

How to fix The installer error uncompress archive on Chrome

There are many Chrome installation errors or upgrade errors affecting users, such as The installer error failed to uncompress the archive.

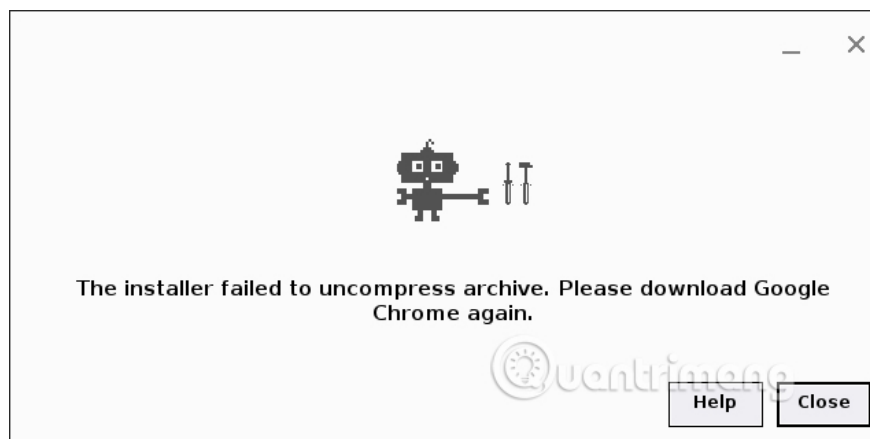
The errors that occur when installing Chrome or in the process of surfing the web on Chrome have many types, such as the error **The installer failed to uncompress the archive** . This error may occur when we install Chrome browser, or when you update Chrome to the latest version. And when displaying this error message, the user cannot continue the job.

The most common way to fix errors is to remove Chrome and reinstall it. However, in the case of the above error, reinstalling Chrome is not enough to fix, the error reporting interface is still displayed. The following article will guide you how to fix the error **The installer failed to uncompress the archive** in Chrome browser.

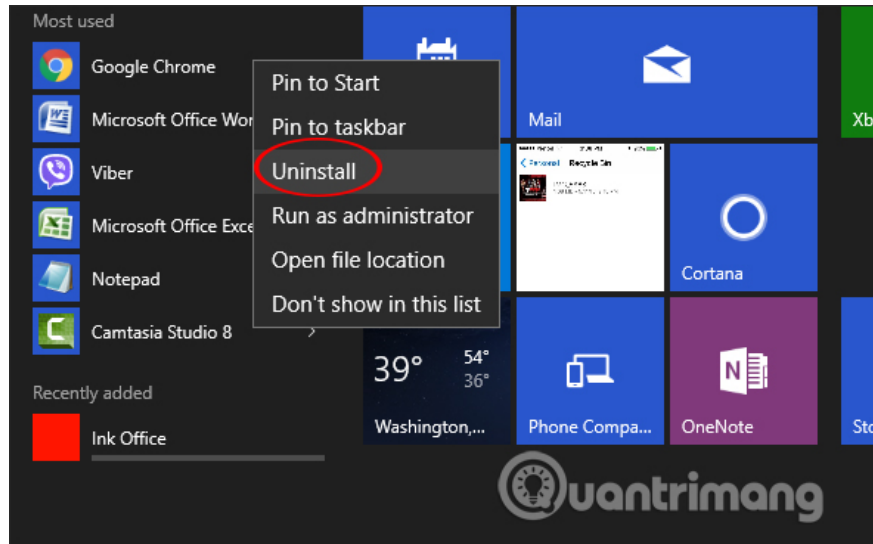
Instructions to fix errors on Chrome browser

The error message looks like below.



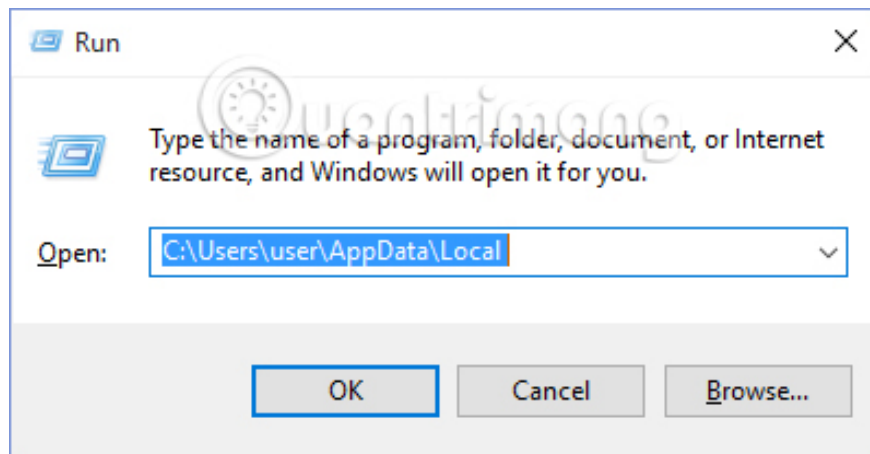
Step 1:

First of all, we also need to **remove Chrome** in the usual way.



