

How to fix Valorant failed to install

If the error fails to install Valorant, especially the message We couldn't install a required dependency, please see how to fix Valorant not installed in this article.

There are some gamers who have encountered the error of not downloading Valorant on the computer. Some players encounter the message "We couldn't install a required dependency" while installing Valorant and don't know how to fix the error yet.

To fix Valorant installation error, you must first know the cause of the error. Often this error will be due to an incomplete installation, or if you play on Windows 7 but don't have the latest appropriate patch.

In addition, the fact that you install Valorant on a virtual machine is also the cause of the game error. To fix Valorant installation errors, you can look through the ways below to download Valorant to your computer normally.

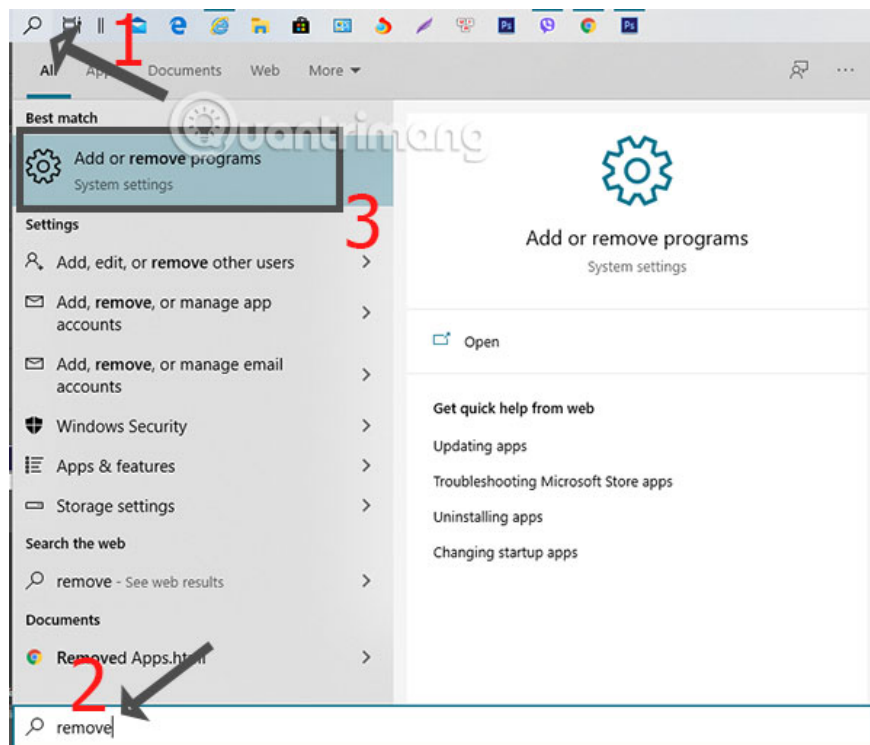
How to fix error cannot install Valorant on Windows 10

First, try one of the following:

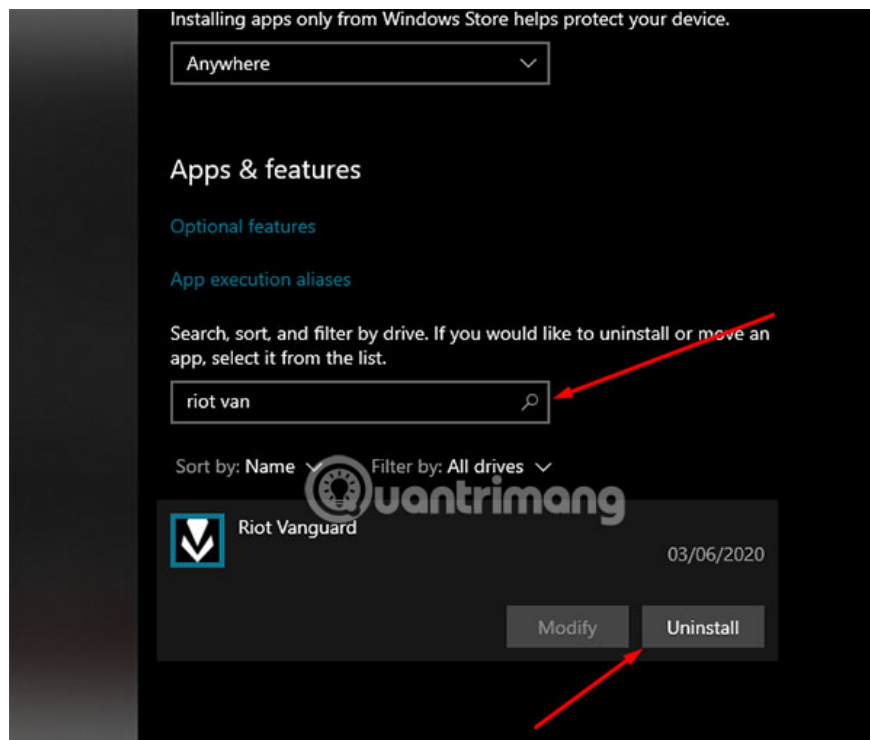
1. Try updating to the latest version of Windows.
2. Update graphics card driver to the latest version.
3. Allow Valorant or Riot Vanguard to run through the firewall you are using.
4. Turn off the firewall and antivirus on your computer.

If you do any of the above and still cannot run Valorant. You still see the error " **We couldn't install a required dependency** " then follow the fix instructions below.

