

How to insert video subtitles on Veed

Veed supports online video editing, including the option to insert video subtitles.

Besides the video editing software installed on the computer, many people need to edit video quickly, no need to login or create an account. Veed is an online video editing site that supports the use of no account creation or login like other websites. With Veed we have a lot of tools to edit videos, including inserting subtitles, inserting stickers, changing frame rates, drawings, adjusting video playback speed. Instead of using caption insertion software on video, you can use Veed immediately to quickly perform operations. The following article will guide you how to insert video subtitles on Veed.

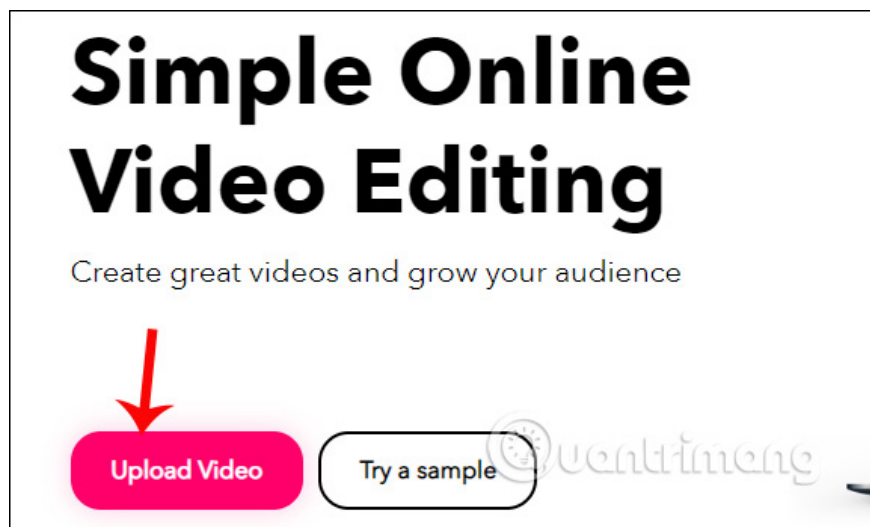
Instructions for inserting video subtitles on Veed

Step 1:

Users access the link below to go to Veed homepage.

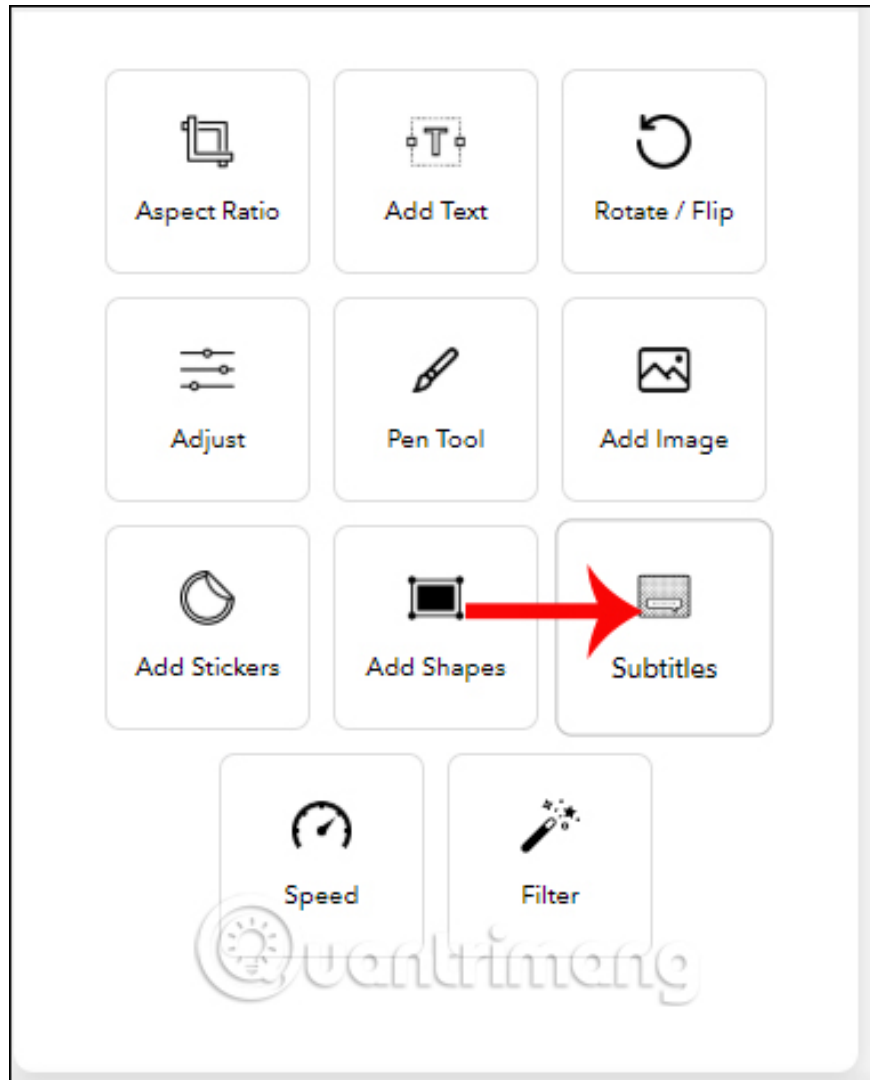

At the interface of the selected homepage, **Upload Video** to select the uploading service video. Uploaded videos should not exceed 50MB.



