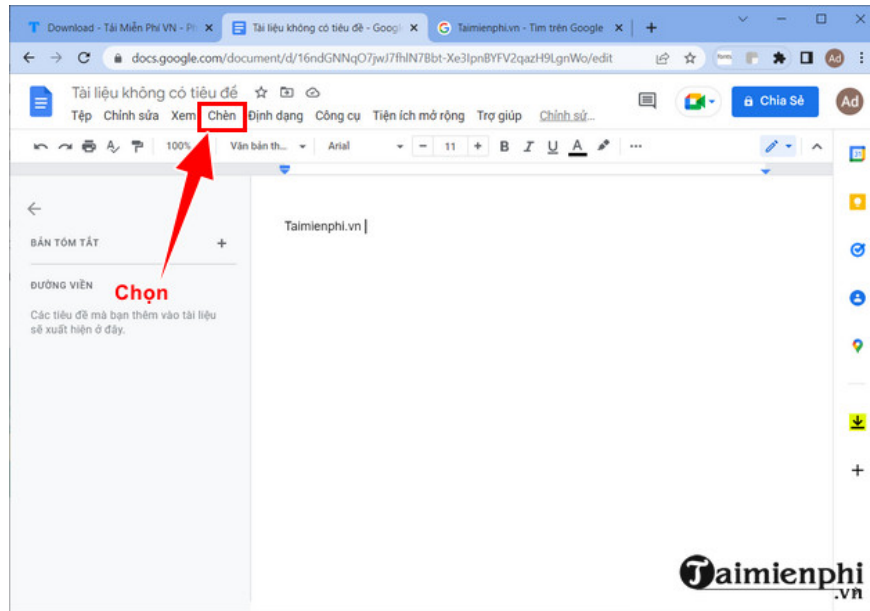

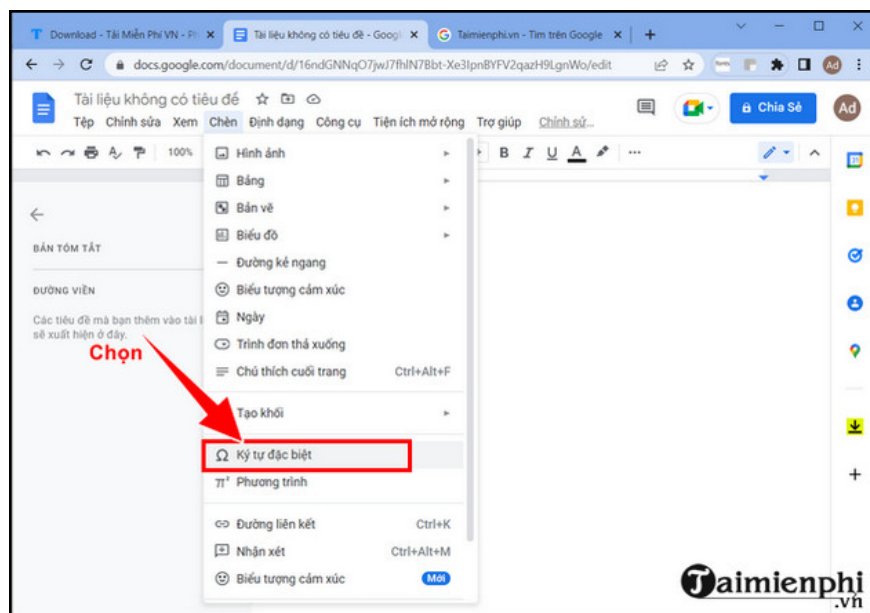
How to insert emojis in Google Docs

1. *Insert emojis into Google Docs using the character set.*

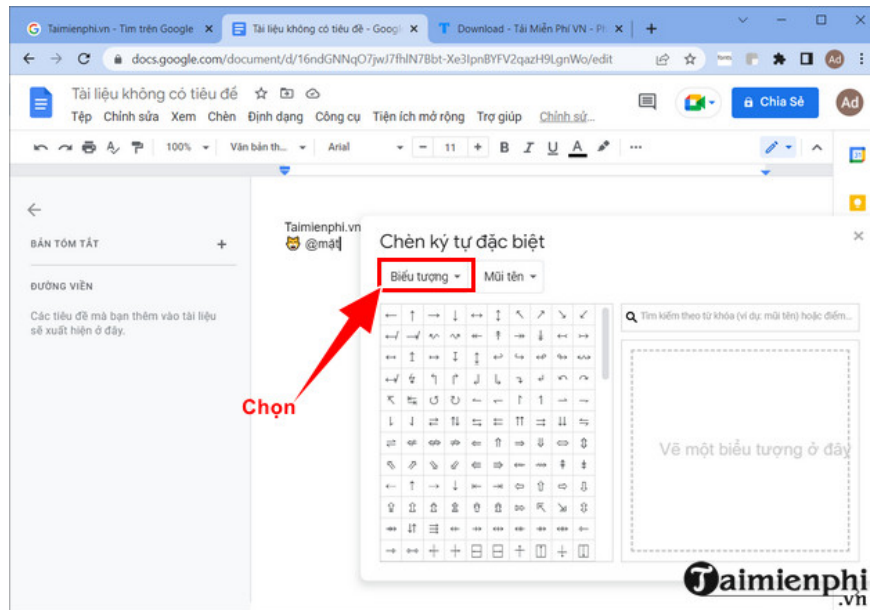
Step 1: Open Google Docs in your browser, and on the document page, select **Insert** .