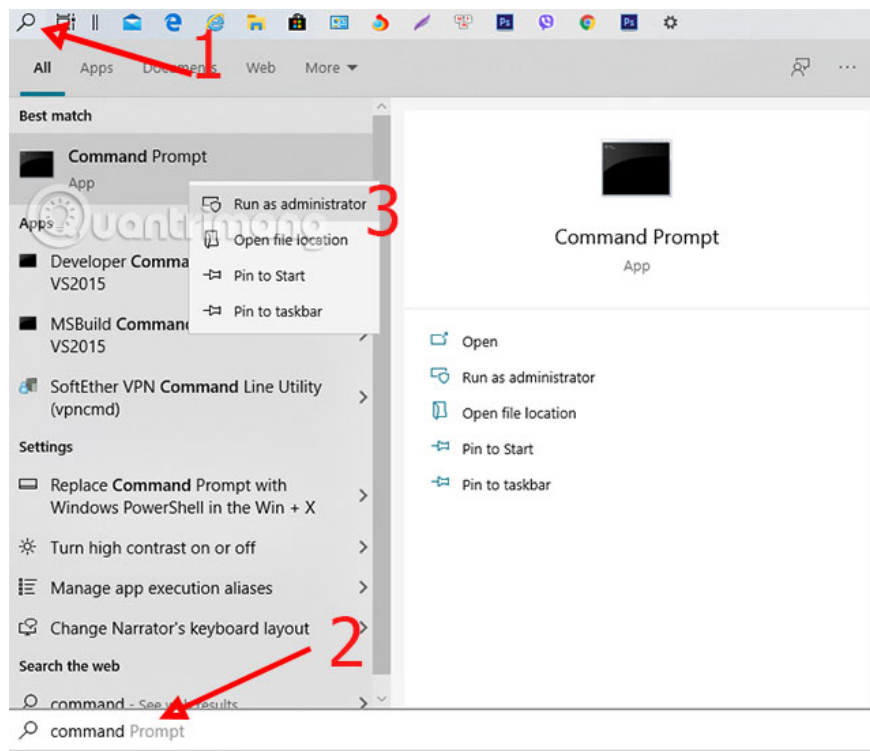
Step 1: First, go to the search icon as shown below, then write **Add or remove Programs** and select.



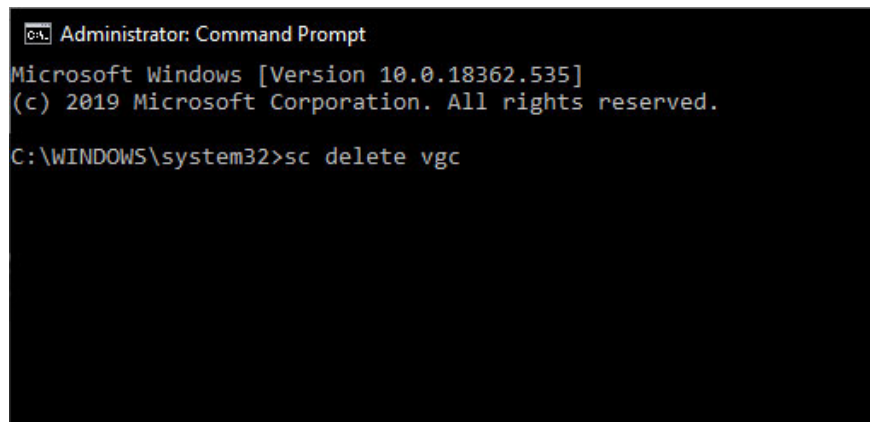
Step 2: In the **Add or remove program** window , find the keyword **Riot Vanguard** at the bottom of the screen. Then click on the Riot Vanguard result below and select Uninstall.



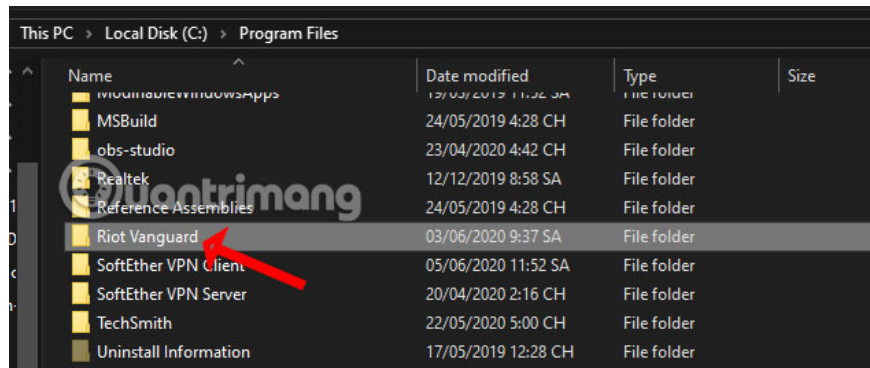
Step 3: Go back to the Command Prompt search tool, open with **Run as Administrator** .



Step 4: Next, type the following two lines of the command `sc delete vgc` and `sc delete vgk`. If you see the message displayed under each line is **SC DeletedServices Success** is.



Step 5: Next, go to drive C: and navigate to the **Program Files** folder, where you find the Riot Vanguard folder and delete it. Then restart your computer.



Once your computer boots up, run Valorant with your admin rights and the system will automatically reinstall Riot Vanguard for you. Then log into your account and see if the error has been fixed yet.

If the error persists, uninstall Valorant and delete the Riot Vanguard folder from the Program folder. Download the latest installation of Valorant and reinstall the game.
