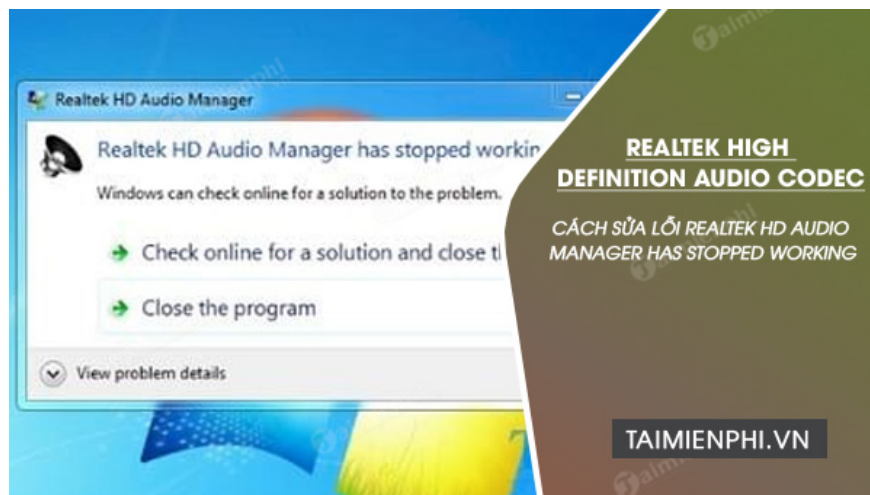


# How to fix the 'Realtek HD Audio Manager has stopped working' error when starting your computer or laptop.

To fix the problem of no sound on your computer , or the occasional "Realtek HD Audio Manager has stopped working" error during startup, what should you do? We **would** like to explain that **the "Realtek HD Audio Manager has stopped working" error** may occur due to an incompatible audio driver, the wrong 32-bit or 64-bit version, or conflicts with other supporting software. To fix **the "Realtek HD Audio Manager has stopped working" error** during computer or laptop startup, users need to thoroughly address the issue using the following methods.

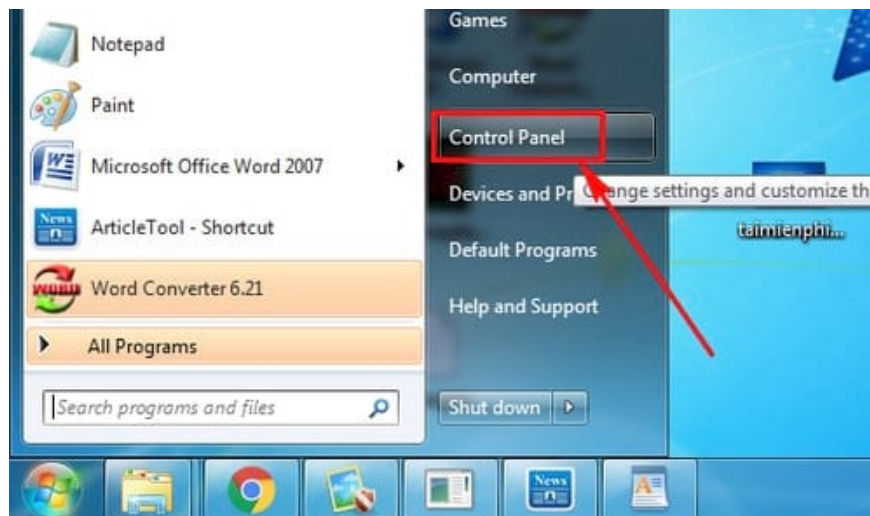


## Fix the "Realtek HD Audio Manager has stopped working" error when starting your computer or laptop:

### 1. Uninstall the old Realtek HD Audio Manager.

The "Realtek HD Audio Manager has stopped working" error occurs in 90% of cases due to driver incompatibility or conflict. If the error persists after restarting your computer, you should uninstall the driver immediately.

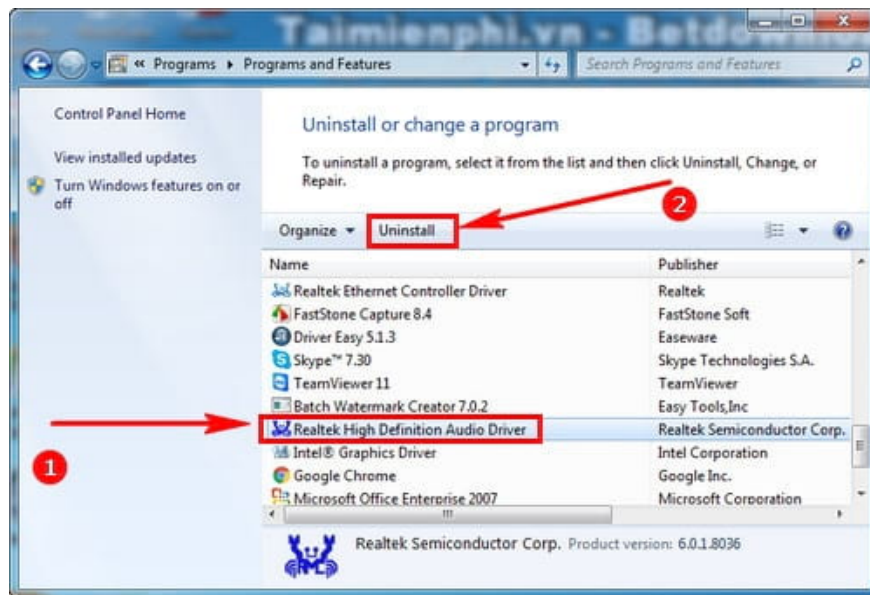
First, press **Start** (Windows key) and select **Control Panel** .



