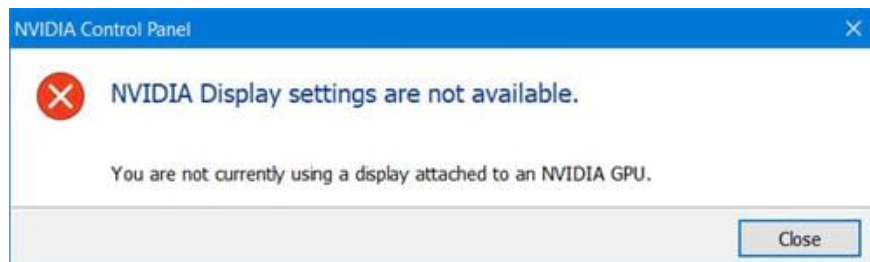


How to fix the Nvidia Display settings are not available error.

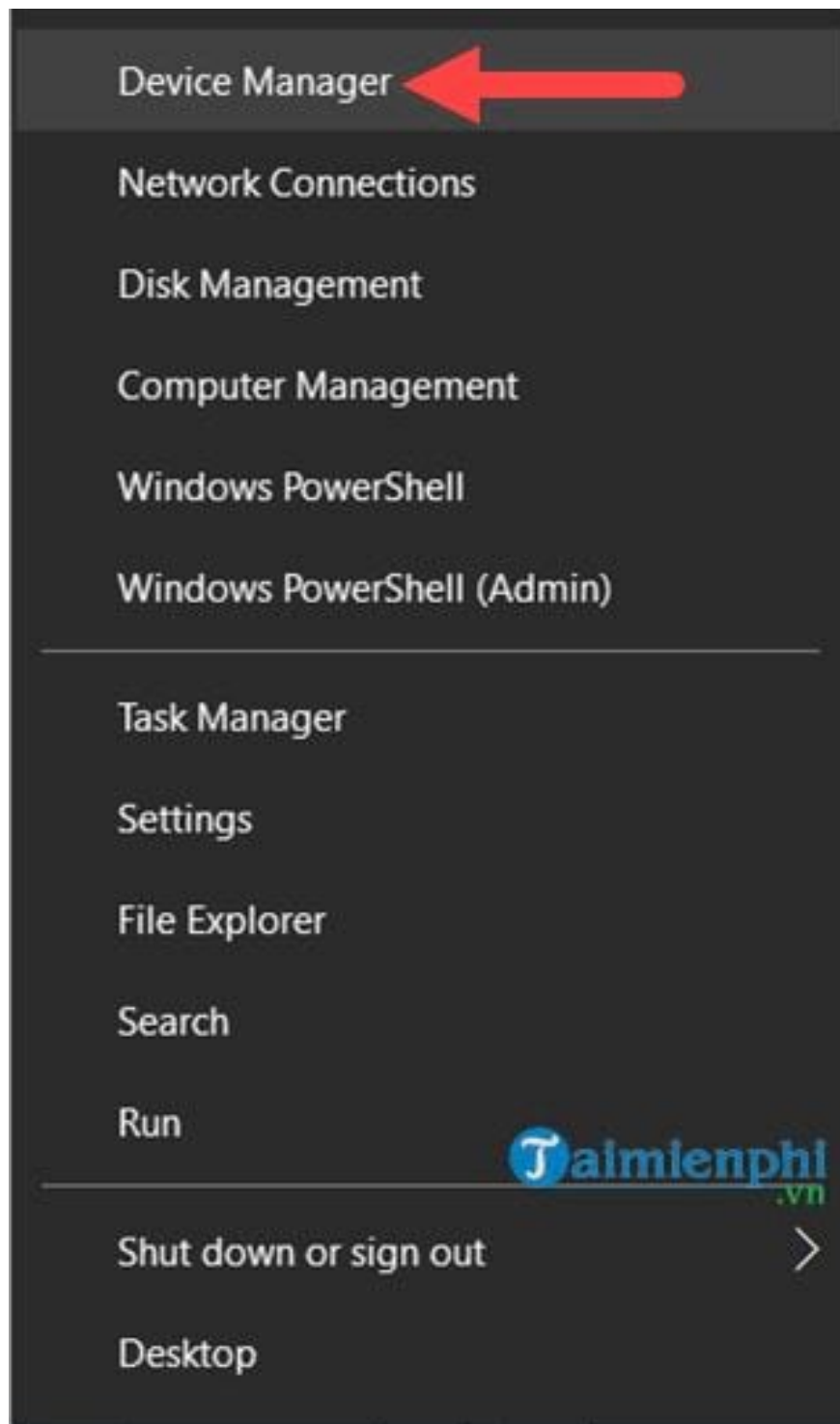

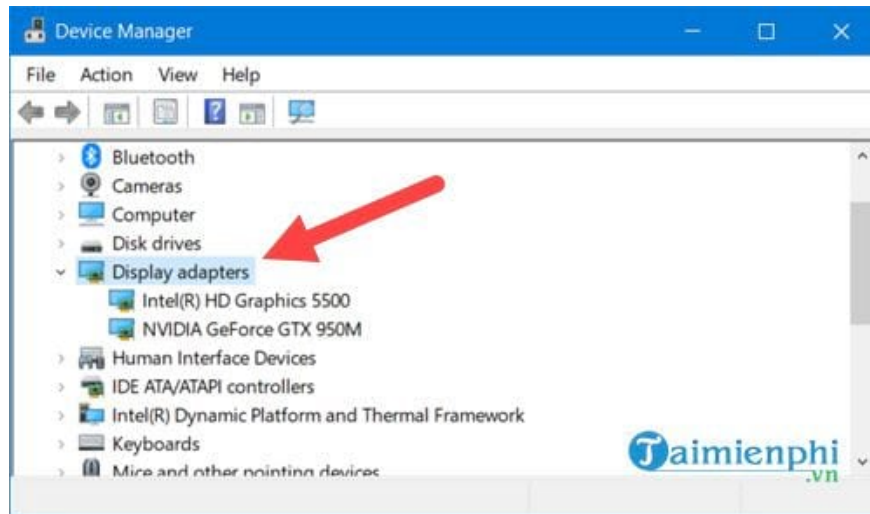

Instructions for fixing the "Nvidia Display settings are not available" error.

