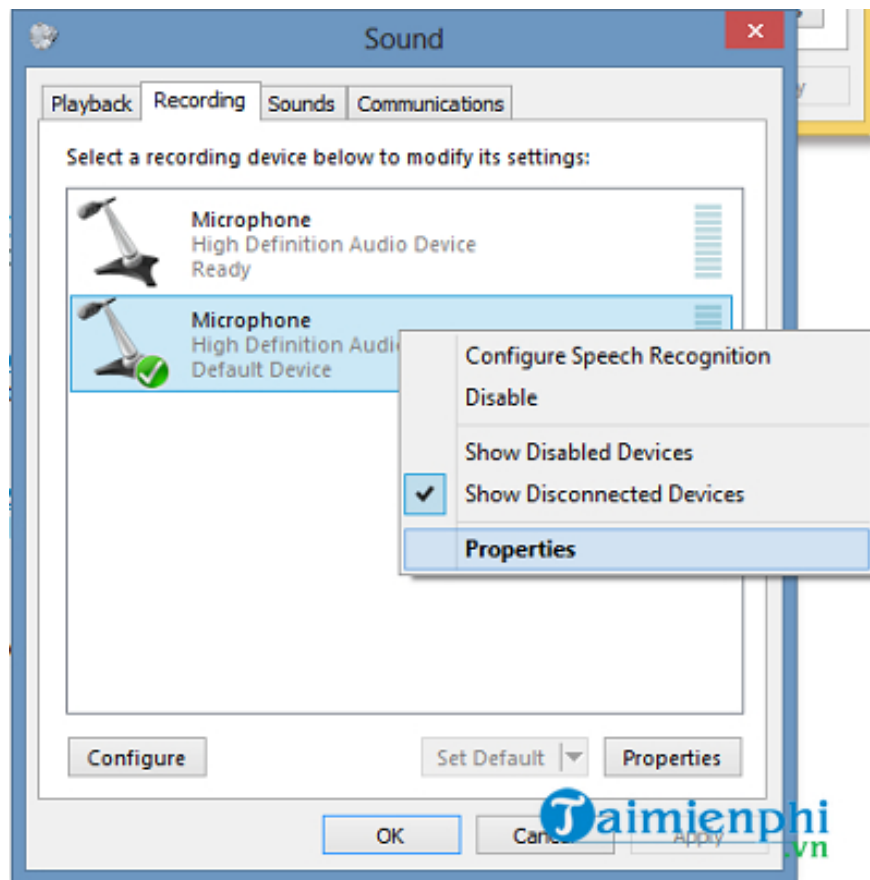

How to increase microphone volume on Windows 7

Windows 7 offers two options for amplifying microphone input. One is the standard microphone level, which controls sensitivity. The other is the Microphone Boost option, which amplifies the input sound to capture more audio.

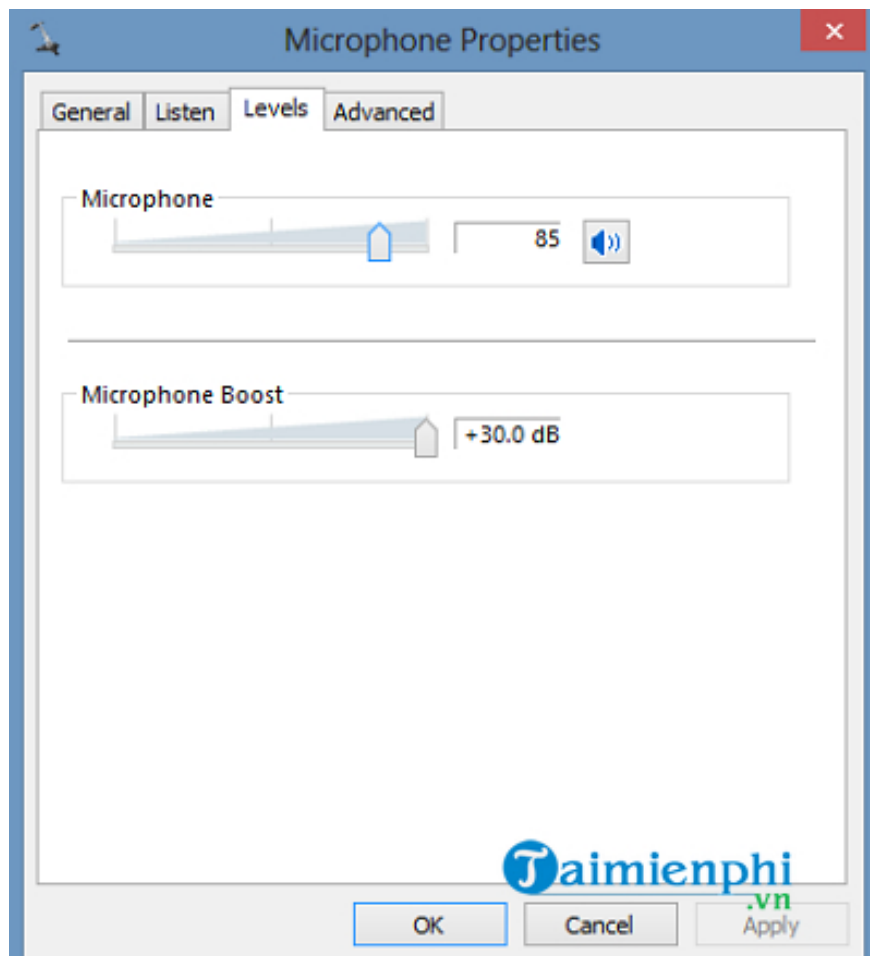
Step 1 : Click the **Start** button and select **Control Panel > Hardware and Sound** , then click on **Manage Audio Devices** under **Sound** .

Step 2 : Click on the **Recording** tab and double-click on your microphone to open the **Properties** window , or right-click on the microphone and select **Properties** . An active microphone is indicated by a green checkmark.



Step 3 : Select the **Custom tab > Microphone Boost** . If your computer does not have a **Custom** tab , skip this step.

Step 4 : Click on the **Level** tab and move **the Microphone** slider to the right to increase sensitivity.



Step 5 : Move the **Microphone Boost** slider to the right to increase the amplification. If you don't see the Microphone Boost slider, your sound card probably doesn't support this feature.

Step 6 : Click **Apply** and **OK** to set it up.

With just a few simple steps, you can amplify your microphone volume on Windows 7. If the sound is still low even after adjusting it to maximum, you need to check your computer's microphone and sound card, as one of them might be malfunctioning. Additionally, you can check out the top software for boosting computer speaker volume here; programs like Sound Booster or DFX will help you hear louder sound on your device.