Next, in the **Programs** section , select **Uninstall a program** to access the application uninstaller on your computer.



Here, you just need to **select Realtek HD Audio Manager** and click **Uninstall**, choosing to remove this application from your computer.



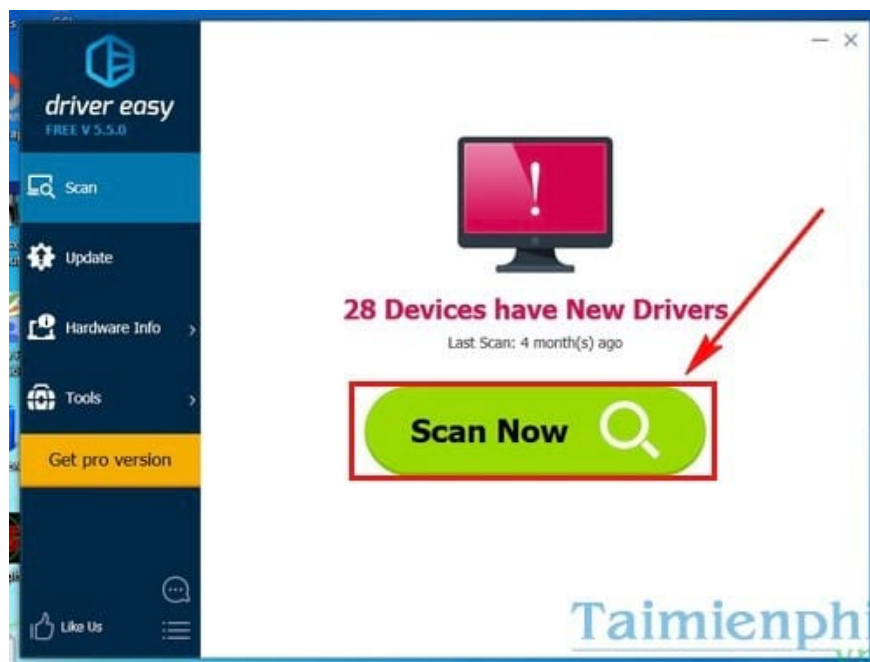
## 2. Update the Realtek HD Audio Manager driver using the software.

The quickest and most effective way to update your audio drivers is to use automatic driver search software. Download **DriverEasy** to your computer now.

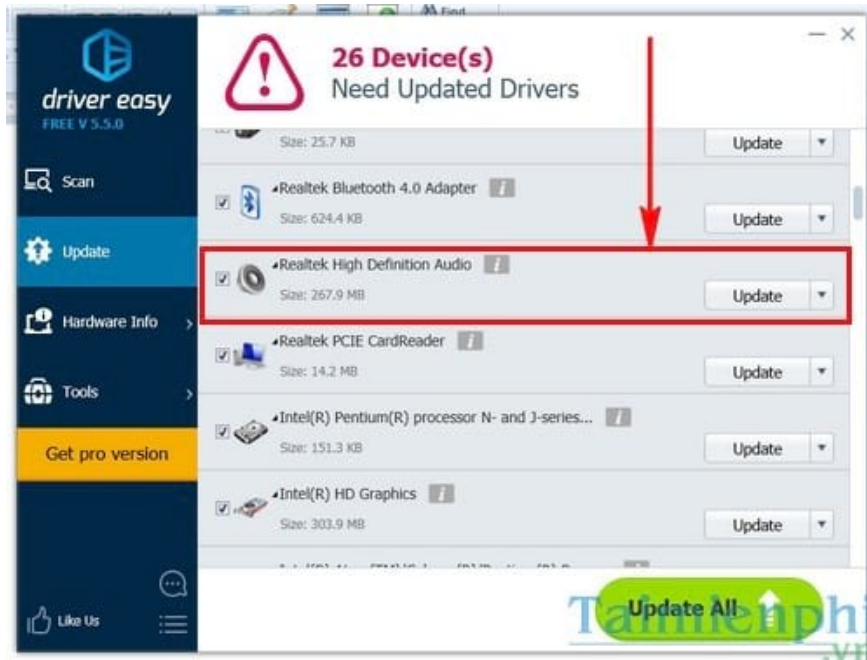
After installing DriverEasy, the software will automatically update drivers successfully. Click **the DriverEasy shortcut** on your desktop to open the application.



