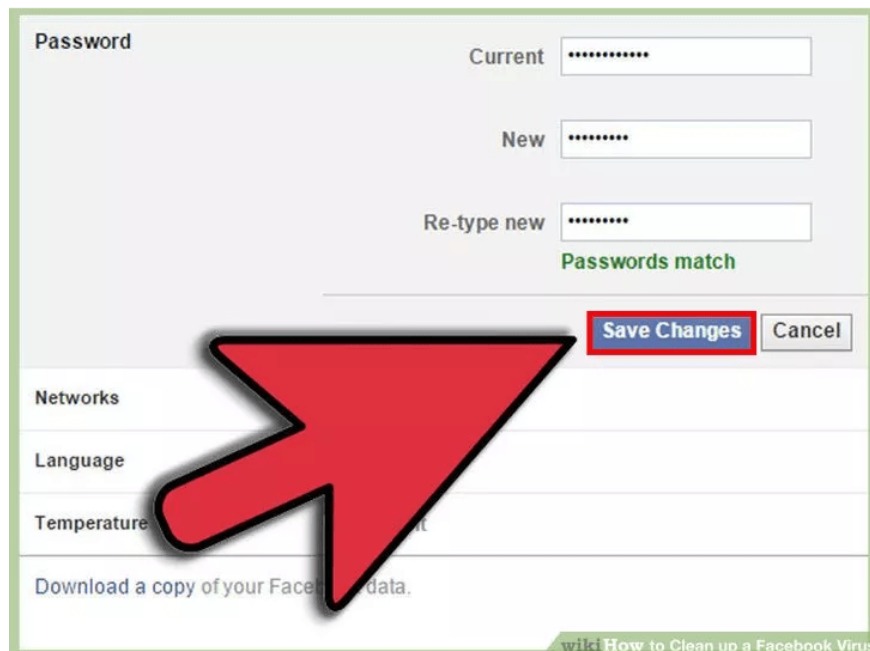

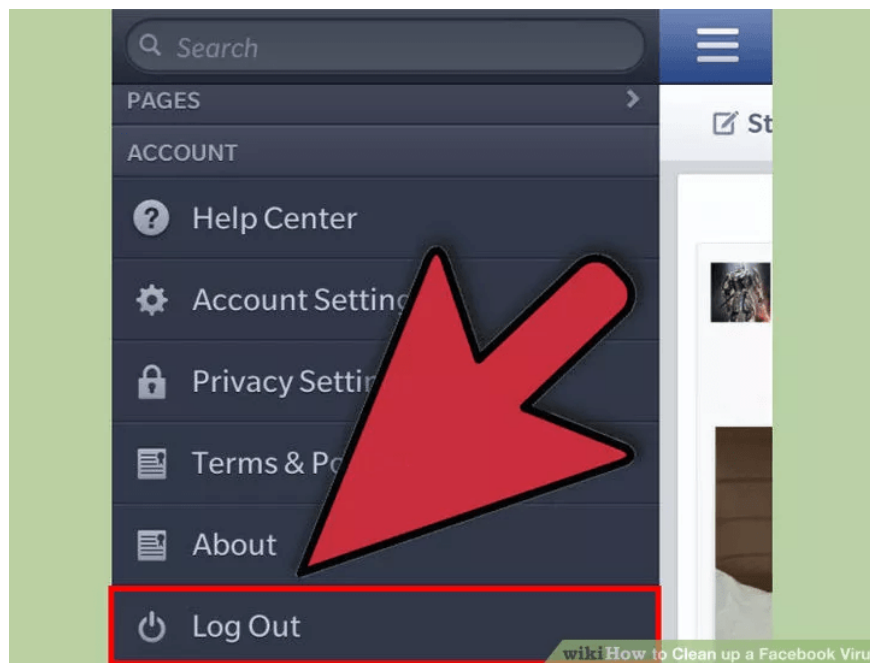
Steps to clean up Virus on Facebook:

Step 1:



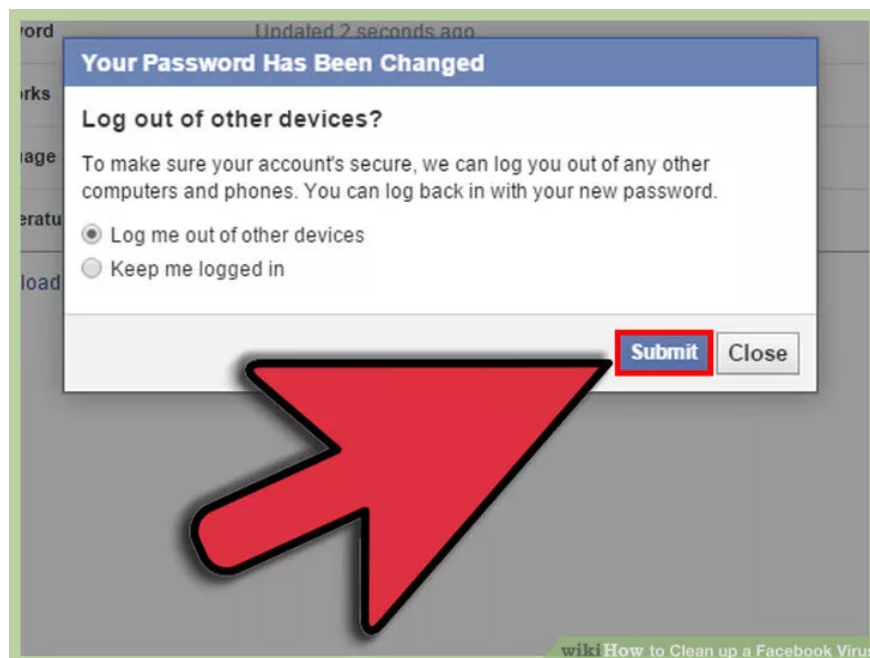
If you suspect your Facebook account is virus, the first step is to quickly change your Facebook password.

