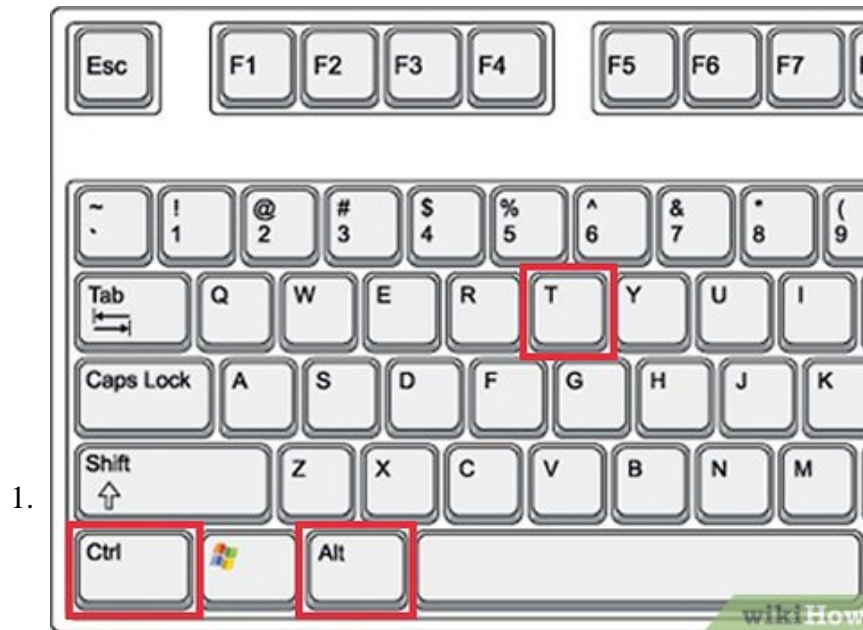


How to Install HandBrake on Ubuntu 14.04

HandBrake is a free, open-source program used to convert video files. It's available for Windows, OS X and Ubuntu. This article will explain how to install it in Ubuntu 14.04. Open a terminal window. This is usually done by pressing .

Method 1 of 2:


Using the Terminal



Open a terminal window.

This is usually done by pressing `Ctrl` + `Alt` + `T`.



Type or copy/paste into the terminal:

```
sudo apt-get install handbrake .
```

1. You might have to enter your password.

Update the software:

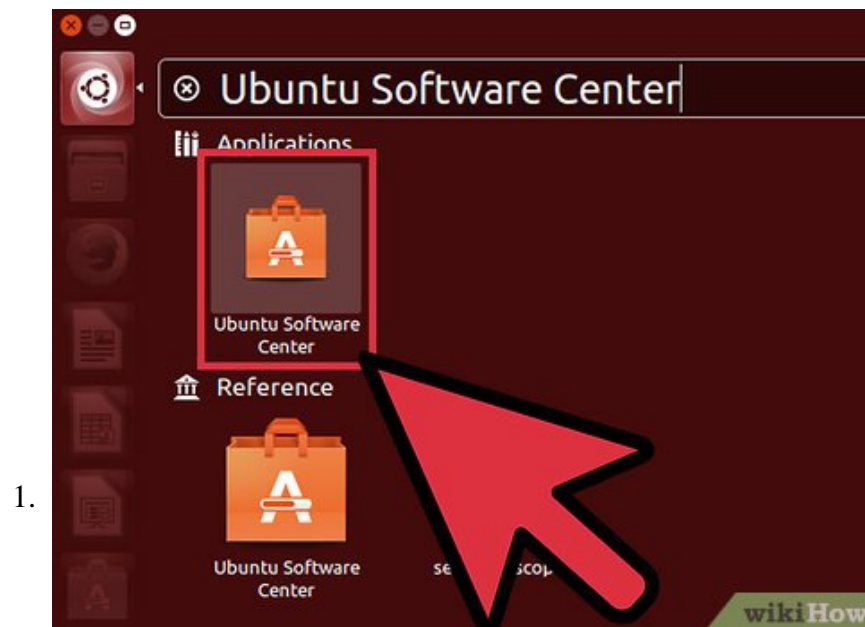
Type or copy/paste: `sudo apt-get update` into the Terminal.



