

How to fix the error of not being able to print images in Word - Images are not displayed

Errors of not being able to print images, or not displaying images on Word, will make it difficult for users to print documents.

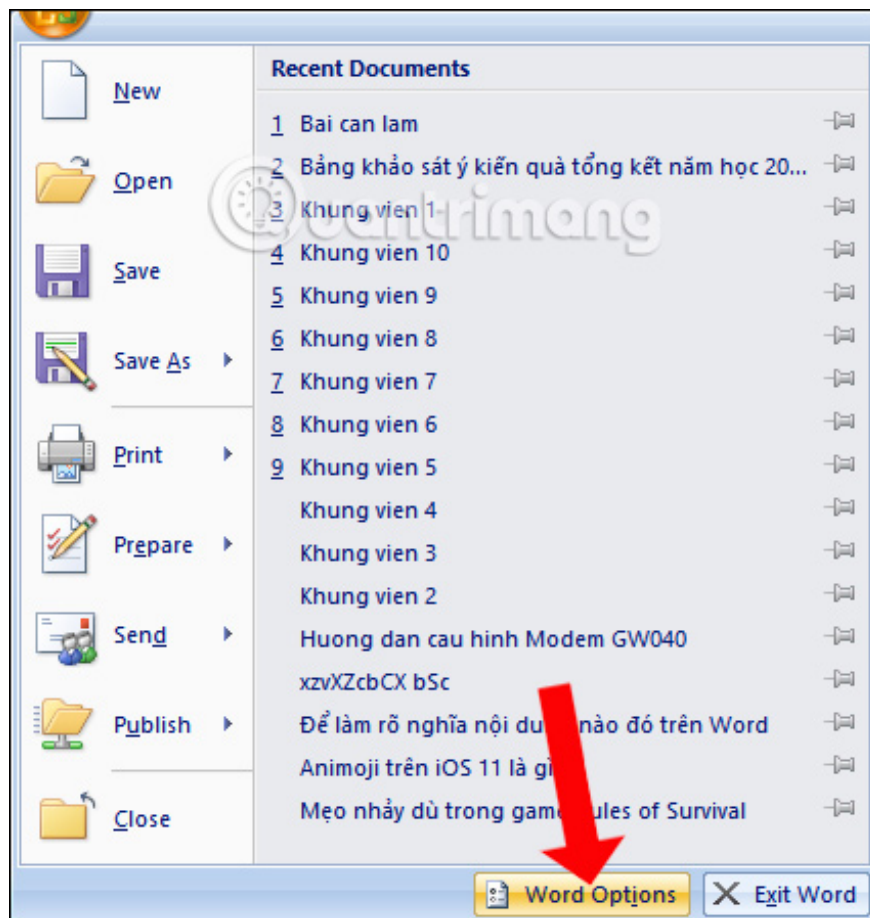
Inserting images into Word is extremely simple and can be done similarly on different versions of Word. And during the process of editing or printing data, sometimes you will encounter an error of not being able to print images on Word. When printing a Word document, the image will not appear in the file, affecting the content in the file. Even if you change to an image with a smaller capacity or smaller size, the image will still not display in Word for printing or exporting to a PDF file.

In fact, this is not a big error, but you can edit it right in Word's settings, with different versions to fix the error of not printing photos on Word.

Instructions to fix the error of not being able to print images on Word

Step 1:

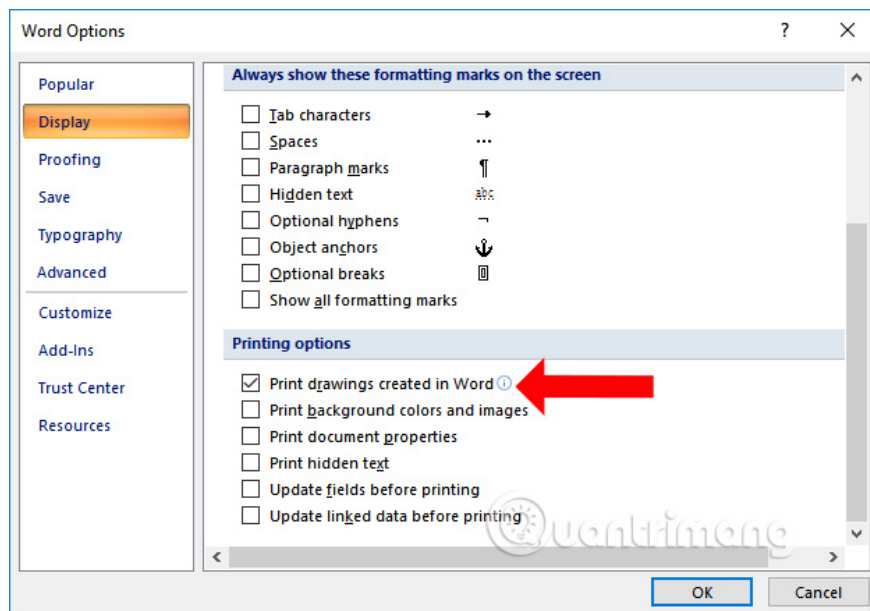
We click on **the Office icon** and then select **Word Options** .



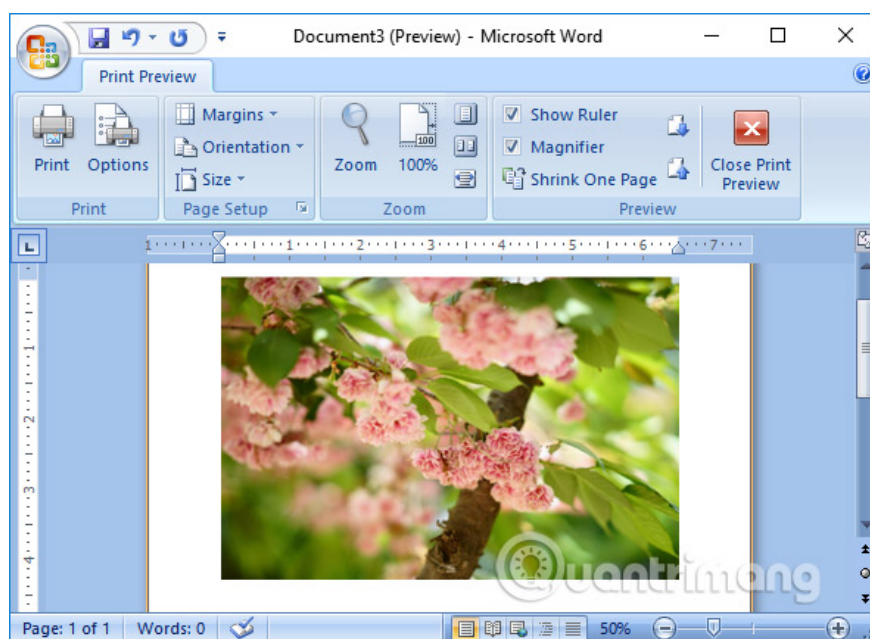
Step 2:

In the new interface, click on Display , then look to the right to find the **Printing Options** setting group to customize the printing mode on Word.

Next, **select Print drawings created in Word** to display the image again in Word when printing and click OK to finish.



Return to the document and click Print to preview the document when printing. Images inserted into the Word file will be displayed again.



Because during the printing customization process, you accidentally turned off the image display mode on Word when printing, and an error occurred that the image could not be printed on Word. Just adjust the image printing mode on Word according to the article above.
