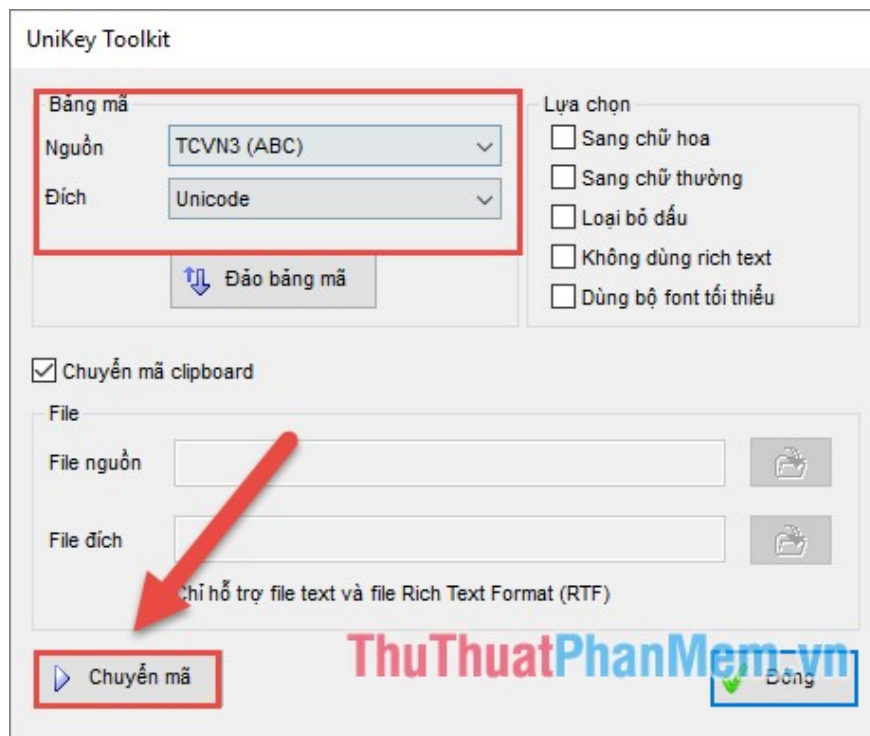
Make a copy of the entire text to be corrected -> right-click the Unikey icon in the lower corner of the screen, select **Tools** or press **Ctrl + Shift + F6**:



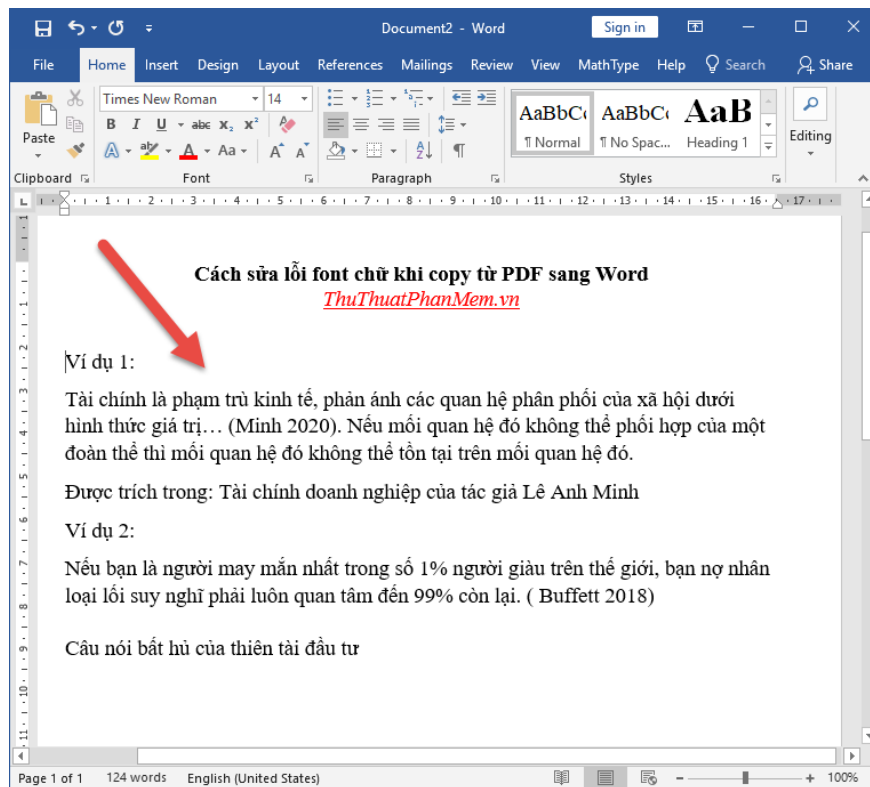
A dialog box appears in the **encoding** options such as the following:

1. **Source:** choose TCVN3 charset (ABC)
2. **Destination:** Select **Unicode**

Click **Transcode:**



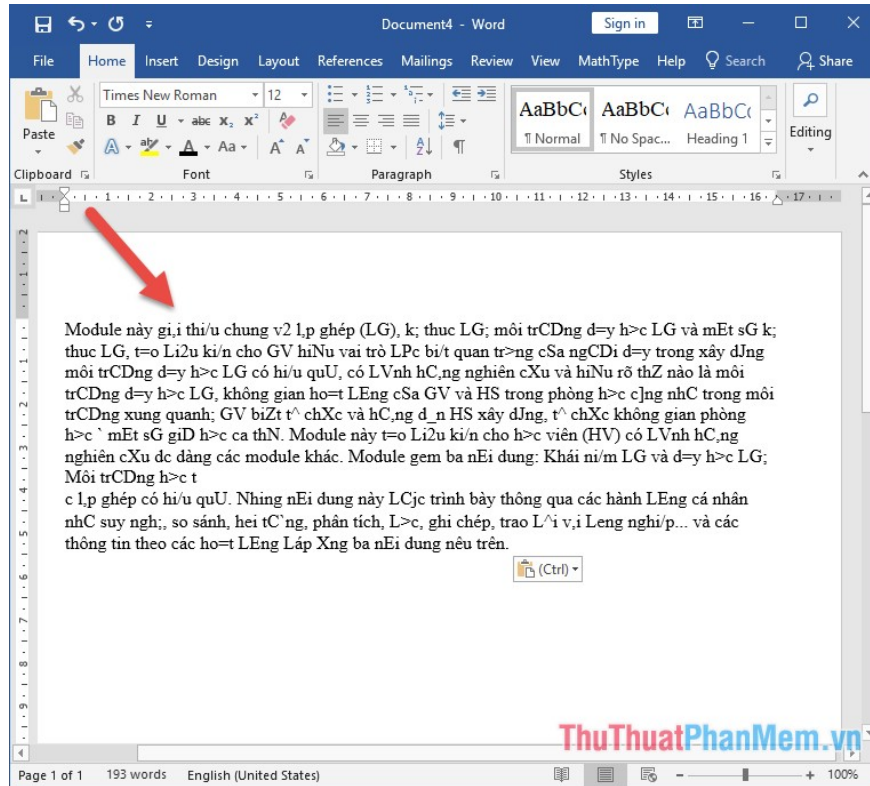
The success message dialog box, click **OK**. Back to his writing paste paste over the old content content font error has been results:



However, you need to determine what the source charset of the text is to choose from in the source charset and destination accordingly.

4. In case of font error when copying from PDF to Word, the entire error and cannot translate any words.

In this case, you should use additional software that supports ABBY conversion to convert from PDF to Word to minimize font errors:
