

How to get Honey fast in Grow a Garden

Like sheckles, you'll need to work extremely hard to get honey to buy items in Grow a Garden.

The super cute and potential Bee Swarm update in Grow a Garden is finally here. This update brings a ton of new additions, including a Honey Shop with tons of exclusive items.

As the name suggests, this shop uses honey, a temporary currency for players to buy items. However, like sheckles, you will need to 'plow' extremely hard to get it. If you want to earn honey quickly in the game, check out the instructions below, and don't forget to get the Grow a Garden .

How to get honey fast in Grow a Garden

As you may have noticed, in the center area of the map, where all the main events of Grow a Garden take place - a new Bee family has appeared, with the Bee Queen in the middle. Next to the queen is a Worker Bee NPC with the Honey Compressor device.



Here, you can top up 10kg of Pollinated fruit to get 10 units of honey. However, you have to wait 3 minutes for the processing to complete. Although you cannot shorten the waiting time, you can definitely increase the chance of getting Pollinated, thereby increasing the speed at which you can get more honey.

Growing fruit trees for high volume fruit

The first step is to plant trees that produce the largest possible quantity of fruit. Combine single and multiple harvest trees for maximum efficiency.



Some effective plants include:

1. Bamboo – Buy at Seed Shop
2. Moon Melon – Available at Blood Moon Shop
3. Beanstalk – Buy at Seed Shop
4. Purple Dahlia – Available in Seed Packets
5. Starfruit – Found in Night Seed Pack

Fill your garden with Bees

The next way is to use all three pet slots with the new Bee variants in the Bizzy Bees update. Except for the Bear Bee, the other three bees have the ability to mutate into pollinators after a few seconds.



Just buy Bee Eggs at the Honey Shop and raise the following pets:

1. Bee: Creates a Pollination mutation that randomly produces fruit after 25 minutes.

2. Petal Bee: Same as Bee, but has an added chance of retaining floral fruit.
3. Honey Bee: Create Pollination Mutation in Just 20 Minutes.

Honey in Grow a Garden



Advantage

1. **Bizzy Bees Event Exclusive Currency:** Honey is the only currency used to purchase limited-edition items during the Bizzy Bees event. This creates a unique economic system that encourages players to actively participate in the event.
2. **Get lots of rare items:** The Honey Shop offers a variety of exclusive items, from rare seeds, new pets to decorative items that most cannot be purchased with the main currency (Sheckles). Some items like the Hive Tree Seed or Honey Sprinkler have high stats and directly affect the growth rate of the farm.
3. **Promote strategic gameplay:** Due to the requirement to submit "pollinated" mutant fruits in exchange for honey, players need to plan their crops properly, use suitable pets, and optimize the process of caring for crops. This makes the gameplay more in-depth.
4. **Create a fair opportunity between new and old players:** Honey earning is not based on level but on strategy and time invested. This helps new players not to be completely left behind by veteran players.

Disadvantages

1. **Takes a long time to farm efficiently:** Each fruit submission takes up to 3 minutes to process and requires a pollinated fruit. If not prepared well, players may find it slow and laborious.
2. **No value after the event ends:** Honey is a temporary currency and will not be usable after the Bizzy Bees event ends. If not spent in time, the accumulated honey will become useless.

3. **Relies heavily on luck:** To get fruit with pollination mutations, players need a bee pet to help. However, mutations do not always happen quickly, making the process unstable.

Honey is an important event currency, creating many opportunities to upgrade the farm faster and more beautifully. However, players need to have a reasonable strategy and time to invest to maximize its value before the event ends.
