

How to install the application on Android without using Google Play Store

Play Store is commonly known as **Android Market** - the digital distribution platform for Android operating systems and digital media outlets run by Google.

The huge storage of apps, games, and all of Google's digital stuff is the largest data warehouse in the world and almost everything you want to find can be here.



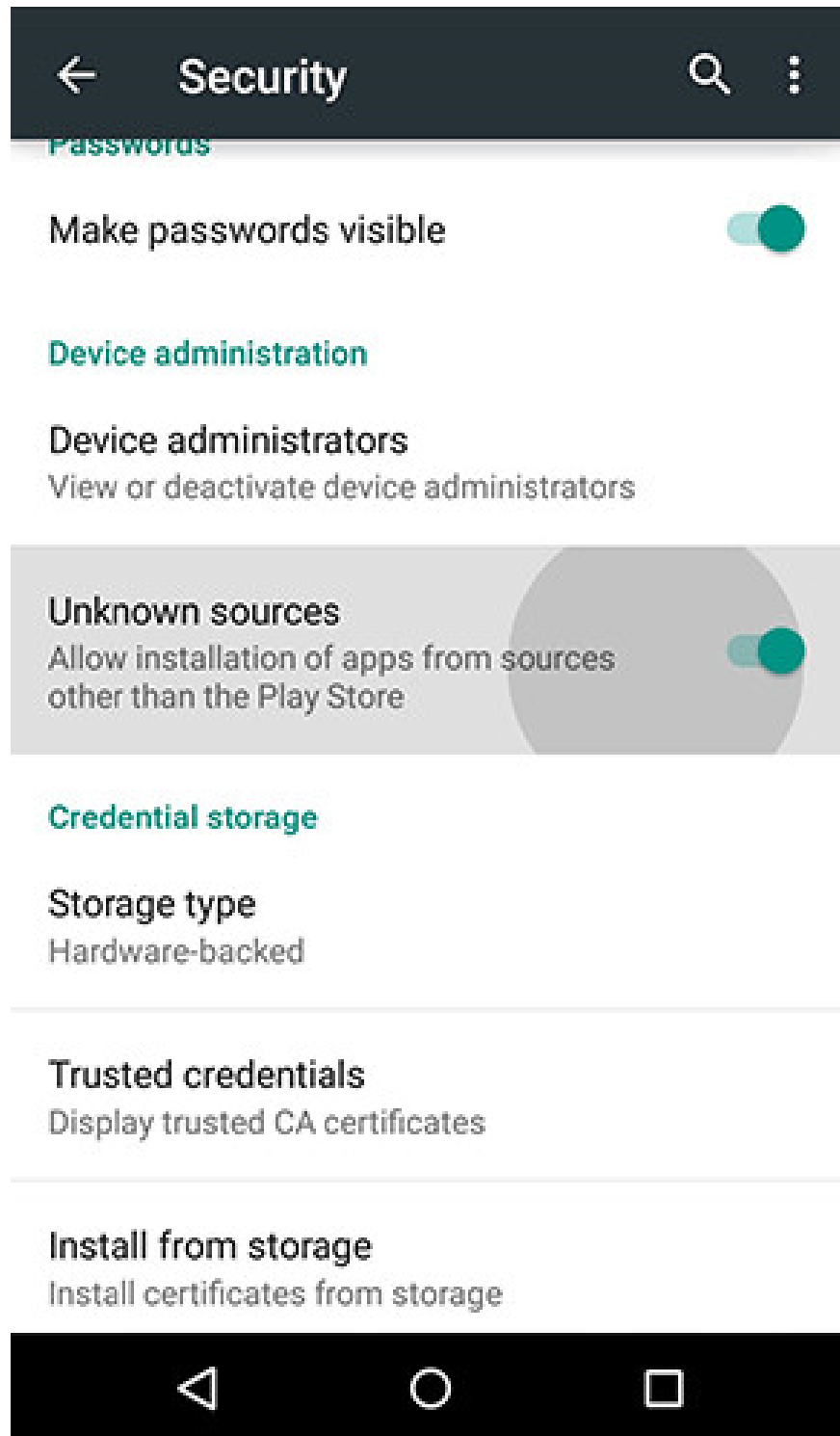
However, there are times when you need to install applications from outside the market that provide Android applications. Google does not operate as closely as Apple when it comes to what is sold in the app store, but it can still check rates on the spot. Or maybe you want to **install an older version** of the application you already own because it works well on your device.

Let's TipsMake.com consult some ways to install applications on Android without using Google Play Store in this article offline!

Enable unknown sources - Unknown Sources

Application packages for Android packaged in **APK** files, can also be downloaded from outside the Play Store store (such as through your web browser). However, before attempting to install APK files, you must first allow the device to install the word " **Unknown Sources** " (ie the application is not in the Play Store store).

To do this, navigate to " **Settings** -> **Security** " and check the box marked " **Unknown Sources** ", then press " **OK** " and " **Trust** ".



Find the APK you want to install

You may already have a trusted site to download APK. If not, we can recommend an **APK** page (<https://www.apkmirror.com>) the ideal place to find legitimate APKs for older versions of the Play Store app, free apps and so on.

You can download the APK directly via the web browser on your phone, at which point you will receive the message " **This type of file can harm your computer - This file may be harmful to the computer.**" yours ". Don't worry, if you get the file from APKMirror or another file on the website you trust, your phone will be safe too.

Download the file, then open the APK from the pull-down notification menu on your phone or by browsing the " **Downloads - Download** " folder on your phone's file manager. Touch **Settings** and your new app will be ready soon.