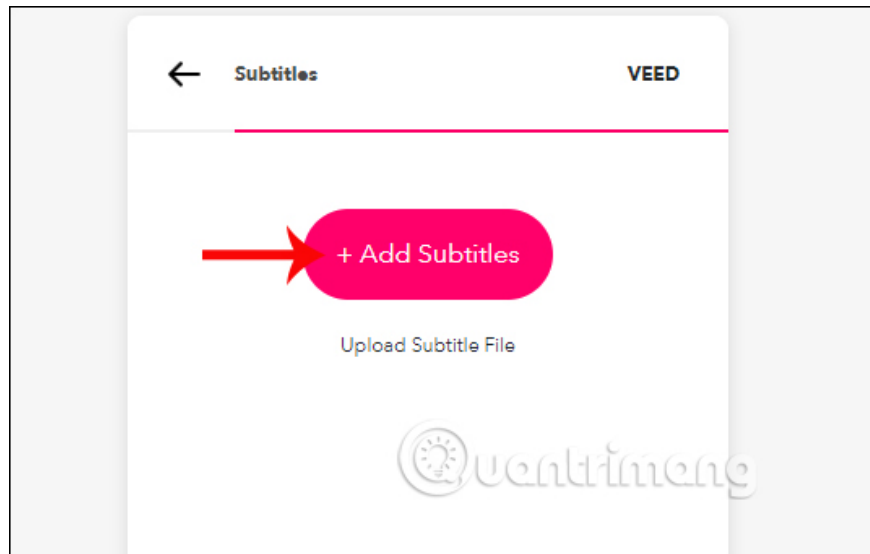
Step 3:

Switch to the video editing interface, click on **the Subtitles tool** to insert subtitles. In addition, Veed also provides many tools to edit other videos, including Aspect Ratio to change the frame rate, Add text to insert text, Filter to adjust the filter, Pen Tools add content to the video, Add Image insert image, Add Stickers Insert emoticons, Insert Shapes Add Shapes, Speed ??adjust playback speed for videos that increase or slow down.

