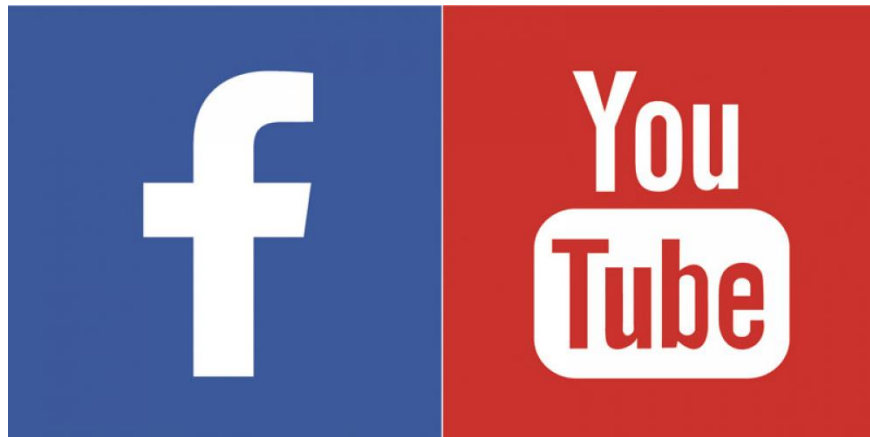


How to insert YouTube videos into Facebook Fanpage page

YouTube provides users with a URL, you can use this URL to share and embed videos on your Facebook page. This process is quite simple and takes only a few minutes to perform.



Steps to insert YouTube videos into Facebook Pages page:

Step 1:

Navigate to the video you want to insert into the Facebook Fanpage.

Step 2:

Click on the **Share** button at the bottom of the video, then copy the video URL.

Step 3:

The next step is to navigate to Facebook.com, log in to your Facebook account and select the Facebook Fanpage page you want to insert YouTube videos in the **Page** section in the left pane.

Step 4:

Click on link **Share something on your Page** at the top of the page when you open the Status pane.

Step 5:

Paste the YouTube video URL you copied in the previous step into **Status** and wait for Facebook to display the thumbnail and the video description.

Step 6:

Finally click **OK** to insert the YouTube video.
