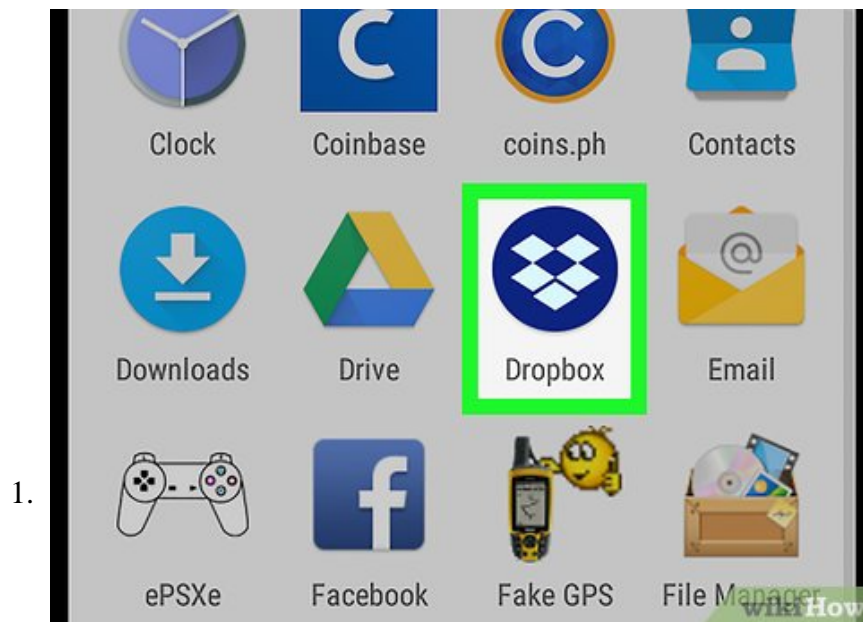


# How to Link a Computer on Dropbox on Android

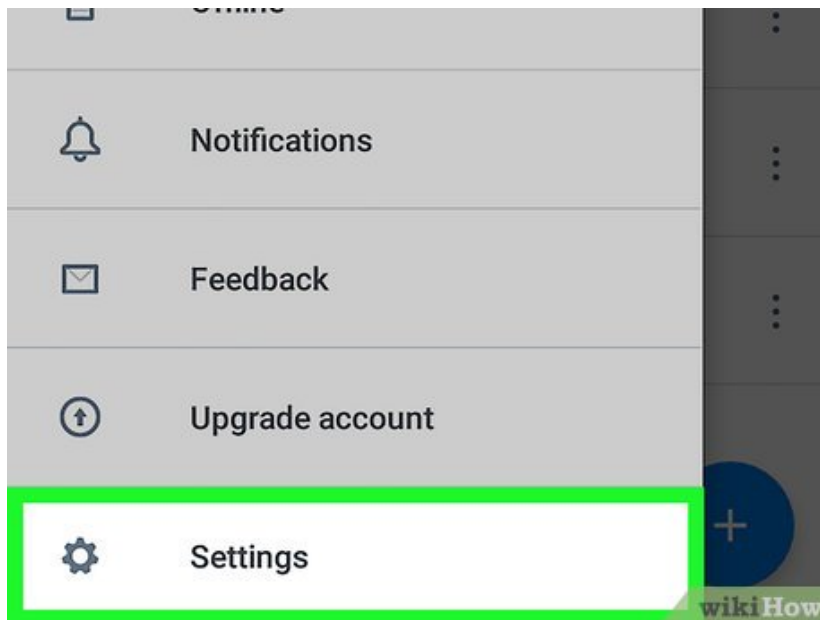
**Open Dropbox on the Android.** It's the blue icon with a white open box inside. You'll usually find it in the app drawer.

1. You must be able to access the computer to use this method.




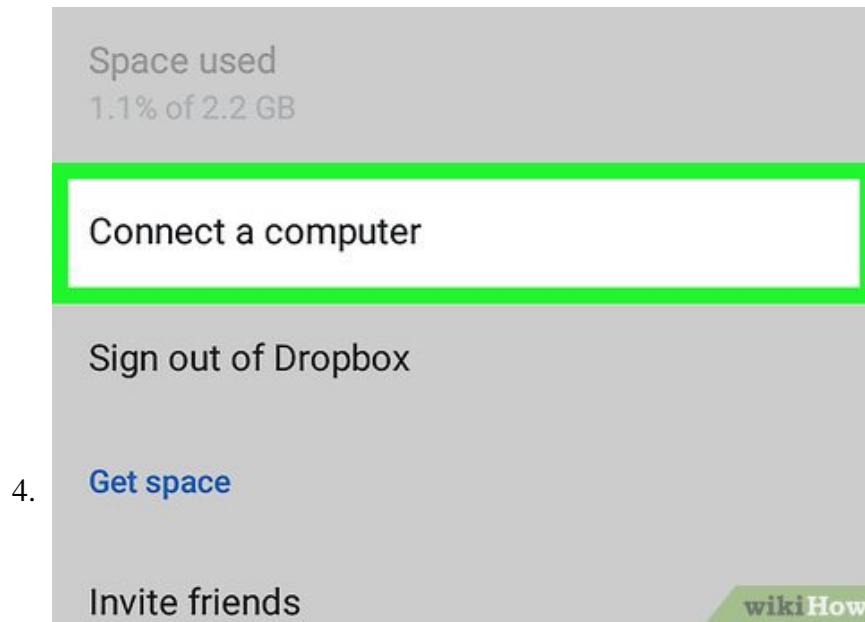

Tap **Connect a computer**. It's under the 'Dropbox account' header.