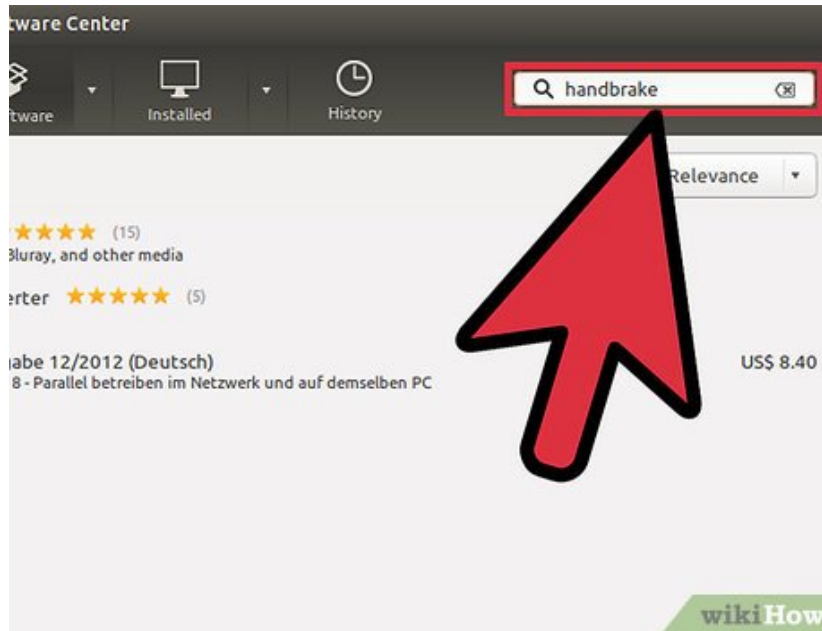
And you're done. You can open HandBrake by typing: `handbrake` in the terminal, or by searching for it in the dashboard.

Method 2 of 2:

Using the Ubuntu Software Center

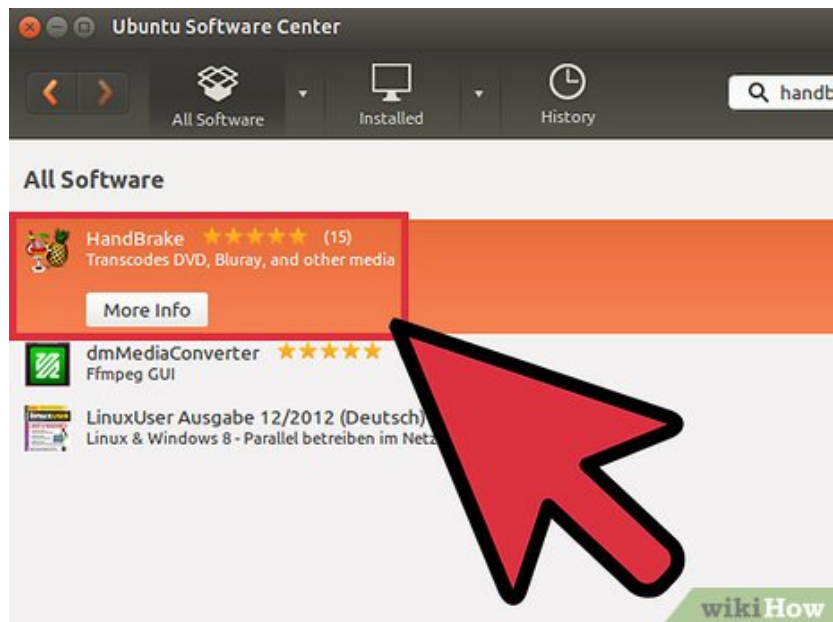


Open Ubuntu Software Center. Go to Dashboard and search for, then click on: `Ubuntu Software Center`.



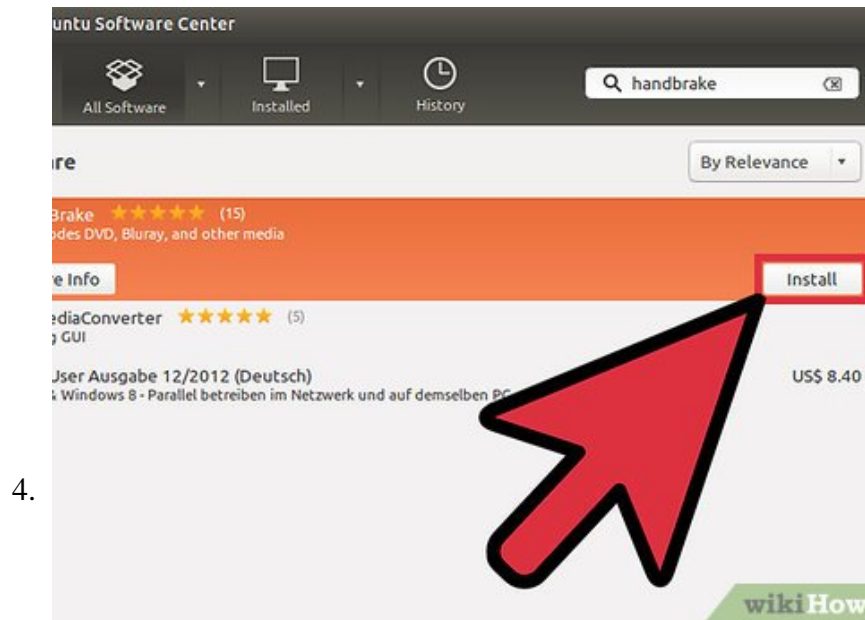

Search for HandBrake. Type `HandBrake` in the top right search bar.

Select the program.



Click on the Install button.