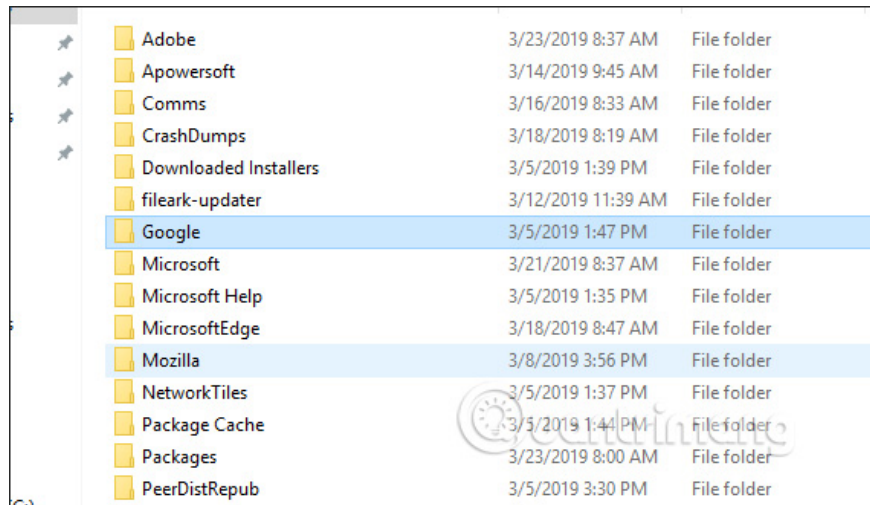
Step 2:

Next go to drive C and follow the path **C: Users [account name] AppDataLocal** to open the Local folder of the user account. Or copy the path into the Run interface for quick access.



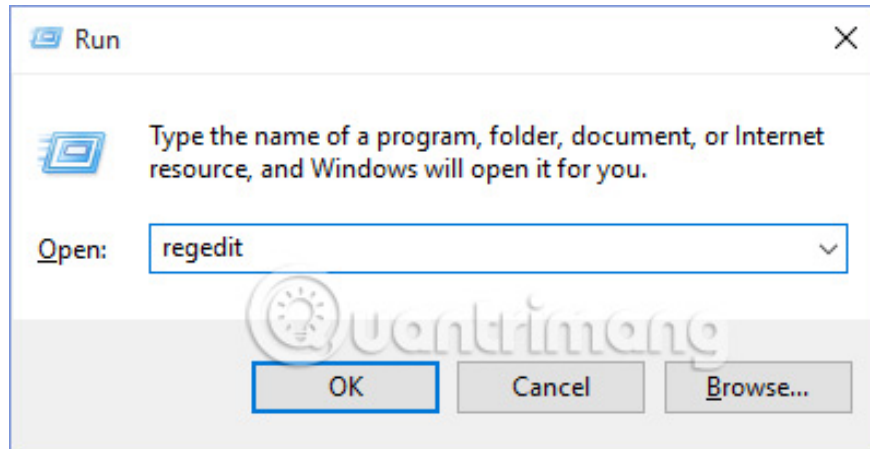
Step 3:

In the new display interface, users navigate to **the Google directory** and press **Delete** to delete.

