

How to get the Fixer in Fallout 76

But this is an assault rifle commonly found in build sets - equipment for special forces in Fallout 76 since the Wild Appalachia update. The Fixer's strength still lies in its balanced stats, suitable for both full-blooded bosses and weak-blooded monsters, but it's still effective for stealthy actions.

The power of the Fixer is further promoted when it possesses powerful Legendary effects. However, the basic version is also enough to become a reliable companion in the late stages of the game.

How to get Fixer in Fallout 76

The way for us to get the first The Fixer is to complete the quest chain in Ash Heap, the land located to the south. Start by going to any train station in Ash Heap and interacting with the poster that says "Sheepsquatch ate my brother!" (Sheepsquatch ate my brother!). This action will trigger the quest "Lying Lowe", which will ask you to search for clues related to the Sheepsquatch monster and three corporate employees.



The Fixer is one of the rewards for the quest "Wolf In Sheep's Clothing". The fourth mission in the series takes the player to Garrahan Estate.

While here, you can also explore Garrahan Mining Headquarters to receive the Scavenger Power Armor from Fallout 76.

Indicators you will get Fixer:

1. Bonus damage when acting stealthily
2. Damage increased by 20%
3. Movement speed when acting stealthily increases by 20%

This gun making drawing is one of the random drops from the Encryptid community event. Where we will be up against a real Sheepwolf, which is essentially an improved assaultron in Fallout 76.

To defeat Wolf Sheep, you will have to coordinate with other players to make this boss take damage by activating three energy-conducting columns while fending off attacks from hostile robots.



You may have to try many times to get the fixer version. We recommend that you complete the mutant community events, which will increase your chances of receiving this Fixer build.

After learning the craft, Legendary effects may drop for you to do quests or appear in Purveyor Murrgrh's shop.

To make a level 50 Fixer at the Weapon Workbench, you will need the following materials:

1. Glue (9)
2. Gears (10)
3. Springs (15)
4. Screws (15)
5. Steel (18)
6. Oil (8)
7. Wood (14)

Fixer highlights



1. **Quite balanced in terms of stats:** Fixer possesses high base damage, fast fire rate and high accuracy. Making it an ideal choice for mid-range attacks and close combat.
2. **Versatility:** Thanks to the ability to act stealthily, Fixer is becoming a powerful weapon for those who like to play stealthily and take down enemies from mid-range.
3. **Easy to upgrade:** Even though you can get it when doing missions, you can still easily make Fixer because the materials to make it are not too difficult to find. However, if you feel that completing the quest to get this gun is difficult. Then we recommend that you collect the crafting materials to make this gun.