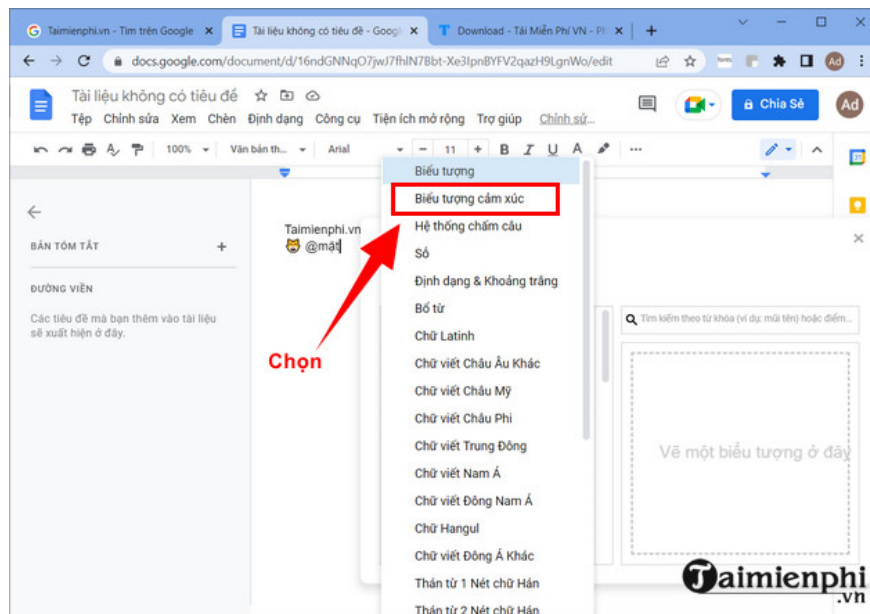
Step 2: Next, to insert emojis into Google Docs using special characters, select the "Special Characters" option .



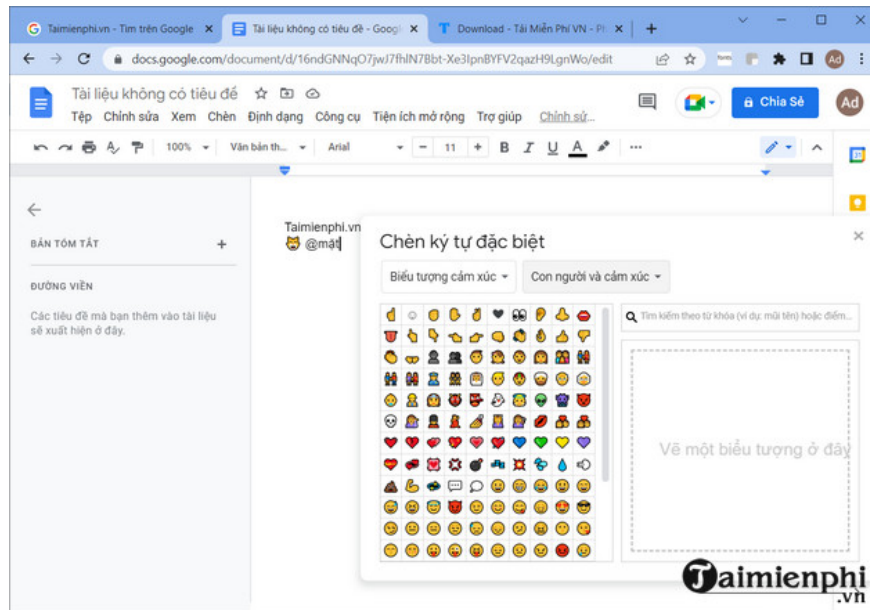
Step 3: Here, click on the **Icon box**.



