

How to fix the error of the computer screen being minimized 2 sides

One of the most common errors on the computer screen is that the screen is scaled on one side or both sides with a black background.

Do not worry ! I will guide you how to fix the computer screen is shrinking, black border on both sides, 1 side most effectively.



1. Recalibrate the screen

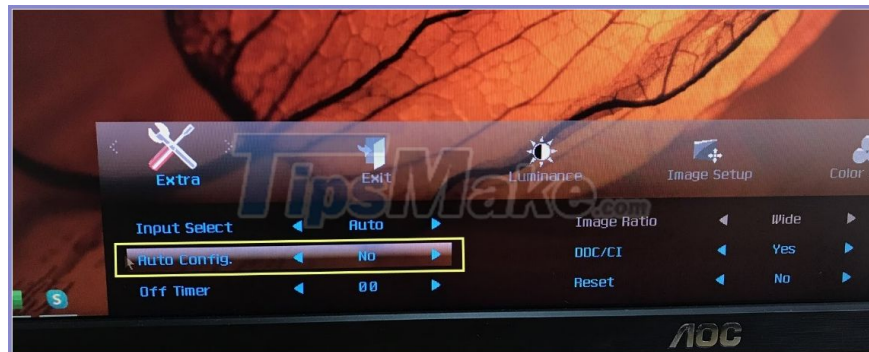
Any monitor model when shipped is also equipped with the feature to tweak, align the screen through the hard key cluster below or on the side of the screen.

The screen alignment feature will help the monitor to bring the correct display frame to the center of the screen or to a certain direction if you want. To enable the screen alignment feature, you need to do the following:

Step 1: Click the **Settings** button on the screen to appear the options window, where you go to the Extra / Restart / Config . (each screen has a different name).



Step 2: Then you go to **Auto Config / Restart** and enable them to **On** so that the screen automatically aligns the data displayed in the center.



In some cases the screen does not align itself to the center or is still a little off, you can choose **Image Setup** and adjust the **H.Position** (left and right) or **V.Position** (adjust up down).

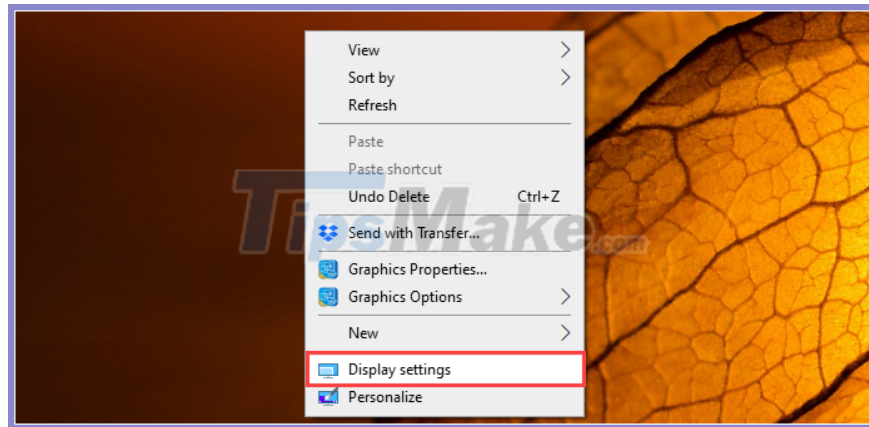


2. Set the resolution for the monitor

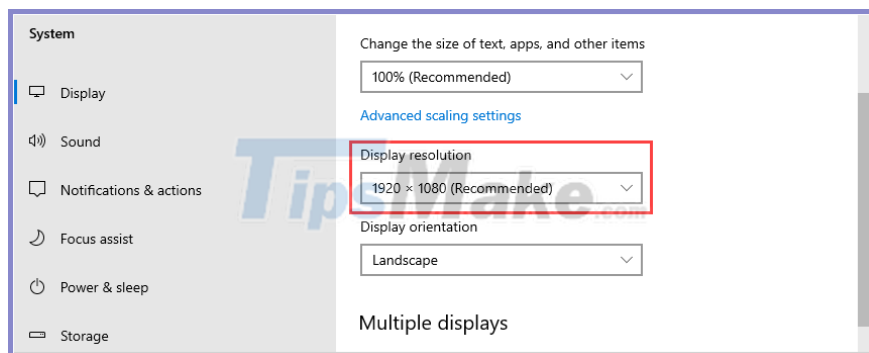
Normally, each monitor will be shipped with different resolutions and if the system has not set the correct resolution, the two sides of the screen will be scaled.

In this case, you just need to set up the correct resolution for the monitor you are using. The display resolution settings on Windows 10 are very simple, you just need to do the following:

Step 1: First, **right-click on the Desktop** and select **Display Settings** (monitor settings).



Step 2 : Then you go to **Display Resolution** and you proceed to set them up on the resolution with **Recommended (recommended)** section .

