- Alternatively, you can practice typing with all ten fingers using the website <https://typingtop.com>, which also has typing practice functions, including typing games, personalized practice exercises, and a history of your practice sessions.



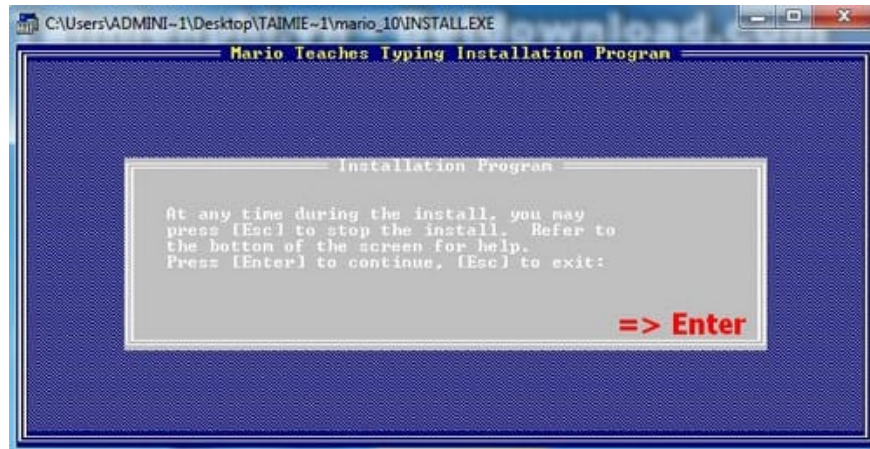

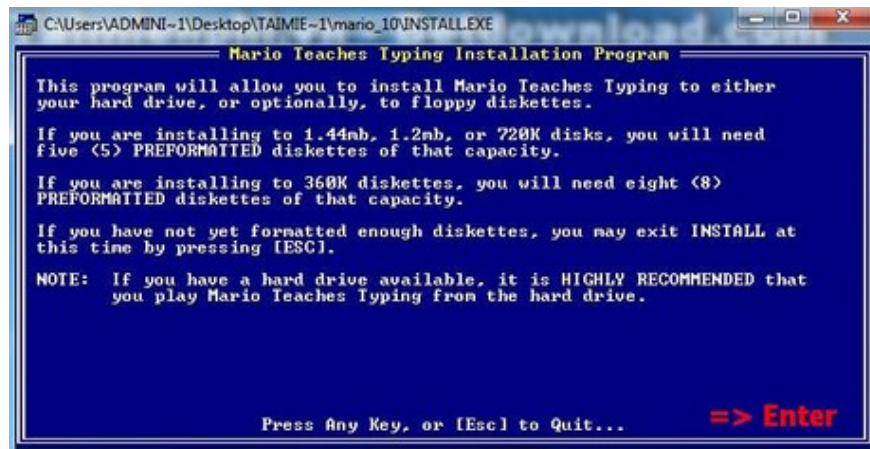

**How to install Mario, set up Mario for 10-finger typing practice on a computer or laptop.**

Step 1: Download Mario here: Download **Mario** or download the **Mario Teaches Typing** software. Step 2: Install the program: Run the **INSTALL.EXE** file in the downloaded folder and press **Enter**.



