

How to hide / show battery percentage on iPhone, iPad

If you want to know how much your iPhone battery has, how many percent of your iPad has been charged, how much is left in use ... The best way is to turn on battery percentage mode.

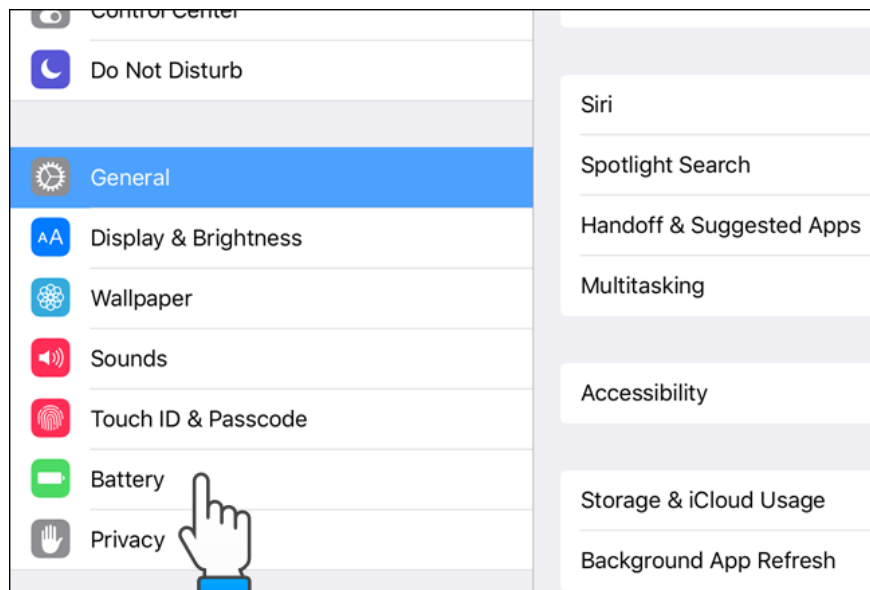
Built-in **iPhone and iPad** function enable battery percentage display so that users know how much the battery has been charged, how much remaining usage is and for users to know if their **iPhone** has a bad battery life. is not?

If you are a new **iPhone** or **iPad user** or you do not know how to hide, show the battery percentage on your **iPhone, iPad** , refer to the article below.

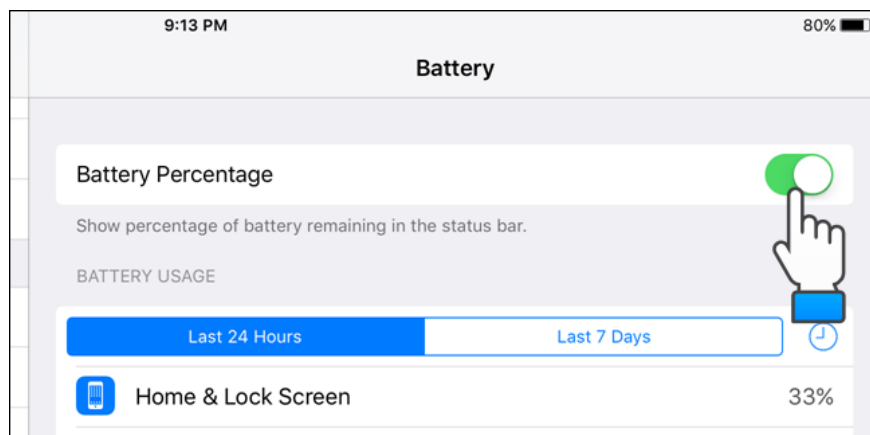
To hide the battery percentage on your **iPhone** or **iPad** device, first go to the **Settings** application (**Settings**) , select **General settings (General)**.



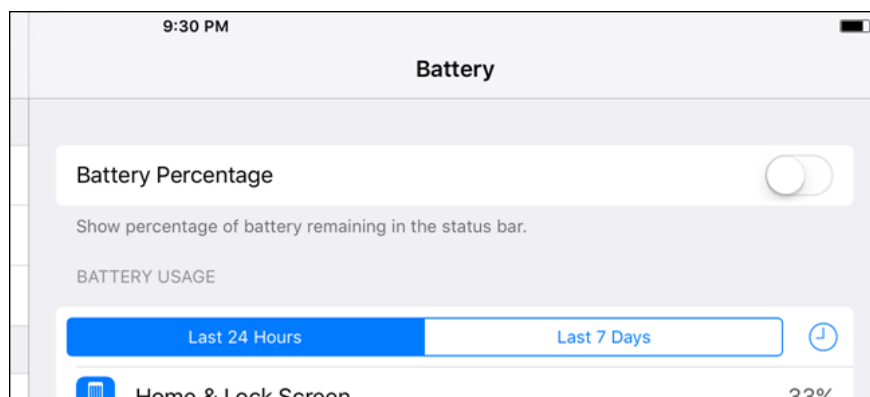
On the **General Settings** screen (**Settings**) , you scroll down to select **Usage** .



In the **Battery Percentage** section, open.



You drag the slide bar from **ON** to **OFF** to hide the battery percentage, then you will see the percentage of battery is hidden.



To show the battery percentage on your **iPhone** or **iPad device**, follow the same steps as in the battery percentage hidden. However, in the **Battery Percentage** section, you pull the slide bar from **OFF** to **ON** to open

it, then you will see the battery percentage appears right next to the battery icon.