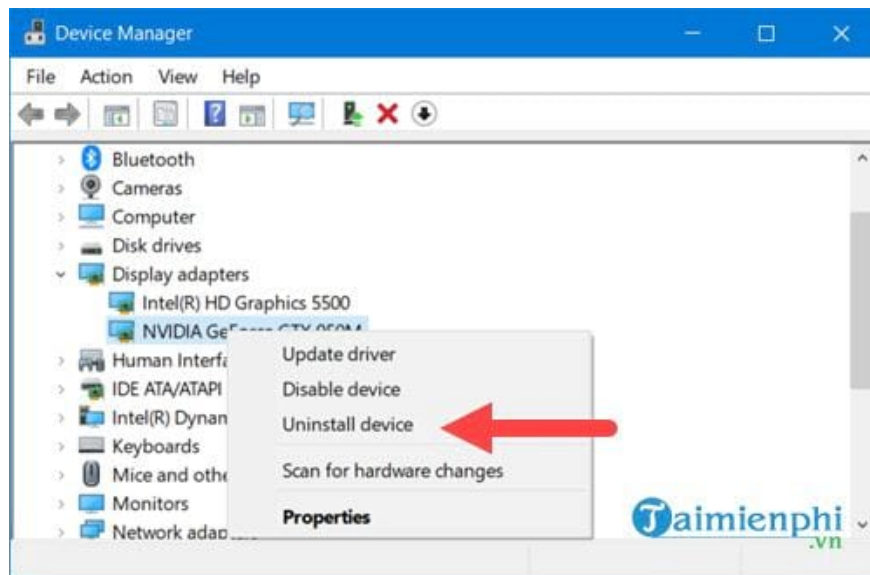
Step 1: To fix the "Nvidia Display settings are not available" error, first press **the Windows key + X** , then select **Device Manager** .



Step 2: Next, select the **Display adapters** section , where you will see the VGA cards currently installed in your system.



