Method 1: Link your Facebook account to Instagram.



To share photos and stories from Instagram to Facebook, you need to link both apps properly. You can do this by following these steps:

Step 1: Open the Instagram app and go to your profile page, then tap the three horizontal lines icon in the upper right corner.

Step 2: Select **Settings** at the bottom of this menu.

Step 3: Scroll down and select **Linked Accounts** . Tap Facebook to link.

Step 4: Follow the instructions until the Facebook icon turns blue.

By completing the steps above, you have successfully linked your Instagram account to your Facebook account.

Method 2: Log out of Facebook and Instagram.

You can fix the issue of not being able to share Instagram to Facebook by logging out of both accounts and then logging back in to Facebook and Instagram. This is a method that many people have successfully tested.

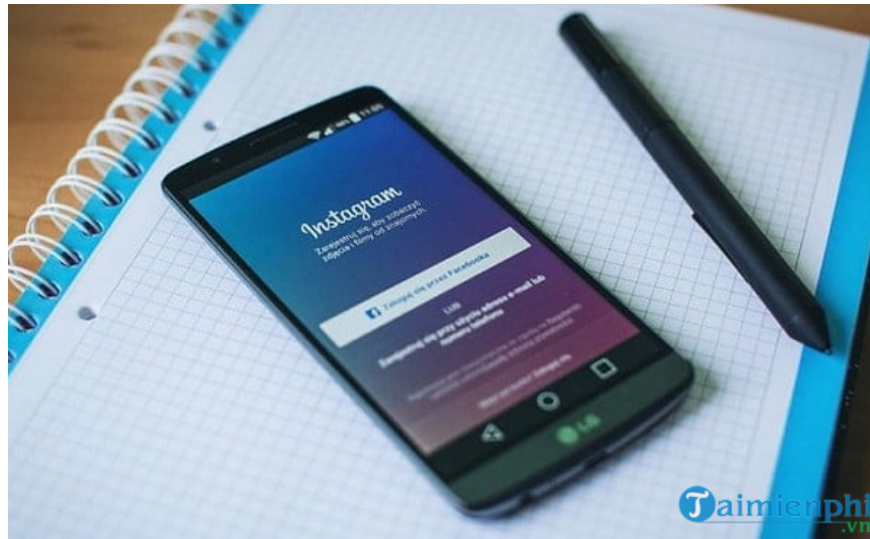
To log out of your Instagram account, follow these steps:

- Go to your profile page and select **Settings**. - Scroll down to the bottom and you will find the **Logout option** .

To log out of your Facebook account, follow these steps:

- Go to your profile page and select the three horizontal lines icon.
- Scroll to the bottom of the page and select **Log Out** .

Method 3: Unlink Instagram from Facebook.



Sometimes changing your Facebook password can prevent you from sharing Instagram posts on Facebook, even though you can still access Facebook directly through Instagram. Therefore, you can fix this by unlinking Instagram from Facebook and then relinking the two accounts using the method suggested above.

To unlink your Instagram account from Facebook, follow these steps:

- Go to **Settings** on your Instagram profile.
- Find and select **Linked Accounts**.
- Select **Facebook** and click **Unlink Account**.

Method 4: Delete Instagram from Facebook

Just like you can unlink Instagram from Facebook, you can also delete Instagram from Facebook. However, remember that when you do this, all your previous Instagram posts will be deleted from Facebook. To delete Instagram from Facebook, follow these steps:

- Open Facebook on your computer browser. Click the small arrow icon in the upper right corner of the screen.
- Select **Settings**.
- Select **Apps and Websites** in the left-hand toolbar.
- Select **Instagram** and click **Remove**.

After successfully deleting Instagram from Facebook, you can try linking Instagram back to Facebook from scratch to see if the issue of not being able to share Instagram posts to Facebook still occurs.
