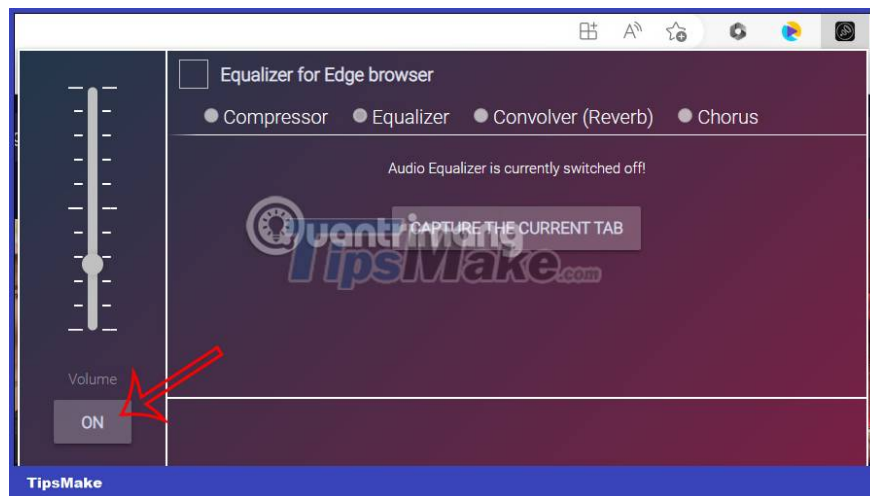
Instructions for listening to music on Microsoft Edge

Step 1:

We download the Equalizer for Edge browser utility for Edge browser according to the link below and install it as usual

Step 2:

Then we open the music page on the browser and then **click on the utility icon** on the address bar. Displaying the utility interface, we click **the On button at the Volume** to activate the sound control panel on the browser.



Step 3:

You will then see the audio control panel. We will adjust each bar to get the sound we like. If you want to return to the original default settings, the user clicks the Reset button.



The utility has several features including:

1. Preamplifier volume control.
2. Supports 10 bands of audio adjustment.
3. More than 21 ready-to-use presets.
4. Less CPU activity at runtime.
5. The rise and fall frequencies of each band are 12 dB apart.

It is known that the utility can boost low (bass) and high (treble) frequencies or to change the volume of different frequencies in an audio stream.
