

How to hover the mouse more accurately on the computer

In principle, mouse acceleration is a useful feature in Windows 10 - it increases the rate of the mouse pointer movement based on how quickly you move the cursor on the screen.

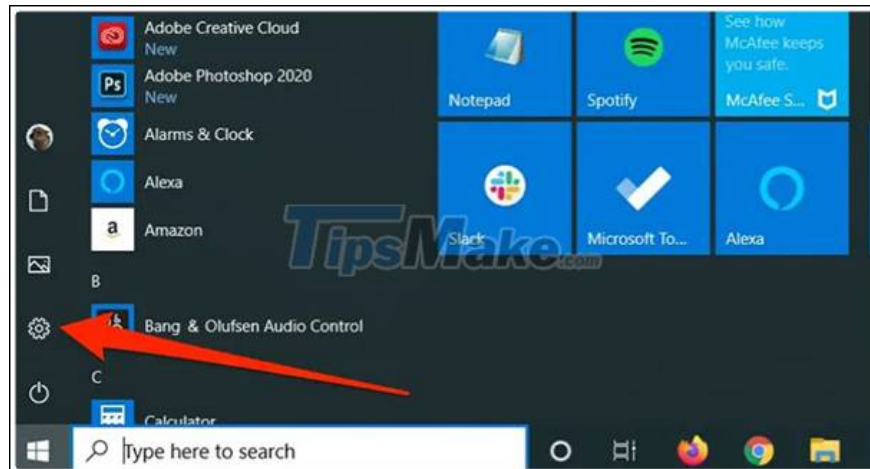
That way, you reach your goals faster and work more efficiently. Unfortunately, that also means you are more likely to mousing over your mouse, which is annoying in everyday use and extremely annoying when playing games, where click accuracy is very. important.

Luckily, this feature can be easily turned off. You simply need to turn off a feature called '**Enhance pointer precision**' in the settings to achieve click-through accuracy, as opposed to exactly what this feature provides. This feature actually works to help the mouse move faster, suitable for those who use a professional computer or do the tasks that need to be manipulated quickly. Those who are not familiar with such a fast mouse speed will find it extremely annoying and also have many difficulties with accurate clicks.

Here's how.

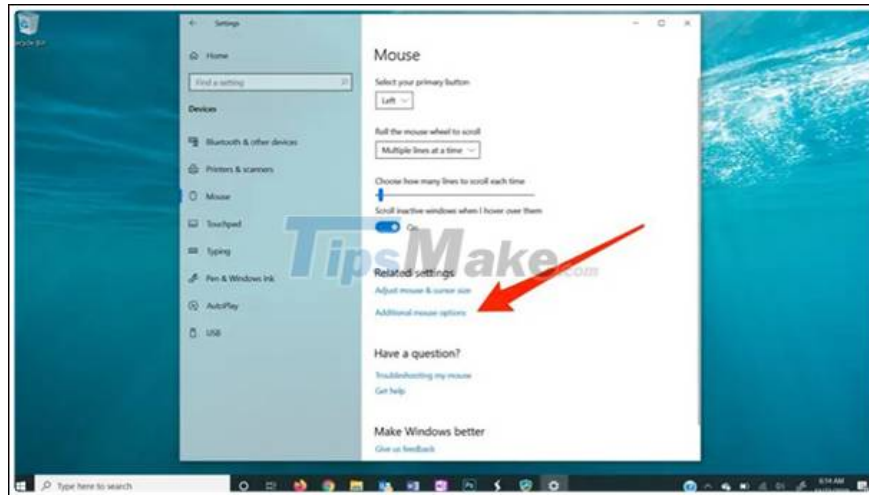
How to hover more accurately in Windows 10

Step 1. Click the **Start** button then select the **Settings** icon that looks like a cog.



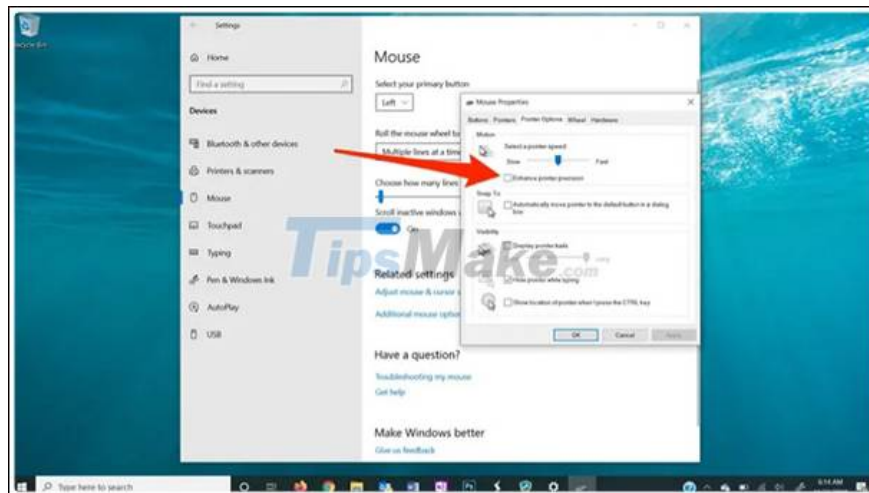
Step 2. Select **Devices** and then on the left side of the screen, click **Mouse** .

Step 3. Select **Additional mouse options** .



Step 4. In the **Mouse Properties** dialog box , select **Pointer Options** to change to the **Pointer Options** tab .

Step 5. Uncheck the **Enhance pointer precision** box .



Step 6. Click **OK** to close the dialog box.