Step 4: Select the **Emoji** section .



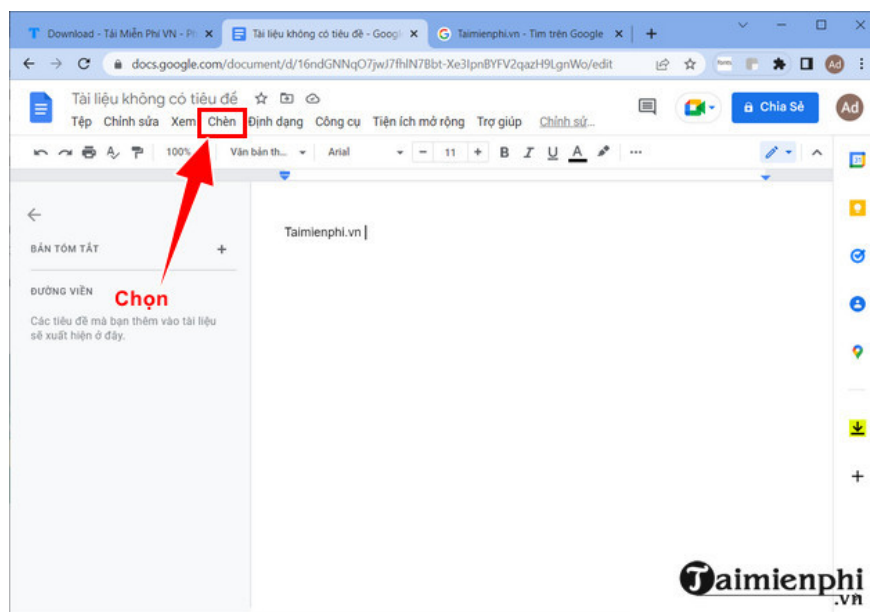
Step 5: Select the emoji you want to insert , and you're done.



