

How to fix loss of copyright on Windows 10

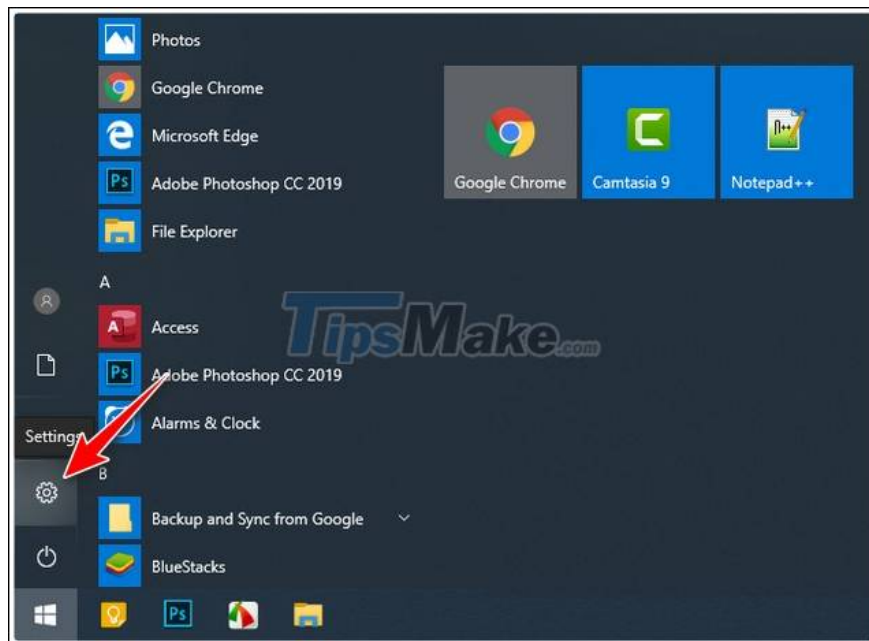

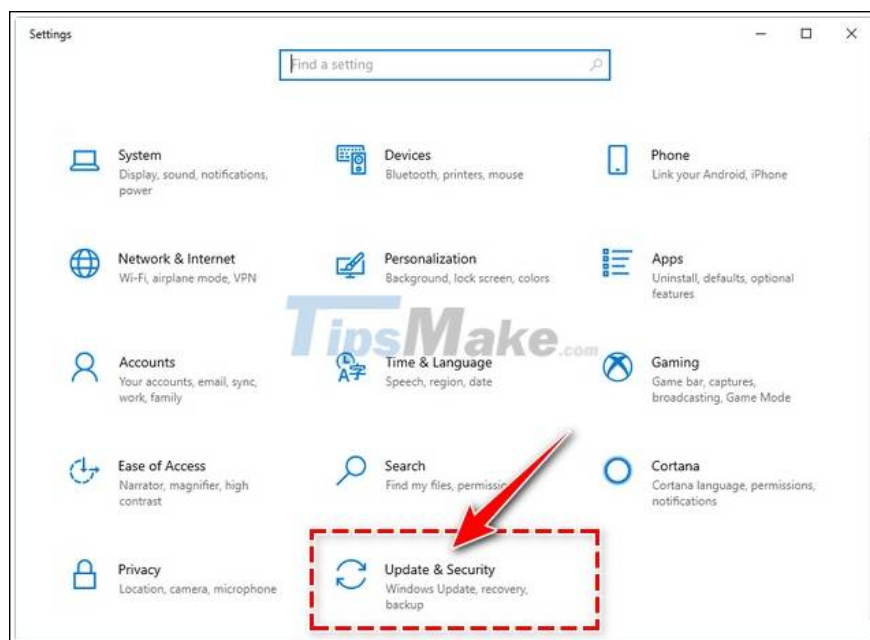

Step 1: Press the Windows button on your keyboard and select Settings. In addition, you can also press the Windows + I key combination for faster access.

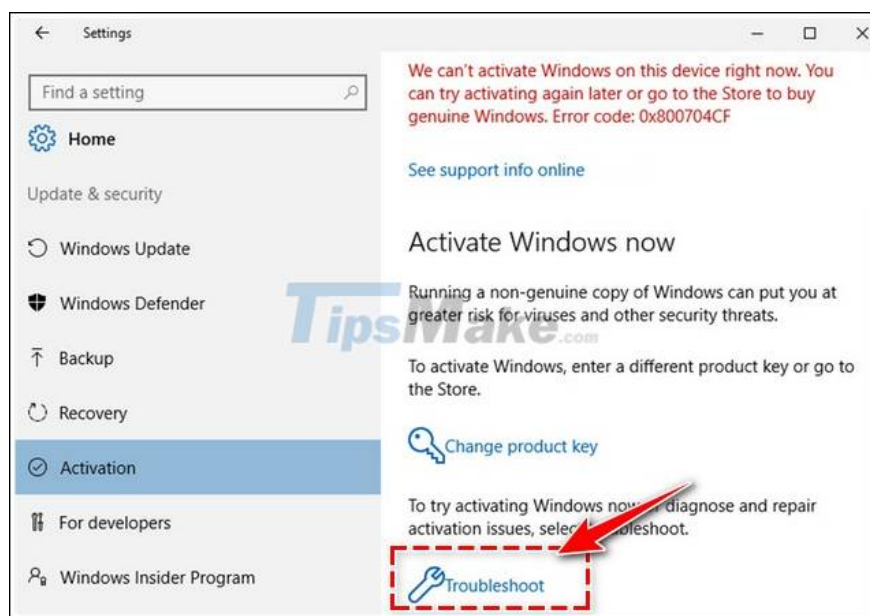


Step 2: In the Settings window, click Update & Security.
