If you encounter this problem, when you type a new word, the old word will be lost. This situation is quite common and the solution is not too complicated. **TipsMake** will immediately share a quick and effective way **to fix typing errors where old words are backspaced** .



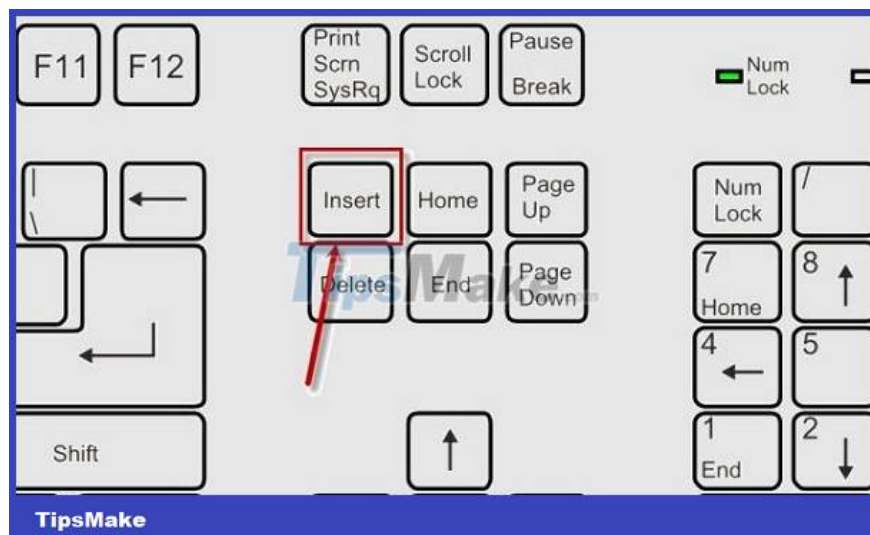


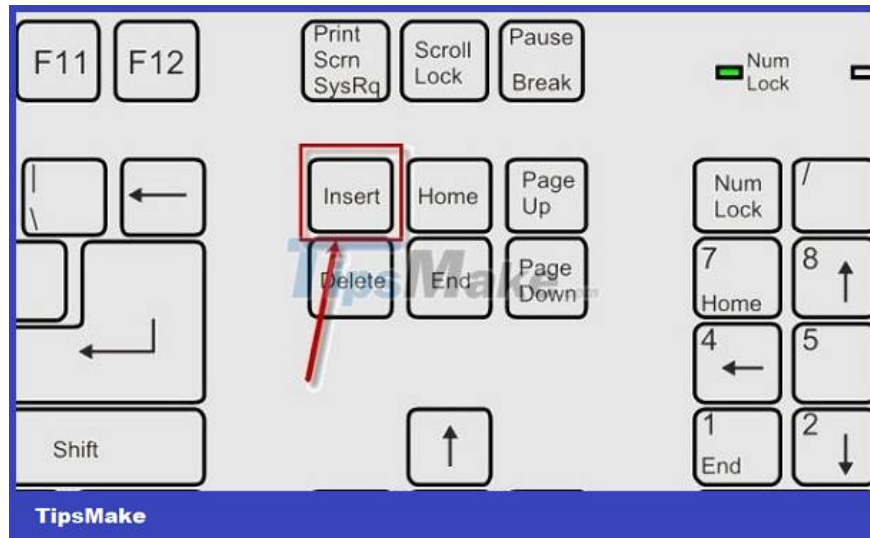
Instructions on how to fix typing errors where old words are backspaced quickly and quickly

*In text editing, when typing the preceding character overwriting the following character, which mode is used is a question many users are looking for an answer to. There's no need to worry too much, because the error of missing letters in Word is probably because you mistakenly pressed the **insert** key on the keyboard. This key has an override function so it will cause typing errors to be backspaced. Besides, it is also possible that the fonts in Word and the Vietnamese keyboard on your laptop are incorrectly formatted. So, below are the specific error correction methods you should apply.*

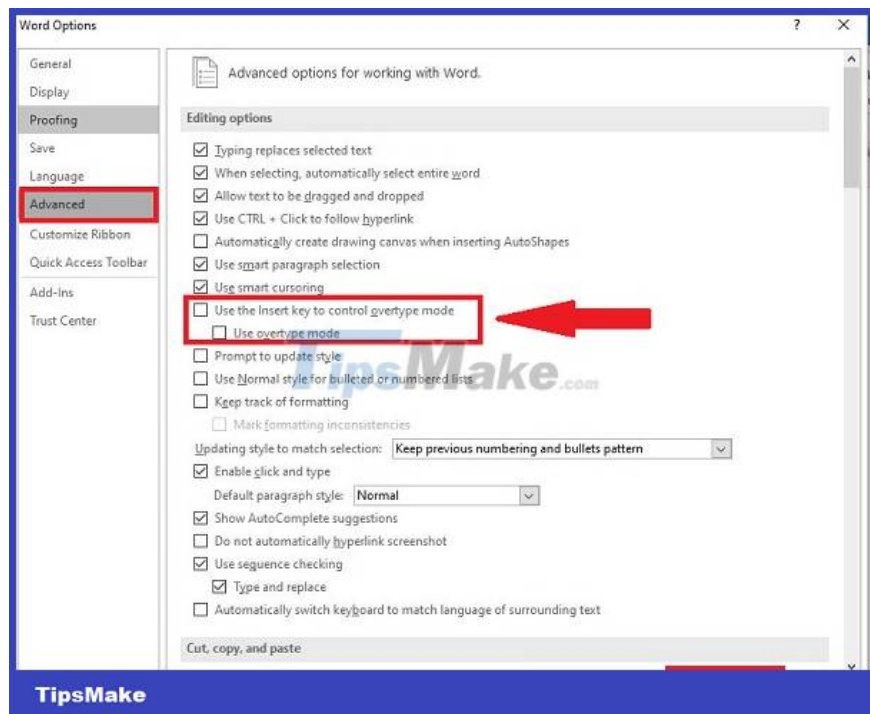
1/ Fix the error of typing being deleted due to pressing the Insert key by mistake