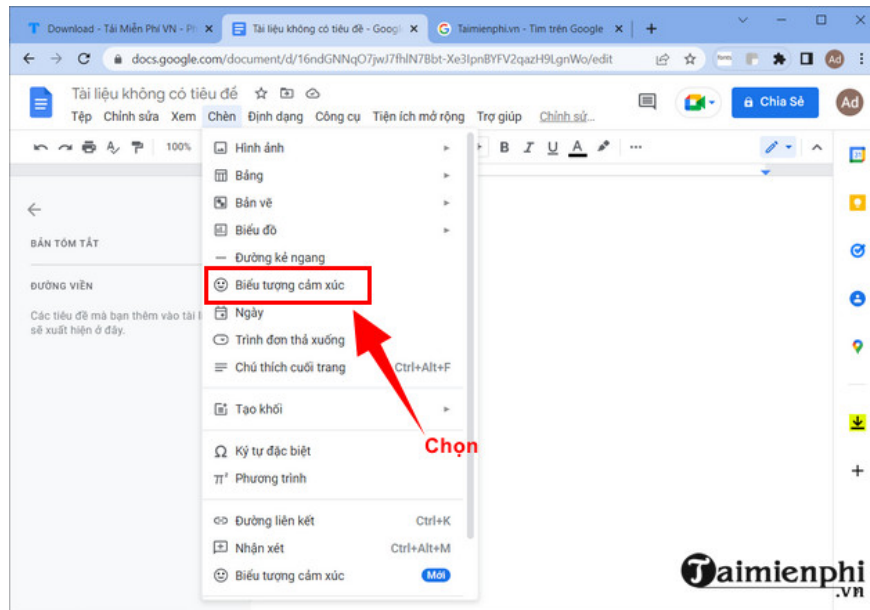

2. Inserting emojis in Google Docs

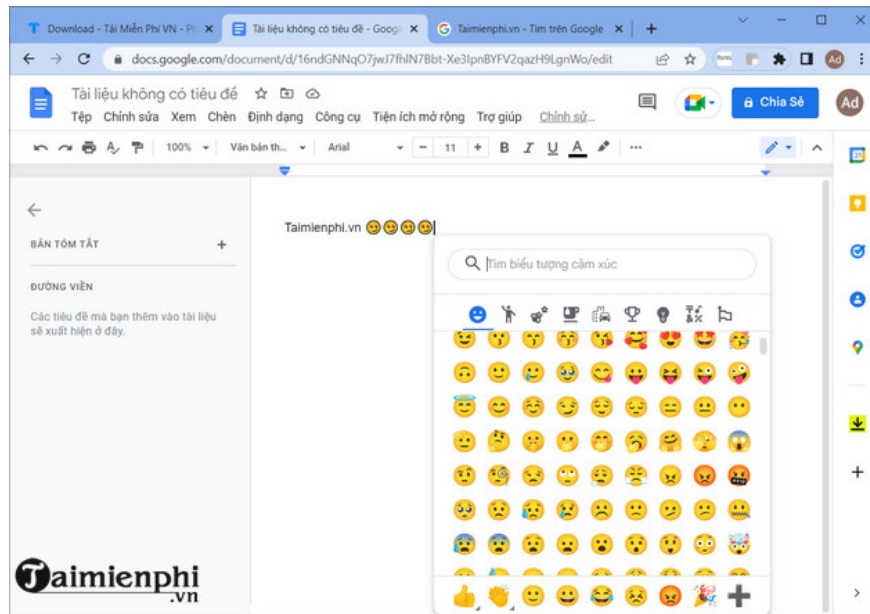
Step 1: Open **Google Docs** in your browser, open a new (or old) document file, then select Insert.



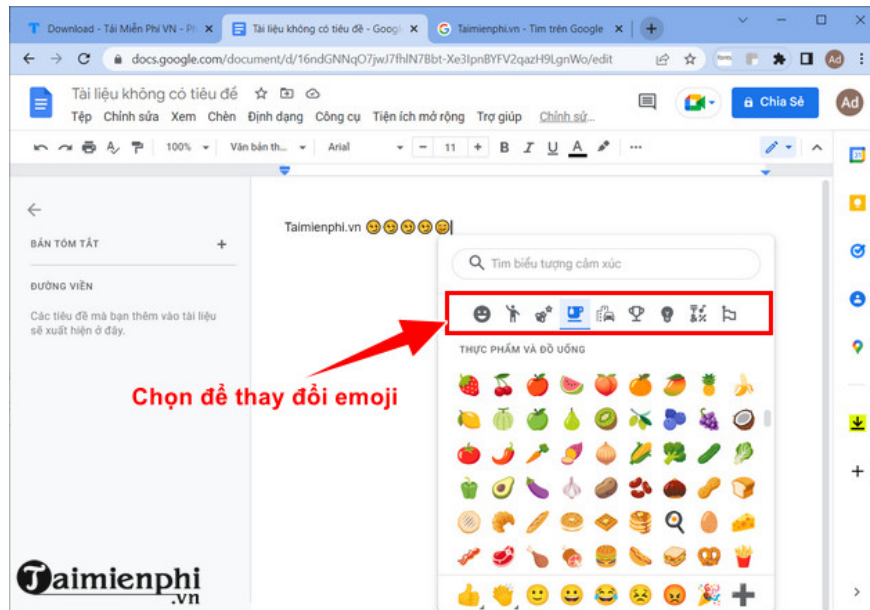
Step 2: Select the **Emoji** section to add to the document file.



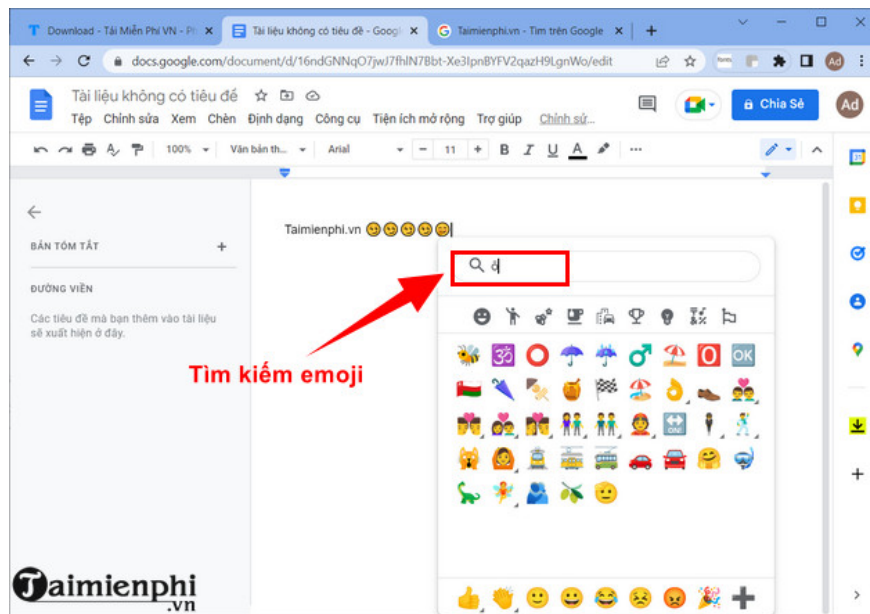
Step 3: Select **the emoji** you want to add from the table, and you're done.