On the main DriverEasy interface, select **Scan Now** to have the software automatically scan and find missing or outdated drivers on your computer or laptop.



Finally, find Realtek HD Audio Manager and click **Update** to download the driver. Then, run the normal audio driver setup to fix the "Realtek HD Audio Manager has stopped working" error.



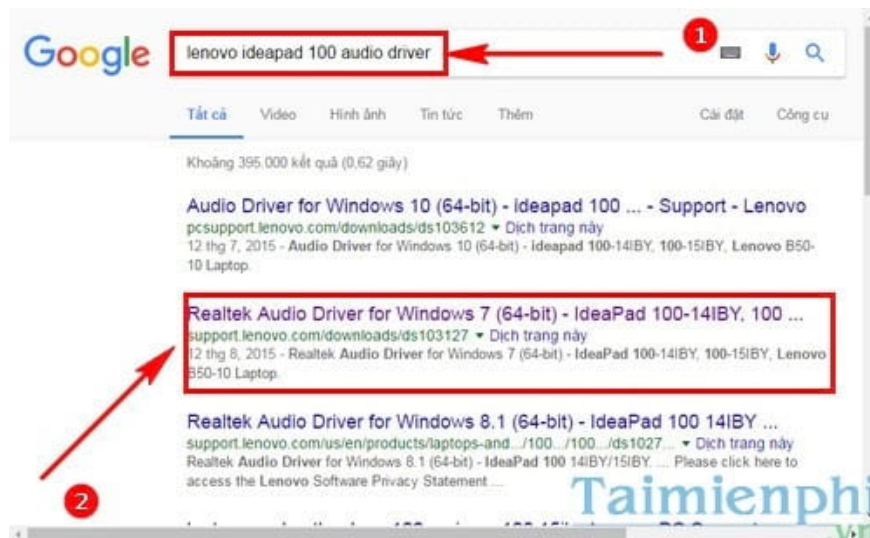
### 3. Update on your computer's home screen.

If you don't like using automatic driver update software, you can also visit the website of your laptop or PC manufacturer. The support sections of these websites usually offer driver downloads for your computer.

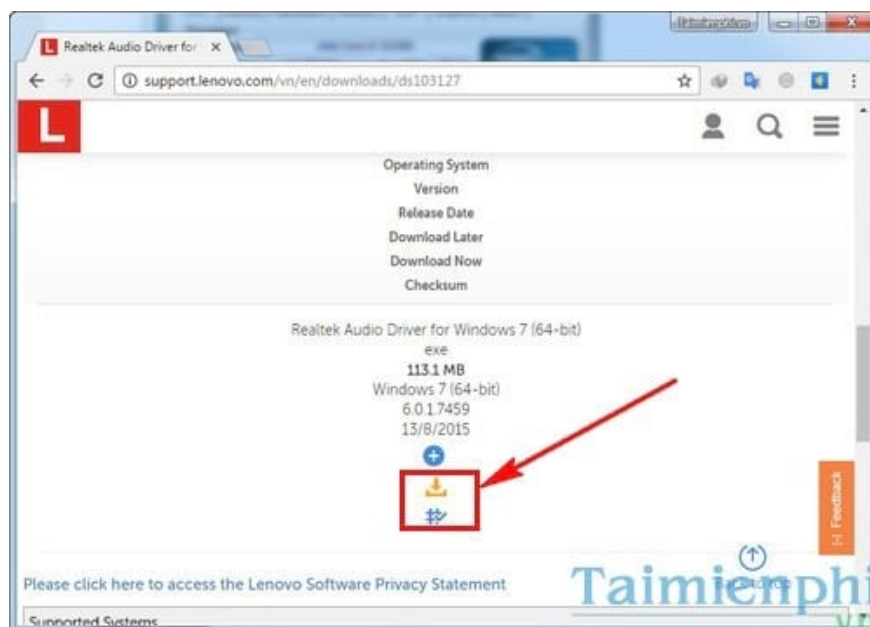
After seeing the device name, you can search Google using keywords:

***Computer name \_ audio driver*** . For example, if your laptop is a Lenovo Ideapad 100, you would search for: ***Lenovo Ideapad 100 audio driver*** .

You can also enter the version of Windows you are using for easier searching.



Finally, download the missing audio drivers from the manufacturer's website to use them.



It's very easy to fix the "Realtek HD Audio Manager has stopped working" error when starting your computer or laptop, right?
