

# How to hide the status bar and iPhone navigation button

To hide the status bar and iPhone navigation button when scrolling, you can install NavAway tweak.

On the iPhone or iPad will always display the status bar and navigation buttons by default when we scroll content settings or in the app. If you want to hide the two components on the iPhone interface, you can install NavAway tweak. When setting this tweak, the status bar and navigation button are hidden when scrolling in the Settings view or in the application interface. The following article will show you how to install NavAway tweak on iPhone.

## Instructions to hide iPhone status bar

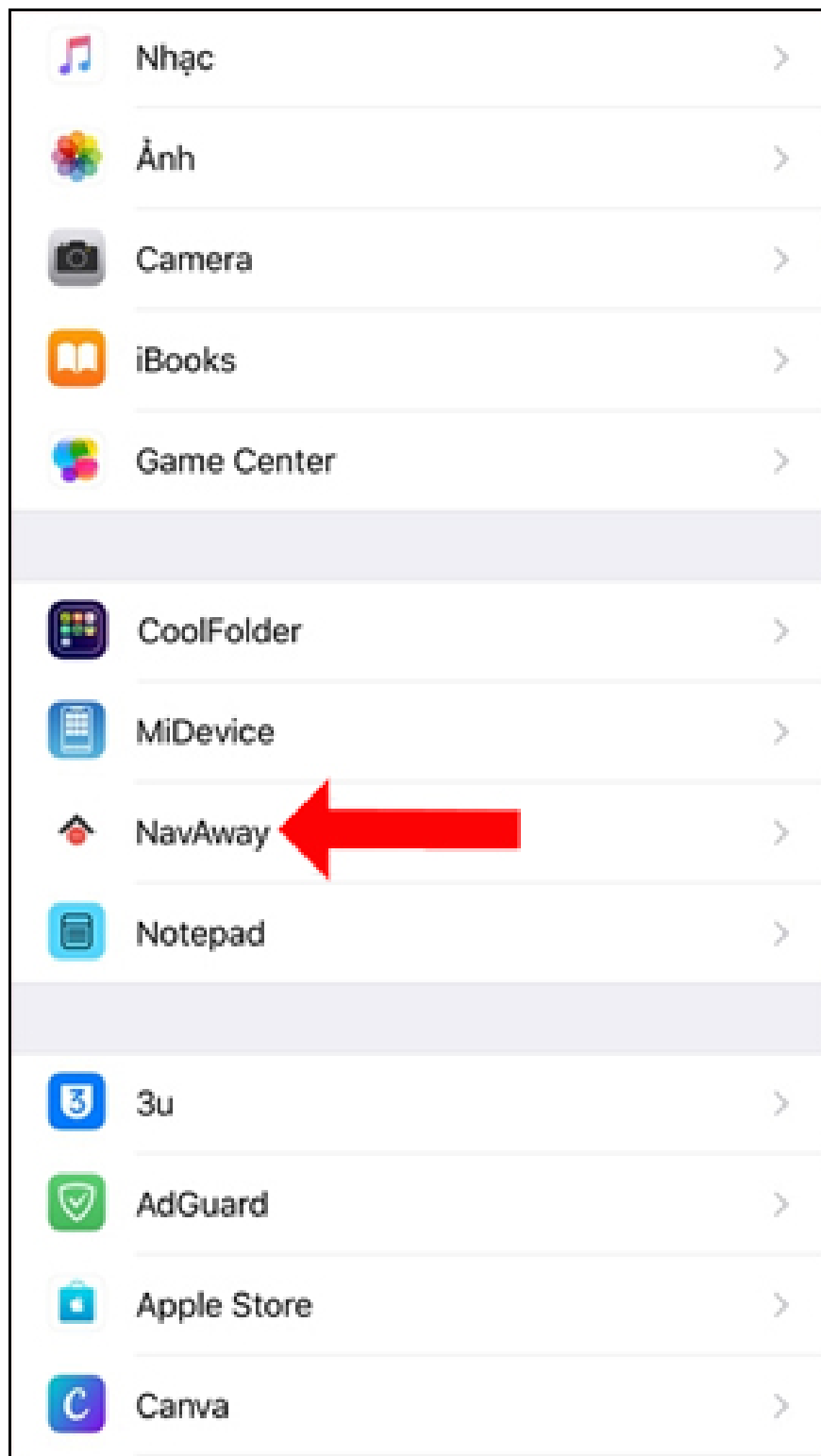
### Step 1:

Currently NavAway tweak is installed for free on Cydia's BigBoss repository. You just need to go to Cydia and then click the Search tab to search for tweak and then install. Tweaking can be installed on iOS 9 and above and jailbroken. Or users can directly access the link below.