Step 4: You can choose emojis based on different themes by **clicking on each item** as shown in the image.



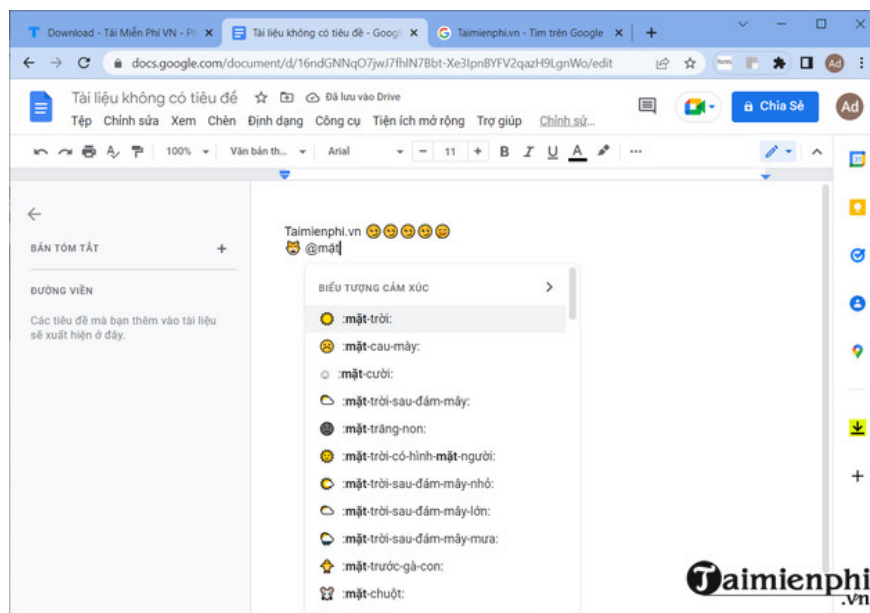
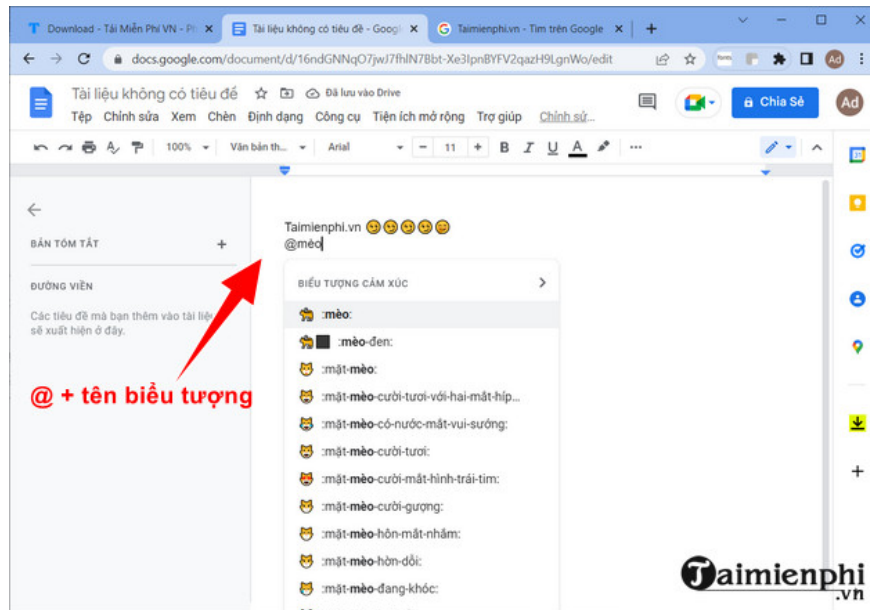
Alternatively, you can also search for emojis using **the search bar** to insert into your document.

Step 1: Open **Google Docs** in your browser, then open a new (or old) **document file**.

Step 2: Type the **@ symbol + the symbol name** , and Google Docs will suggest some related symbols. Then, simply choose the symbol you want to add.
