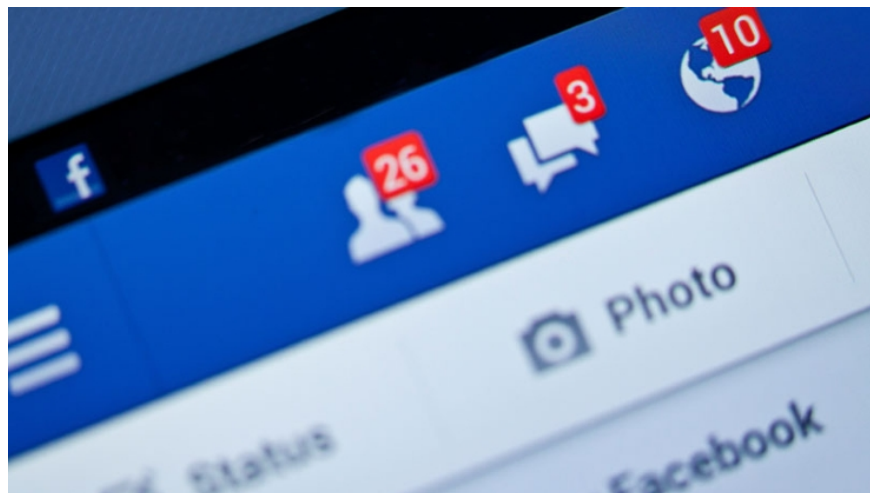
**To determine the unauthorized IP address to log into your Facebook account, follow the steps below:**

**Step 1:**

Open your browser and visit Facebook.com address.

## Step 2:

Log in to your Facebook account.



## Step 3:

Click on the Settings icon (Settings) - the serrated icon in the top right corner of your Facebook account interface and then select **Account Settings** .

## Step 4:

Click to select **Security** in the list of items on the left.

## Step 5:

Click **Edit** in the Login Notifications section.

## Step 6:

Check the **Email** option checkbox and then click **Save Change** to enable email notification.

Every time someone stealthily logs into your Facebook account, Facebook will quickly send you a notification via email address.

## Step 7:

Open your Email and search for the line **A new unknown device ??ng nh?p vào ?? ??ng nh?p Facebook c?a b ?n .**

Here will show your IP address and your Facebook account login location. You will know the IP address of the sneaky user who logs into his Facebook account.

### **Step 8:**

Enter your device name in the **Name New Device** window and select **Save Device** in case you log in to your Facebook account with safety devices such as your computer or mobile phone. friend. You will be asked to enter a trusted device name only once.

When you sign in with an unsafe device like a public computer or a computer, mobile phone that you borrow from someone else, select **Do not Save** .

If someone signs in to your Facebook account on a trusted device such as using your computer or mobile device, you will not receive a notification.

The IP address information of unauthorized users of your Facebook account will be sent to your Email.