### Step 2:

After installing, go to **Settings** and choose to **refine NavAway** to proceed with customizations.



### Step 3:

In the main interface of the tweak when clicking **Enabled Apps**, we will be able to **choose which application** wants to hide the status bar and navigation buttons on the interface. Swipe the horizontal bar to the right at the application you want to hide both the status bar and the navigation button.

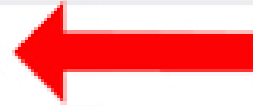
You then need to restart the application for the changes to take effect.

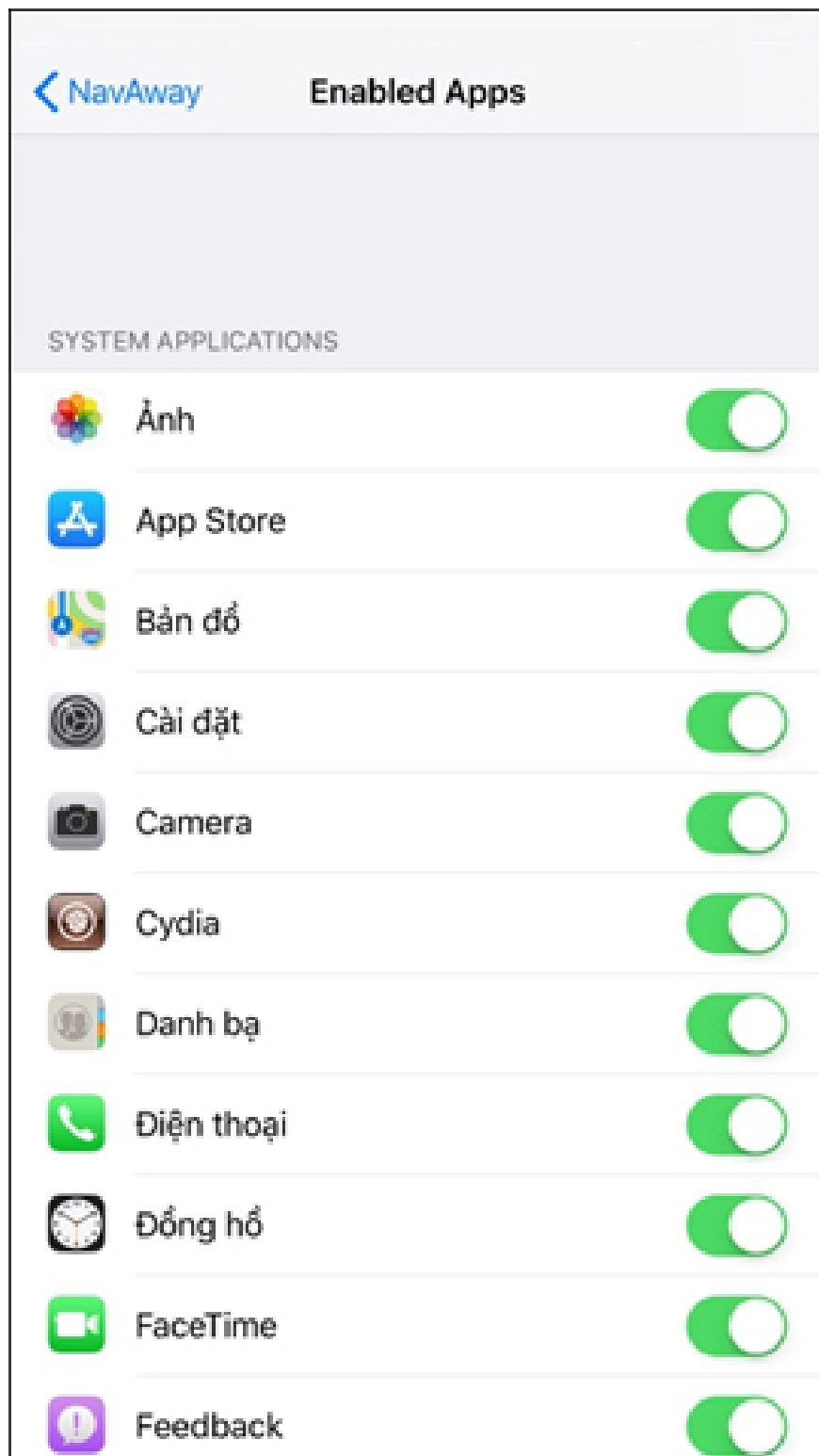

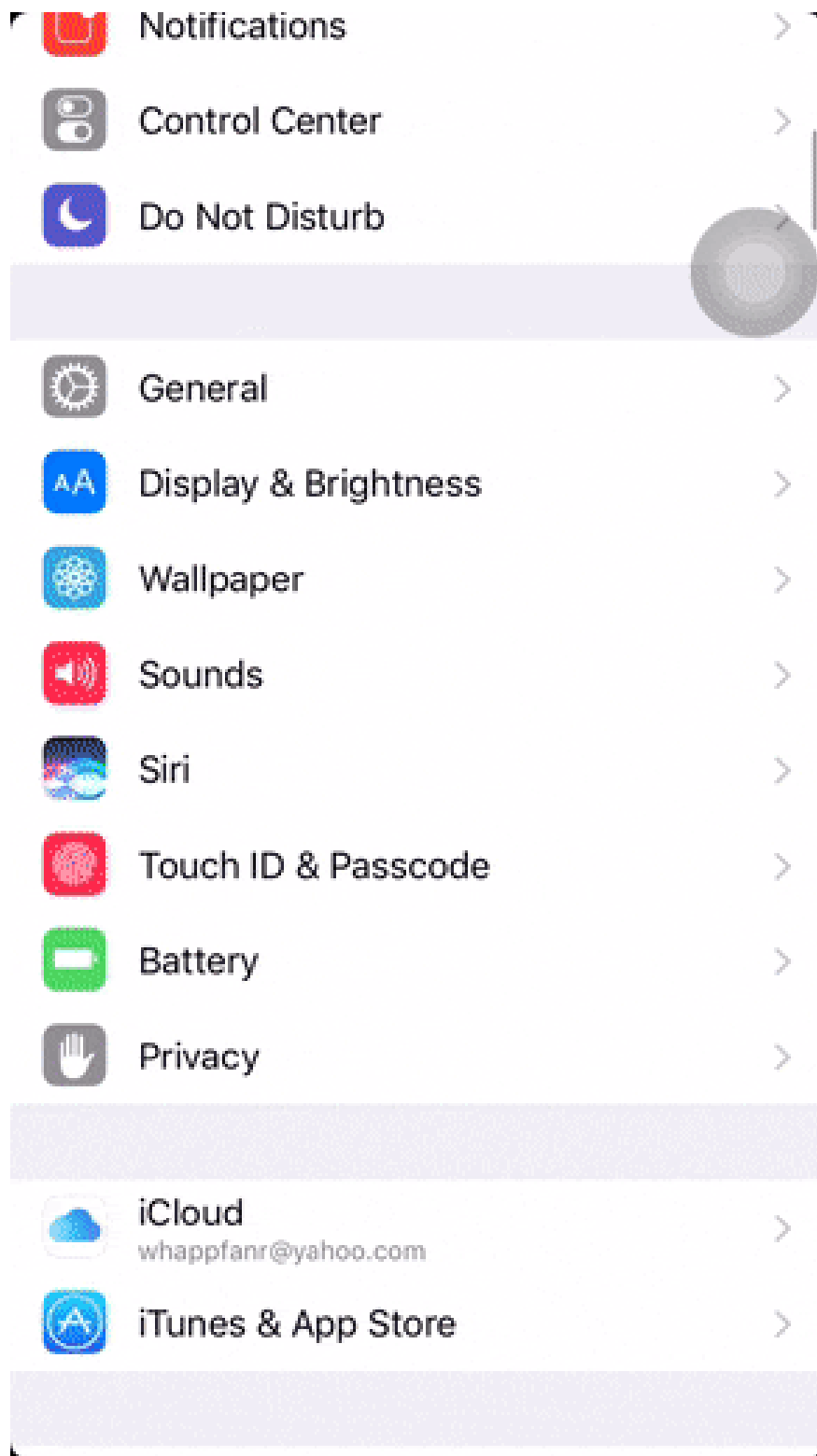

When enabling/disabling the tweak in certain app(s) you have to restart the app(s) for the tweak to take changes



Then the navigation button and status bar on the iPhone will disappear when scrolling. You can see clearly in the image below.



Hiding the status bar and navigation button on the iPhone with NavAway tweaking will help the interface be expanded, viewing full-screen content. Depending on your needs, you can choose to hide the navigation button and status bar with any application on iPhone.
