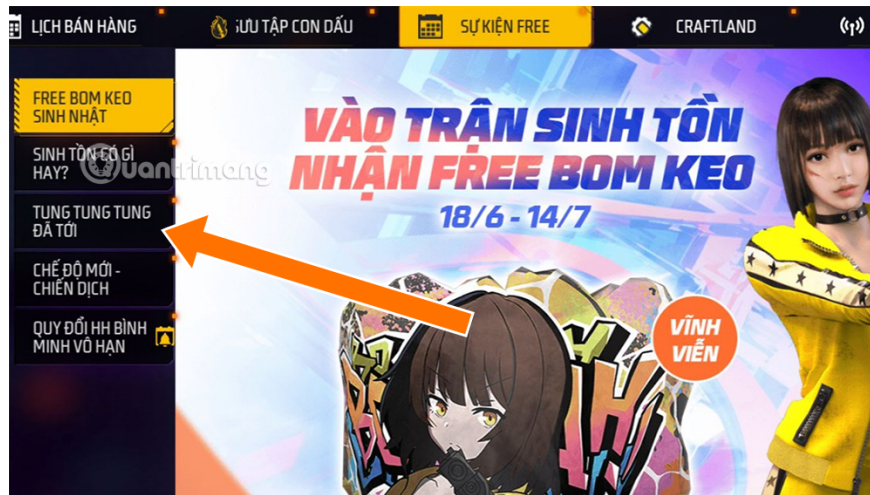

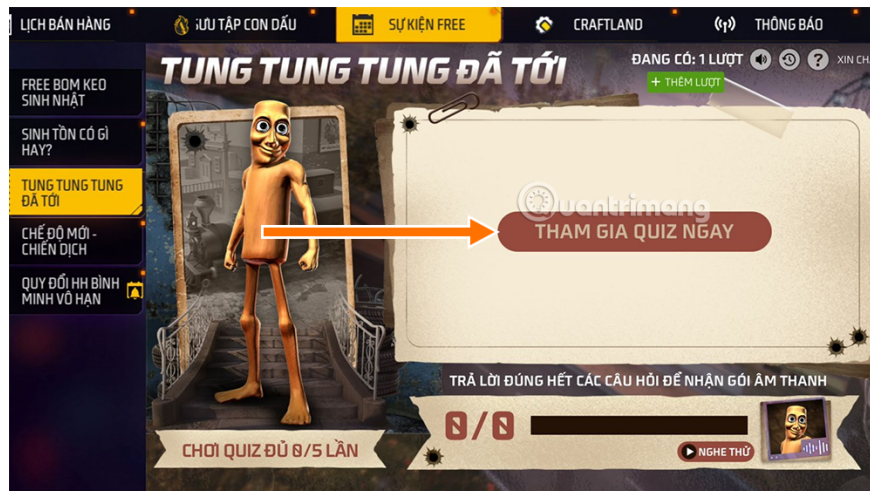
1. **Step 1:** Open the Free Fire app and make sure your version is the latest.

Event time and related information



Time: June 15 - June 21

1. You will get 1 free turn when you first enter the event. After that, you can play ranked (Survival/Deathmatch) for 10 minutes to get 1 extra turn. The play time will be counted from the first time you enter the event and will not be refreshed every day.
2. You will participate in the event by participating in answering the quiz. When a player answers a question incorrectly, you will end your turn there and play again from the beginning.
3. Players who answer all questions correctly in 1 turn will receive the Tung Tung Tung Sound package.
