TV control feature by phone

Most of Smart TVs today support TV control by phone through applications developed by other companies. For example, Samsung TV has Samsung Smart View application, LG TV has LG TV Plus application (or LG TV Remote), Sony TV has Video & TV SideView application, TCL TV is T-Cast, Panasonic TV is Panasonic TV Remote 2,.



To check, download and install the TV control applications with the phone above. Then, launch the application and search for the TV, if the app can find your home TV, it shows that the TV supports this feature and you only

need to do the next connection.

Note: Phones and TVs must catch a Wi-Fi network together.

Check whether the TV features a miracast phone screen

This feature is only available on Smart TV and Internet TV, please see the instructions to check the screen feature of phone screen on some Smart TV, Internet TV below to know how to do it.

For LG TV: On the TV control, press the **Home** button (house icon)> search for **Screen Share** . If yes, that means the TV has a feature to project the phone screen.

For Samsung TV: Press **SOURCE** button on remote> if Screen Mirroring is available, the TV has this feature.

For TCL TV: Press the **Home** button on remote> find out if there is **T-Cast** application, if so, the TV has this feature (only some new TCL TV models support Miracast screen projection in T-app Casst).



For Sony TV: Click **Input** button on remote> if **Screen Mirroring** is available, the TV has this feature.

For Toshiba TVs: Press the **Home** button on remote> if **Screen Mirroring** is available, the TV has this feature.

For Panasonic TVs: Press the **Home** button on remote> to the application section if there is item **Mirror** (or Screen Mirroring) then the TV has this feature.

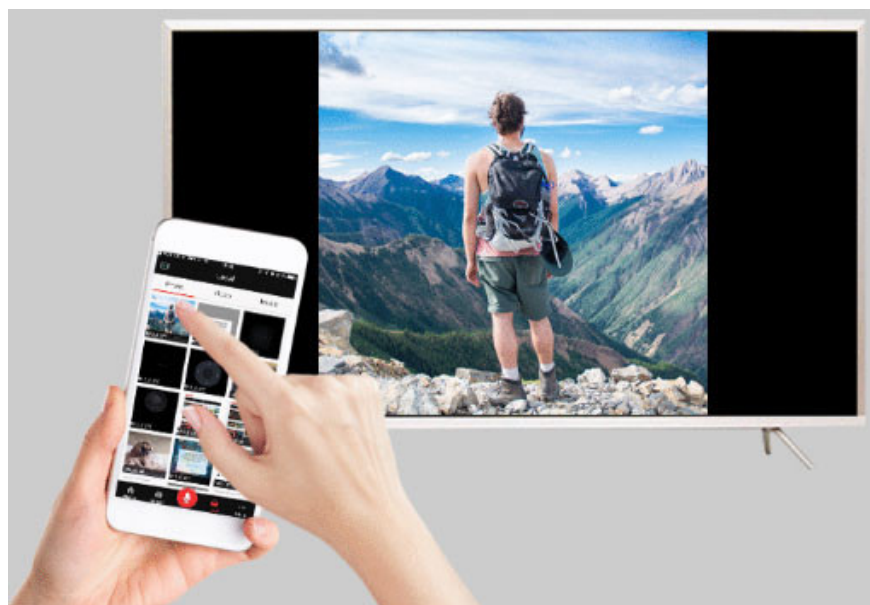
In addition, you can check right on your phone by opening the screen projection feature, if the phone detects the TV, it proves that the TV supports phone screen projection.

Check if the TV has an HDMI port (MHL)

The easiest way to know if the TV is connected to the phone is to watch it on a TV with an HDMI port. If so, congratulations because surely the TV supports the connection with the phone via the MHL port. Similarly, you must also check if your phone supports MHL connection. If so, you can absolutely connect to the phone.

Check other wireless connection features (DLNA, Wifi Display, .)

Of course, these wireless connectivity features are only available on Smart TV or Internet TV, and TVs are usually not available. The simple test is as follows, you let two devices catch the same Wi-Fi network then open any image on the phone. There will usually be a connection section, allowing you to share this picture. If you find the phone detects the name of the TV, you can confirm that the TV supports the sharing of pictures, music, . from the phone to the TV.
