

How to increase OLED lock screen experience on iPhone

Users will have more custom OLED lock screens on the iPhone with Lisa tweaks.

OLED displays first appeared on the iPhone X but the lock screen interface did not really meet the needs of users, as they wanted Apple to improve to be more friendly with OLED displays. Before waiting for Apple to change, users can install Lisa tweaks to make changes to the OLED screen. This tweak will make the notifications appear better on a black background, increase the experience with OLED screens, or customize which elements do not appear in the notification. The following article will guide you how to install Lisa tweaks on iOS jailbreak devices.

Instructions to customize iPhone lock screen

Step 1:

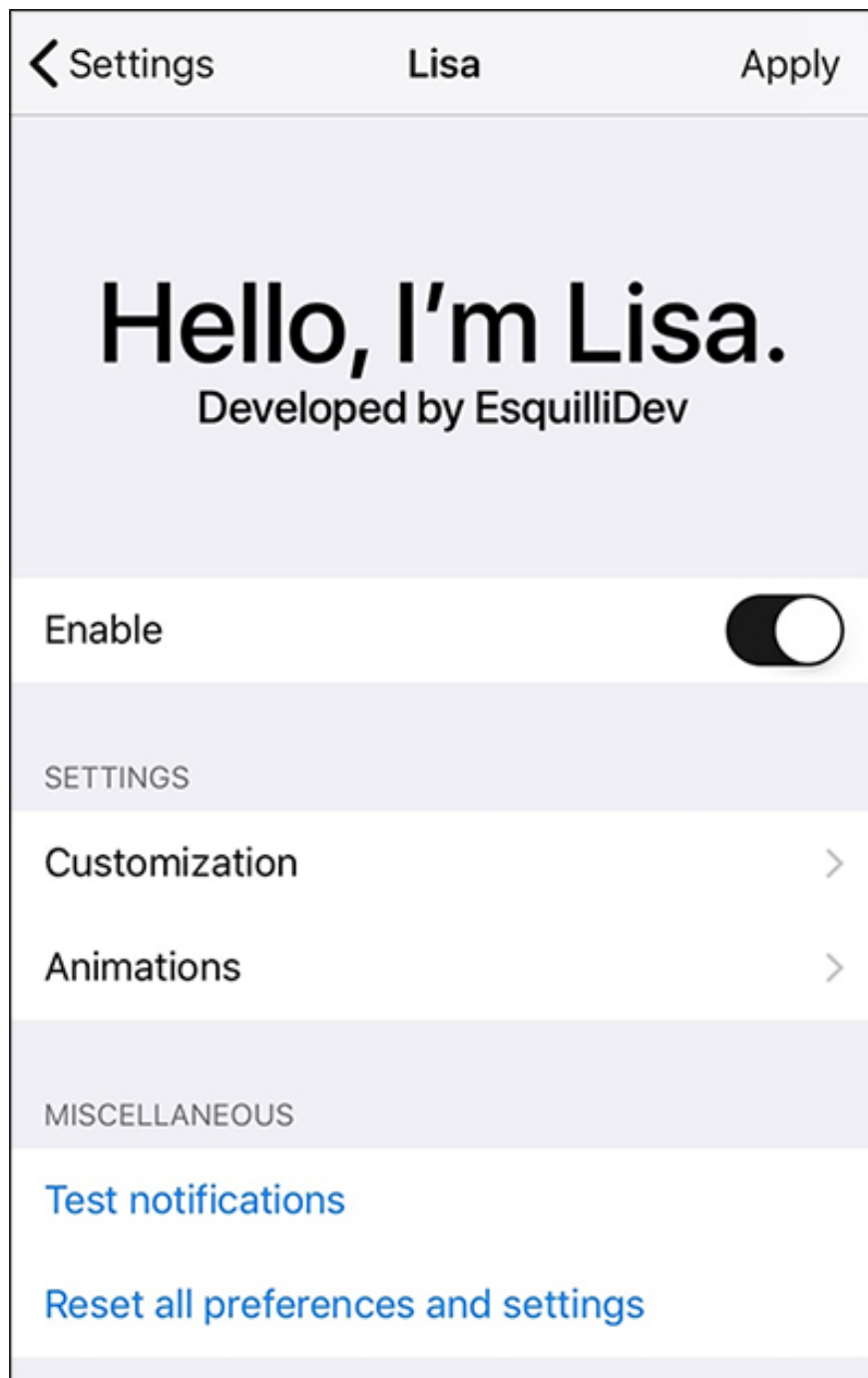
Users download refine Lisa according to Cydia's Esquilli source or go directly to the link below. Lisa works on jailbroken iOS 11 and 12 devices, but works more efficiently on devices with OLED displays such as iPhone X, XR, XS or XS Max.