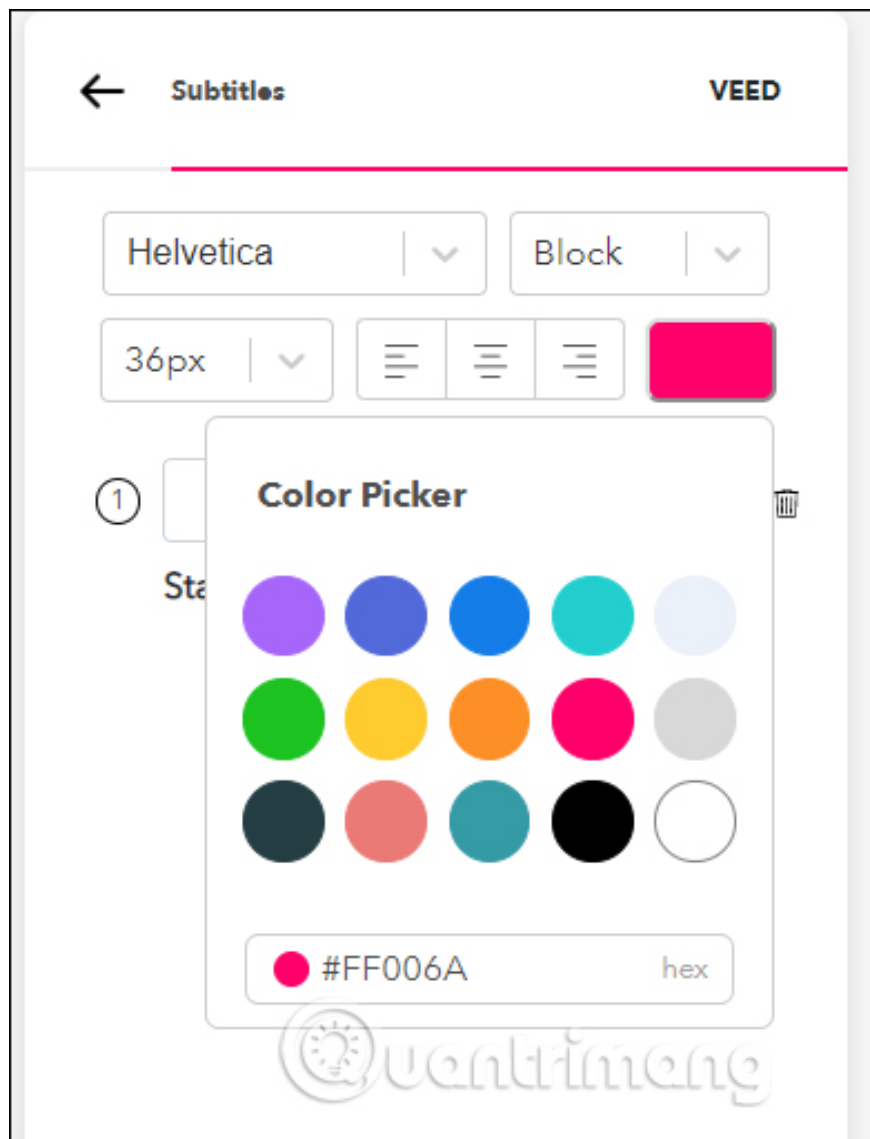


Step 4:

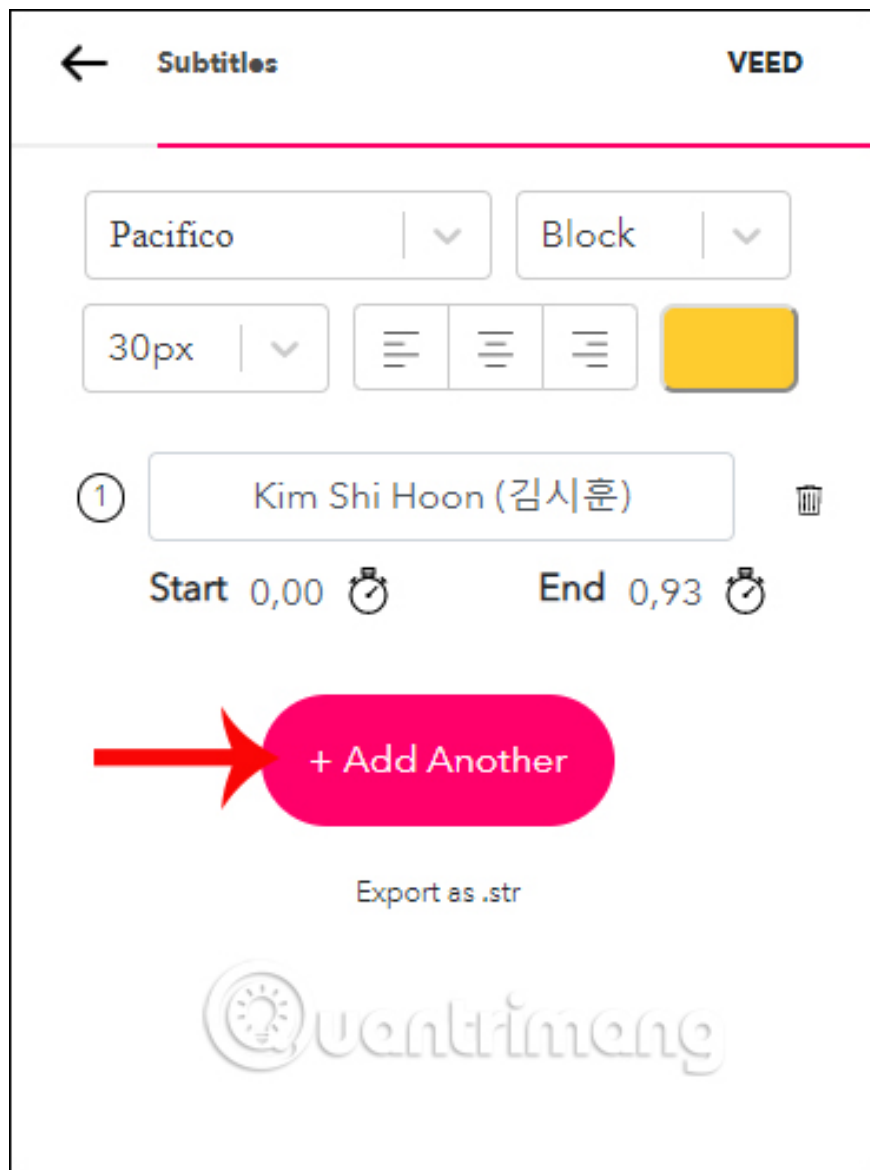
Display the frame to insert subtitles for the video, **click Add Subtitles** to create the first subtitle content.