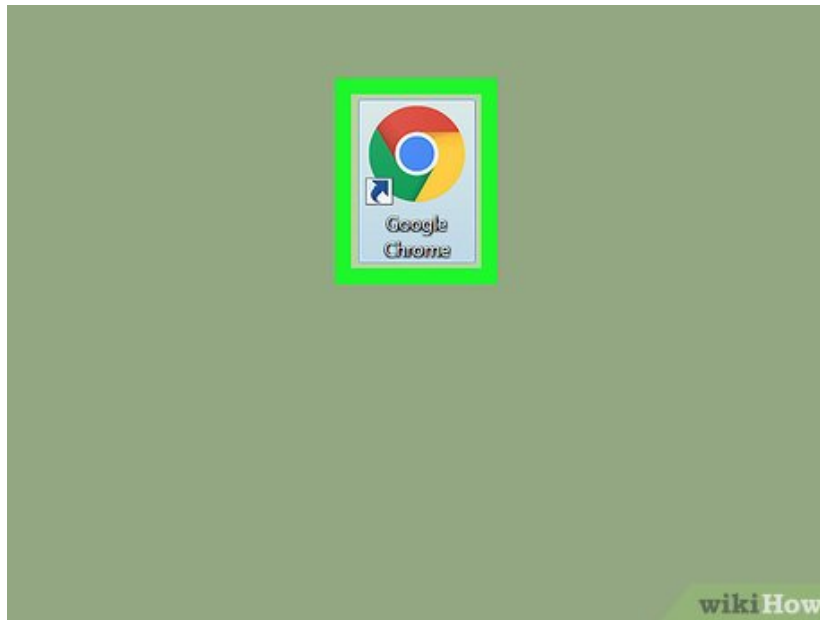


Tap **YES, CONTINUE**.

