

How to fix the error that cannot update Windows 10

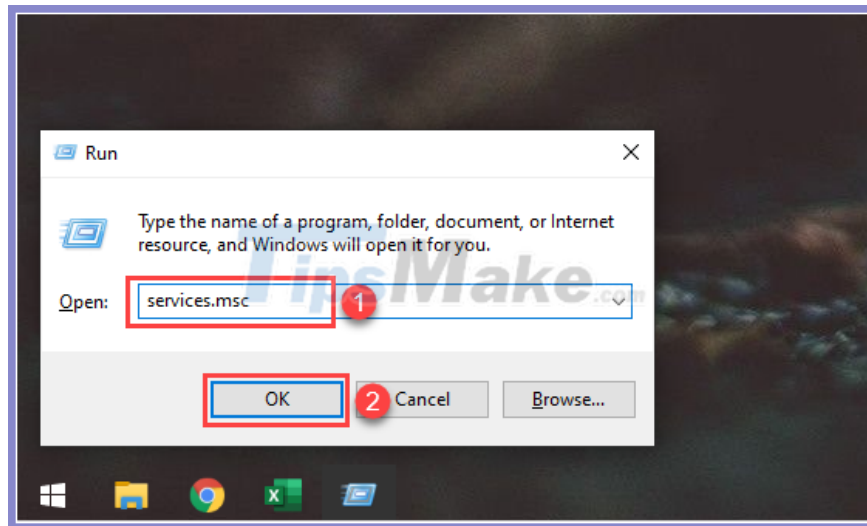
One of the fairly common errors on Windows 10 is not being able to update to the highest version.

In this article, I will guide you how to fix Windows 10. Please follow the instructions below:

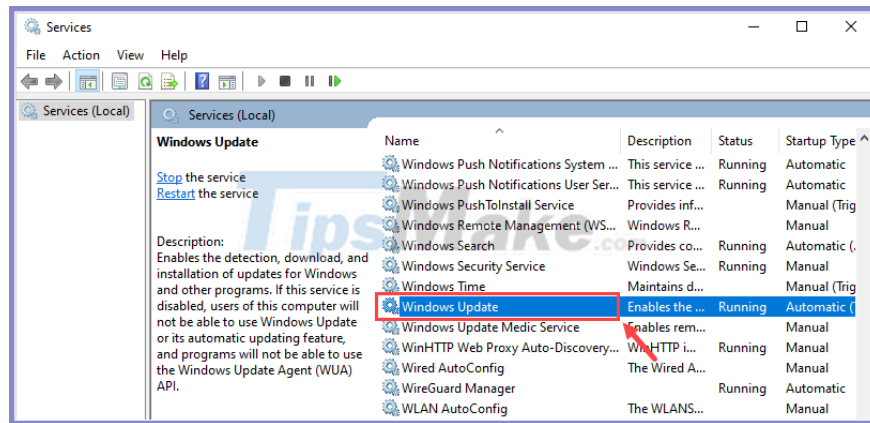
1. Turn on Update Windows 10

Normally, those who install Windows for you will turn off Windows Update to avoid being checked for copyright as well as encountering 'stupid' errors of the new Windows version. Disabling Update Windows will prevent your computer from updating itself and will live forever with the old version of Windows. To re-enable the Windows 10 Update feature, you need to do the following:

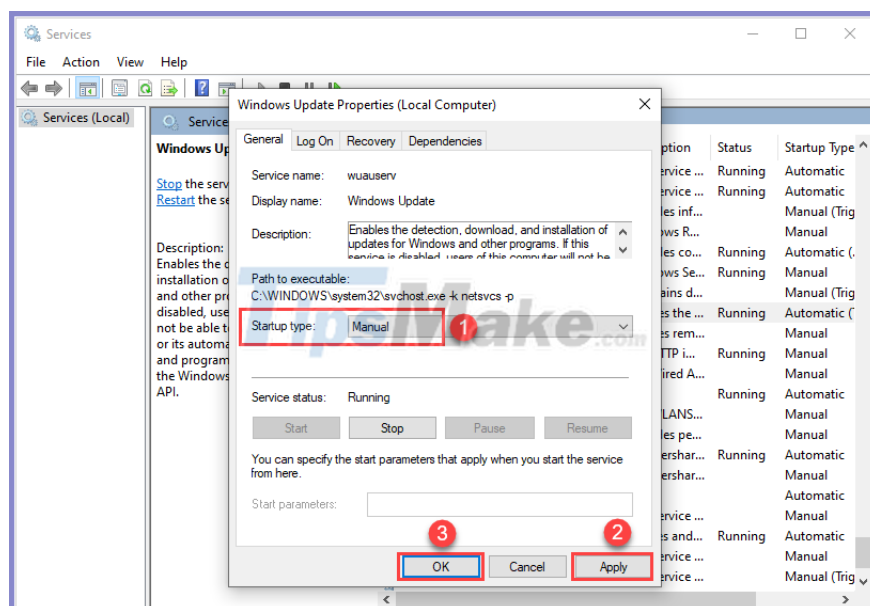
Step 1: First, press Windows + R to open the RUN window, when the RUN window appears, enter Services.msc and click OK to finish.



