

# How to improve Parental Lock feature for Apple Watch

It only takes a second to do it, and if you're lucky, it will make your smartwatch a little less interesting until your kids are old enough to figure out how to reverse what you've done.

1. Open **Control Center** on ??Apple Watch??: Swipe up on the watch face or when in an app, tap the lower edge of the screen, and then drag **Control Center** up.
2. Click the **Water Lock** icon (looks like a drop of water).



Click on the Water Lock icon

Here, you improvise using the **Water Lock** feature, which is used when you are swimming. This feature locks the screen so you can swim without the clock activating. But it also works great as a Parental Lock tool, because your watch will not respond to pushes, as long as Water Lock is activated.

Turning off this feature is also very easy, if you know how. Simply turn the **Digital Crown** (control button next to the watch). You will see an animation on the screen that indicates the speaker is being cleaned after water "swims". Keep rotating until you hear the beeping increase and the Apple Watch c?m touch screen will return to the normal feedback state.

If your child is bored and fast asleep, turn off the Water Lock feature.
