Causes and solutions when losing the mouse pointer on the laptop screen

Losing the mouse cursor on the laptop screen is not a rare situation. This usually happens after you **download the Windows 10 Build 2004 update** . In addition, software errors, drivers and some other errors on the computer can also lead to this situation. So to fix this error, please immediately perform the following **computer tips** :

How to fix the error of losing the mouse pointer on the laptop screen

For each operating system version and different device model, we will have different solutions. However, you can apply some general measures as follows:

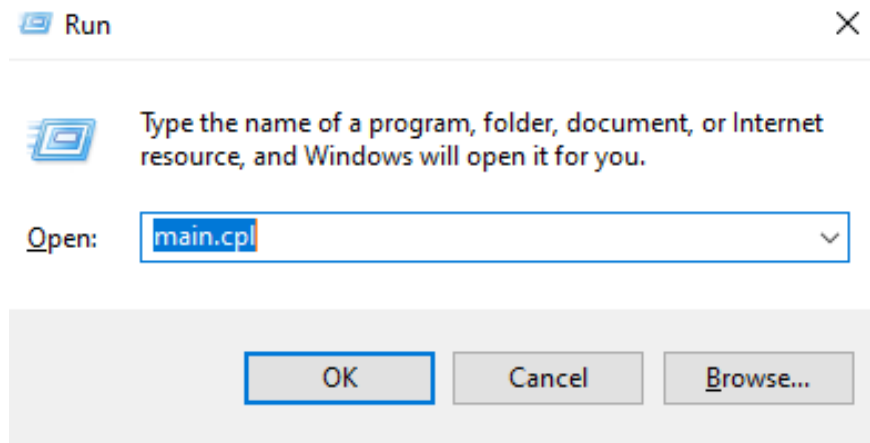
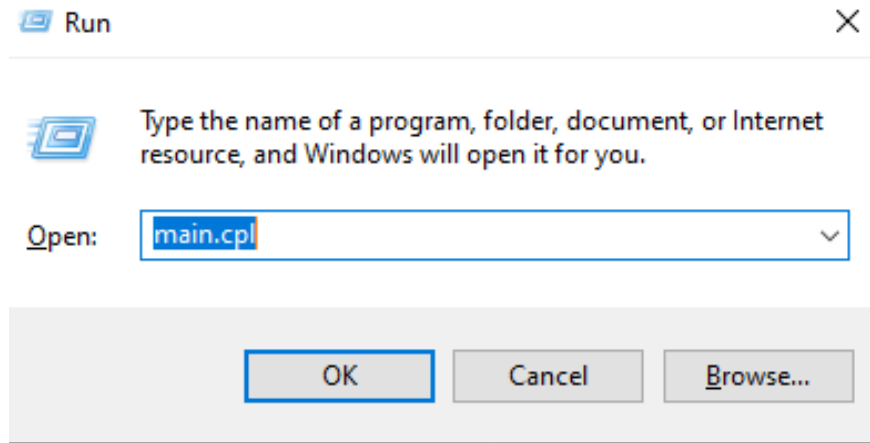
Turn the laptop mouse cursor back on

To fix the problem of losing the mouse pointer on the Windows 10 screen, first try reactivating the mouse pointer on the screen. Press the key **F5** to turn on the mouse pointer. If that doesn't work, you can press a few key combinations like **Fn + F3**, **Fn + F9** or **Fn + F11**. Depending on the device model, the way to turn on the mouse pointer is different. I have shared the details below so you can apply right away!

If you can't turn the mouse pointer on using the key, use the 'run' dialog box.

Step 1 : Press the key combination to open the 'run' dialog box . **window + R**

Step 2 : In the 'run' dialog box , enter **main.cpl** then press ' **Enter** ' on the keyboard to display the mouse properties window.