Step 2: When the Services window appears, scroll down to find the Windows Update item .



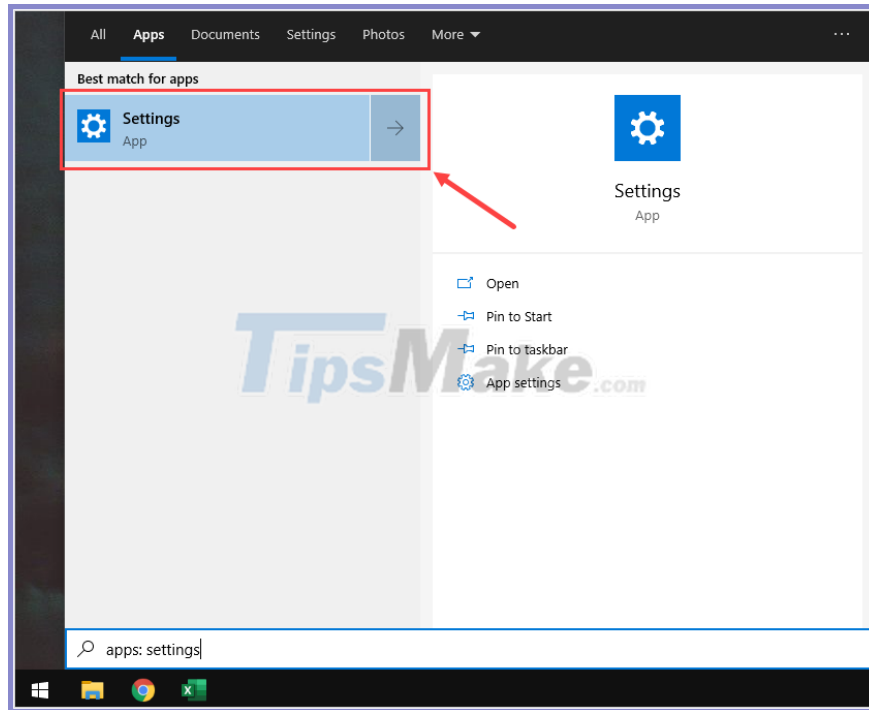
Step 3: At the Windows Update Properties window , set the Startup Type to Manual and click Apply -> OK in turn to complete the setup.



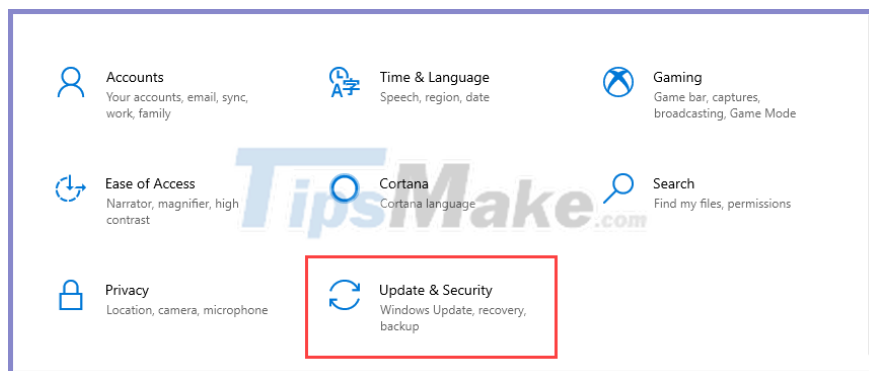
2. Change Windows 10 Update pause date

On Windows 10, when you do not want to update Windows, the system will automatically delay Update date and when they are too far back, forcing you to adjust to the nearest date so that they automatically update.