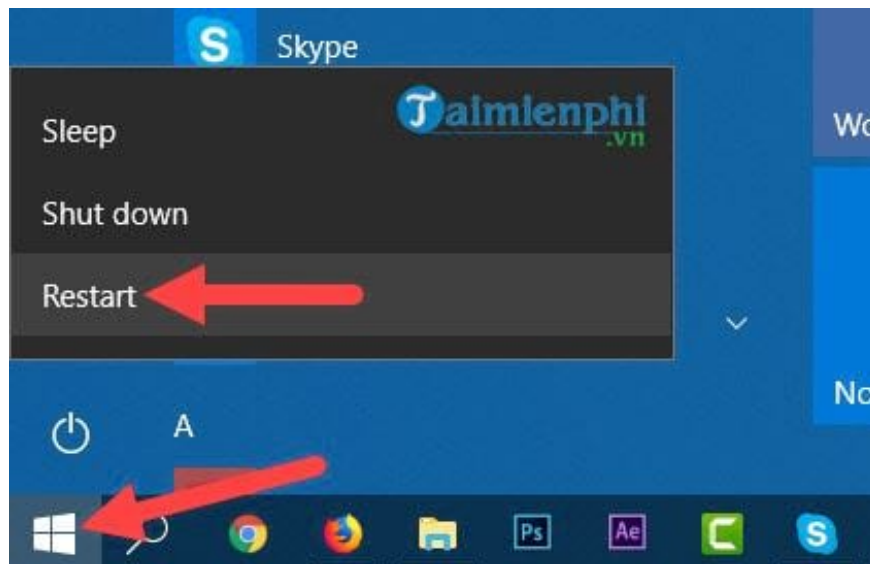
Step 3: However, to fix the "Nvidia Display settings are not available" error, we must uninstall it by right-clicking > selecting **"Uninstall device"** .



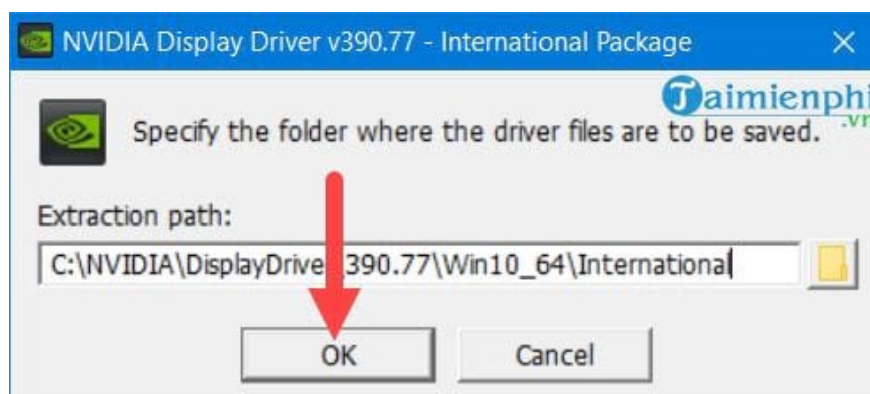
Step 4: Confirm the uninstallation one more time and click **Uninstall** .



Step 5: After uninstalling the Nvidia driver, restart **your computer immediately** .



Step 6: Make sure your computer restarts before proceeding to this step. Download the latest Nvidia driver from here, extract it, and install it.



The extraction process may take a few minutes of your time.



Step 7: After the extraction is complete, the system will check for driver compatibility. If we did not restart the computer in the previous step, this step will definitely fail.



Step 8: Click on **Agree and continue** to agree to install the Nvidia driver.

