3. **Here's a simple solution:** Phone straps are easy to use, and just a small change can make a big difference in keeping your phone safe.

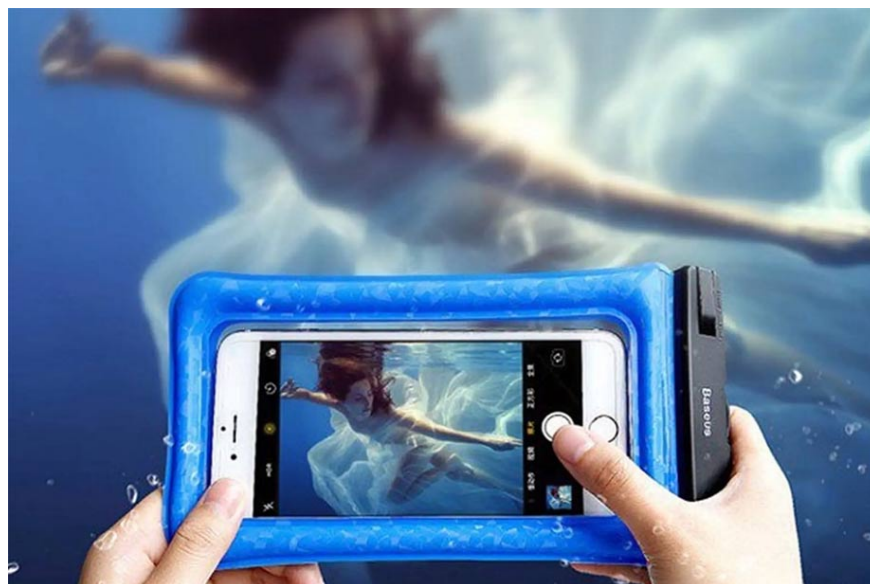
### **Bring essentials with you**