B3 : Use the 'tab' key to move to item 'pointing Options'. Next use the arrow keys to select 'Show location of pointer when I press the CTRL key' then select 'OK'. With this operation, every time you can't find the mouse pointer, you just need to know where the mouse is on the screen.

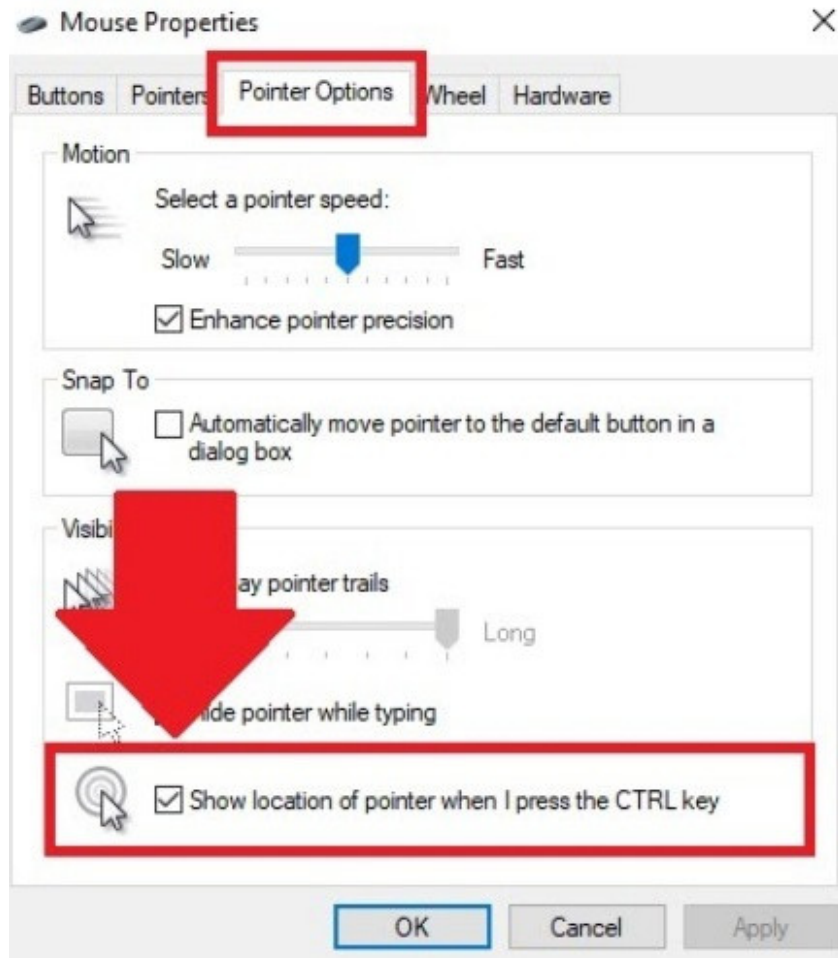

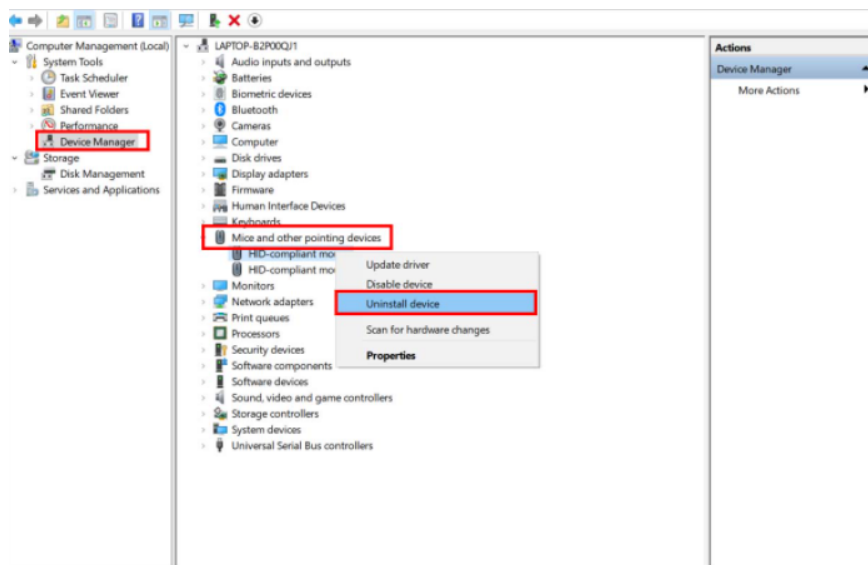
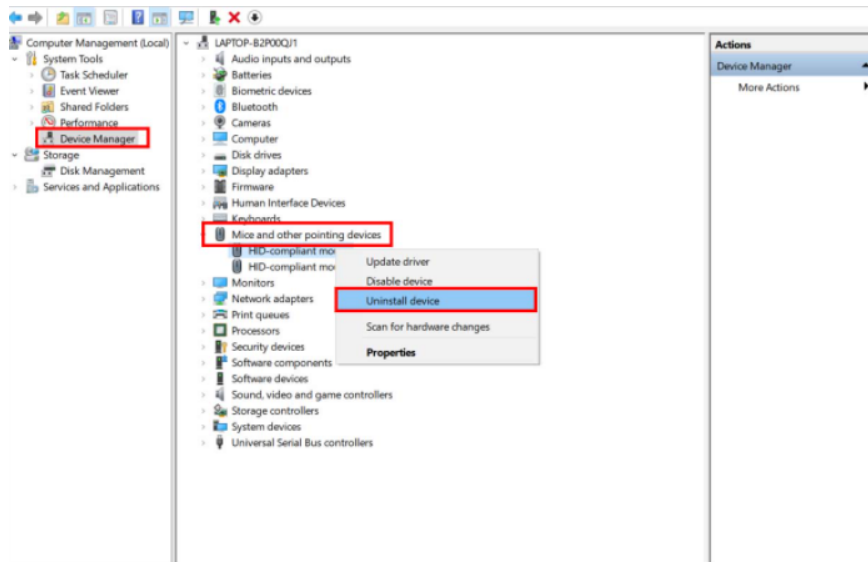
Update mouse driver for laptop

Updating the mouse driver is also an effective solution to fix the error of losing the mouse cursor on the Windows 7 screen. On other versions, you can also do the same.

Step 1 : Press the key combination **windows + R** to open the 'run' dialog box .

Step 2 : Enter **devmgmt.msc** from the keyboard then press 'enter'.

B3 : Use the 'tab' key and the down arrow signs to move to item '**Mice and other pointing devices**'. Then press the right arrow key to expand the '**Mice and other pointing devices**' section .



Step 4 : Scroll to the name of the mouse you are using and press ' **Enter** '.

Step 5 : Use the '**tab**' key and right arrow key to move to item '**Driver**'. Continue pressing '**tab**' to select 'update driver' and finally press 'enter'.

Step 6 : Use the '**tab**' key to select '**automatically**' and follow the instructions.