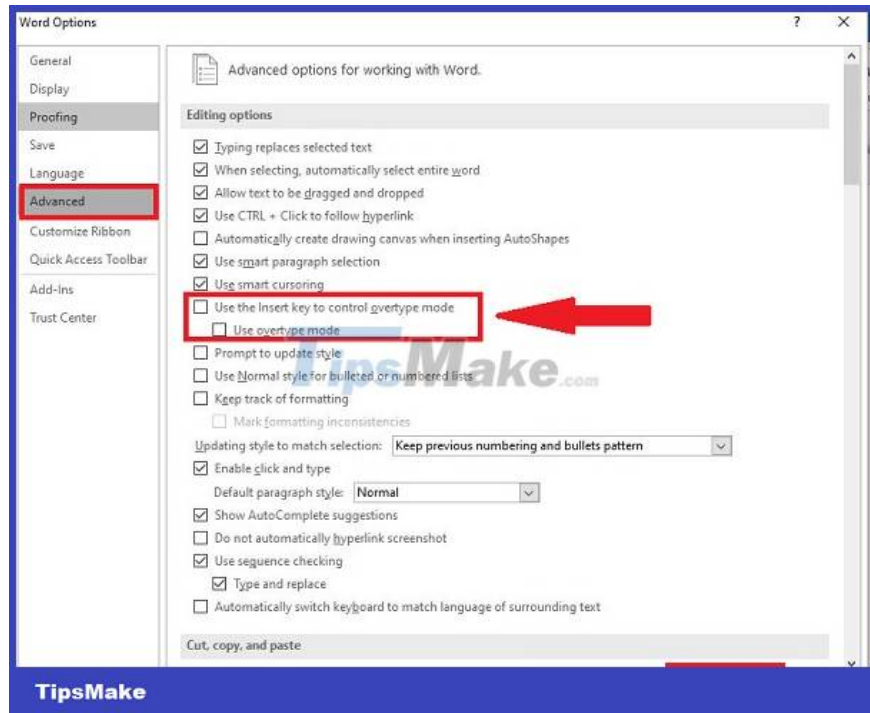
To overcome the problem of typing new letters and losing old letters, you just need to press the **Insert** key again and you're done. This is also a quick way to fix the error of typing old words backward on Zalo.





In case it cannot be done this way. In the open Word version, click on the **File** tab > Select **Options** > In the new window that appears, click on the word **Advanced** > Uncheck the 2 lines you have marked in the image below > Click Ok to save and check. Has the problem been fixed or not?



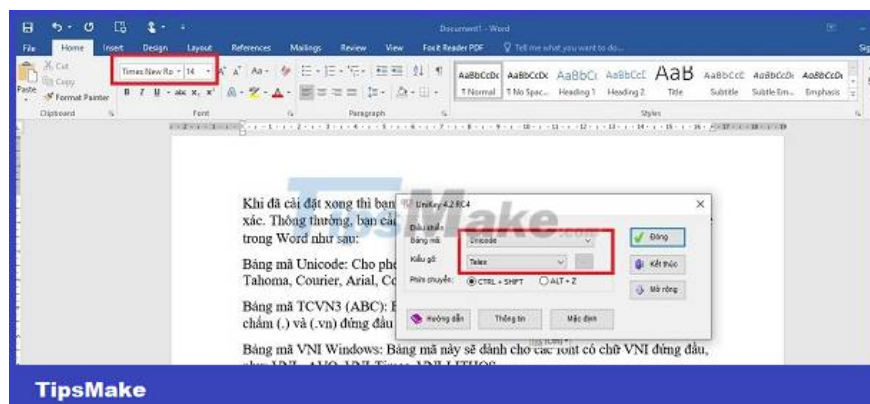


2/ Fix errors due to font format

As I shared, the reason may be because the font in Word with Vietnamese input is incorrectly formatted. Because the font in the Word tool will be different from the encoding in the Vietnamese set. Wrong formatting will lead to Vietnamese typing errors, lost letters, missing accents. To fix it, first remove the Unikey or Vietkey Vietnamese toolkit currently on your computer > Then re-download the new version. best.

Once installed, open the percussion suite and adjust the encoding and typing method correctly. Normally, you need to pay attention to adjusting the encoding and typing style to match the font in Word as follows:

1. **Unicode encoding** : Allows you to use the following fonts: Time News Roman, Tahoma, Courier, Arial, Courier New.
2. **TCVN3 (ABC) code table** : This code table allows you to use fonts with dots (.) and (.vn) at the beginning such as, .Vntime, .VnArial and .VnTimeH,.
3. **VNI Windows code table** : This code table will be for fonts with the word VNI at the beginning, such as: VNI ??-AVO, VNI-Times, VNI-LITHOS.



Some note:

1. *If you encounter the situation: When you type more words in the middle of the line, the words behind them will be deleted on Zalo. If the above two measures do not work, please update Zalo to the latest version.*
2. *If it doesn't work anymore, consider deleting and redownloading Zalo on your computer! Don't forget to back up carefully and restore using the backup. Because after deleting Zalo, all messages will be lost.*

Above are 2 ways to fix typing errors where old words are backspaced. Hope you guys do it successfully!
