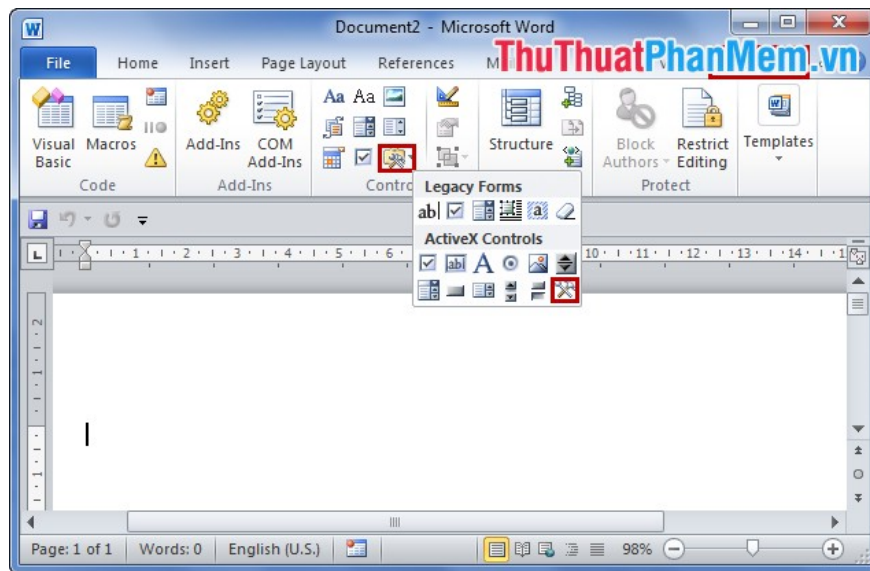
Microsoft Word allows you to insert videos into Word. Below are detailed instructions on how to insert Video into Microsoft Word 2010, and other similar versions.

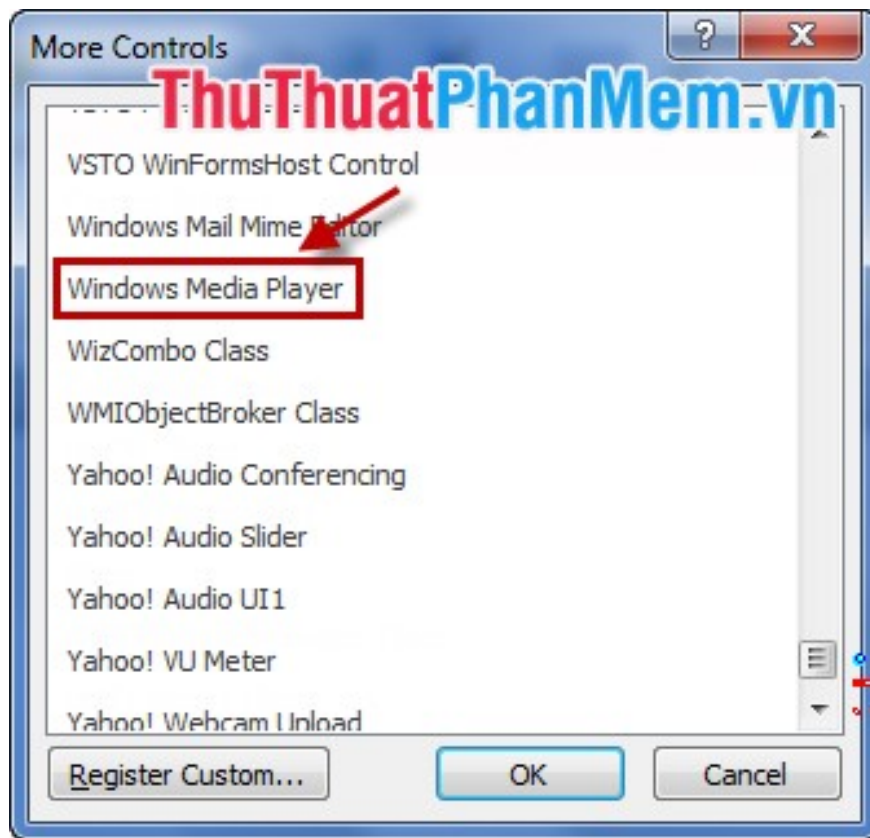
Microsoft Word allows you to insert videos into Word. Below are detailed instructions on how to insert Video into Microsoft Word 2010, and other similar versions.

