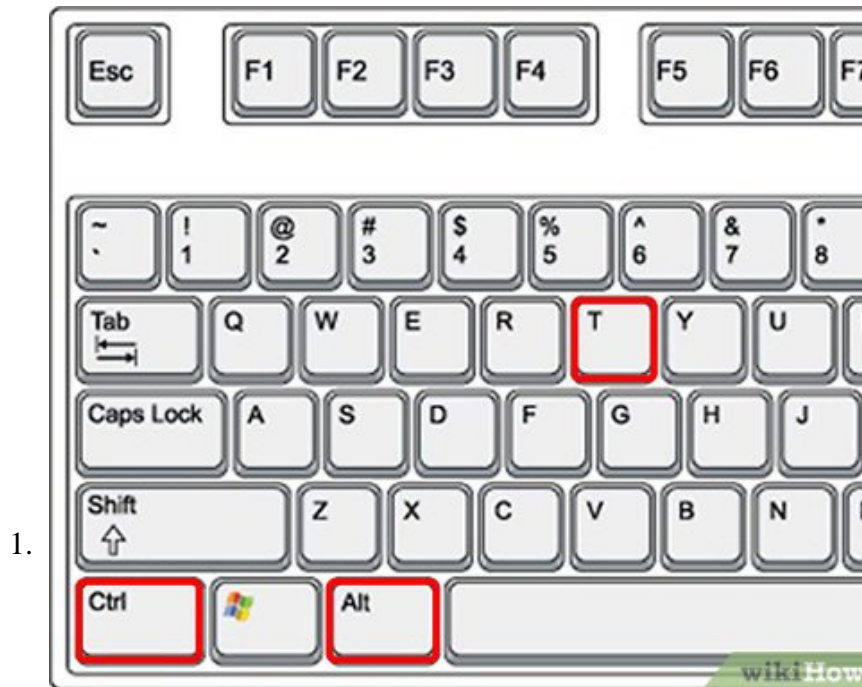


# How to Install Ubuntu Tweak 0.5.1 in Ubuntu

If you want to install this package manually, just go to their homepage. There you will be able to see which versions are available and which version you need. Second way is to install this application through Terminal using three simple...


Method 1 of 2:

## Use Keyboard Shortcut Or Main Menu To Open The Terminal



To open Terminal, press **Ctrl+Alt+T** on your keyboard or go to **Applications > Accessories > Terminal** (which is located in main menu) to add repository of Ubuntu Tweak.



~$ sudo add-apt-repository ppa:tualatrix/ppa
```

To do this you need to type following command or to use copy/paste method: `sudo add-apt-repository ppa:tualatrix/ppa`

```

Now hit Enter, after that when it asks you for password, type the password and hit Enter.

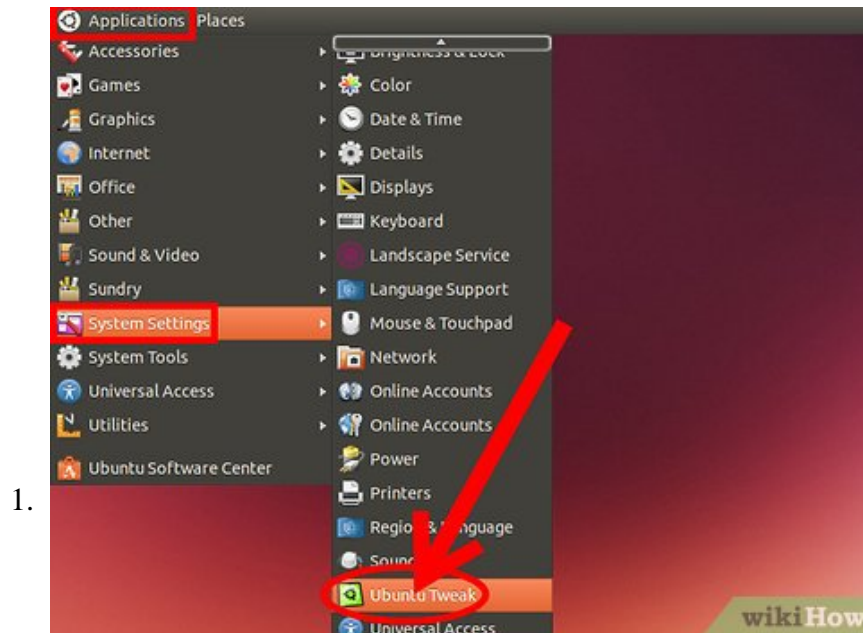
