

How to grow mango and longan from seeds super quickly to have a super beautiful bonsai pot

No need to buy trees, you can grow mangoes and longans from seeds simply by following these steps.

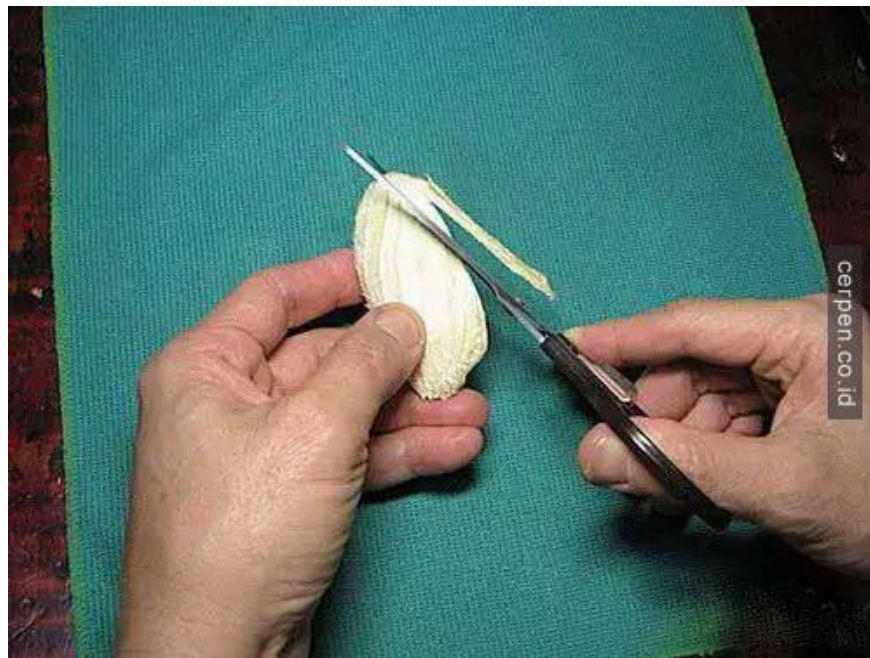
Growing mango from seed

Step 1. Scrape off the outside of the mango with all the flesh eaten, then place it in a well-ventilated place to dry.



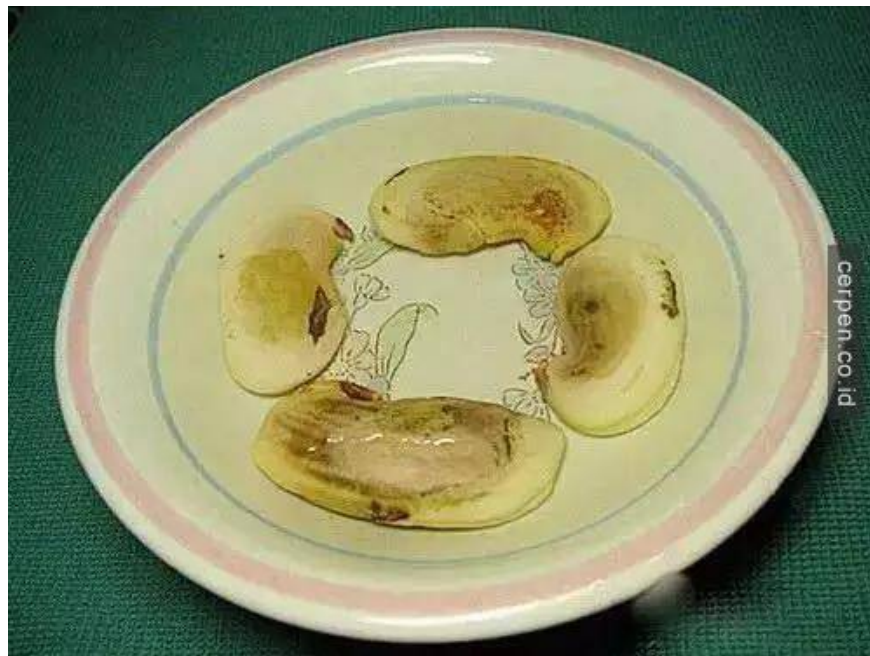


Step 2. Use scissors to cut the seed shell to take out the seeds inside.





Step 3. Use a knife to peel off the brown outer shell, then soak the seeds in water for 4 days. Note, change the water once a day and when cutting, be careful not to scratch the mango seeds inside. During the time it is soaked in water, the seeds begin to germinate.



Step 4. Use a bucket or tall flower pot, fill it with moist soil, then bury the base of the mango seed in the ground and leave the sprouting part exposed.



Step 5. Continue to spread a thin, clean layer of stone on the surface, water the seeds and soak the soil. Then, place the bucket/pot in a cool place, away from direct sunlight. Water once every 1 or 2 days.



After about 4 days, the seeds will germinate and grow in height very quickly. 20 days later, you will see the leaves turn green and the mango tree actually appears right in your front yard.





Grow longan from seeds as an ornamental plant

Plant longan seeds in soil pots

Compared to mango seeds, longan seeds are much easier to grow. Note, if you want to grow plants from longan seeds, you should thoroughly remove the whites to avoid attracting ants or other insects.



Step 1. Soak the longan seeds for 1 week so that the longan shells gradually break down. Change the water once a day.



Step 2. After the above time is up, put the seeds in a flower pot, with the seed head facing up.



Step 3. Spray water twice a day, a week later, the seeds will begin to germinate.



Step 4. 10 days later, the seeds will begin to sprout.

Step 5. In about a month, you will see the pot full of plants growing like the image below.



Growing longan with aquatic seeds

After eating the longan, take the seeds and plant them in a cup of water and wait until the longan seeds sprout.