In the new interface, we enter the subtitle content in **the New Text frame** . Subtitles have font, font, font size, display position, text color options.

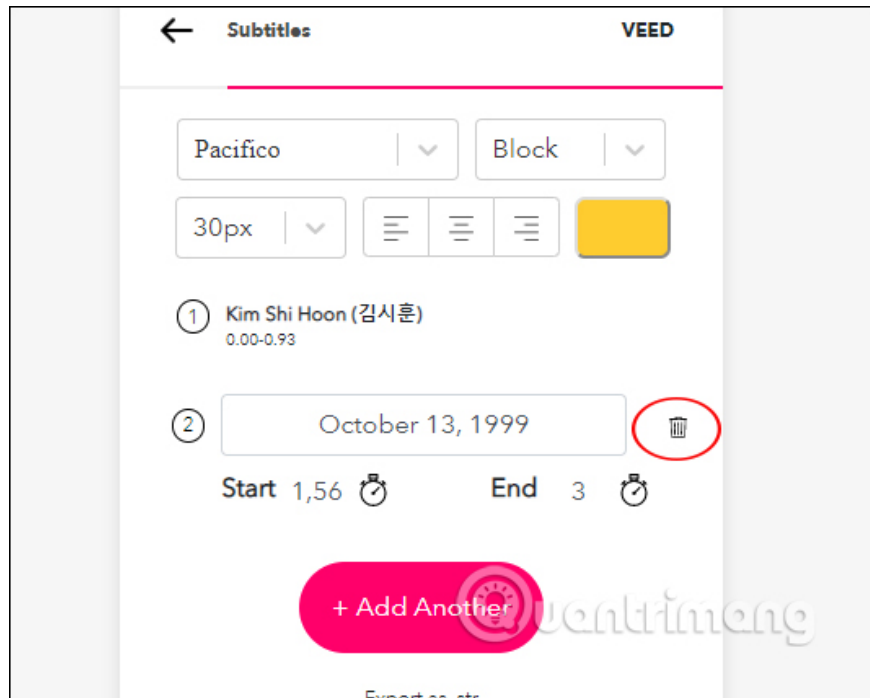


Users can choose the time that the subtitles display and end using the first and last two markers, then press Start and End. Click on **Add Another** to insert the next subtitle content.



Step 5:

Video subtitles are separated into different sections so that we can easily edit and change them. If you want to delete any subtitle, click **the trash can icon** next to the subtitle.

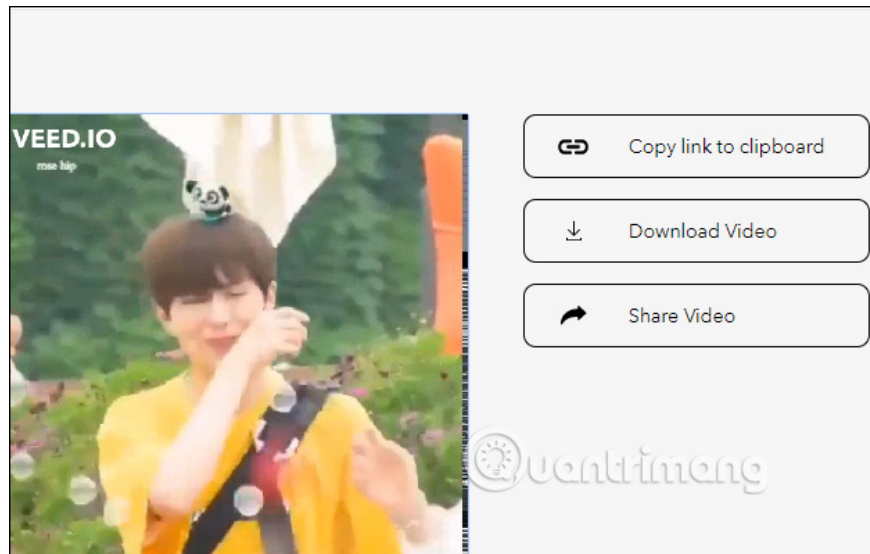


Click the play icon below to see if the subtitles inserted into the video are right for you. If satisfied, **click Download** to VEED to apply all subtitles and other effects if available on the video. If you create an account on Veed, you have the option to Save project to save videos in Veed account.



Step 6:

Wait for the video export application. In the video download interface, we click **Download video** to download the video to the computer. In addition, users have the option to get a video link (Copy link to clipboard) and share video (share video). Free videos will have Veed logo.



So you have the right subtitle for the video with simple steps on Veed. However Veed is only suitable when you make short video subtitles, have low capacity and do not upload to other websites because the video has a logo.