Step 2:



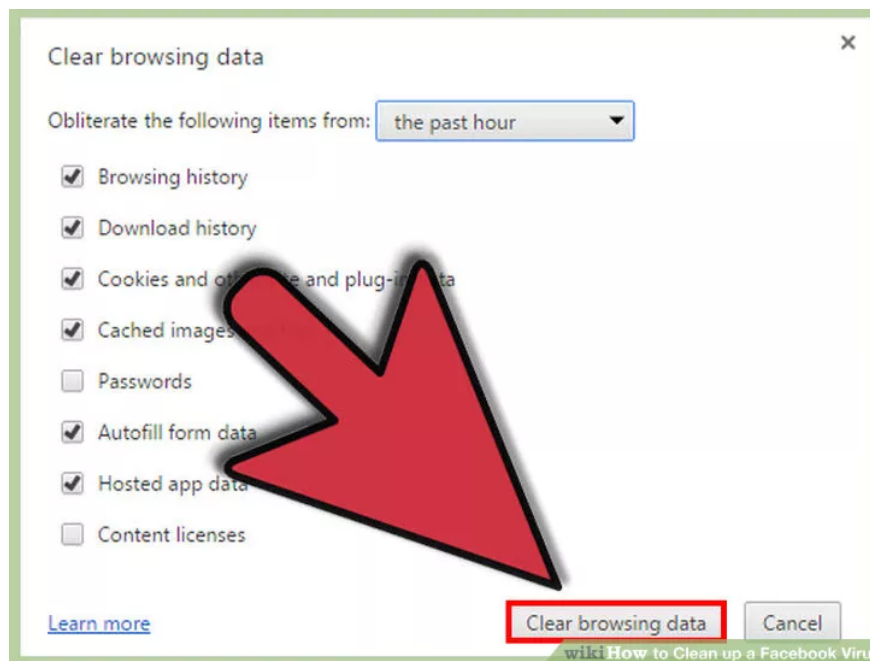
If you have a Facebook account on your mobile device or any other device, quickly log out of your account on that device.

Step 3:



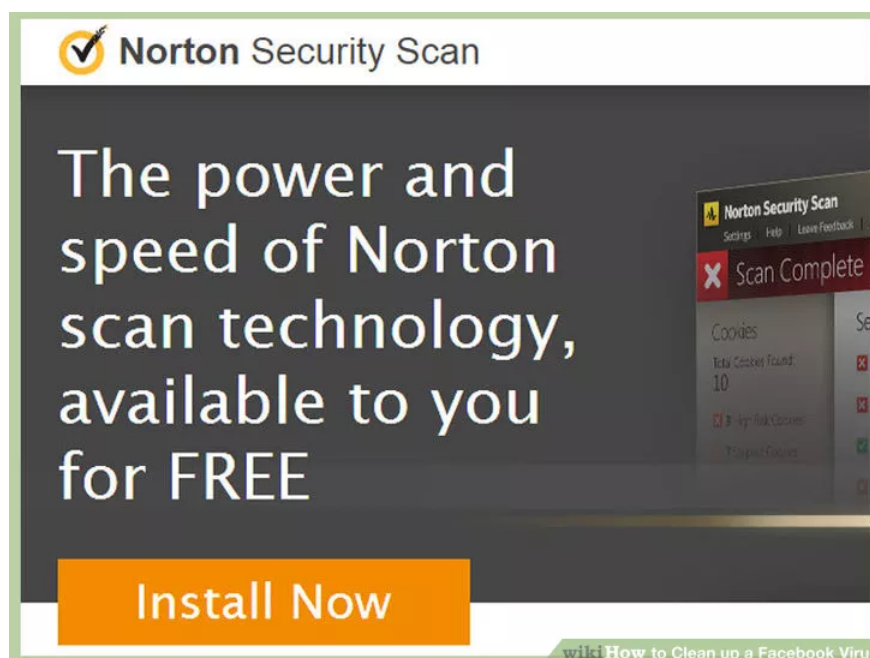
Just changing your Facebook account password is not enough. Your next task is to "clean up" the data on your web browser.