Step 2:

After installation is complete, tweak the user to open Settings and then click on Lisa to customize the settings. At the first interface of tweaking we have big options.

1. Activate tweaks.
2. Customize behavior.
3. Custom animation.
4. Show notifications for preview changes.
5. Reset all settings to default.

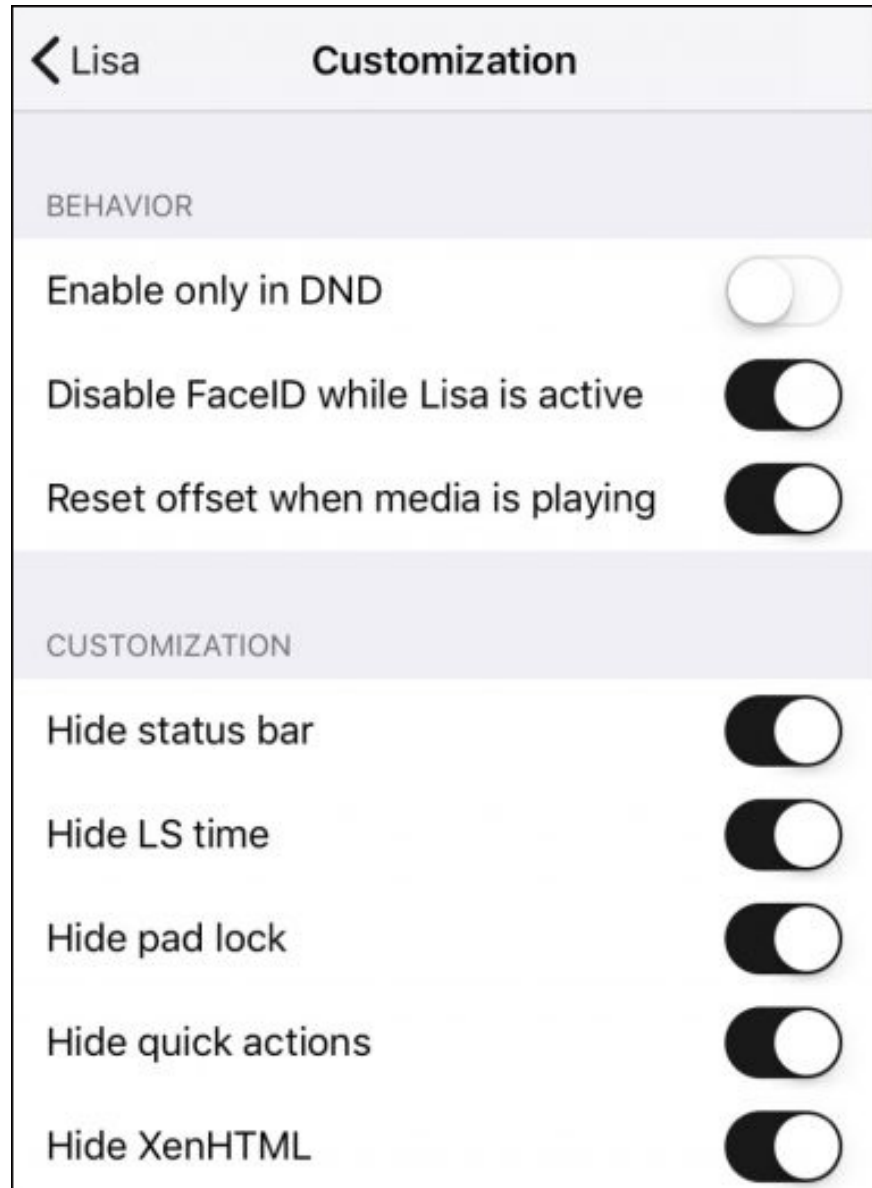


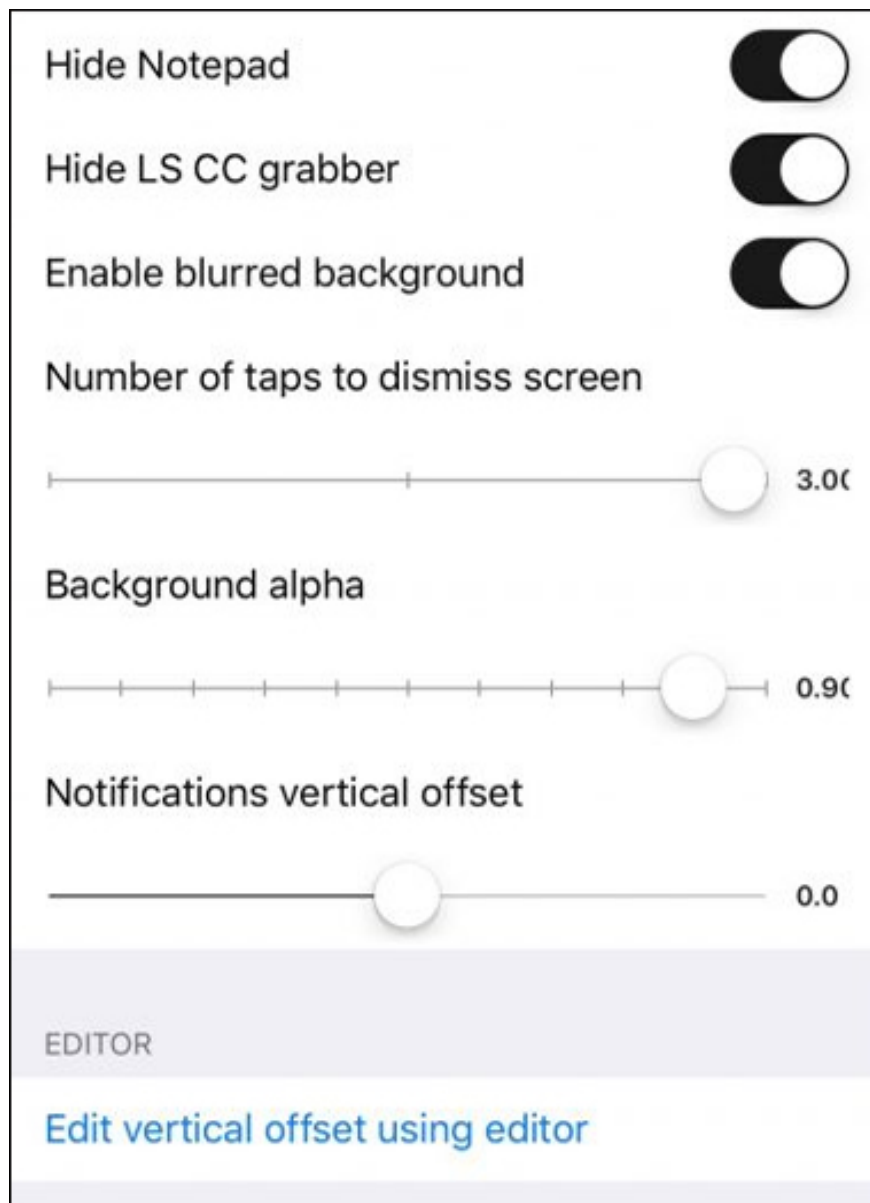
Step 3:

Click on **the Customization section** to further edit the tweak.