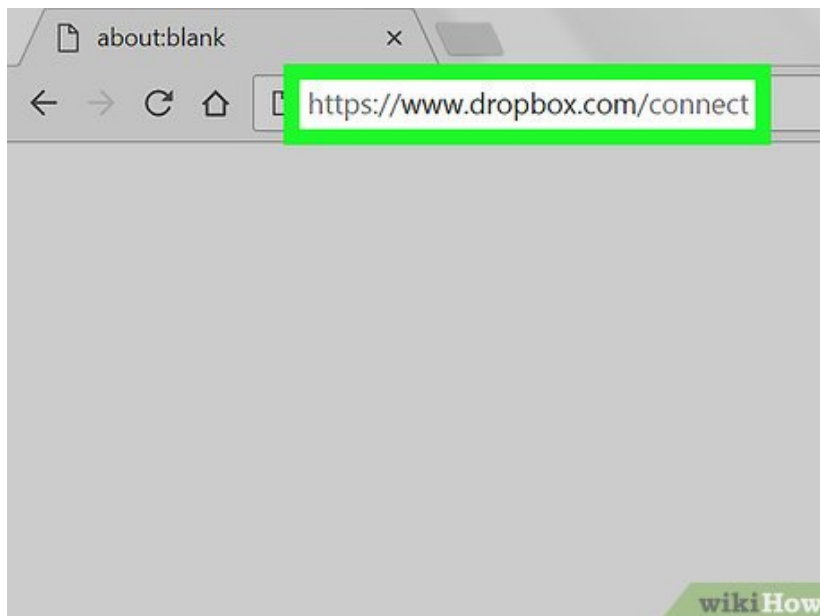
## Connecting the Computer

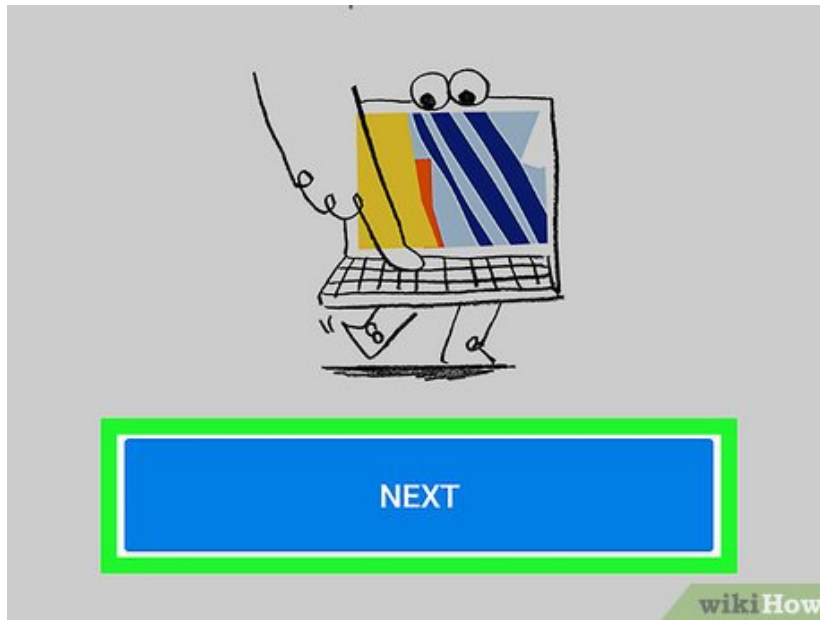


**Open a web browser on your computer.** You can use any browser, such as Chrome, Firefox, or Safari.

2.



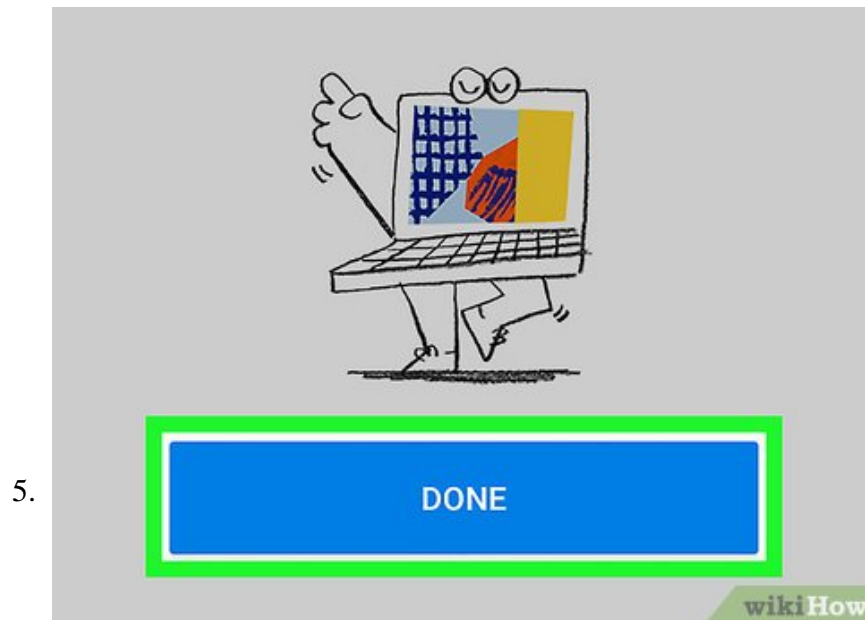
**Navigate to <https://www.dropbox.com/connect>.** A website with a QR code will appear.



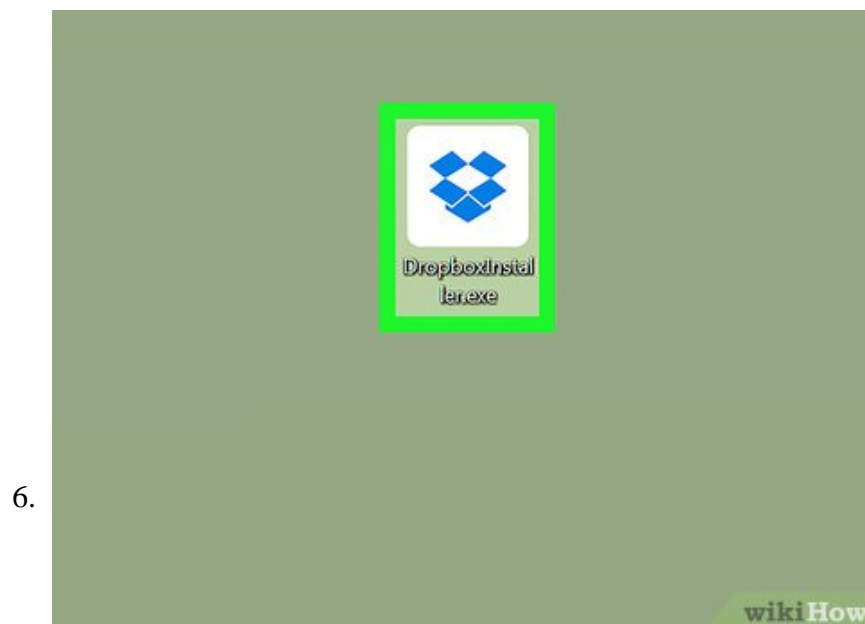
Tap **NEXT** on your Android. This opens a screen with a camera lens.



**Aim the Android's camera at the QR code on the computer.** Once the code is properly aligned, Dropbox will automatically scan it, and you will be logged into Dropbox on the computer.



Tap **DONE** on the Android.



**Install Dropbox on the computer.** Now that the computer is connected to Dropbox, you'll be prompted to install Dropbox for PC or macOS.<sup>[1]</sup> Follow the prompts to complete the installation.