Step 4:



To clean up the internet cache, temporary browsing history, Internet files, select all the items in the Clear browsing data window and click the **Clear browsing data** button to clean up the data.

Step 5:



Download Norton Security Scan to your computer and install it.

Step 6:

After downloading and installing Norton Security Scan successfully, open the application and scan the virus on your computer. The process takes about 45 minutes.

Step 7:

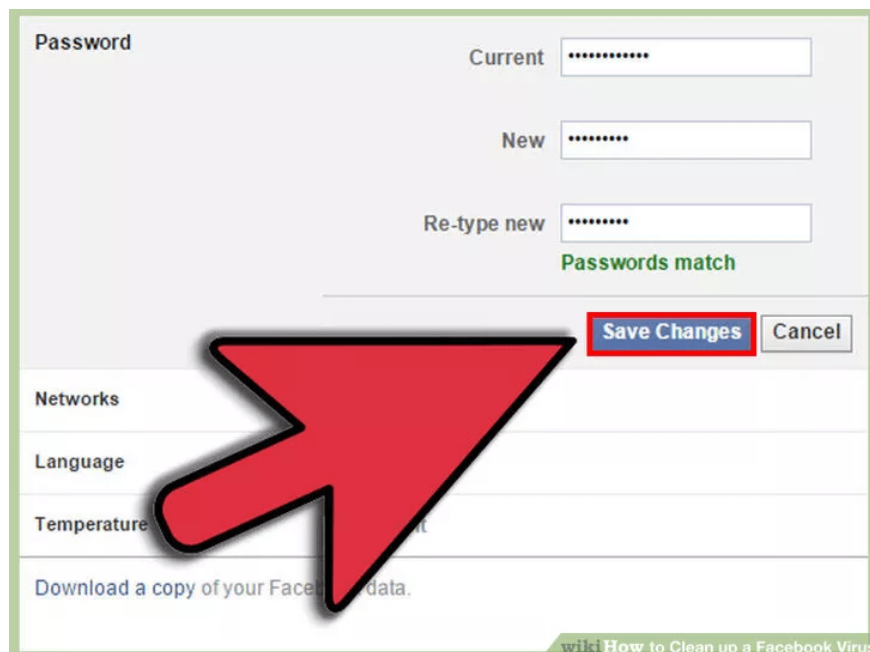


Next download CCleaner and install it.

Download CCleaner and install it here.

After downloading and installing CCleaner, run the application and clean up the registration.

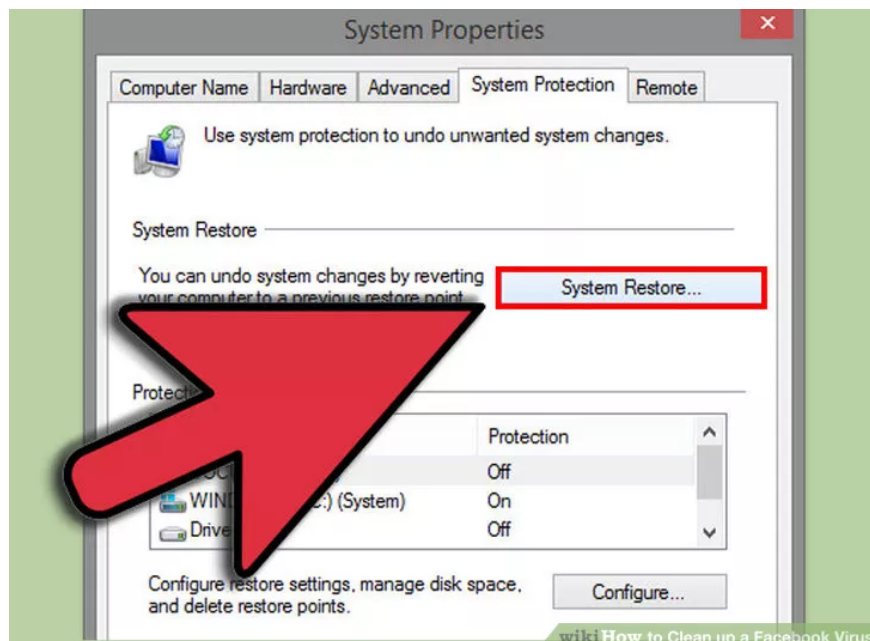
Step 8:



Finally proceed to change the Facebook password again if the first step to change the password does not fix the problem.

Step 9:

The final solution is to perform a system restore in **checkpoints** before the date you were attacked by a virus. If you apply the above measures are still not thoroughly remove the virus, then you can do this step.



Find a restore point about a week before. On Windows XP, the restore point is found in **Start => Programs => Accessories => System Tools => System Restore** .

On Windows Vista, click on **the Start button** . Then, enter '**System** ' in the Search and System Restore frames will display on the search results list.