**Step 1:** You open **Microsoft Word** .

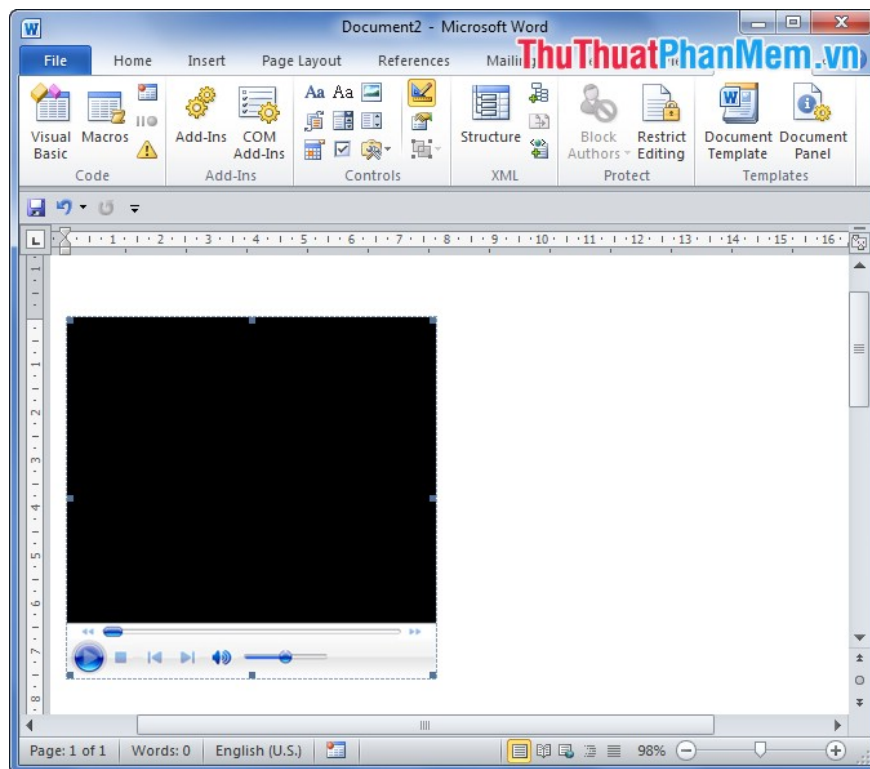
**Step 2:** Select **Developer** , in the **Control** you select the **Legacy Tools** icon and select the **More Controls** icon .



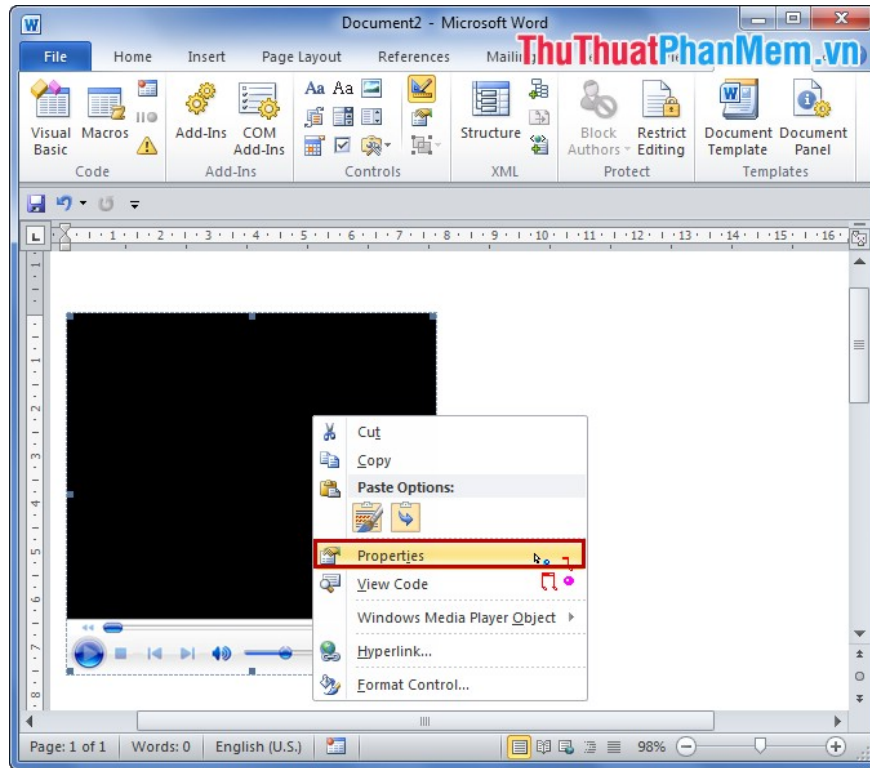
**Step 3:** In **More Control**, select **Windows Media Player** and select **OK** .



