The formula bar in Excel is an important tool that helps users work quickly. However, you can hide or show the formula bar when necessary. Let's find out how to do it in the following article.

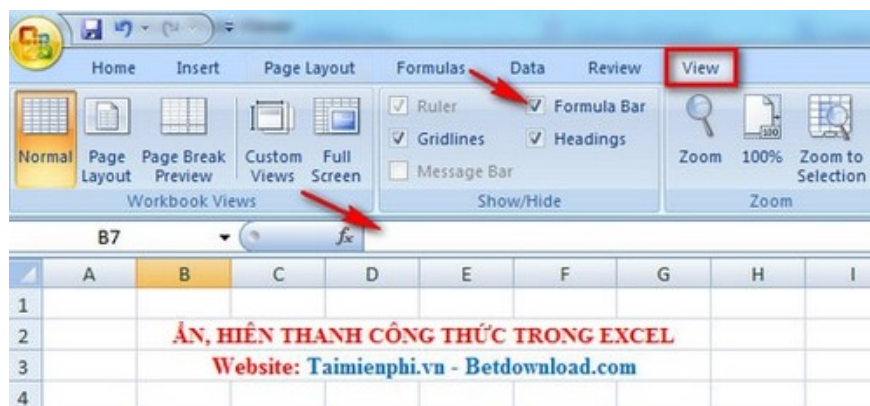