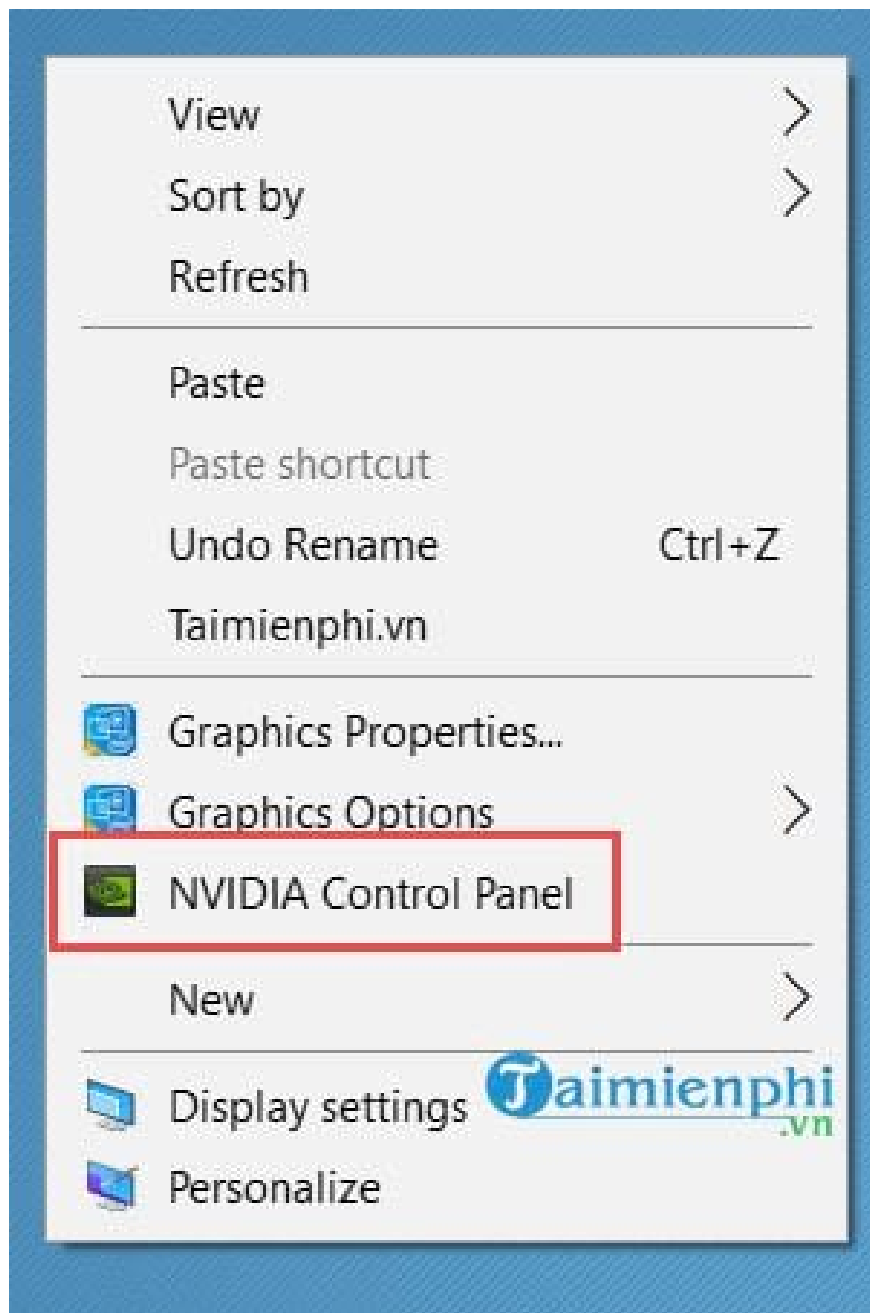


Step 9: Leave the default **Express** settings and click **Next** to continue the installation.

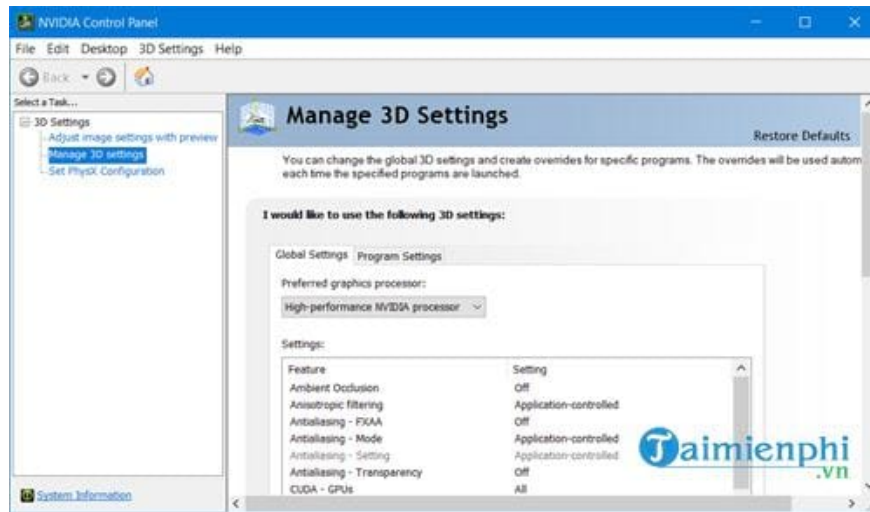


After this step, please restart your computer once the installation process is complete.

Step 10: Right-click on the desktop and select **Nvidia Control Panel**.



If it works, then you have successfully fixed the "Nvidia Display settings are not available" error.



With just a few basic steps, the "Nvidia Display settings are not available" error is completely resolved. It's incredibly simple, isn't it? While this isn't the only error Nvidia VGA users encounter, this method can be applied to many other issues.