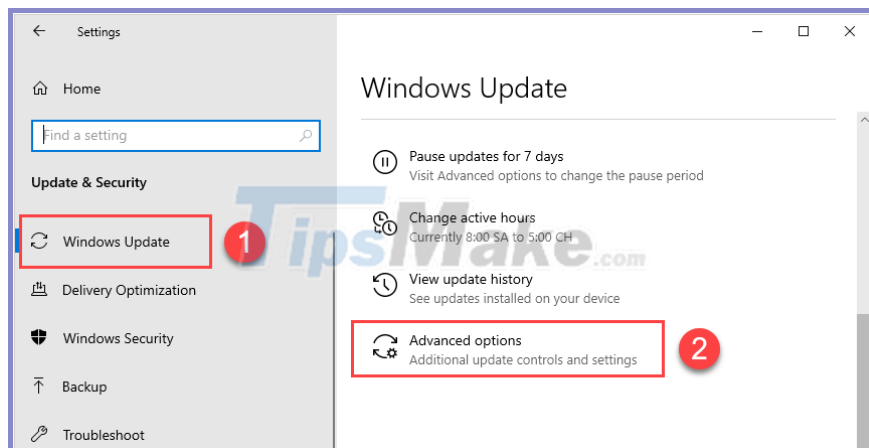
Step 1: First, open MenuStart and enter Settings to open.



Step 2: In the Settings window , select Update & Security to open Windows update settings.

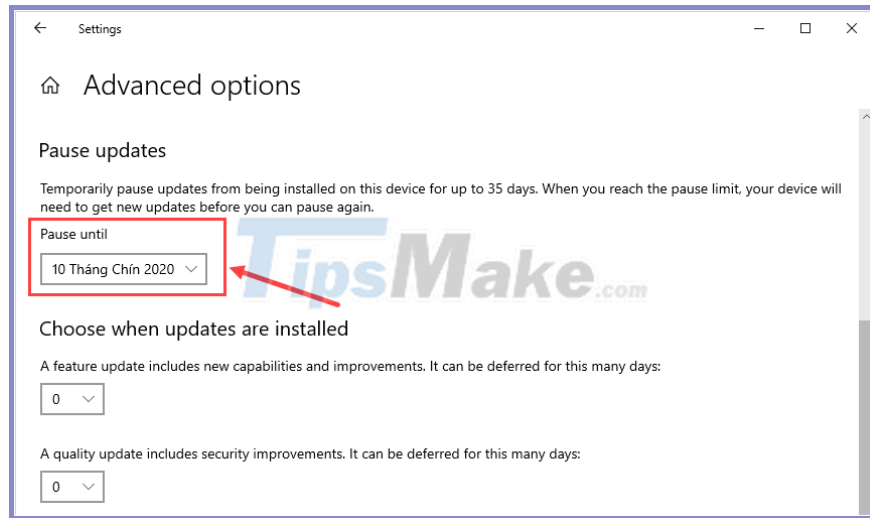


Step 3: You continue to select Windows Update and select Advanced options .



Step 5: When the Advanced Options window appears, you proceed to find the Pause Update section . Here, you make an appointment for your computer to automatically update to the latest version.

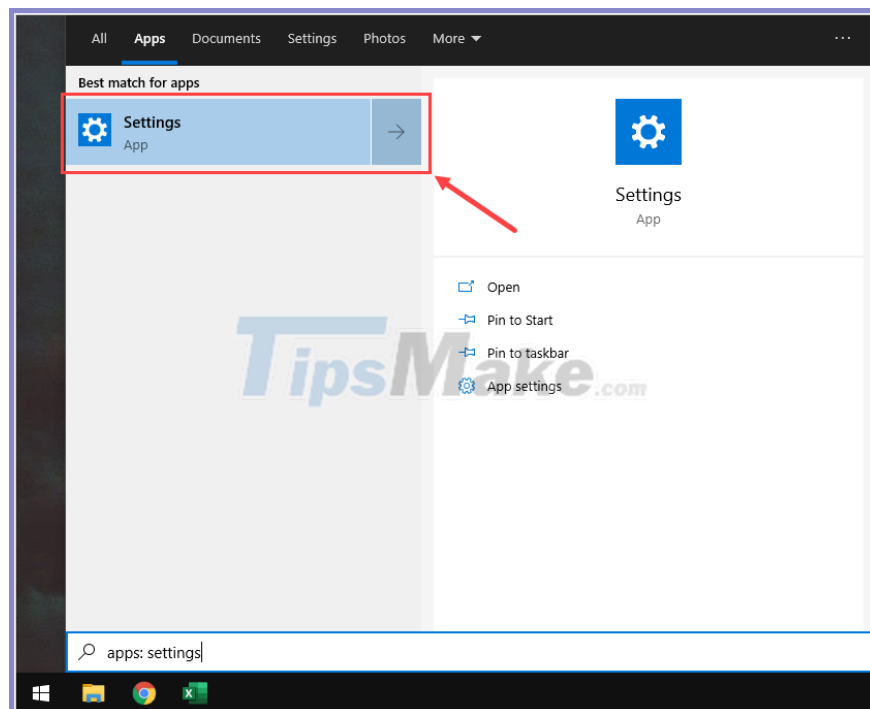
Note: Set the appointment date as closest date to current time



