

How to fix the error of not sending messages on Facebook Messenger

3. Update the Facebook Messenger application to the new version

Check if there are any new updates available for the Messenger app and update it to the latest version. The new update can fix errors and issues related to messages not being sent on Messenger.

4. Update the web browser on your computer

Sometimes the error of not being able to send messages on Facebook Messenger is because your web browser is on an old version, not fully supported by Facebook. Indeed, this case is rare but not impossible. 5. Delete cache and Facebook Messenger data

In your device's app settings, you can find and select the Messenger app. Then, select "Storage" or "Storage" and clear the app's cache and data. Restart Messenger after completing this process and try sending the message again.

6. Check network configuration

Sometimes, your device's network settings can cause problems when sending messages on Messenger. Check your network settings and make sure there aren't any restrictions on the Messenger app.

7. Use Another Wi-Fi Network

If you're having trouble sending messages on Facebook Messenger while using a mobile network, trying to connect to a different Wi-Fi network can be a helpful solution to determine the cause of the problem.

Mobile networks may experience connection issues or bandwidth limitations, making it difficult to send messages. By switching to a different Wi-Fi connection, you can eliminate the possibility of your mobile network causing the problem.

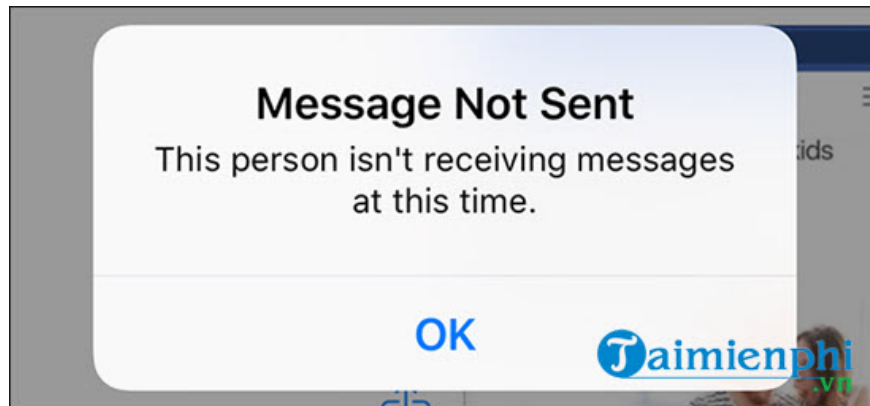

8. Contact Facebook Messenger support center

If you've tried all of the above methods and the problem persists, you may need to contact Facebook support for detailed support and guidance.

9. You have been blocked from contacting

And another obvious thing is that the error of not being able to send messages on Facebook Messenger is because the other person has blocked you. And of course when they block you, you will not be able to send them messages on Facebook Messenger. This case cannot be cured and the only solution is to create another account and chat with the person who blocked you.