1. Use Lisa when Do not disturb mode is turned on.
2. Disable Face ID when Lisa is active.
3. Hide status bar.
4. Hide screen lock time.
5. Hide lock icon
6. Hide actions quickly.
7. Hide Notepad.

8. Hide the Control center Lock screen.
9. Activate blur background.
10. Choose the number of times you need to press the screen to remove Lisa.

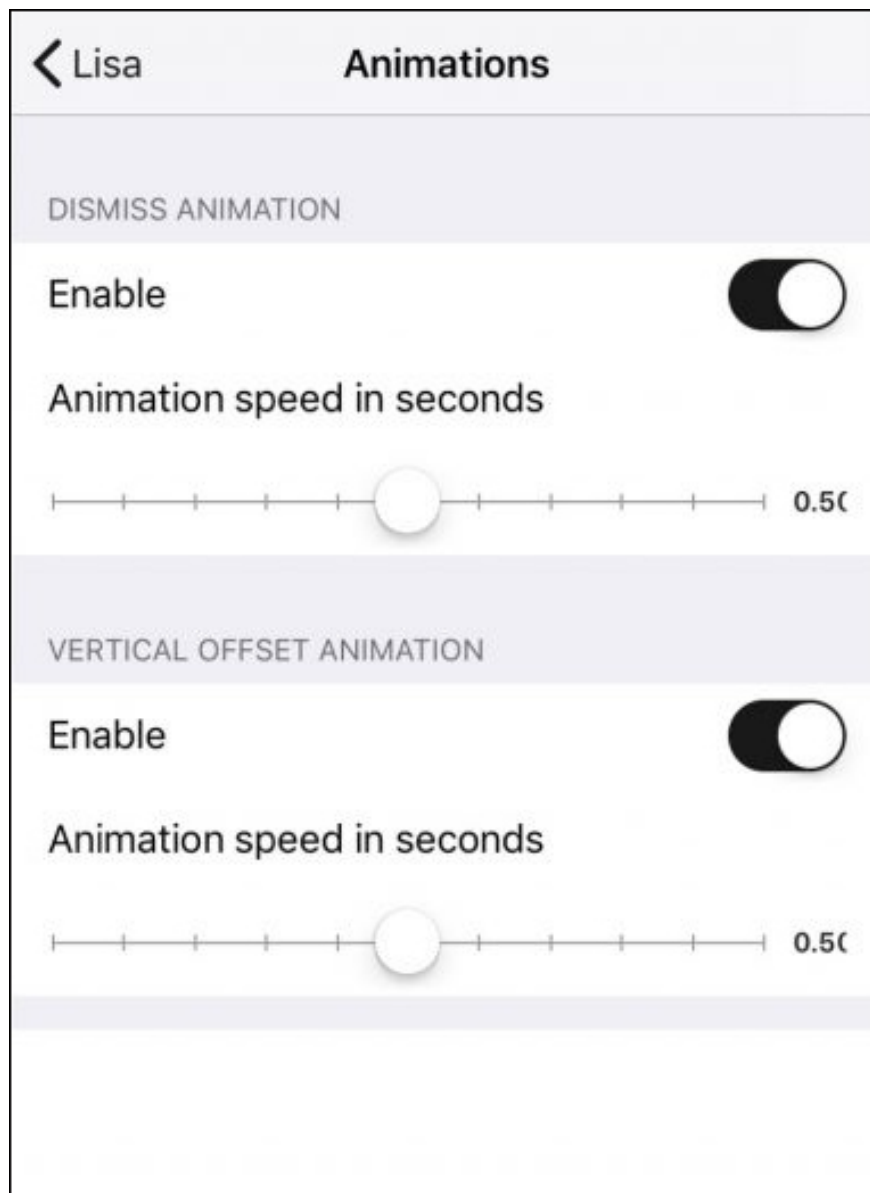




Step 4:

Clicking on Animations has a number of options including:

1. Enable or disable animation.
2. Configure animation speed.
3. Turn on or off vertical offset animation.
4. Vertical speed compensation animation configuration.