Use a separate mouse

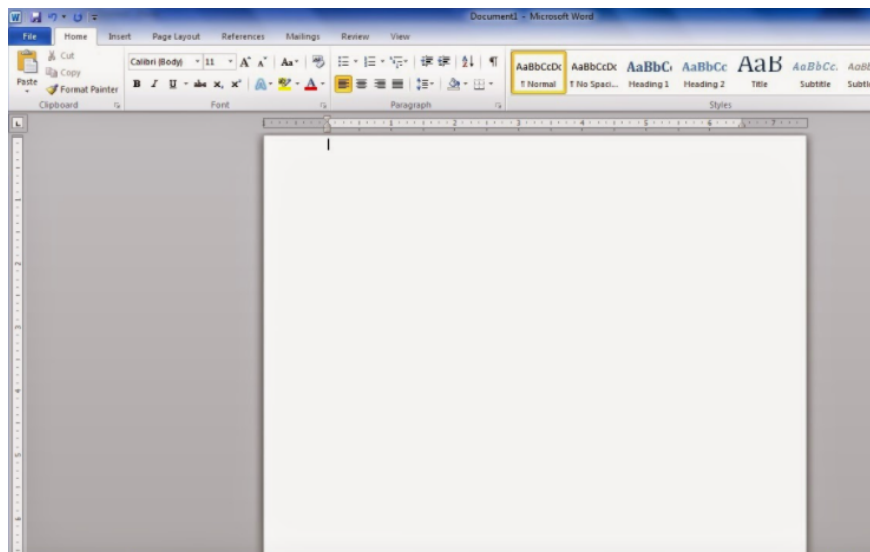
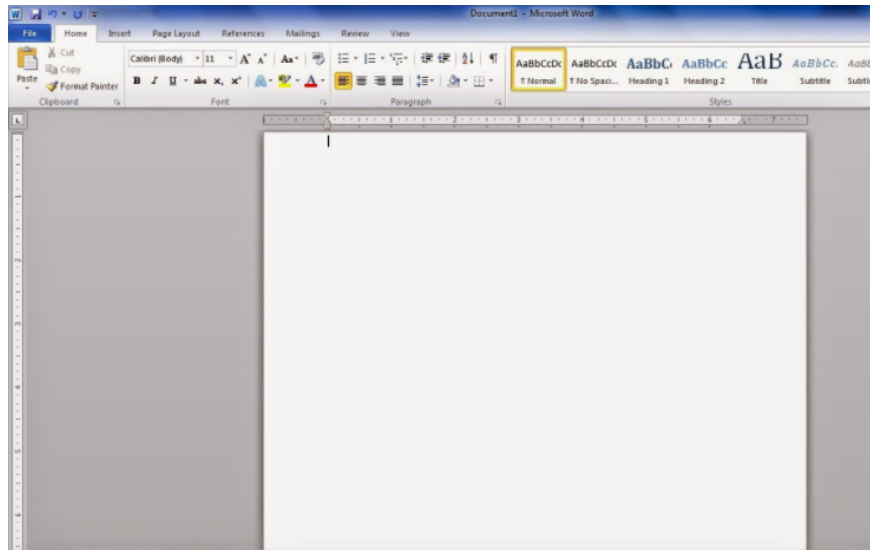
If you cannot use the touch mouse on your laptop. Consider using a separate mouse to fight fires. Currently, you can choose a wireless mouse or wired mouse to temporarily replace the touch mouse for a while.

Above are general instructions to fix the problem of losing the mouse pointer on a laptop. Next we will come to a few specific cases.

Fix the error of losing the mouse pointer in Word

This is an isolated case of losing the mouse pointer. The difference is that you only lose the mouse cursor when opening Word. This mainly stems from the fact that you have installed an unofficial version of Word (crack version). This word version has an error that causes the mouse pointer to be lost. Please install a new version of Word (official version) to fix this situation.



In addition, you should also turn on the mouse pointer on your computer when you lose the mouse pointer in Word. The following information will guide you how to turn on the mouse pointer on each specific device model:

How to turn on the mouse pointer on Asus and Dell laptop screens

Press the Fn + F7 or key combination Fn + F9 on the keyboard to re-enable the mouse pointer on the Asus laptop screen.

In case you lose the mouse pointer on the Dell laptop screen. Now you can try pressing the key combination Fn + F8 to turn the mouse back on.

How to turn on the mouse pointer on HP and Acer laptop screens

When you don't see the mouse on the hp laptop screen. Try pressing twice in a row on the glowing point on the mouse touchpad. Additionally, you can also press a key combination Fn + F7 to turn on the mouse.

Similar to HP laptops, when the mouse pointer is lost on the Acer computer screen. You can also press the key combination Fn + F7.
