Fix Steam not working

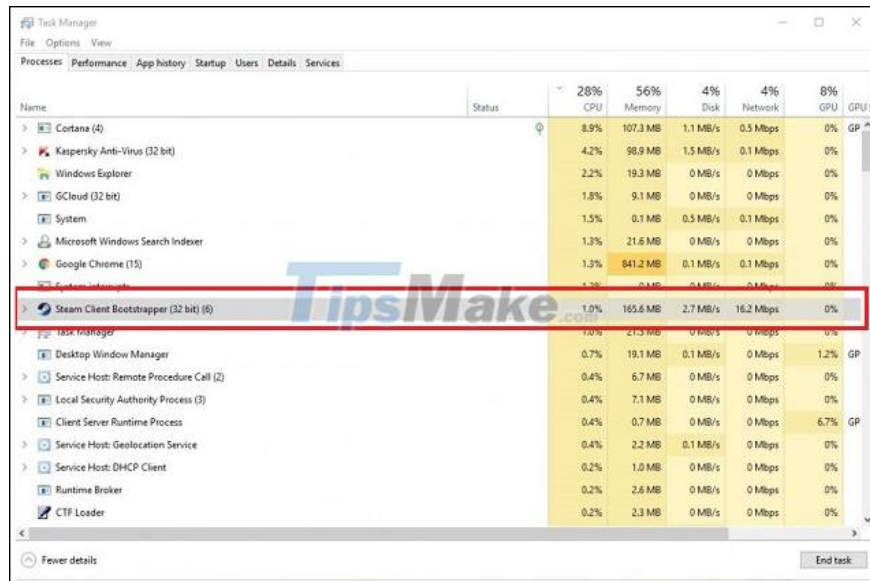
Method 1: Restart Steam

In this way, we will restart Steam with all its related tasks active on the computer, details are as follows:

Step 1: Press Alt + Ctrl + Del on the keyboard to display the Task Manager Window.

Step 2: In the Processes tab, navigate to Steamstra Bootstrapper.

Step 3: Click the End task button below.



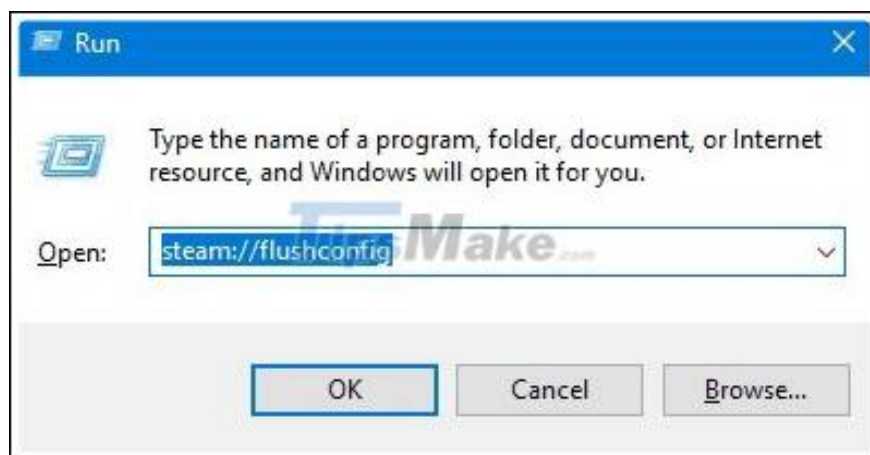
Step 4: Once done, restart Steam on your Windows 10 computer.

Method 2: Clear the Cache memory

We can also try by clearing Steam's Way memory on Windows 10 computer, the steps you need to take are as follows:

Step 1: Press the Windows + R key combination to launch the Run Command window.

Step 2: Type steam: // flushconfig and press Enter.



Step 3: Restart Steam on the computer.

Step 4: Select the Downloads section of Steam and click on the Clear Download Cache button.

Step 5: Click the OK button to confirm clearing the Cache. Then restart your computer and Steam.



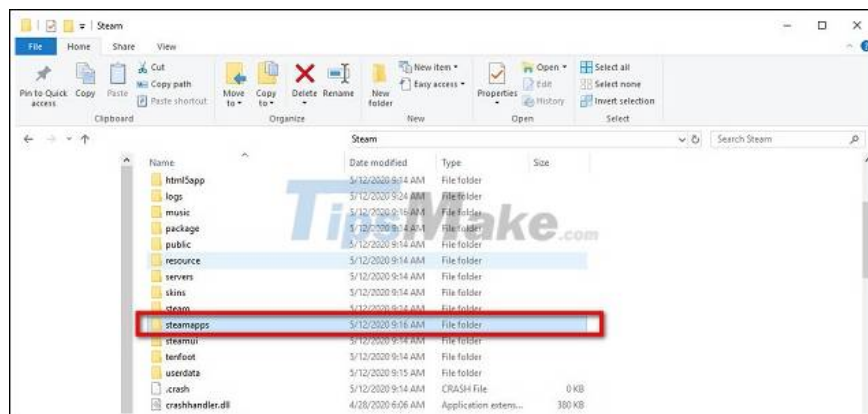
Method 3: Reinstall Steam

In case both of the above methods do not work, we recommend you to uninstall and reinstall Steam for your Windows 10 computer. Don't worry because all your data and games will not be deleted. Proceed as follows:

Step 1: Open File Explorer on your computer.

Step 2: Navigate to the directory of Steam.

Step 3: Select the steamapps folder and copy it to another location on your computer.



Step 4: Uninstall and reinstall Steam to the computer.

Step 5: After you have completed the above steps, replace the current steamapps folder in your computer with the folder that was copied earlier.

Step 6: Restart Steam on the computer.