You can also download APKs via the browser on your computer, at which point you will need to transfer files via phone via microUSB or wireless network and install from there.

Install using Google Drive, Dropbox and other cloud services

Also, if you download the APK on another device on your device, you can navigate to that device on your device, then upload it to the cloud service like **Google Drive** or **Dropbox** . When finished, you can access it via Drive or Dropbox on your phone and open directly from the cloud service, starting the installation process.

Install the application using the online APK installer

The online apk installer is a web application created by **XDA-Developers** forum member **htc-hd2** for the purpose of manually installing an **.apk** file more easily. This is useful if you want to share an APK file with your friends because after uploading the APK you want to install, it will generate a **QR code** that you (or friends) can scan on the screen. to start the installation process.

To do this, first navigate to **APKInstall** .

Here you will see a black button " **Browse Files - Browse files** . ". Select this file and select the apk file on your computer.

1 Select your file



Browse Files...

Click on the above "Browse Files..." button, and navigate to the .apk file what you would like to install on your Android device.

When uploading a file, a QR code will appear on the website.

2 Scan QR code with camera

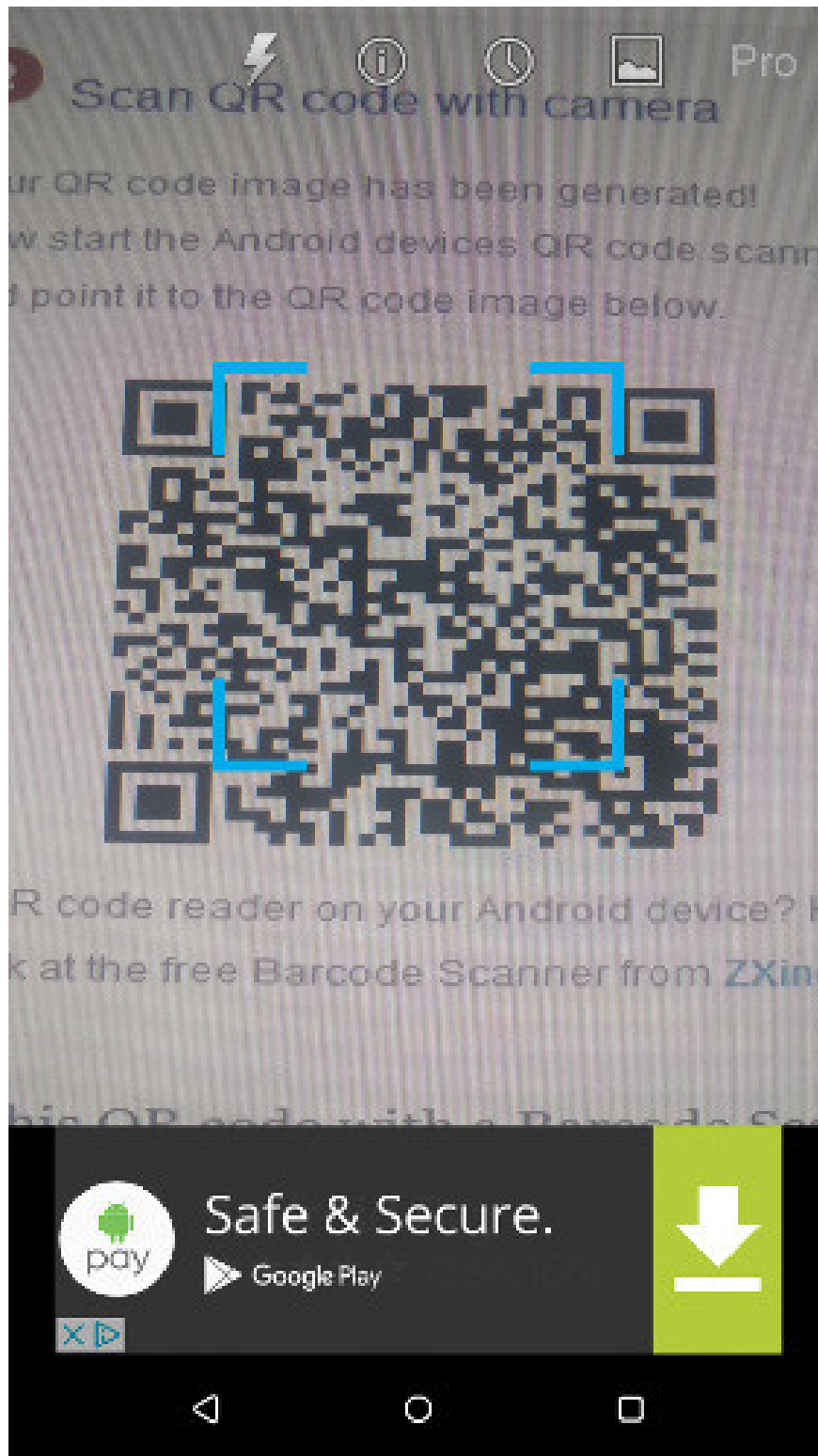
Your QR code image has been generated!

Now start the Android devices QR code scanner and point it to the QR code image below.



No QR code reader on your Android device? Have a look at the free Barcode Scanner from [ZXing](#).

You must scan this QR code with a **barcode scanner** . We recommend using QR Code Reader and we find that Unlimited QR Code Reader is also not bad.



When the QR code has been scanned, you can click on the link to download the **.apk** file straight to your device.

After the **.apk** file has downloaded to your Android device, you can install it by touching in the notification menu or find the file in the file manager and follow the instructions on the phone screen. .