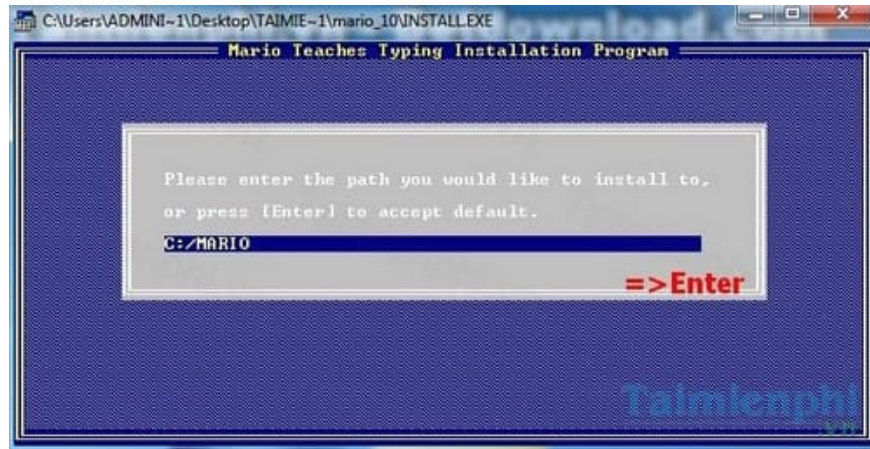
Press **Enter**



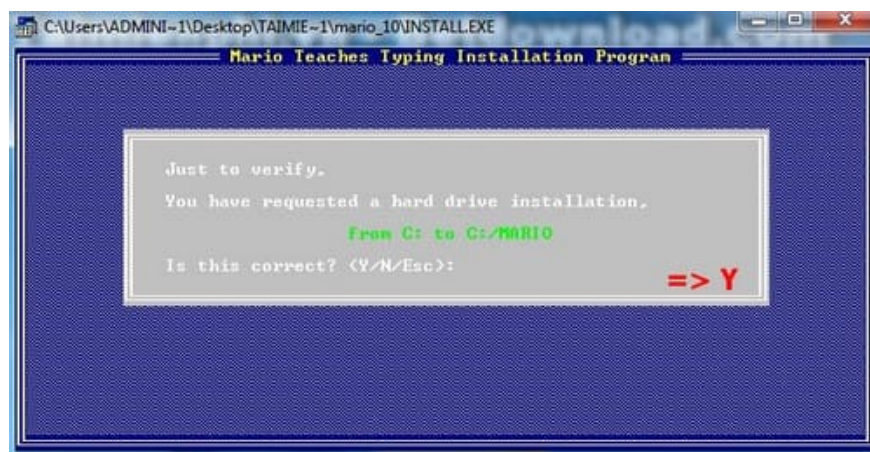

Press **Enter**



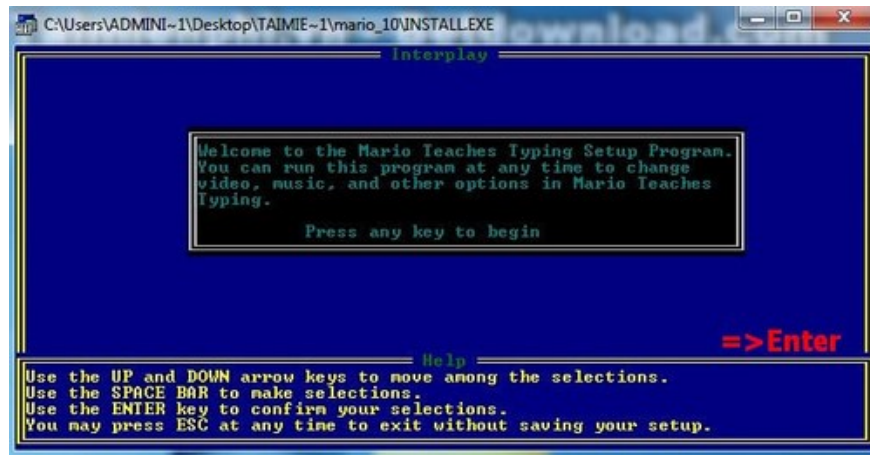
Choose **Y**

That completes the Mario installation process on Windows XP and Windows 7. To open the program, follow these steps:

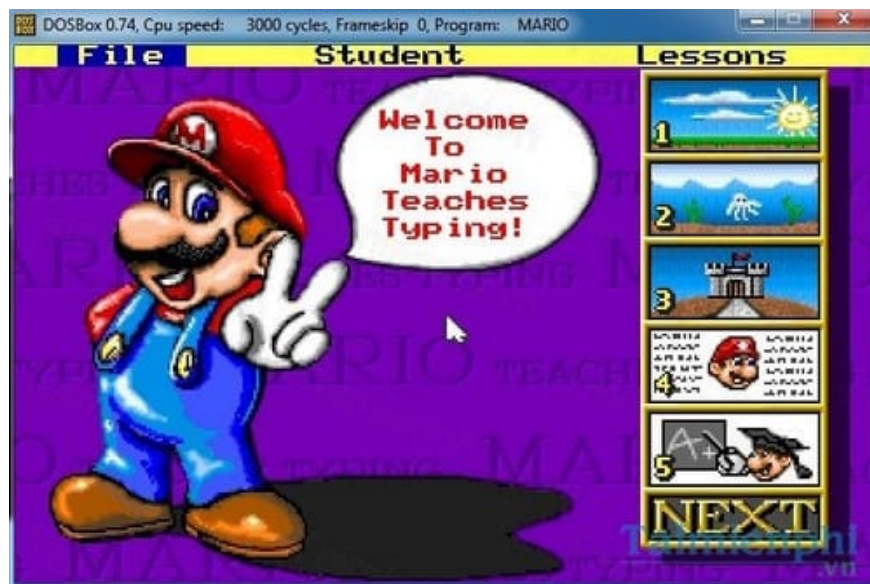
+ *For Windows 7*

, download and install DOSBox on your computer. Download **DOSBox**

. Then, open DOSBox, type `mount cc:MARIO`, press Enter, then type `C:`, press Enter, and finally type `mario`, press Enter.



Then the Mario program will appear for you.



+ *For Windows XP*

, go to the default Mario installation folder on drive C ( **C:MARIO**) and find the **MARIO.EXE** file to run the program.

## **Here are some tips for using the Mario software to practice 10-finger typing and achieve better results:**

- Maintain proper posture: Keep your back straight, your hands relaxed, and your eyes looking straight at the screen to avoid neck and shoulder strain.
- Position your hands correctly: Always place your fingers on the basic key row (ASDF and JKL;) for easy movement to other keys.
- Practice with both hands: Avoid using only one hand or a few fingers; try to distribute your force evenly to increase speed and accuracy.
- Avoid looking at the keyboard: It may be difficult at first, but practicing looking at the screen helps you memorize key positions faster.
- Practice consistently: Dedicate at least 15-20 minutes each day to maintain the habit and gradually improve your skills.
- Track your progress: Mario has a score statistics feature; you should review it to monitor your typing speed and error rate.
- Choose the appropriate level: Start with easy exercises to get acquainted, then gradually increase the difficulty to challenge yourself.