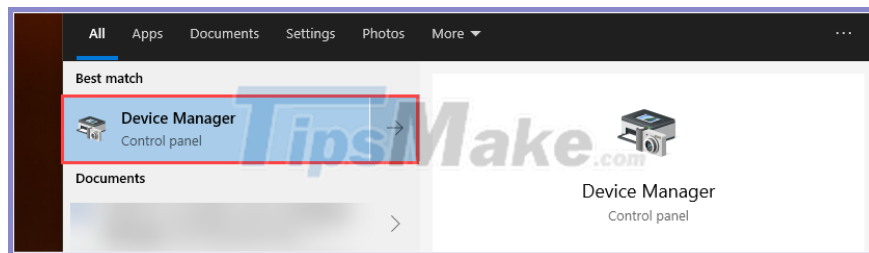


When you set the display resolution to the correct screen resolution, they will not be reduced and the black border on both sides will disappear. So, you have successfully fixed the error.

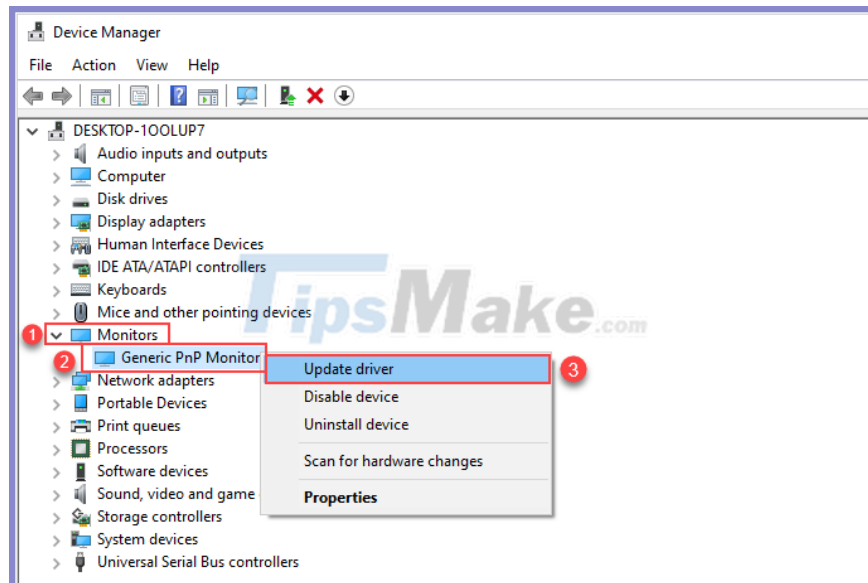
3. Update Driver for the monitor

To display the image, the Windows operating system needs certain drivers, in some cases the driver of the screen has an error that also causes the screen to be miniature and has black borders on either side or one side . In this case, you need to do the following:

Step 1: First of all, open **MenuStart** and enter **Device Manager** to open.

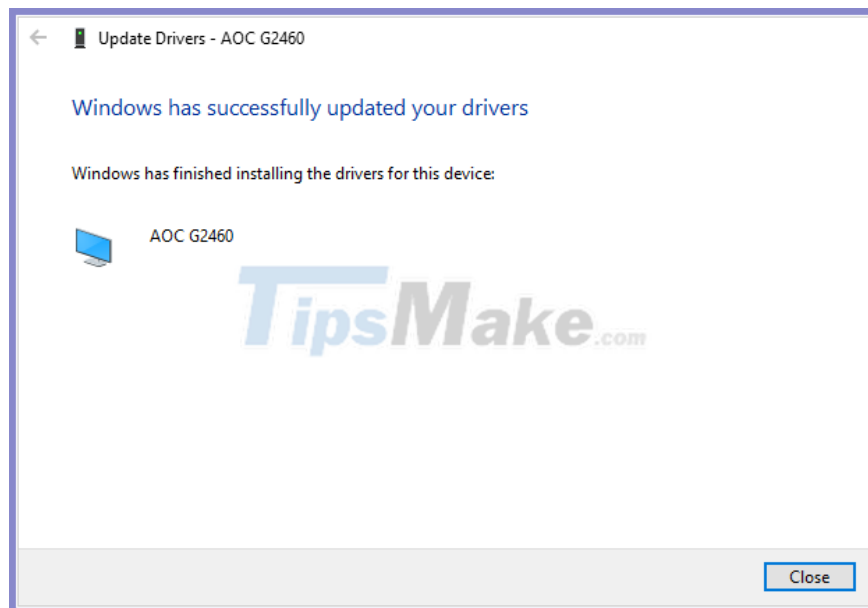


Step 2: Then you open the **Monitors** and you will see the **Genetic PnP Monitor** , where you **right-click** and select **Update Driver** .



The system will automatically search and update the latest Driver for your monitor.

Step 3: When the screen is updated Driver is complete, you will receive the message as shown below, now you select **Close** and restart the machine is finished.