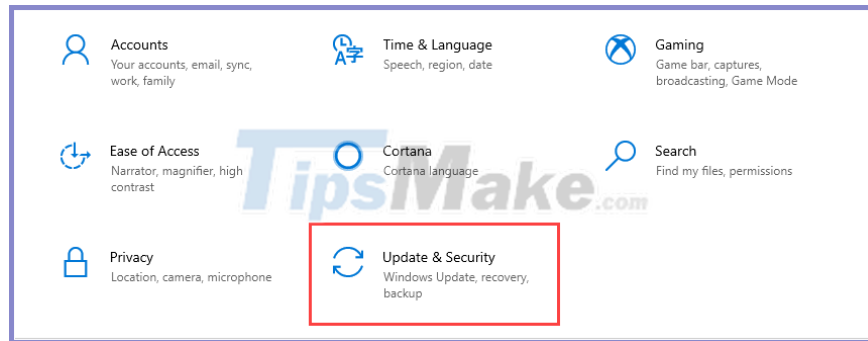
3. Use Windows 10's debugger

Windows 10 operating system was born with automatic error correction feature directly through Troubleshoot tool, this tool also supports you to check Windows update feature on your computer.

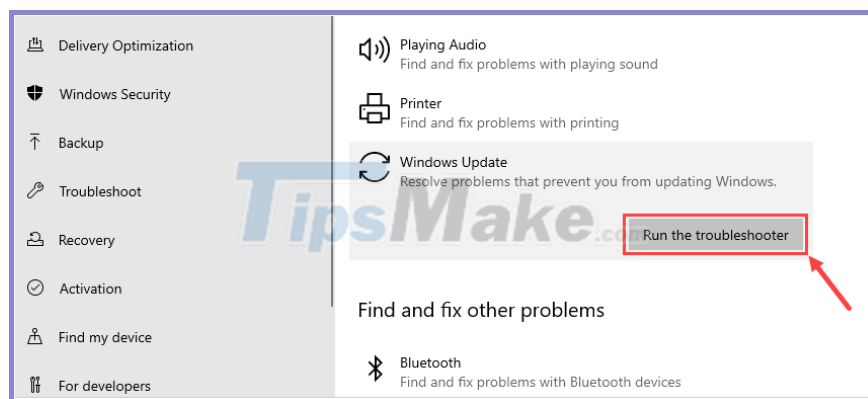
Step 1: First, open MenuStart and enter Settings to open.



Step 2: In the Settings window , select Update & Security to open Windows update settings.



Step 3: Next, you need to choose Troubleshoot and click Windows Update to run the fixer. You choose Run the Troubleshoot , the system will automatically run and support you to update Windows to the latest version.

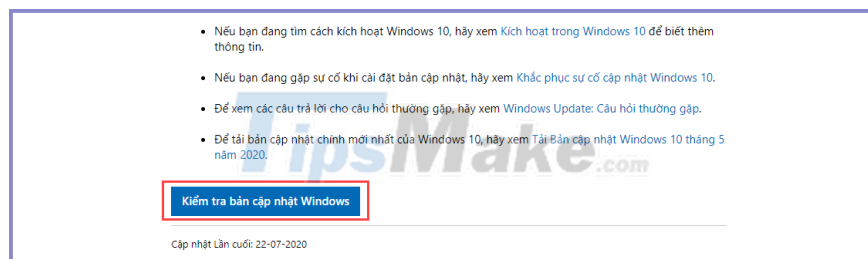


4. Use check for Windows 10 updates

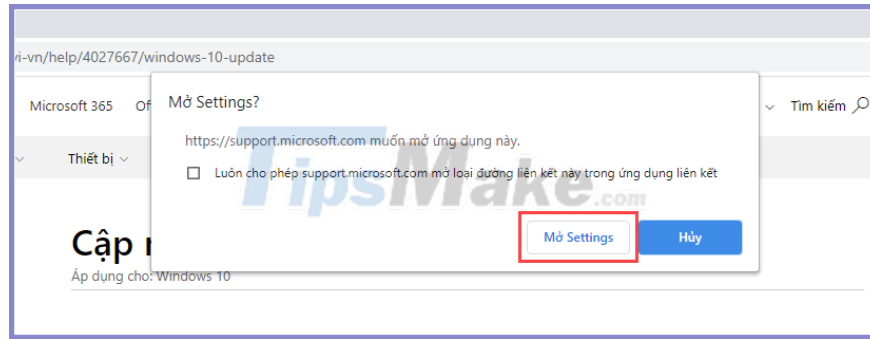
In addition to monitoring the Windows version on the computer, Microsoft also supports users to check online for suitable updates for the machine.

Step 1: Go to the homepage and click Check for Windows updates .



Step 2: Next, choose Open Settings , the system will automatically check for updates and give you a report.