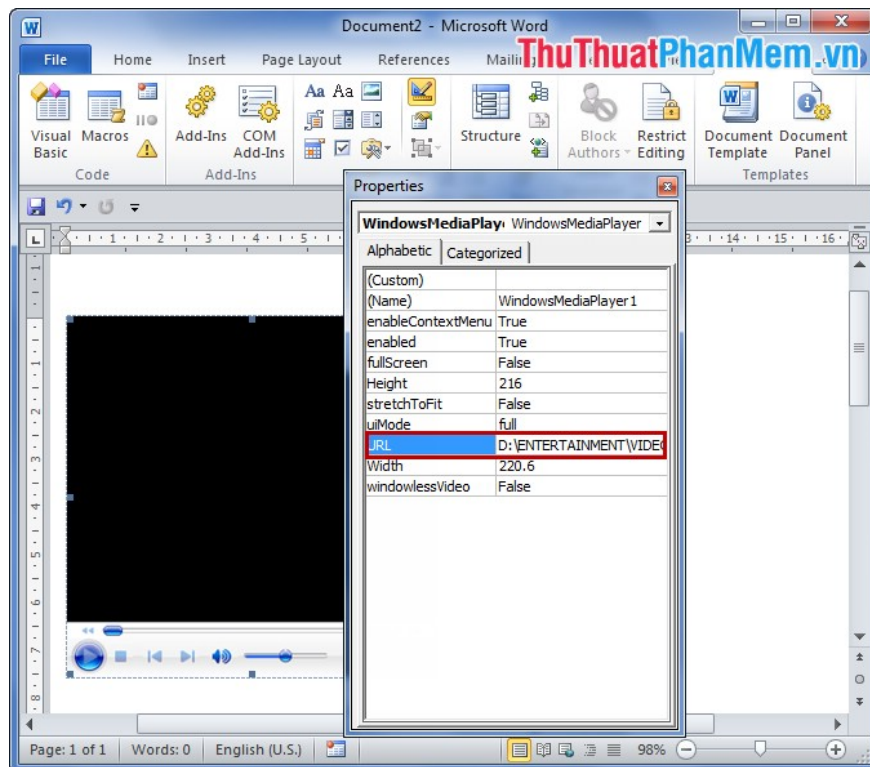
Word will display a frame running Video, you can select on the edges to resize to the Video you want to insert into Word.



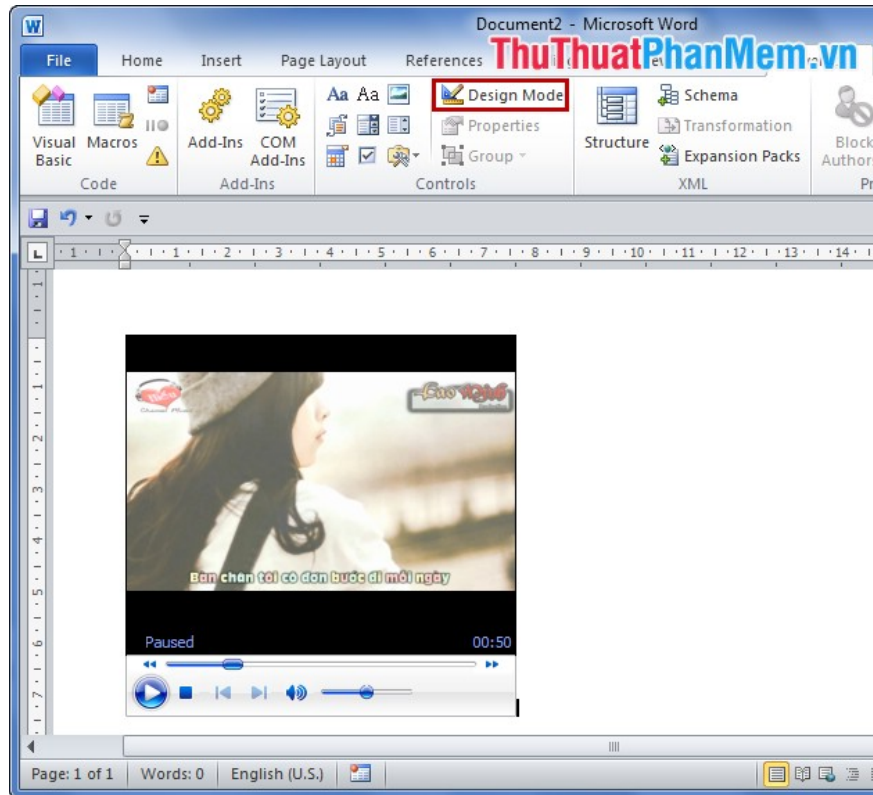
**Step 4:** After resizing the Video, select the right mouse button and select **Properties**.