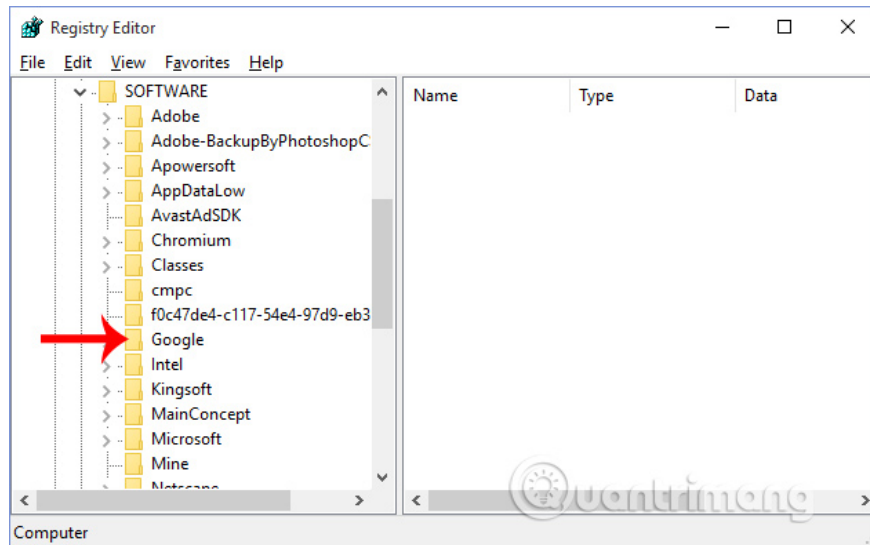


Step 4:

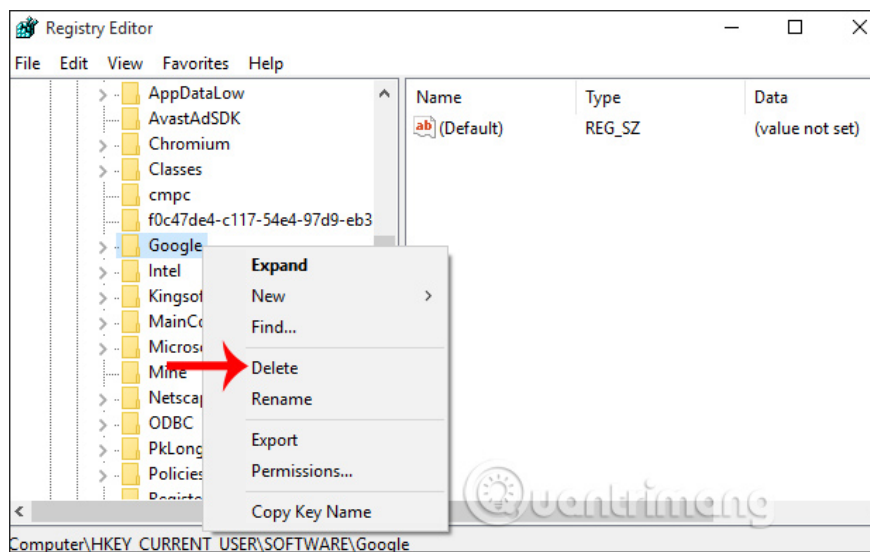
Next, open the Run dialog box and enter the **keyword regedit** .



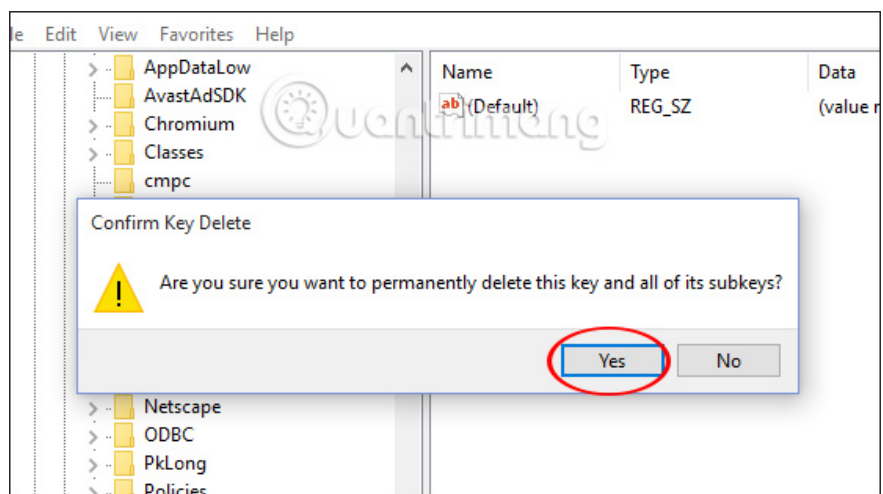
In the Registry Editor interface, users proceed to access the **HKEY_CURRENT_USERSOFTWAREGoogle** path.



Then right-click on **the Google key** and then **press Delete** to delete the Google key.



When displaying the bulletin board as shown below, **click Yes** to agree to delete. We do the same thing with the Google key under the **HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINESOFTWARE** path.



In case the Google key cannot be deleted, it can be ignored. Finally, we restart Windows and then reinstall Chrome browser. If the error is not fixed, proceed to follow the steps above.
